



## 2-4 Transfers

In order to practice, receive athletically related financial aid, and compete immediately, a 2-4 transfer SA must complete the following at the two-year school:

### Qualifiers

- Minimum one semester or quarter of FT enrollment.
- Complete an average of 12 transferable-degree credit hours per term of FT enrollment.
- Earn a minimum 2.50 GPA in transferable credits.

### Non-Qualifiers

- Minimum three semesters or four quarters of FT enrollment.
- Earn AA Degree.
- Earn a minimum 48 semester hours of transferable-degree credit hours (6 English, 3 Math, 3 Science).
- Earn a minimum 2.50 GPA in transferable credits.

If the SA does not meet **all** of the requirements, the SA can practice and receive athletically related financial aid, but cannot compete until completing one full academic year of residence.

## 4-2-4 Transfers

In order to practice, receive athletically related financial aid, and compete immediately, a 4-2-4 transfer SA must complete the following at the two year school:

### Qualifier and Non-Qualifier

- Complete an average of 12 transferable-degree credit hours per term of FT enrollment.
- Earn a minimum 2.50 GPA in transferable credits.
- Earn AA degree.
- Have one calendar year elapse since leaving previous four-year school.

If the SA does not meet **all** of the requirements, they must complete an academic year of residence.

\*\*Exception for calendar-year time lapse: Does not have to be complete prior to enrollment, but must be complete prior to competition at four-year school.



## **Permission to Contact**

Permission to contact is required before CU can have communication or contact with a potential 4-4 transfer, or a 4-2-4 transfer that is not 1-year removed from the 2-year school. Permission to contact is not required for 2-4 transfers, but coaches cannot have contact with a potential 2-4 transfer that was a NQ in their first year at the 2-year school. Work with compliance to request permission to contact.

## **4-4 Transfers**

4-4 Transfers are generally not eligible to compete until spending one full academic year in residence at the second institution. However, there are exceptions that may allow a SA to compete immediately upon transfer.

### **Exceptions to transfer requirements:**

- SAs transferring for the first time may receive a one-time transfer exception if the first school agrees to release the SA (not available in MBB, WBB, FB).
- SAs may return to their initial institution if they did not practice or compete at the second school
- If the sport the SA played was discontinued or not sponsored by the first school
- If the SA was never recruited and did not receive an athletics scholarship
- If the SA has not participated in their sport for two years immediately prior to the transfer

Only Qualifiers may be granted an exception during their first year of collegiate enrollment. Non-Qualifiers must spend at least one academic year in residence at first institution before receiving an exception at second institution.

Any SA receiving a transfer exception must meet progress towards degree requirements to be immediately eligible.

## **Intraconference Transfers**

### **Pac-12 Intraconference Transfer Rules:**

- Fulfill one academic year or residency at the new school
- Lose one season of competition before being eligible to compete

### **SAs are exempt from transfer rules if:**

- Not recruited and did not receive athletically related aid
- Not recruited and only received institutional aid
- Recruited but received no institutional or athletically related financial aid
