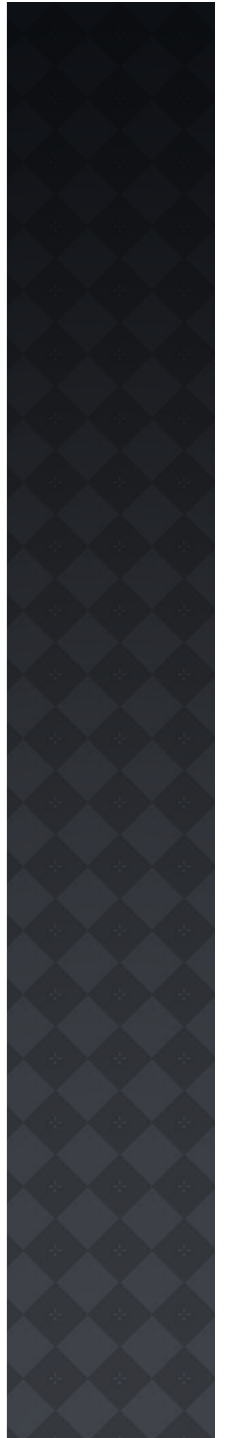

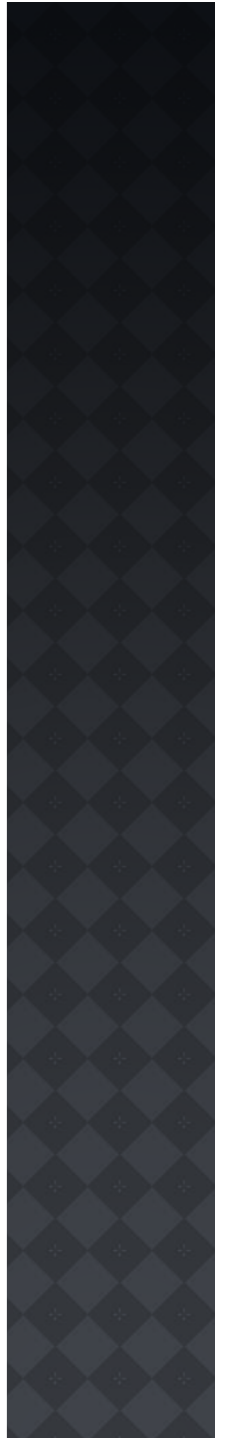

# PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITIES

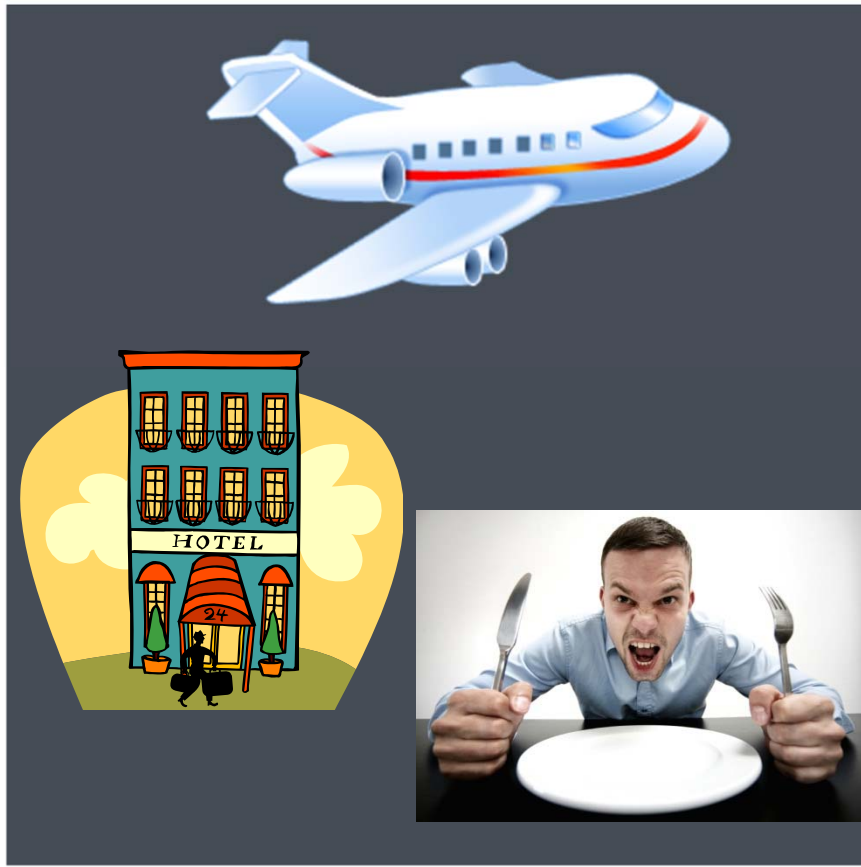
## ◎ General Rule: 12.5.1.1

- A university entity, the Pac-12 Conference, or a charitable, educational, or non-profit agency may use a CU student-athlete's name, picture or appearance to support its charitable or educational activities if conditions are met:
- SA must receive written approval from AD or designee
- **SA cannot miss class**
- Incoming PSAs may not be in attendance

# PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITIES

- ◉ All money derived from the activity must go directly to the University, conference or the CENA
- ◉ SAs can receive actual and necessary expenses from CU or CENA related to participation.
- ◉ The activity may NOT involved co-sponsorship, advertisement or promotion by a commercial entity (other than the sponsoring company's trademark or logo on printed items)
  - Company's emblem, name, address and number may be included with logo/trademark
  - Personal names, messages and slogans are prohibited.

## OFFICIAL VISITS

# OFFICIAL VISITS

- ⦿ Cannot take an Official Visit until the first day of classes their senior year.
  - MBB, January 1<sup>st</sup> of Junior year.
- ⦿ Cannot take more than 1 official visit to any institution, with not more than 5 official visits total.
  - Multi-sport athletes are limited to 5 total visits!
- ⦿ 48-hour limit on official visits.
  - Begins when the PSA arrives on campus,
  - Begins when a CU coach picks up the PSA from their home, or
  - Begins when you have a 'sit down' meal on the way to CU from DIA.

# OFFICIAL VISITS

- ◎ CU can provide transportation expenses for the prospect.
  - MBB can provide for two parents/legal guardians.
- ◎ Mileage can be reimbursed for the round trip.
  - If riding in car with HS or club coach, mileage cannot be reimbursed.
- ◎ Cannot pay car rental fees or insurance.
- ◎ A CU coach can pick up a prospect, but the 48-hour time period starts immediately.

# OFFICIAL VISITS

- ◎ Requirements for an official visit:
  - Turn PSA card into Dee.
  - With PSA card include transcripts and test score.
  - PSA must be registered with the NCAA Eligibility Center and be on CU's IRL.
  - Turn the following forms into Jo:
    - Official Visit Checklist
    - Student Host Form
    - Detailed Itinerary

# OFFICIAL VISITS

- ◎ CU can provide 3 meals per day during an official visit, as well as a snack.
- ◎ CU can provide a meal while the PSA is in transit to CU.
  - Pick PSA up from airport and go through 'drive through' -48 hours does not start.
  - Pick PSA up from airport and have a 'sit down' meal -48 hours has started.
- ◎ Meals can be provided to a PSA and their parents/guardians. No siblings, aunts, uncles, grandmother, grandfather, coaches, etc.

# OFFICIAL VISITS

- ⦿ Pac-12 per diem limit of \$70 has been lifted.
- ⦿ CU's \$50 per meal limit is still in effect.
- ⦿ Impermissible Restaurants:
  - Brasserie Ten Ten
  - Flagstaff House
  - Greenbriar Inn
  - John Elway's Restaurant\*
  - L'Absinthe Restaurant
  - L'Atelier
  - Q's in the Hotel Boulderado
  - Red Lion Inn

# OFFICIAL VISITS

- ◉ Lodging must be standard rooms. No mountain views at the St. Julian, no jacuzzi suites, etc.
- ◉ CU can pay for a prospect's room as well as the parent/legal guardian's room. Cannot pay additional fees for siblings or other family members to stay.
- ◉ No decorating or altering the rooms for the prospect.

# OFFICIAL VISITS

- ◉ Host money has increased from \$30/day to \$40 per day.
- ◉ Can receive an additional \$20/day for additional prospects.
- ◉ All entertainment costs must come out of the host money. PSAs cannot supplement the student host money with their own money.

# OFFICIAL VISITS

- ◎ CU's recruiting policy is in effect for ALL official visits.
- ◎ Midnight curfew, must check in with coaching staff or operations staff member.
- ◎ PSAs cannot be in the PRESENCE of drugs and/or alcohol. It is the host's eligibility that is at stake—please remind them!

## CU VS. CSU 2012

- ◎ This game is considered a HOME game for CU for the 2012 year, therefore CU may provide complimentary admissions for prospects on both official and unofficial visits.
- ◎ CU may also provide tickets to HS coaches, maximum 2 tickets.

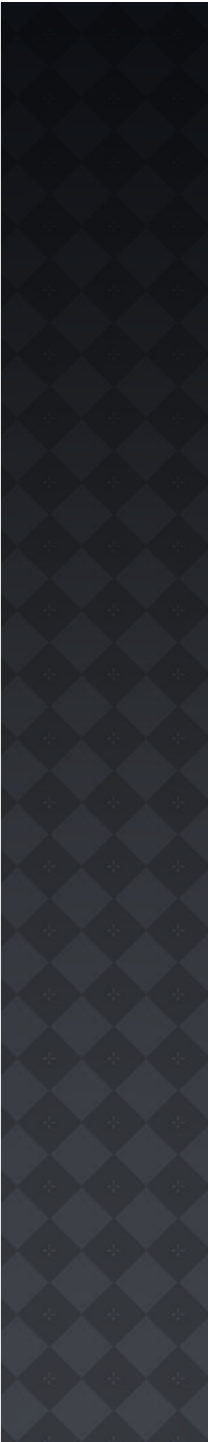
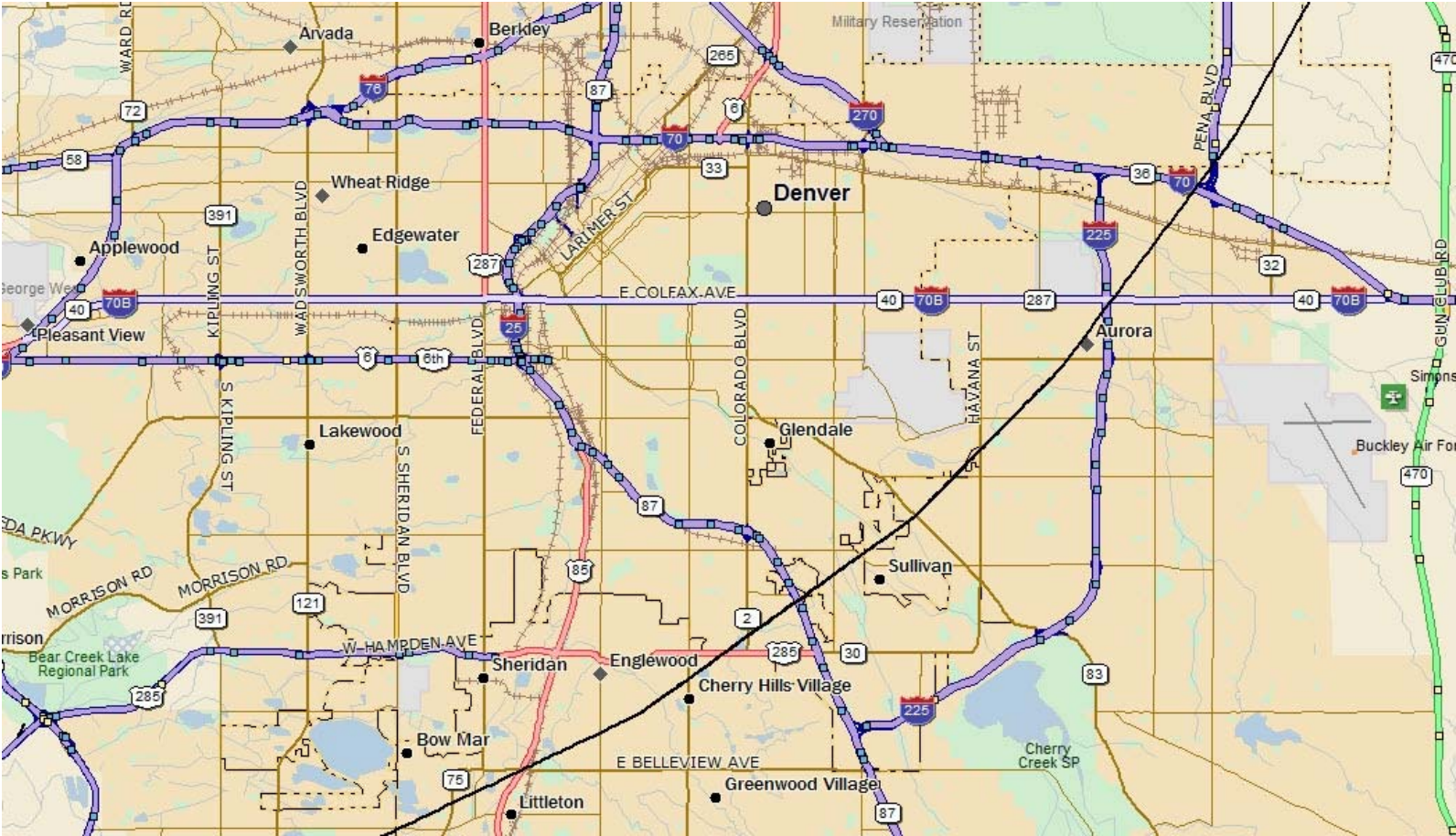
# CU VS. CSU 2012

## ◎ OFFICIAL VISITS:

- May provide three tickets, five if nontraditional family.
- May provide transportation and parking for the game.
- May have a meal in the area of the game—please be mindful of the 30-mile radius.

# CU VS. CSU 2012

## ◎ UNOFFICIAL VISITS:

- Only three tickets—did not change with new legislation.
- May NOT provide transportation to the game.
- May NOT have a meal in the area of the game, unless you are utilizing one of your three permissible contacts with a **senior**.
  - SENIORS ONLY!
  - Must be during contact period.
  - They must pay for their meal.
  - Be aware of the # of coaches you have recruiting off-campus at one time.

# CU VS. CSU 2012

## ◎ Staff Tickets

- Staff Tickets are typically club seats.
- These tickets cannot be provided to prospects or their family or coaches.
- It is permissible for PSAs to be in the club prior to but not during the game. The same goes for being on the field (if SA Field allows this.)

# WRITTEN OFFERS OF AID

- ◎ Starting August 1<sup>st</sup> prior to a prospect's senior year in high school, CU may provide a written offer of aid. This includes handwritten letters as well as emails.
- ◎ Obviously, the official financial aid agreement cannot be sent until the NLI is sent, but you can provide a written offer at this point.
- ◎ Do not email in their junior year regarding an offer of aid!

# ELIGIBILITY CENTER

- ◉ If you'd like to do so, you can conduct your own review of a PSA's transcript.
- ◉ You can view their high school's approved core list (aka, 48-H) via the eligibility center website:

# ELIGIBILITY CENTER

- ⦿ Ensure the courses you are counting are on the 48-H.
- ⦿ Be aware of specifics.
  - “=” is a course counted for EID students only
  - Some courses have a maximum number of credits, which may not be a full unit.
  - The course name must be exact in order to count.
  - “A” or “H” courses could have weighted GPAs.

# NCAA INTERPRETATION

- ◉ Staff Interpretation Meals and Lodging while in Transit to Official Visit -- Sports Other Than Men's Basketball (I)
- ◉ Date Published: July 26, 2012
  
- ◉ The academic and membership affairs staff reviewed issues related to meals and lodging for prospective student-athletes while in transit to an official visit in sports other than men's basketball and confirmed the following:
- ◉ a. A prospective student-athlete may receive lodging in the locale of the institution without beginning the 48-hour official visit period in instances in which he or she arrives in the locale too late to begin the official visit that day. Such expenses may not be provided for any other individual who is accompanying the prospective student-athlete on the official visit (e.g., parents, spouse) prior to the start of the 48-hour official visit period, including the cost of additional occupants in the same room.
- ◉ b. A prospective student-athlete may receive a drive-thru or "to-go" meal while in transit with an athletics department staff member from the major airport or bus or train station nearest the institution without beginning the 48-hour official visit period. Such expenses may not be provided for any other individual who is accompanying the prospective student-athlete on the official visit (e.g., parents, spouse, children) prior to the start of the 48-hour official visit period.

# NCAA INTERPRETATION

- ◉ c. A prospective student-athlete may receive a "sit-down" meal at the major airport or bus or train station nearest the institution while accompanied by an athletics department staff member at the time of his or her arrival for an official visit or a "sit-down" or "drive-in" meal en route to the institution's campus with an athletics department staff member, even if such a meal occurs outside a 30-mile radius of the institution's campus; however, such a meal begins the 48-hour official visit period. Under these circumstances, the prospective student-athlete's parents (or legal guardians), spouse and/or children may also receive such a meal.
- ◉ d. A prospective student-athlete may receive a meal at or in the vicinity of his or her place of lodging without beginning the 48-hour official visit period in instances in which he or she arrives in the locale of the institution too late to begin the official visit that day, provided no athletics department staff members or student-athletes are present during the meal. Such expenses may not be provided for any other individual who is accompanying the prospective student-athlete on the official visit (e.g., parents, spouse, children) prior to the start of the 48-hour official visit period.

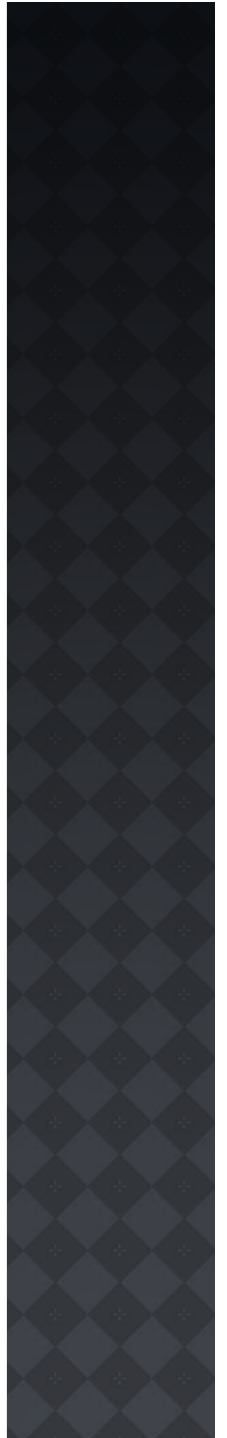
