COMPLIMENTARY ADMISSIONS



Comp Tickets

□ Prospects

■ Official Visit—3 complimentary admissions.

- Must show photo ID!!!
- 1 additional for the student host. Extra Complimentary admissions should not be used for additional CU student-athletes.
- Up to 2 additional tickets for step-parents (non-traditional families).

■ Unofficial Visit—3 complimentary admissions.

- Must show photo ID!!!
- No student host tickets for UOV
- Up to 2 additional tickets for step-parents (non-traditional).

Comp Tickets

- High School, Club, Two-Year College Coaches
 - ▣ Maximum 2 complimentary admissions to HOME events.
 - Must show photo ID!!!
 - Must be a coach!
 - Cannot be used for 4-year college coaches, professional coaches, friends of coaches.
- Selling your tickets
 - ▣ CU Coaches cannot sell their tickets (even for face value) to student-athletes, their family/friends, prospects, PSA coaches, etc.
 - ▣ They must purchase the tickets by regular means, through the ticket office.

Comp Tickets

□ Student-Athlete Tickets

- Student-athletes should not be leaving tickets for staff members —we also caution you on having your SAs leave tickets for scholarship donors/ boosters—it is permissible, but keep an eye on this!
- Student-athletes cannot sell or exchange their tickets for anything of value.

□ Booster Tickets

- Boosters should not be giving tickets to any event to student-athletes or their friends/family (i.e., CU events, professional events).

VACATION PERIOD REMINDERS



CARA

□ If Your Sport is --Out-of-Season

- CARA is not permissible during the week of finals (December 10-16) and, one week prior (December 2-9).
- Promotional Activities do not count as CARA as long as it is not required.
- CARA can begin again on the 1st day of classes for the spring, Tuesday, January 17, 2012.
 - Unless your spring 'in season' begins prior to that date.

CARA

□ If Your Sport is --- In-Season

- CARA is permissible during the week of finals (December 10-15th) and the week prior (December 2-9), still restricted to the 20 hrs/week, 4 hrs/day, 1 day off.
- The day following the end of finals (December 16) CARA time restrictions no longer apply.
 - Travel departure/return expense restrictions do not apply December 16-January 16.

Employment

- Student-athletes must report employment at **all times!**
This includes brief employment over holiday breaks.
- We have been receiving a number of questions about employment where SAs are asked to use their name, appearance, photo to promote products. Remember, student-athletes cannot promote or endorse commercial products or services at **ANY** time.
 - This includes advertisements with their photos, testimonials, websites with their name in it, posting on Facebook or twitter regarding certain places, products or services.

Holidays!!

□ Gifts

- It is not permissible to give holiday gifts to student-athletes. If you conduct “Secret Santa” it must be between SA s only.

□ Parties

- Occasional Meal is an option if you are having a team gathering for the holidays! Don’t forget to complete the paperwork PRIOR to the meal.

□ Cards to prospects

- You cannot send a specific holiday card to a prospect.
- Remember, your ‘institutional letterhead’ is an option!

OUTSIDE/UNATTACHED COMPETITION



Outside/Unattached Competition

- For sports other than basketball, it is permissible for student-athletes to participate in outside/unattached competition during the academic year.
 - ▣ Cannot engage in this competition as a member of another team or receive expenses from this team, unless it is a vacation period.
- During the academic year, unattached SAs cannot:
 - ▣ Represent CU or wear a CU uniform,
 - ▣ Receive any expenses from CU (meals, travel, lodging, entry fee, etc.), OR
 - ▣ Receive any coaching, athletic training, medical services immediately before, during or after the competition.

Outside/Unattached Competition

- Only during a vacation period a SA may represent another team and receive expenses from that team.
 - ▣ Must be 'out of season'.
 - ▣ Basketball can only use this exception during the summer and in an approved league.
 - ▣ Volleyball and Soccer: Competition cannot take place prior to May 1.
- A few teams and events are exempt from the vacation period time limitation:
 - ▣ Olympic Games
 - ▣ Pan American Games Tryouts and Competition
 - ▣ US National Team
 - ▣ World Championships, World University Games, World Cup Tryouts and Competition

Outside/Unattached Competition

- Any student choosing to participate in outside or unattached competition must complete paperwork with Jo Marchi **prior** to participating in any outside event.
 - ▣ This ensures the event is permissible.
 - ▣ It will affect their eligibility if they do not receive prior approval.
- Unattached competitors should not be identified as CU student-athletes, unless there is a clearly stated 'unattached' or 'individual' status with their name as well.

SPORTS WAGERING REMINDER



GAMBLING REMINDER

- ❑ It is impermissible to wager anything of value (cash, meals, etc.) on a sport sponsored by the NCAA, at any level.
- ❑ Bowl Games
- ❑ Super Bowl
- ❑ NCAA Championship Events
- ❑ Fantasy Leagues
