Tryout Events

CU may not host, sponsor or conduct a tryout camp, clinic, group workout or combine (e.g., combination of athletics skill tests or activities) devoted to agility, flexibility, speed or strength tests for prospective student-athletes at any location. CU may host National Team tryout events in sports other than basketball and football.

Football

In football, CU shall not host, sponsor or conduct a nonscholastic football practice or competition (e.g., seven-on-seven events) in which football prospective student-athletes participate. The use of CU facilities for noninstitutional camps or clinics that include prospect-aged participants shall be limited to the months of June and July.

Basketball

In Men’s or Women’s Basketball, CU shall not host, sponsor or conduct a nonscholastic basketball practice or competition. In Men’s or Women’s Basketball, the use of CU facilities for noninstitutional camps or clinics that include prospective student-athletes shall be limited to the months of June, July and August.

Other Events. CU may host, sponsor or conduct a nonscholastic event that involves men’s or women’s basketball prospective student-athletes, provided it meets one of the following conditions:

- The event is open and all participating basketball prospective student-athletes reside within a 50-mile radius of CU’s campus;
- The event is part of a program that is consistent with the mission of the institution (e.g., state wellness and educational programs); or
- The event is an ancillary event that is part of a nonathletics program (e.g., Girl Scouts).
