



Graduation Rings

Requests for graduation rings will be accepted by the Equipment Room. A student-athlete may get their ring sized any time during their last semester at CU or after. In order to receive a ring, a student-athlete must have graduated and have lettered once in their sport or activity.

The Office of Compliance Services will verify that each student-athlete is eligible for a ring using past letterman award records and the graduation report information from ISIS. Rings will be ordered twice a year, once after the fall semester (approx. Feb 1st) and once during the summer (approx. July 1st). All requests made after the order date will be included with the next order.

Rings will be delivered to Equipment and distributed, notifying student-athletes that their ring is available for pick-up or mailing the ring to their forwarding address.

Photo Boxes

Photo Boxes are the fourth year letter award, typically given to seniors. Any senior transfer student-athlete may have the option of receiving the photo box or the next participation award.

Photo box orders will be made twice a year, once in July after the Spring Sport season has finished and once in January following the completion of the Fall sports. Compliance will notify Sports Information about which student-athletes will receive the photo box and they will forward a photo to Buffvision for processing. BVO will then submit a CD of photos to Compliance for placing the order.

Photo boxes will be delivered to Compliance and distributed. The Office of Compliance Services will notify former student-athletes that their award is available for pick-up or mail it to their forwarding address.
