Transfers



Basic Guidelines

- What constitutes transfer status?
 - Enrolled FT and present for first day of classes
 - Attended classes while enrolled FT
 - Reported for regular practice, including summer preseason practice
 - Practice or competed in their sport, even if they were not FT
 - Receive financial aid for summer school prior to enrollment

Transfers

- **Permission to contact is required before having any contact or communication with any student at another 4-year institution.**
- **This includes all NCAA and NAIA institutions.**
- **This is not specific to just student-athletes, it is applicable to ANY student at another institution.**

Transfers

- If a student has been withdrawn from a four-year institution for one academic year, permission to contact is not required.
- Permission to contact is not required for 2-year transfers.
- Don't forget you cannot have face-to-face contact with a NQ in their first year at a 2-year institution. Communication is ok!!

Transfers

- Send any request for permission to contact to Jo Marchi.
- If you directly receive permission to contact, be sure to send her a copy.
- If you are contacted by the potential transfer, but do not have permission, you must end the conversation.

Basic Guidelines

2-4 Transfers

Qualifier:

- One FT semester/quarter
- Average 12 transferable degree credit hours per FT term
- 2.50 GPA

Basic Guidelines

2-4 Transfers

Non-Qualifier:

- 3 semesters/4 quarters FT
- Associates (AA) Degree
- 48 transferable degree credit hours
(6 Eng, 3 Math, 3 Sci)
- 2.50 GPA

Basic Guidelines

4-2-4 Transfers

Qualifier or Non-Qualifier:

- Average 12 transferable degree credit hours per FT term @ juco
- Associates (AA) degree
- 2.50 GPA
- One calendar year must elapse since four year school

Basic Guidelines

4-4 Transfers

Must serve one FT year in residence

Must meet PTD requirements

**Must have left last institution in good
academic standing**

Basic Guidelines

4-4 Transfers

Exceptions to Year in Residence:

- One time Transfer Exception (not M/WBB, FB)
- Return to initial school if they did not participate at second school
- Sport was discontinued or not sponsored by first school
- SA was not recruited and no athletic scholarship
- SA has not participated in their sport for two years prior to transfer

Basic Guidelines

Pac-12 Transfer Rules

Any intraconference transfer must meet NCAA transfer regulations and serve the conference penalty:

Sit a year

Lose a year

Restriction of Financial Aid is no longer a penalty

Potential petition with approval from original institution

Basic Guidelines

Pac-12 Transfer Rules

SA's are exempt from the intraconference transfer rules if:

- Not recruited and no athletics aid
- Not recruited and only institutional aid
- Recruited but no institutional or athletics aid

Basic Guidelines

Waivers

A waiver for immediate eligibility due to family illness is no longer an option.

Graduate transfers can be immediately eligible if their aid was not renewed at the first institution

Transfer Evaluation

Send the PSA card and all college transcripts to Dee Menzies and Kris Livingston.

If possible, know what degree program they'd like to study for the PTD evaluation.

Fall/Winter Break Reminders

Meals-Vacation Period

When student-athletes are required to remain on campus for practice or competition during a vacation period (Fall Break, Winter Break), room and board can be provided.

- 3 Meals or per diem can be provided in any combination.
- A 4th meal can also be provided, but no cash for that meal.

Meals-Vacation Period

Room can be provided if they are not living at home and dorms are closed (winter break) = \$25.

Per Diem = Maximum \$50 day

Breakfast-\$10

Lunch-\$15

Dinner-\$25

- If meal is provided—no per diem for that meal.
- If per diem is provided, no occasional meal or going home (Thanksgiving)
- Sunday Dinners 11/23 & 11/30

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Meals-Vacation Period

- Requests for Break Per Diems must be made by sport program to OCS and ABO (Jo and Tim).
- Provide a breakdown of all days/meals per student-athlete. Please include which meals you will be providing and which they will get per diem for and if you have any travel status during the break.
- Once approved, a cash advance request can be made. If you want to provide checks, please contact Jo, as there are other factors to consider.

CARA-Out of Season

- For those sports out of season, no CARA can occur during these vacation periods.
- Voluntary activities only.

Post-NLI Signing

Post-NLI Signing

- Once it has been confirmed that your PSA has signed a valid NLI, it is permissible to:
 - Comment publicly about the PSA
 - Communicate publicly (i.e., social media) about and with the PSA
 - Call, text, email, contact, evaluate as much as you would like. Be careful with evaluations that may include other PSAs and contacts at school during the day
 - Send pre-enrollment information (strength/conditioning)
 - Still cannot announce PSA when they are on campus.
 - Signed PSA cannot attend 'closed team meetings/film'.

Pac-12 Reform



Pac-12 Reform

- The Pac-12 has come out with 5 reform initiatives
 1. Multi-year Awards
 2. Degree Completion
 3. Medical Expenses
 4. Liberalizing Transfer Rules
 5. SA representation in Conference Governance

Pac-12 Reform

Multi-Year Awards

- All scholarships for incoming students must be four-year guaranteed scholarships.
- Cannot be reduce or canceled provided the SA is in good standing and meets the terms of the agreement.
- This is effective for 2016-2017, so your signing class next year.

Pac-12 Reform

Degree Completion

- If a student does not complete their degree, but returns to school, they can receive the remaining terms of the four-year agreement at any time.
- Must have completed 50% of their degree before departure.
- If they transfer, CU is no longer on the hook.

Pac-12 Reform

Medical Expenses

- Four years following departure (or until the SA turns 26, whichever comes first).
- For athletically related injuries/illness that occurred while at CU.
- Documentation is key!!
- Utilize medical exams during U/OVs.
- Incoming physicals are important to document any preexisting conditions.
- Exit physicals will also become an important piece of this legislation.

Notes



Notes

- New “Meals” arrangement will be evaluated at the end of the semester to determine how CU will proceed in the spring semester. Not to be used as a recruiting tool instead of scholarship money.
- **Holiday Gifts** – you may not participate in secret santa-type gift exchanges with your SAs.
- **Occasional meals** – parents of SAs are not permitted to attend with SAs. Please help us educate and reinforce this!
