



2015-16 VOLUNTEER COACH POLICY

- I. Definition: In sports other than football and basketball, a volunteer coach is any coach who does not receive compensation or remuneration from the institution's athletics department or any organization funded in whole or in part by the athletics department or that is involved primarily in the promotion of the institution's athletics program. (Bylaw 11.01.6)
- II. The Office of Compliance Services must have a Volunteer Coach Agreement Form, and a resume on file for each volunteer coach.
- III. Head coaches must submit a specific job description outlining duties and expectations of the volunteer coaching position and define length of appointment.
- IV. Head coaches should refer to NCAA 11.01.6 for applicable provisions to the volunteer position.

Regarding Volunteer Coaches:

Volunteer coaches are only permitted to receive meals during a PSA's OFFICIAL visit and at away from home contests.

A volunteer coach CANNOT contact and evaluate PSAs off-campus or scout opponents off-campus.

A volunteer coach may receive:

- 1) A maximum of two complimentary tickets to home athletics contests in the coach's sport;
- 2) Compensation for employment at an institution's sports camp or clinic;
- 3) Transportation to and from, and room and board, at away games; and parking expenses associated with practice and competition, and
- 4) Complimentary meals during a PSA's official visit, provided the volunteer coach dines with the PSA.
