C4C Card Process and Policy



C4C Card Process and Policy

- Effective May 9th , card price will change from \$8.50 to \$9.50
- Business Office is sole custodian
- Cards are “cash-like”, thus Sports and Admin departments may not maintain “contingency” stocks
- Card disbursement log maintained in ABO and is subject to audits
- ABO can be flexible on working with urgent requests as long as required info is provided



C4C Card Process and Policy

- An Official Function Form & C4C Policy Acknowledgement Form must be completed prior to receiving cards
 - List of names for each card checked out must be provided
 - Important for University cash control and NCAA policy compliance
 - Cards used for Unofficial Visits must be paid for PRIOR to the meal (money can be deposited with ABO after meal)
 - Unused cards must be returned to ABO within 2 business days
 - Value of cards used will be charged to the appropriate speedtype
- Alternative is to track each card individually by serial number which is not necessary if this process done right

Pac-12 Violation Summary



- **A student manager actively practiced during the playing season.**
- **Penalty:** Letter of admonishment to head coach. Additional rules education.

Pac-12 Violation Summary



- **Assistant coach arranged for a PSA to receive travel expenses for two unofficial visits from a close family friend. The family friend was neither an immediate family member nor the PSA's legal guardian.**
- **Penalty:** PSA declared ineligible, pending reinstatement by the NCAA. PSA must repay value of the expenses to charity.

Pac-12 Violation Summary



- **Assistant coach had impermissible in-person contact with junior PSA's mother outside of PSA's high school campus or home.**
- **Penalty:** Program will count contact as one of the permissible off-campus contacts with PSA during senior year. PSA declared ineligible, pending reinstatement by the NCAA.

Pac-12 Violation Summary



- **Noncoaching staff member permissible PSAs to complete unofficial visits on the institution's campus on the same day as their first competition during a tournament.**
- **Penalty:** Letter of admonishment issued to staff member. Institution will reduce permissible in-person recruiting opportunities with each PSA by one. All PSAs declared ineligible, pending reinstatement by the NCAA.

Pac-12 Violation Summary



- **Two unsigned PSAs participated in an UOV to institution during July quiet period. Compliance mistakenly approved the visits.**
- **Penalty:** Letter of admonishment issued to compliance staff member. Additional rules education.

Pac-12 Violation Summary



- **Institutional booster provided four PSAs with complimentary admission to his stadium suite during institution's football contest.**
- **Penalty:** PSAs declared ineligible. Additional rules education.

Pac-12 Violation Summary



- **Staff member placed personalized recruiting aids in the hotel rooms of four PSAs during OV to campus.**
- **Penalty:** Letter of admonishment issued to staff member. Additional rules education.

Pac-12 Violation Summary



- **Head coach provided a loan to the coach of a local club team comprised of PSAs.**
- **Penalty:** Letter of admonishment issued to head coach. Head coach required to attend NCAA Regional Rules Seminar at his own expense. Head coach prohibited from recruiting off-campus until the loan is repaid in full.

Pac-12 Violation Summary



- **Coaching staff posted pictures of a team's out-of-season skill instruction workouts to their Instagram account.**
- **Penalty:** Letter of admonishment issued to head coach. Additional rules education.

Pac-12 Violation Summary



- **Many instances of EARLY texts, phone calls, emails.**
- **Be sure you are checking TWO sources to verify a PSA's age prior to reaching out to the PSA.**

Noninstitutional Camps



- You must submit paperwork prior to working any noninstitutional camps or clinics.
- These camps/clinics have to meet NCAA camp guidelines.
- When submitting paperwork, a camp flyer or web address is VERY helpful.

Recruiting vs. Working for a Club



- Common in team sports for institutional coaches to also be club coaches.
- You can only wear one hat per trip. Either you are recruiting for CU or you are working for the club.
- You can't recruit one day and then work for the club the next. Either CU has then paid club expenses or the Club has paid CU recruiting expenses.

Amateurism



- **Incoming prospects can now request their final amateur status.**
- **An easy process to complete with the EC.**
- **Completing this now helps assure quick eligibility certification.**
- **Also remind students to turn in FINAL, OFFICIAL transcript (with proof of graduation/graduation date) as soon as they graduate!**

New Legislation



New Legislation



- **2103-24**

- **Countable Coaches** --any individual who provides technical or tactical instruction.
- Same rules apply as before, this is just a definition.
- **Effective August 1, 2014**

New Legislation



- **2103-26**

- **Initial Date for Communication**—Sports other than basketball, cross country, track and field and football.
- September 1st of Junior year.
- Any form of electronic correspondence (email, chat, texts)
- **Effective August 1, 2014**

New Legislation



- **2103-27**

- **Printed Recruiting Materials** – Just general correspondence with no limits except size.
- Notecards or post cards must meet applicable size limits, but can be fancy!
- **Effective August 1, 2014**
