Blue Cross Blue Shield, Cigna, Kaiser, Humana, United Healthcare, Aetna, Rocky Mountain Health Plans...

→ Saves Department considerable costs in actual dollars and self insured plan premium cost.

→ Keeps Self Insurance Premiums lower due to cost savings.

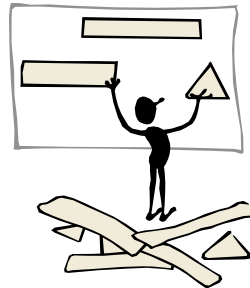
## ○ Secondary Payer – Sports Medicine

We pay co-pays, deductibles, and medical cost balances as if we were the Athlete. We are NOT an insurance company ☺

## WHY????

### January – Health Insurance Verification

- A **standard** time of year for Employer and Insurance Company renewals/changes - CU's is July, another standard time of year
- What can change.....



1. Actual Health Insurance Company change
2. Same Health Insurance Company yet NEW member ID Number or Group Number (very common)
3. Health Insurance Company contact changes: Phone Number or Claim Address
4. Specific service or deductible coverage changes
5. Prescription Provider or Bin Number information

- One form for all requests.
  - \$500 toiletries/clothing/etc.
  - Emergency travel.
  - Medical Requests
- Student-athlete must complete form in its entirety.
- Receipts must be submitted with approval form, not on their own.

# New Legislation

The override period is in full force and some proposals have garnered quite a bit of attention.

If you want to request an override, please let us know ASAP.

# New Legislation

The NCAA has held conference calls to discuss the proposals and we are waiting for a Q&A document to come out.

We have tried to answer all questions from the last sessions, but a few remain unanswered.

## 11-2

Which will eliminate the rules defining recruiting coordination functions that must be performed only by a head or assistant coach.

- Placing Telephone Calls
- Evaluating and Selecting PSAs
- Still no off-campus recruiting

Effective August 1, 2013

# 11-2 additional notes

This includes all staff members.

Currently has **25** override votes.

## 11-3-B

Which will prohibit the live scouting of future opponents except in limited circumstances.

- Can scout at tournaments.

Effective August 1, 2013

## 11-3-B additional notes

Future opponent in academic year that must be on your schedule.

Not 'potential' opponents.

Currently has **19** override votes.

## 11-4

Which will remove limits on the number of coaches who can recruit off-campus at any one time, the so-called “baton rule.”

- Recruiting Person Days still in effect.
- No need to return to campus if being replaced.

Effective August 1, 2013

## 11-4 additional notes

This is applicable to countable coaches only.

Currently has **5** override votes.

## 13-1

Which will allow schools to treat prospects like student-athletes for purposes of applying recruiting regulations once a National Letter of Intent or signed offer of admission or financial aid is received.

- Recruiting Rules ONLY.
- Extra Benefit legislation is still applicable.

Effective August 1, 2013

## 13-1 additional notes

The recruiting ban is still in effect for NLI signees from other institutions.

Currently has **3** override votes.

## 13-3

Which will eliminate restrictions on methods and modes of communication during recruiting.

- September 1 of junior year, unlimited email, text messages, chat.
- July 1 prior to senior year, unlimited phone calls.
- No longer need OV, NLI exceptions.

Effective July 1, 2013

## 13-3 additional notes

Skype is still considered a phone call.

Currently has **18** override votes.

## 13-5-A

Which will eliminate restrictions on sending printed recruiting materials to recruits. Conferences still will be prohibited from sending printed recruiting materials.

- September 1<sup>st</sup> of junior year is still the start date.
- Can still send NCAA, academic info, questionnaires and camp brochures at any time.
- Website may contain 'items created for recruiting purposes'.

Effective **July 1, 2013**

## 13-5-A additional notes

Tangible items still cannot be provided per Bylaw 13.2.1.

This takes fatheads out of consideration.

Currently has **25** override votes.

## 13-7

Which will eliminate restrictions on publicity once a prospective student-athlete has signed a National Letter of Intent or written offer of financial aid or admission.

- Still can only confirm recruitment prior to signing.
- No limit on publicity once they sign.

Effective August 1, 2013

## 13-7 additional notes

Does not allow a coach to be present at the NLI signing.

No NLI/FAA, no publicity (walk-ons).

Currently has **5** override votes.

## 13-8

**Which will deregulate camps and clinics employment rules related to both recruits and current student-athletes. Senior football prospects will be allowed to participate in camps and clinics.**

- PSAs can be employed, provided they have signed a NLI, written offer of admission or submitted financial deposit.
- Can only be paid for work actually performed and at the going rate. Cannot be paid for only demonstrating or lecturing. Cannot be paid based on reputation.
- No limit on the number of FB SAs that can be employed.

**Effective August 1, 2013**

## 13-8 additional notes

No 'going rate' standard will be defined. It will be left up to the institution.

Coaches must leave scrimmage if SA's are participating.

Currently has **3** override votes.

## 16-3

Which will allow institutions, conferences or the NCAA to pay for other academic support, career counseling or personal development services that support the success of the student-athlete.

- Removes 'typewriters' and non-electronic day planner from legislation.

Effective August 1, 2013

## 16-3 additional notes

Nothing from a Grant in Aid can be provided (i.e., books).

No longer has to be checkout and retrieval basis.

Currently has **5** override votes.

## 16-4

Which will allow institutions, conferences or the NCAA to pay for medical and related expenses for a student-athlete.

- Cleans up the legislation to allow an institution to pay medical bills at its discretion.

Effective August 1, 2013

## 16-4 additional notes

Disability insurance cannot be provided.

Currently has **7** override votes.

## 16-5

Which, except in limited circumstances, will change all Bylaw 16 references to a student-athlete's spouse, parents, family members or children to "family member," establish a specific definition of "family member," and permit specified benefits to such individuals.

- An institution is in the best position to determine who is a 'family member'.

Effective August 1, 2013

## 16-5 additional notes

This does not transfer over to recruiting restrictions.

Currently has **4** override votes.

## 16-6

Which will allow institutions to provide reasonable entertainment in conjunction with competition or practice.

- No 100 mile radius on away trips.
- No 30 mile radius for vacation periods.

Effective August 1, 2013

## 16-6 additional notes

During the playing season only (20 hour weeks).

No missed class, still no cash to SA.

Can be on day off, if it is not CARA.

Currently has **6** override votes.

## 16-7

Which will allow schools to provide actual and necessary expenses to student-athletes representing the institution in practice and competition (including expenses for activities/travel that are incidental to practice or competition) as well as in noncompetitive events such as goodwill tours and media appearances.

- 48/36/24 hour restrictions removed.
- Missed class time will still be evaluated.

Effective August 1, 2013

## 16-7 additional notes

No expenses for initial travel to campus.

Can reimburse mileage/gas to practice off-campus.

Can pick up SA to transport to practice or competition.

Can retain equipment.

Currently has **5** override votes.
