LEGISLATION ALREADY IN PLACE



Proposal No. 2011-69

ELIGIBILITY -- TRANSFER REGULATIONS -- 2-4 AND 4-2-4 COLLEGE TRANSFERS

To revise the two-year college and 4-2-4 college transfer requirements, as specified.

- 2.50 GPA
- 3 credit hours natural/physical science
- No more than 2 hours of physical education activity courses

ELIGIBILITY -- FRESHMAN ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS -- ELIGIBILITY FOR FINANCIAL AID, PRACTICE AND COMPLETION -- CORE COURSE REQUIREMENTS AND INITIAL-ELIGIBILITY INDEX

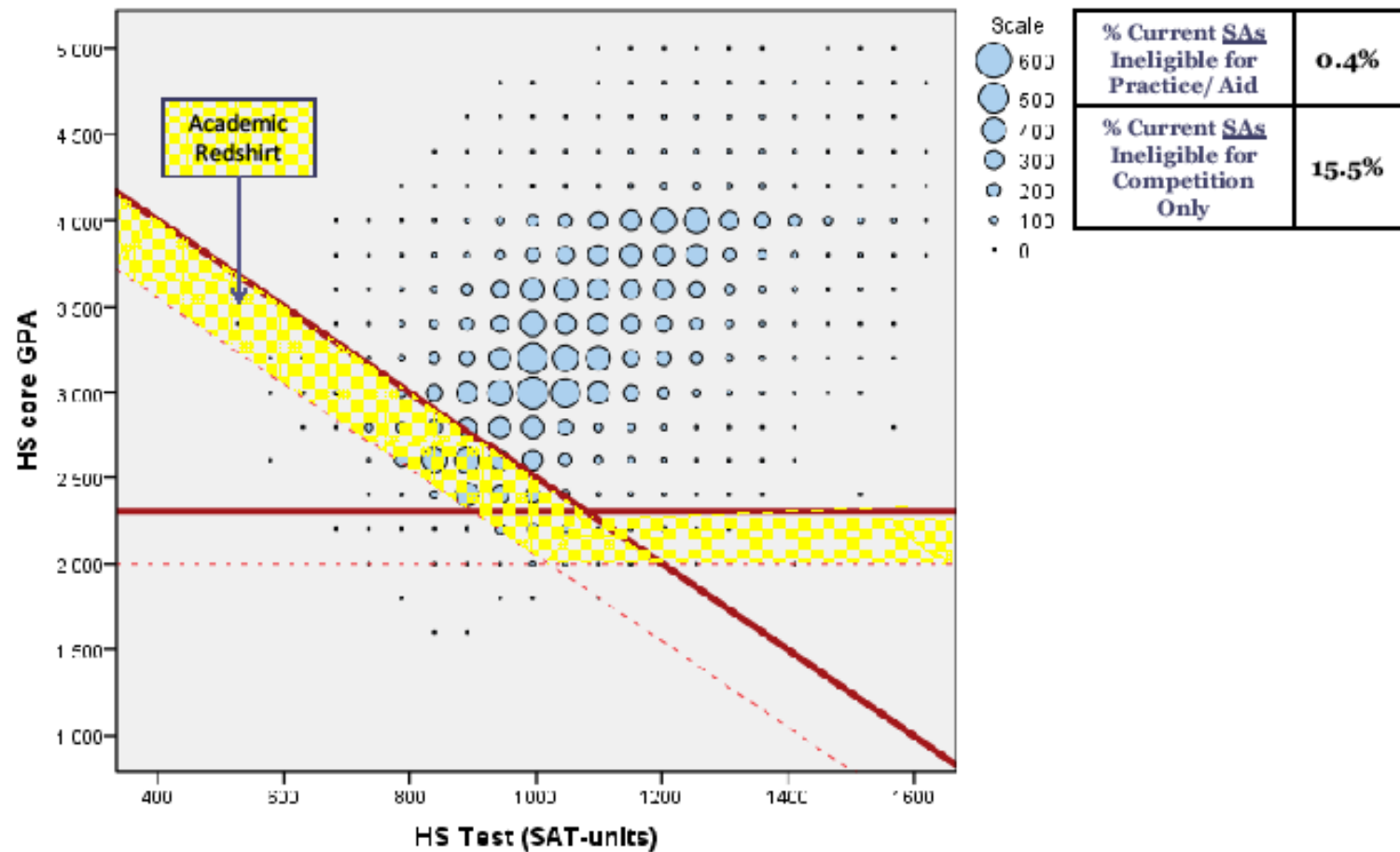
To revise the academic requirements that shall be satisfied for an entering freshman with no previous full-time college attendance to be eligible for financial aid, practice and competition during the first academic year in residence, as specified.

Effective Date:

Immediate – For those first enrolling Aug 1, 2015 or after.

New Initial-Eligibility Standard

Sliding Scale Elevated to ~0.5 SD Below National Mean; 2.30 Floor



Note: All SAs in yellow area would be ineligible for competition only. New sliding scale for competition requires HSCGPA ~ 0.50 units higher for given test score compared to current rule.

ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE PROGRAM --
PENALTIES AND REWARDS -- PENALTIES AND
ACCESS TO POSTSEASON COMPETITION

To revise the NCAA Division I Academic Performance Program, as specified; further, to specify that each conference shall maintain a written policy regarding teams that are subject to a postseason competition restriction with respect to the conference's automatic qualification for postseason competition/championships and revenue distribution.

To establish a new men's basketball recruiting model, as specified.

AMATEURISM -- DEFINITIONS AND APPLICATIONS -- AGENT

To specify that an agent is any individual who, directly or indirectly, represents or attempts to represent an individual for the purpose of marketing his or her athletics ability or reputation for financial gain, or seeks to obtain any type of financial gain or benefit from securing a prospective student-athlete's enrollment at an educational institution or from a student-athlete's potential earnings as a professional athlete.

**AMATEURISM, RECRUITING, ELIGIBILITY AND
AWARDS, BENEFITS AND EXPENSES -- WORLD
UNIVERSITY CHAMPIONSHIPS**

To include the World University Championships in all
bylaws that apply to the World University Games.

I.e.—Outside Competition

AMATEURISM AND EXECUTIVE REGULATIONS -- FINANCIAL DONATIONS AND ADVERTISING AND SPONSORSHIP OF INTERCOLLEGIATE EVENTS -- PROFESSIONAL SPORTS ORGANIZATIONS

To specify that a professional sports organization may serve as a financial sponsor of an intercollegiate competition event, including regular season and postseason events, provided the organization is not publicly identified as such; and that a professional sports organization may serve as a financial sponsor of an activity or promotion that is ancillary to the competition event and may be publicly identified as such; further, to eliminate the prohibition on professional sports organizations or personnel as acceptable advertisers in conjunction with NCAA championships.

**RECRUITING -- BASKETBALL EVALUATIONS --
WOMEN'S BASKETBALL -- EVALUATIONS DURING
ACADEMIC YEAR EVALUATION PERIODS -- LIVE
EVALUATIONS**

In women's basketball, to specify that evaluations of live athletics activities during the academic year evaluation periods (other than permissible nonscholastic events) shall be limited to regularly scheduled high school, preparatory school and two-year college contests/tournaments and practices; and regular scholastic activities involving prospective student-athletes enrolled only at the institution at which the regular scholastic activities occur. **(Change in open gyms!)**

RECRUITING AND FINANCIAL AID -- LETTER-OF- INTENT PROGRAMS, FINANCIAL AID AGREEMENTS - - LETTER OF INTENT RESTRICTION -- LIMITATION ON NUMBER OF SIGNINGS -- BOWL SUBDIVISION FOOTBALL

In bowl subdivision football, to specify that there shall be an annual signing limit of 25 on the number of prospective student-athletes who may sign a National Letter of Intent or institutional offer of financial aid from December 1 through May 31; further to specify that a prospective student-athlete who signs a National Letter of Intent or an institutional offer of financial aid and becomes an initial counter for the same academic year in which the signing occurred (e.g., midyear enrollee) shall not count toward the annual limit on signings.

RECRUITING -- TRYOUTS -- NONSCHOLASTIC
PRACTICE OR COMPETITION AND
NONINSTITUTIONAL CAMPS AND CLINICS --
WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

In women's basketball, to specify that an institution [including any institutional department (e.g., athletics, recreational/intramural)] shall not host, sponsor or conduct a nonscholastic basketball practice or competition in which women's basketball prospective student-athletes participate on its campus or at an off-campus facility regularly used by the institution for practice and/or competition by any of the institution's sport programs, and to establish limited exceptions, as specified; further, to specify that the use of an institution's facilities for noninstitutional camps is limited to the months of June, July and August; finally, to prohibit evaluations at noninstitutional events, camps or clinics that occur on a Division I campus during evaluation periods.

RECRUITING -- TRYOUTS -- NONSCHOLASTIC
PRACTICE OR COMPETITION AND
NONINSTITUTIONAL CAMPS OR CLINICS --
FOOTBALL

In football, to specify that an institution [including any institutional department (e.g., athletics, recreational/intramural)] shall not host, sponsor or conduct a nonscholastic football practice or competition (e.g., seven-on-seven events) in which football prospective student-athletes participate on its campus or at an off-campus facility regularly used by the institution for practice and/or competition by any of the institution's sport programs; further, to limit the use of institutional facilities for noninstitutional camps or clinics that include prospect-aged participants to June and July in bowl subdivision football.

RECRUITING -- USE OF RECRUITING FUNDS -- RECRUITING OR SCOUTING SERVICES -- CRITERIA FOR SUBSCRIPTION

In **sports other than basketball and football**, to specify that an institution may subscribe to a recruiting or scouting service involving prospective student-athletes, provided the service is made available to all institutions desiring to subscribe and at the same fee rate for all subscribers; further, to specify that an institution is permitted to subscribe to a service that provides scholastic and/or nonscholastic video. In **basketball and football**, to eliminate the restriction on subscribing to a service that includes access to nonscholastic video.

**RECRUITING -- USE OF RECRUITING FUNDS --
RECRUITING OR SCOUTING SERVICES -- CRITERIA
FOR SUBSCRIPTION -- NCAA APPROVAL --
BASKETBALL AND FOOTBALL**

In **basketball and football**, to specify that an institution shall not subscribe to a recruiting or scouting service unless the service has been approved by the NCAA pursuant to an annual approval process.

Immediate for implementation, June 1, 2012 for application.

ELIGIBILITY -- GENERAL ELIGIBILITY
REQUIREMENTS -- ELIGIBILITY FORM --
INTERNATIONAL STUDENT-ATHLETE

To eliminate the requirement that the eligibility of an international student-athlete shall be certified on an international student-athlete eligibility form.

ELIGIBILITY -- GENERAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS -- GRADUATE STUDENT/POSTBACCALAUREATE PARTICIPATION -- POSTSEASON EVENT FOLLOWING LAST TERM OF ELIGIBILITY

To specify that a student-athlete who is eligible during the term in which degree work is completed (or is eligible as a graduate) remains eligible for any postseason event that begins within 60 days after the end of the term in which the student completes the requirements for the degree (or graduate eligibility).

**ELIGIBILITY -- FRESHMAN ACADEMIC
REQUIREMENTS -- ADVANCED PLACEMENT --
INTERNATIONAL CERTIFICATION**

To specify that for purposes of fulfilling the advanced placement requirements for initial eligibility, "similar proficiency examination," must be an advanced or higher level, nationally administered proficiency exam with a uniform grading scale that is taken after high school graduation; further, to specify that an institution shall use the NCAA Eligibility Center to certify the eligibility of an international student-athlete pursuant to the advanced placement requirements.

FINANCIAL AID -- SUMMER FINANCIAL AID -- PRIOR TO INITIAL FULL-TIME ENROLLMENT -- FOOTBALL -- COUNTER FOR THE ENSUING ACADEMIC YEAR

In football, to specify that a prospective student-athlete who receives athletically related financial aid during a summer term prior to initial full-time enrollment at the certifying institution shall be an initial and overall counter for the ensuing academic year.

**PLAYING AND PRACTICE SEASONS -- WOMEN'S
BASKETBALL -- PRESEASON PRACTICE -- ON-
COURT PRACTICE -- ELIMINATION OF 5 P.M. START
TIME ON FIRST PERMISSIBLE PRACTICE DATE**

In women's basketball, to eliminate the 5 p.m. start time on the first permissible practice date.

**PLAYING AND PRACTICE SEASONS -- GOLF --
PRESEASON PRACTICE AND FIRST DATE OF
COMPETITION -- EXCEPTION -- TOPY CUP**

In golf, to specify that an institution selected to participate in the Topy Cup may commence practice sessions five days before the practice round of the event and that the institution may participate in the competition before the legislated date for the first date of competition.

COMMITTEES -- ASSOCIATION-WIDE COMMITTEES -- RULES COMMITTEES WITHOUT CHAMPIONSHIPS ADMINISTRATION RESPONSIBILITIES -- SWIMMING AND DIVING, TRACK AND FIELD AND WRESTLING

To establish a separate Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving Rules Committee, a **separate Men's and Women's Track and Field Rules Committee** and a separate Wrestling Rules Committee without championships administration responsibilities, as specified; further, to establish a Division I Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving Committee, a **Division I Men's and Women's Track and Field Committee** and a Division I Wrestling Committee, as specified.

**EXECUTIVE REGULATIONS -- DAY OF COMPETITION
-- NOON START TIME -- EXCEPTION -- MEN'S GOLF
CHAMPIONSHIPS**

In men's golf, to specify that in instances in which the final day of the men's golf championships occurs on a Sunday, competition may begin prior to noon.

- Year of Academic Readiness at 2-year college.
 - This was somehow raised again and is in consideration.
- Football exceptional APR exception.
- WBB first contest date (Tuesday instead of Friday).

- Fifty proposals were tabled.
- Including, but not limited to:
 - Phone call limitations
 - Texting limitations
 - Recruiting materials
 - Noncoaching staff limits
 - Tennis \$10K
 - Contact by relatives of SAs
 - Camp recruiting conversations
 - Bagel Spreads ☹

Future Legislation

- The NCAA has placed a moratorium on legislation for the 2012-2013 academic year.
 - This means the tabled legislation will probably never been seen again as proposals.
- Look for big changes, coming soon to a NCAA Manual near you.
 - The Rules Working Group is evaluating the manual and its fairness.
 - Looking for meaningful and enforceable rules that contribute to student success.

Postseason Access

A team with a multiyear APR below 930 is ineligible for postseason competition.

Postseason competition is any event that occurs after the regular season or conference tournament.

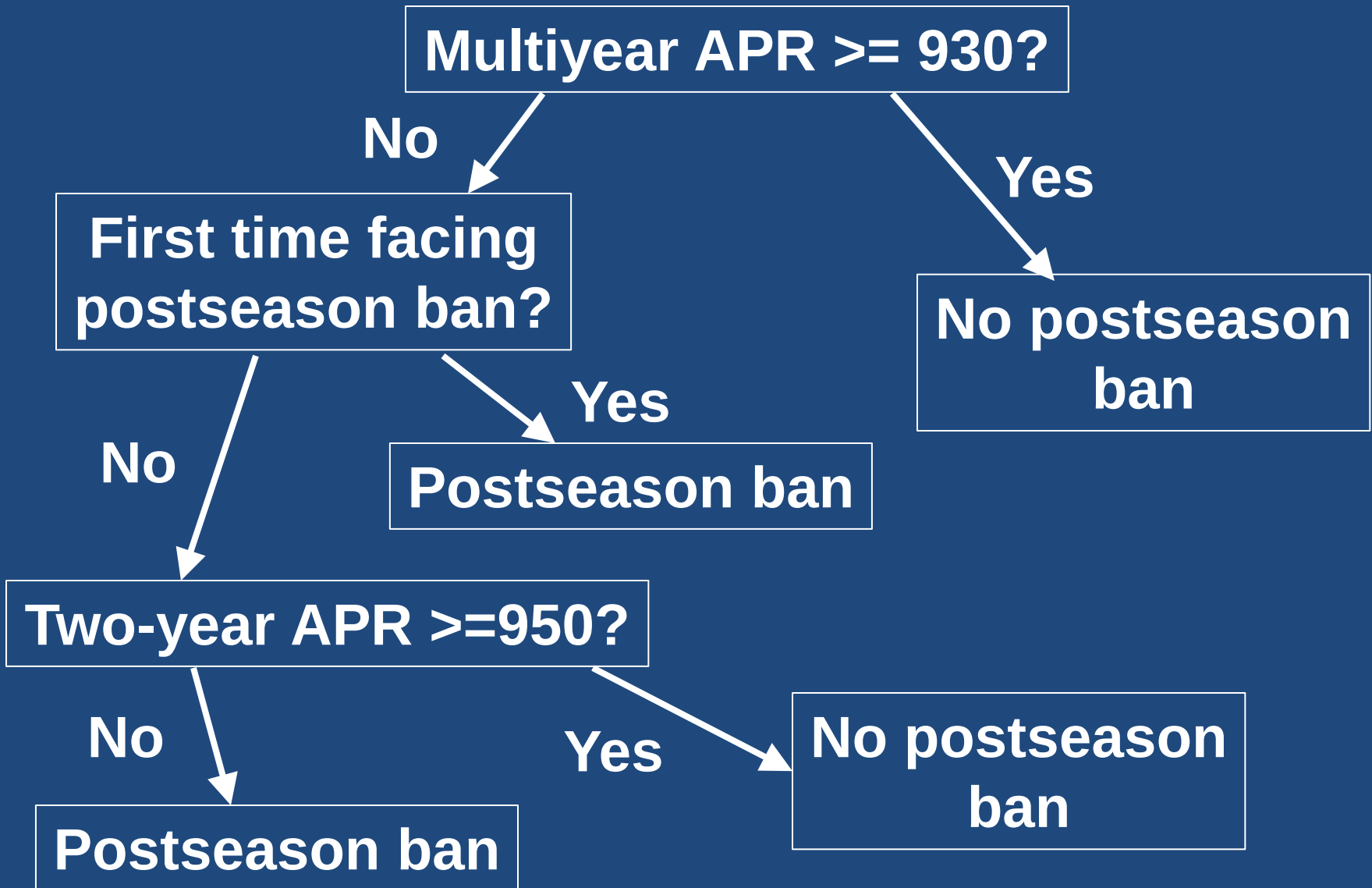
- **football -- bowl game**
- **basketball -- NCAA, NIT, WNIT**
- **other -- NCAA regional or final**

Note: Multiyear APR refers to the four-year APR calculation.

Transition Period

- 2012-13 Multiyear APR > 900 or
two-year APR > 930**
- 2013-14 Multiyear APR > 900 or
two-year APR > 930**
- 2014-15 Multiyear APR > 930 or
two-year APR > 940**
- 2015- Multiyear APR > 930**

Postseason access -- 2015-16 and after



Note: there are exceptions for low-resource institutions. 39

Penalty Structure

Sub-930 Multiyear APR first occurrence

Level 1

- 4-hour reduction in weekly practice time
- additional day off
- 4 hours must be replaced by structured academic activities

Penalty Structure

Sub-930 Multiyear APR

second occurrence

Level 1 plus

Level 2

- eliminate participation in non-championship segment, if applies, e.g., no spring football

or

- 10% reduction in playing and practice season and competition

Penalty Structure

**Sub-930 Multiyear APR
third occurrence**

**Level 1 plus Level 2 plus
Level 3**

self-imposed penalties from menu

- **financial aid (scholarship reduction)**
- **additional practice restrictions**
- **additional contest reductions**
- **restricted membership**
- **coach-specific game & recruiting**
- **restricted access to practice for incoming student-athletes**
- **multiyear postseason ban**

Penalty Structure

Three "clean" years required to reset the penalty sequence.
