# NCAA Deregulation

The NCAA recently adopted new legislation that will deregulate many trivial rules and allow more flexibility in recruiting.

\*\*Please note—these changes are not effective until **July 1 or August 1, 2013** and are subject to an override vote from the membership.

# NCAA Deregulation

## Recruiting Telephone Calls.

Proposal 13-3 allows coaches to place unlimited telephone calls to prospects once it is permissible to call.

This proposal is effective **July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2013.**

# NCAA Deregulation

## Recruiting Telephone Calls.

Start Date for each sport:

MBB: June 15<sup>th</sup> following sophomore year

WBB: Sept 1<sup>st</sup> of junior year

FB: 1 call to juniors April 15-May 31.

Unlimited calls September 1<sup>st</sup> of senior year.

All other Sports: July 1<sup>st</sup> prior to senior year.

# NCAA Deregulation

## Text Messaging

Proposal 13-3 also allows coaches to text message recruits starting September 1<sup>st</sup> of their junior year.

Men's basketball can still send text messages on June 15<sup>th</sup> following sophomore year.

# NCAA Deregulation

## Recruiting Materials

Proposal 13-5-A will remove regulations on what type of recruiting materials can be sent to prospects.

Starting **July 1, 2013** CU can send athletic-specific information to **senior prospects** with no restriction on the content.

Then, on **September 1, 2013** CU can send the same type of materials to **junior prospects**.

# NCAA Deregulation

## Recruiting Communication

Proposal 11-2 allows athletic department staff members OTHER than coaches to place **permissible** telephone calls and text messages to prospects. This includes, but is not limited to: operations staff members, academics staff, Athletic Directors and SWAs. This type of communication can only be sent after the first permissible date, which is different for each sport. Please be aware of these dates!

This proposal is effective **August 1, 2013**.
