New Legislation



New Legislation

The NCAA Board of Directors met last month and voted on the new working group proposals.

25 proposals were adopted, most with an August 1, 2013 effective date.

1 proposal was tabled, with hopes of a solution in April. This was for a uniform start date for recruiting.



New Legislation

All 25 adopted proposals are currently in a '60-day override period'.

This means, with enough votes against the legislation, the proposal could be reconsidered.

A proposal needs 75 votes to be reviewed and 125 votes to be suspended.

New Legislation

This is also pending any conference or institutional policies put into place.

Budget will be a large discussion piece.

The NCAA should be releasing more specifics in the near future.



2-1

Which will establish the commitments that guide the underlying operating bylaws. This includes a commitment to fair competition, which “acknowledges that variability will exist among members in advantages, including facilities, geographic location and resources and that such variability should not be justification for future legislation.” It also includes a commitment to diversity and inclusion.

Effective August 1, 2013

11-2

Which will eliminate the rules defining recruiting coordination functions that must be performed only by a head or assistant coach.

- **Placing Telephone Calls**
- **Evaluating and Selecting PSAs**
- **Still no off-campus recruiting**

Effective August 1, 2013

11-3-B

Which will prohibit the live scouting of future opponents except in limited circumstances.

- **Can scout at tournaments.**

Effective August 1, 2013

11-4

Which will remove limits on the number of coaches who can recruit off-campus at any one time, the so-called “baton rule.”

- **Recruiting Person Days still in effect.**
- **No need to return to campus if being replaced.**

Effective August 1, 2013

12-1

Which will establish a uniform definition of actual and necessary expenses.

- (a) Meals;
- (b) Lodging;
- (c) Apparel, equipment and supplies;
- (d) Coaching and instruction;
- (e) Health/medical insurance;
- (f) Transportation (expenses to and from practice and competition, cost of transportation from home to training/practice site at the beginning of the season/preparation for an event and from training/practice/event site to home at the end of season/event);
- (g) Medical treatment and physical therapy;
- (h) Facility usage;
- (i) Entry fees; and
- (j) Other reasonable expenses.

Effective August 1, 2013



12-2

Which will allow the calculation of actual and necessary expenses to be based on the total over a calendar year instead of an event-by-event basis for both prospective and enrolled student-athletes.

- **January – December.**

Effective August 1, 2013

12-3

Which will allow a student-athlete to receive \$300 more than actual and necessary expenses, provided the expenses come from an otherwise permissible source.

- **Event Sponsor**
- **Club Team**

- **Must be permissible outside competition.**

Effective August 1, 2013



12-4

Which will permit individuals to receive actual and necessary competition-related expenses from outside sponsors, so long as the person is not an agent, booster or representative of a professional sports organization.

Effective August 1, 2013



12-5

Which will allow student-athletes in sports other than tennis to receive up to actual and necessary competition-related expenses based on performance from an amateur team or event sponsor.

- Prize money based on his or her place finish or performance in an athletics event (no longer restricted to 'open').
- Prize money may not exceed actual and necessary expenses
- May be provided only by the sponsor of the event.
- Calculation of actual and necessary expenses shall not include the expenses or fees of anyone other than the individual (e.g., coach's fees or expenses, parent's expenses).

Effective August 1, 2013



12-6

Which will allow student-athletes and prospects to receive actual and necessary expenses for training, coaching, health insurance and the like from a governmental entity.

- **This is in addition to the NGB/USOC.**
- **Example: British Columbia Athlete Assistance Program.**

Effective August 1, 2013



13-1

Which will allow schools to treat prospects like student-athletes for purposes of applying recruiting regulations once a National Letter of Intent or signed offer of admission or financial aid is received.

- **Recruiting Rules ONLY.**
- **Extra Benefit legislation is still applicable.**

Effective August 1, 2013

13-3

Which will eliminate restrictions on methods and modes of communication during recruiting.

- **September 1 of junior year, unlimited email, text messages, chat.**
- **July 1 prior to senior year, unlimited phone calls.**
- **No longer need OV, NLI exceptions.**

Effective **July 1, 2013**

13-4

Which will eliminate the requirement that institutions provide materials such as the banned-drug list and Academic Progress Rate data to recruits.

- **Eligibility Center already does this.**

Effective August 1, 2013

13-5-A

Which will eliminate restrictions on sending printed recruiting materials to recruits. Conferences still will be prohibited from sending printed recruiting materials.

- **September 1st of junior year is still the start date.**
- **Can still send NCAA, academic info, questionnaires and camp brochures at any time.**
- **Website may contain ‘items created for recruiting purposes’.**

Effective **July 1, 2013**

13-7

Which will eliminate restrictions on publicity once a prospective student-athlete has signed a National Letter of Intent or written offer of financial aid or admission.

- **Still can only confirm recruitment prior to signing.**
- **No limit on publicity once they sign.**

Effective August 1, 2013



13-8

Which will deregulate camps and clinics employment rules related to both recruits and current student-athletes. Senior football prospects will be allowed to participate in camps and clinics.

- PSAs can be employed, provided they have signed a NLI, written offer of admission or submitted financial deposit.
- Can only be paid for work actually performed and at the going rate. Cannot be paid for only demonstrating or lecturing. Cannot be paid based on reputation.
- No limit on the number of FB SAs that can be employed.

Effective August 1, 2013

14-1

Which will eliminate academic regulations that are covered elsewhere and directly supported by institutional academic policy.

- **45 day temporary certification period for practice for both recruited and non-recruited students.**
- **Degree Declaration date removed, should be covered by institutional policy.**
- **HS All-Star Game Limits are lifted.**

Effective August 1, 2013



16-1

Which will allow institutions, conferences or the NCAA national office to provide an award to student-athletes any time after initial full-time enrollment.

Effective August 1, 2013



16-2

Which will allow conferences, an institution, the U.S. Olympic Committee, a national governing body or the awarding agency to provide actual and necessary expenses for a student-athlete to receive a non-institutional award or recognition for athletics or academic accomplishments. Expenses can also be provided for parents/legal guardians, a spouse or other relatives.

Effective August 1, 2013



16-3

Which will allow institutions, conferences or the NCAA to pay for other academic support, career counseling or personal development services that support the success of the student-athlete.

- **Removes ‘typewriters’ and non-electronic day planner from legislation.**

Effective August 1, 2013

16-4

Which will allow institutions, conferences or the NCAA to pay for medical and related expenses for a student-athlete.

- **Cleans up the legislation to allow an institution to pay medical bills at its discretion.**

Effective August 1, 2013

16-5

Which, except in limited circumstances, will change all Bylaw 16 references to a student-athlete's spouse, parents, family members or children to "family member," establish a specific definition of "family member," and permit specified benefits to such individuals.

- **An institution is in the best position to determine who is a 'family member'.**

Effective August 1, 2013

16-6

Which will allow institutions to provide reasonable entertainment in conjunction with competition or practice.

- **No 100 mile radius on away trips.**
- **No 30 mile radius for vacation periods.**

Effective August 1, 2013



16-7

Which will allow schools to provide actual and necessary expenses to student-athletes representing the institution in practice and competition (including expenses for activities/travel that are incidental to practice or competition) as well as in noncompetitive events such as goodwill tours and media appearances.

- **48/36/24 hour restrictions removed.**
- **Missed class time will still be evaluated.**

Effective August 1, 2013



16-8

Which will allow student-athletes to receive actual and necessary expenses and “reasonable benefits” associated with a national team practice and competition and also will allow institutions to pay for any number of national team tryouts and championship events.

Effective August 1, 2013
