



Student Host Certification

In order to be a student host at the University of Colorado, you must be an enrolled student-athlete at CU. Each fall, during the team compliance meetings, the student-athletes will be given a copy of the student host information sheet. The Office of Compliance Services staff will inform the student-athletes of the necessary information and then give the student-athletes a quiz. Each student-athlete that has a completed quiz on file and has signed the “Student-Athlete Contract” is eligible to be a student host.

By signing this form, I affirm that I have been informed of the NCAA rules regarding contact with prospective student-athletes. I understand that any time I come in contact with a prospective student-athlete I must follow all federal and state laws, as well as CU, athletic department, team and NCAA regulations. I am aware of the following expectations placed on me during any such visit:

- No illegal activity.
- No use of alcohol or illegal drugs.
- No activities or entertainment at any location that would be judged inappropriate or that may cause a perception of impropriety.
- Returning to lodging before 1:00 a.m. curfew.
- All entertainment arranged during the visit will meet the University's expectations of appropriate activities and NCAA rules; prospective student-athlete hosts will follow the staff's directions for activities during the visit.

Please remember that you are a representative of the University of Colorado and your actions, both positive and negative, will reflect on the University.
