# HAC Announcements

# OFFICIAL VISITS

# Basic Guidelines

- **Requirements for an official visit:**
  - Turn PSA card into Jill/Kevin.
  - With PSA card include transcripts and test score.
  - PSA must be registered with the NCAA Eligibility Center and be on CU's IRL.
  - Turn the following forms into Jo:
    - Official Visit Checklist
    - Student Host Form
    - Detailed Itinerary

# Basic Guidelines

- **Cannot take an official visit until the first day of classes their senior year.**
- **Cannot take more than 1 official visit to any institution, with no more than 5 total official visits.**
  - **Multi-sport athletes are limited to a total of 5 visits!**
- **48-hour time limit on official visits**
  - **Begins when the PSA arrives on campus.**
  - **Begins when a CU coach picks up the PSA from their home, or**
  - **Begins when you have a 'sit down' meal on the way back to CU from DIA.**
    - **Be aware of the 30-mile radius!**
  - **Scenarios with extended transportation options**

# Transportation

- **CU can provide transportation expenses for only the prospect.**
- **Mileage can be reimbursed for the round trip.**
  - If riding in car with HS or club coach, mileage cannot be reimbursed.
- **CU cannot pay car rental fees or insurance.**

# Transportation

- **A CU coach can pick up a prospect from their home, but the 48-hour time period starts immediately.**
- **Transportation must be standard transportation (coach's car, commercial flight). No extended leg room, upgrades, etc.**
- **CU can pay bag fees associated with travel.**

# Meals

- **CU can provide 3 meals per day during an official visit, as well as a snack.**
- **CU can provide a meal while the PSA is in transit to CU.**
  - **Pick PSA up from airport and go through 'drive through' – 48 hours does not start.**
  - **Pick PSA up from airport and have a 'sit down' meal -48 hours has started.**
- **Meals can be provided to a PSA and their parents/guardians. No siblings, aunts, uncles, grandmother, grandfather, coaches, etc.**

# Meals

- **CU's \$50 per meal limit is still in effect.**
- **Impermissible Restaurants:**
  - Brasserie Ten Ten
  - Flagstaff House
  - Greenbriar Inn
  - John Elway's Restaurant\*
  - L'Absinthe Restaurant
  - L'Atelier

\*Set Menus are potentially possible—check with compliance.

# Lodging

- **Lodging must be standard rooms. No mountain views at the St. Julian, no jacuzzi suites, etc.**
- **Hotel Boulderado (limited selection, no suites).**
- **CU can pay for a prospect's room as well as the parent/legal guardian's room. Cannot pay additional fees for siblings or other family members to stay.**
- **No decorating or altering the rooms for the prospect.**

# Entertainment/Hosts

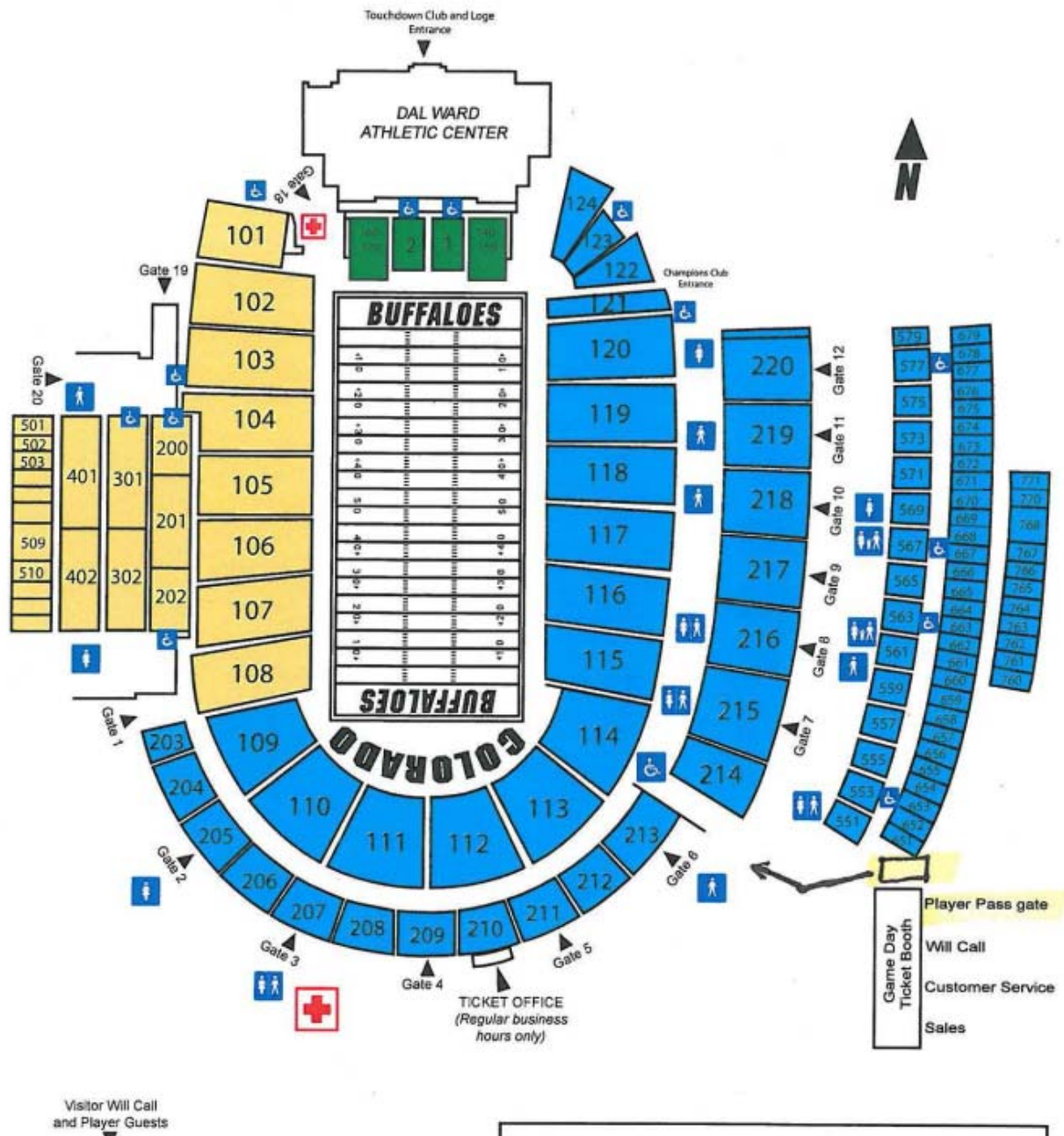
- **SA Hosts can get up to \$40/day (max \$80)**
  - Can receive an additional \$20/day for additional prospects.
- **All entertainment costs must come out of the host money. PSAs cannot supplement the host money with their own money.**
- **Host money does not need to be used on SA if it is actual team entertainment. Cannot 'create' team entertainment just for OVs.**

# Medical Exam

- A physician for CU can conduct a medical exam for a PSA on a visit.
- A CU trainer can be present, but a CU coach or noninstitutional coaching staff member cannot be present.
- This is a medical exam, not a skills or agility exam.
- This exam cannot be used to deny a PSA admission to CU.

# Complimentary Tickets

- **CU can provide three complimentary admissions for regular season, home events.**
- **PSA MUST show their ID to receive tickets.**
- **Franklin Field to get tickets, North of permanent ticket booth. Must enter right away.**
- **Coaches tickets are also at Franklin Field. No more Gate 14.**



# Ralphie's Run

- **SW Corner of the field is where you must watch Ralphie Run (by the “O” in Colorado).**
- **Must get off field ASAP following her run, walk towards the “C” in Colorado to get up in the stands.**
- **Must request VIP pass for PSAs to go down on field and they must be escorted by a coach. Must retrieve passes as soon as Ralphie is done running and you return to the stands.**
- **Request VIP passes from Jen Green.**

# Publicity

- **CU cannot publicize a recruit's visit to campus.**
- **No tweeting, posting photos, etc. by coaches or student-athletes.**
- **PSA can post all they'd like, but CU coaches should not encourage this.**

**MEALS**

# MEALS

- **The new legislation does not circumvent OV/UOV meal legislation.**
- **Only one host can receive a free meal during an OV.**
- **Whole team can use meal swipes at C4C, but if you are tailgating, or going elsewhere off campus, should use occasional meal to have more than 1 SA attend.**

# MEALS

- **Prospects can attend Sunday Family Dinner (\$13.42 for UOV) as a part of their visit to campus.**
- **Please be sure to contact Miguel or Laura to ensure PSA is on list.**
- **Document payment for business office.**

# MEALS

- **Boosters/Donors can still provide occasional meals to our SAs.**
- **Must have prior approval for the meal.**
- **Occasional Meal numbers are still the same.  
~2/month.**

# ADMISSIONS

# ADMISSIONS

- CU Athletics cannot ask admissions to go to certain high schools.
- CU Athletics cannot ask admissions to reach out to specific prospects while they are out recruiting.
- CU Athletics cannot ask admissions to hand out athletics information to prospects.
- CU Athletics can hand out admissions information at any time.
