# **Noninstitutional Camps**

# Noninstitutional Camps

## **Golf, Track/CC, Tennis, Soccer, Ski, Lacrosse:**

- In sports other than basketball, football and women's volleyball, an institution's athletics department personnel may serve in any capacity (e.g., counselor, guest lecturer, consultant) in a noninstitutional, privately owned camp or clinic, ***provided the camp or clinic is operated in accordance with restrictions applicable to institutional camps*** (e.g., open to any and all entrants, no free or reduced admission to or employment of athletics award winners).

**Volleyball:** Same as above, just not during a quiet period.

# Noninstitutional Camps

- This is applicable to all coaching and noncoaching staff members
- You must submit paperwork prior to working any noninstitutional camps or clinics.
- When submitting paperwork, a camp flyer or web address is required to verify that the camp/clinic meets NCAA camp guidelines.

# Voluntary Activities

Voluntary Athletically Related Activities may occur in the weight room, on the court, etc., provided the following conditions met:

- Coaching staff members cannot be present.
- The student-athlete cannot be required to report back any information regarding the activities. Strength coach, trainer, manager also cannot report back any information.
- Attendance and participation in the activity cannot be recorded to report back to the coaching staff.
- There can be no penalty or reward for participation or lack of participation.
  
- Coaches may prepare film rooms for use by student-athletes, but may not participate in watching film.
- Coaches may provide student-athletes with athletically related information (e.g., weight room times, general workout programs).

# Voluntary Activities

Student-athlete initiated activity in the summer (individual sports only).

- Cross Country/Track/Field, Golf, Ski, Tennis
- A coach may participate in individual-workout sessions with student-athletes from the coach's team during the summer, provided the request for such assistance is initiated by the student-athlete.
- A coach may reserve the use of a facility during the summer to participate in individual workout sessions requested by the student-athlete.

# Voluntary Activities

## **SAFETY EXCEPTIONS – (Skiing, Track)**

- A coach may be present during voluntary individual workouts in the institution's regular practice facility (without the workouts being considered as countable athletically related activities) when the student-athlete is engaged in activities for their sport. The coach may provide safety or skill instruction but may **NOT** conduct the individual's workouts.
  - **Track & Field (field events, hurdles, and steeplechase only)** – when the student-athlete is engaged in **field events or jumping activities in conjunction with hurdles or jumping portion of the steeplechase.**
  - **Skiing** – when the student-athlete is engaged in skiing. The coach may provide safety or skill instruction but may not conduct the individual's workouts.
- If a countable coach is conducting skill instruction with four (4) student-athletes THEN a "fifth" student-athlete could not participate in the same skill instruction. HOWEVER, it would be permissible for the "fifth" student-athlete to workout on his own (the coach is NOT driving the activity) under the "safety exception"

# CARA

## **Promotion of Voluntary Activities**

- It is not permissible to publicize voluntary activities. So, no press release, no social media, no opening to the public, etc.
- It is permissible for the media to interview an incoming student that is enrolled in summer school. The focus cannot be CARA.
- Cannot have voluntary activities in front of campers.

# CARA

## OUT OF SEASON

- Today is the last day for the entire team to be involved in skill instruction at one time in any facility.
- Starting Thursday, no more than 4 in any facility at one time.
- Sunday, April 26, no CARA as this begins the week before finals.

# Financial Aid

- **Offers cannot be put in writing to a PSA until August 1 of their senior year.**
- **Any recruits beyond 2015 will receive a multi-year award offer.**
- **Nonrenewal process will still go through sport supervisor and Rick.**
- **If approved, coach must sit down with student, with sport supervisor present.**
- **SA's must be given the opportunity to appeal. Sitting down with coach and sport supervisor does not waive opportunity to appeal.**

# FAA Update

- **New Financial Aid Agreement was approved by legal.**
- **These will be included with any future signings.**
- **All current students will be re-signing this summer for the remainder of their eligibility.**
- **November 2014 signees are not under the new legislation, but will need to re-sign summer of 2016.**
- **Team Rules do not need to be presented with NLI/FAA.**

# Team Rules

- **Team Rules do not need to be presented, but do need to be made available if requested.**
- **Have sport supervisor review.**
- **Compliance and legal will review for ‘nonathletic’ vs ‘athletic’ reasons. Ultimately up to appeals committee.**
- **Treating two students, in the same scenario, differently does put you at risk. If this is the case, we can get legal involved for guidance.**

# Summer Meals

- **Fueling Stations are permissible in the summer for any student in summer school or participating in voluntary activities.**
- **Meals incidental to participation are not permissible during summer school.**
- **All must be approved via your sport supervisor.  
BUDGET!!**

# Outside Participation

- **Student-athletes must complete the outside participation paperwork with Jo prior to participating in any other activity.**
- **There have been teams/leagues in the past that were impermissible! Directly affects eligibility.**
- **Each sport has limits as to how many individuals can participate. We will educate your SAs, but your guidance is also appreciated.**

# Amateurism/O'Bannon

- **O'Bannon antitrust case decision is effective August 2015. Name/Image/Likeness, COA.**
- **Up to \$5k/year for eligible SAs in a fund to receive at the end of their eligibility or graduation.**
- **Make no promises in recruiting, as there will likely be an appeal or stay. More to come...**
