Led Utah with 267 all-purpose yards in 30-24 win over California. Rushed for a season-high 222 yards with two touchdowns on 34 carries (6.5 avg). Also had four receptions for 45 yards.

DEFENSE

Travis Feeney, Sr., LB
 Washington

Led Husky defense that held No. 17 USC to just 12 points and 346 yards total offense in 17-12 win over the Trojans in Los Angeles. He had seven total tackles, including three and a half tackles for loss and two and a half sacks.

SPECIAL TEAMS

Tom Hackett, Sr., P
 Utah

In the 30-24 win over California, he averaged 50.8 yards on four punts and placed two inside the 10-yard line. Cal had one punt return for no yards and its average starting field position following a punt was the 15-yard line. His final punt of the game for 51 yards was downed at the 5-yard line with 4:52 remaining, forcing Cal to start its final drive deep in its own territory.

The Pac-12 posted has posted a winning record outside league for 30 consecutive seasons . . . The Pac-12 recorded a 37-9 record in non-conference action last season, posting the most wins ever outside of conference play. Since 1934, only one other season witnessed the Conference capture more than 29 wins in non-league play - 2002 (32-15) when the league played an eight game conference schedule, allowing an additional 10 non-conference games to be played.

AROUND THE PAC-12

POLL WATCHING: With four teams appearing in this week's AP Poll, the Pac-12 had a streak of five or more teams in the AP Top 25 snapped at eight consecutive weeks ... UTAH moves up to No. 4 in this week's AP poll, the highest ranking ever for the Utes during the regular season. The Utes had final AP rankings of No. 2 (2004) and No. 4 (2008) following postseason play ... Utah is the fourth different Pac-12 team this season to be ranked in the Top 10 ... Over the last two seasons, nine different Pac-12 teams have been ranked among the AP Top 25, while six different Conference teams have been ranked among the Top 10 ... With OREGON falling out of the AP poll earlier this season, the Ducks had their streak of Top 25 appearances snapped at 98 weeks. It had been the nation's second-longest active streak.

ALL-PURPOSE: STANFORD sophomore RB **Christian McCaffrey** is currently second in the FBS with 229.8 all-purpose yards per game. Since 1978, only four other Conference players have averaged 200 or more all-purpose yards per game for an entire season - USC's Marcus Allen in 1981 (232.6 avg), Stanford's Glyn Milburn in 1990 (202.0 avg), USC's Reggie Bush in 2005 (222.3 avg) and USC's Marqise Lee in 2012 (206.4 avg). Coincidentally, Milburn's teammate in 1990 was Ed McCaffrey (father of Christian), who had 61 receptions for 917 yards and a Conference-leading 91.7 receiving yards per game that season.

PAC-12 NETWORK TO TAB ALL-CENTURY TEAM: The Pac-12 Network will honor the Conference's 100-year anniversary with the selection of an All-Century team. Each Tuesday on the Network's Inside Pac-12 Football show, the finalists/top 10 vote getters for each position as selected by a panel comprised of media, former players, coaches and administrators will be unveiled. PAC-12 CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION

#100Pac12: The Pac-12 Conference is set to celebrate 100 years of excellence. The yearlong celebration of the Conference centennial, including marking the date of the official formation 100 years ago on December 2, will kick off with the start of the football season and continue throughout the 2015-16 academic year.

The Conference's storied history dates back 100 years to Dec. 2, 1915 when four schools - the University of California, Oregon Agricultural College (now Oregon State University), the University of Oregon and the University of Washington - gathered at the historic Imperial Hotel in Portland, Ore., to form the Pacific Coast Conference.

Since that day, the Conference has been known for its widespread excellence – on the field, in the classroom, and with the contributions its graduates make in the world. No other Conference can match the collective achievements and distinctions accomplished over the last century.

#COMPLETE12

COMPLETE CAMPAIGN: Pac-12 students are known for their success on the field, but they are also impressive, complete people with outside interests, diverse backgrounds, extracurricular activities, interesting families, busy schedules, and full lives. Here's a look at some of the off-field accomplishments:



CATS DEDICATED TO CURING CYSTIC FIBROSIS: ARIZONA has partnered with the "Uplifting Athletes Arizona Chapter". It's a local charitable organization run by members of the Arizona football team. The Wildcats hosted their first-ever Kids Clinic over the summer and all proceeds went to benefit the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation of Southern Arizona ... The Wildcats will continue to wear the initials "AV" on the back of their helmets for the remainder of the season in honor of Andrew Valdez, who passed away on June 20 after suffering from Cystic Fibrosis. Valdez was an honorary member of the Arizona football family, as the Wildcats made frequent trips to visit him at the Diamond Children's Medical Center.

THIS WEEK'S GAMES

UCLA at STANFORD

Thurs., Oct. 15 • 7:30 p.m. PT • ESPN

UCLA: The Bruins are 5-0 following a bye week under coach Jim Mora ... Over the last two games, senior WR **Jordan Payton** and junior WR **Thomas Duarte** have combined for 23 receptions for 375 yards and 4 TDs, while nine other receivers have been targets for 18 receptions and 189 yards ... UCLA is in the middle of playing four ranked opponents in five games ... From more than 1.1 million high school football players, the National Football Foundation has announced that freshman QB **Josh Rosen** was named one of five outstanding individuals as recipient of the 2015 NFF National High School Scholar-Athlete Awards.

STANFORD: The Cardinal will be looking for its first win over a ranked team at home since 2013 ... Head coach David Shaw is 5-0 against UCLA in his tenure on The Farm ... In Stanford's seven-game win streak over the UCLA, the Cardinal has out-scored the Bruins, 221-96 ... Over its past three games, Stanford has rushed for 834 yards (5.8 ypc) ... The Cardinal has scored 40 or more points in each of the last three games, its' longest streak in 14 years ... Senior QB **Kevin Hogan** ranks seventh in the NCAA in passing efficiency at 169.8 and has completed 79 percent of his throws in the last three games ... Sophomore RB **Christian McCaffrey** is second in the FBS in all-purpose yards (229.8 avg) ... Over Stanford's past three games, senior RB **Remound Wright** has more rushing touchdowns (7) than the Cardinal has punts (6) ... Senior LB **Blake Martinez** has five consecutive 10+ tackle game with 13 tackles vs. Arizona and leads the FBS with 12.6 tackles per game.

Last Meeting (11/28/14): Kevin Hogan completed 16-of-19 for 234 yards and two TDs as Stanford won its seventh straight over UCLA and crushed the ninth-ranked Bruins' hopes for a Pac-12 South Division title with a 31-10 victory. The Cardinal defense limited UCLA to 262 yards (100 rush, 162 pass).

OREGON STATE at WASHINGTON STATE

Sat., Oct. 17 • 1 p.m. MT • PAC12

OREGON STATE: Senior TB **Storm Barrs-Woods** became the sixth back in school history to run for more than 2,500 yards with his 60 on nine carries in the loss at Arizona. Barrs-Woods has 2,505 career rushing yards and needs 48 yards to crack the school's career top five ... The Beavers lead the Pac-12 in pass defense, allowing a league-low 177.6 yards per game. They'll certainly be tested this week as they go up against the league's top passing offense in Washington State (396.4 passing yards per game).

WASHINGTON STATE: The Cougars handed Oregon its first back-to-back home loss since 2002 and snapped Oregon's 8-game win streak over Washington State ... Sophomore QB **Luke Falk** completed 50-of-74 for a career-high 505 yards and 5 TDs as he connected with 10 different receivers ... Junior WR **Gabe Marks** had eight receptions for 111 yards and a pair TDs. It was his third 100-yard game of the season and seventh of his career. Marks is tied for fifth on WSU's all-time list for receptions with 166.

Last Meeting (11/8/14): Redshirt-freshman Luke Falk made his first start and threw for 471 yards as he completed 44-of-61 with five TDs and Washington State snapped a four-game losing streak with a 39-32 victory over Oregon State. Tyler Baker caught nine passes for 113 yards and a touchdown for the Cougars who also snapped a three-game losing streak to the Beavers. Sean Mannion completed 31-of-41 for 419 yards and a touchdown. Garrett Owens added four field goals for the Beavers.

USC at Notre Dame

Sat., Oct. 17 • 7:30 p.m. ET • NBC

USC: Head coach **Steve Sarkisian** was relieved of his duties on Oct. 12, 2015. Offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach **Clay Helton** will serve as interim head coach. Helton also served as USC's interim head coach in the 2013 Las Vegas Bowl, a 45-20 victory over Fresno State ... Freshman LB **Cameron Smith** had a game-best 12 tackles against Washington. His 42 total tackles leads USC, while his 8.4 tackles/game is sixth in the Pac-12. He could be the first true freshman to top the Trojans in tackles in a season since records were first kept in 1954 ... Sophomore WR **JuJu Smith-Schuster** leads the Pac-12 with 123.8 receiving yards/game, averaging 18.8 yards/catch.

Last Meeting (11/29/14): USC's Cody Kessler threw a Notre Dame opponent record 6 TD passes as USC overwhelmed the Irish, 49-14. The 49 points and 35-point margin were USC's most ever in the series. Kessler hit 80% of his passes, completing a career-best 32-of-40 attempts (including 16 consecutive at one point) for 372 yards and no interceptions. His 5 scoring TDs in the first half tied a USC record and were the most ever thrown in a half against Notre Dame.

ARIZONA at COLORADO

Sat., Oct. 17 • 7 p.m. PT • FS1

ARIZONA: Senior RB **Jared Baker** rushed for a career-best 123 yards vs. Oregon State. He's the third different Wildcat to rush for 100 or more yards in a game this season ... The win over Oregon State gave coach **Rich Rodriguez** the 150th of his career (150-100-2) ... Arizona leads the league in scoring (42.3 ppg). The Arizona single-season record for scoring is 38.5 ppg, set in 1954 ... Arizona is second in the Pac-12 in rushing (298.5 avg). The 1954 season also was witness to the school's best single-season rushing average (276.5 avg) ... The seven points allowed in the win over Oregon State are the least amount of points an Arizona defense has surrendered since giving up seven at Washington State on Nov. 7, 2010.

COLORADO: Senior WR **Nelson Spruce** had six receptions for 77 yards at Arizona State and continued to add to his school marks in career receptions (242) and yards (2,724). He is within 18 of becoming the Pac-12's all-time leader in catches. He still is chasing the career TD mark (he has 20, two shy of McKnight's record), and he has caught at least one pass in 31 straight games (multiple in 26 straight) ... Spruce connected on a pass attempt with sophomore QB **Sefo Liufau** for 12 yards. Liufau has four career receptions for 68 yards. All four passes were thrown by Spruce.

Last Meeting (11/8/14): Arizona scored 28 points off of a season-high four forced turnovers, as the Wildcats rolled to convincing 38-20 victory over Colorado. Anu Solomon completed 21-of-38 passes for 211 yards and four TDs on the night, while also rushing for a career-high 115 yards in the win. Nick Wilson rushed for a game-high 153 yards on 21 carries, while Samajie Grant hauled in six balls for a team-high 83 yards and two TDs.

ARIZONA STATE at UTAH

Sat., Oct. 17 • 8 p.m. MT • ESPN

ARIZONA STATE: Junior WR **Tim White** pulled in seven receptions for team-leading 144 yards and 2 TDs in the win over Colorado. Three of his catches went for at least 38 yards, including both TD receptions (38 and 45) ... ASU has had a different receiver lead the team in receiving yardage in each of the six games this season. It had three different receivers lead in that category in all games last season ... Senior QB **Mike Bercovici** tossed five TDs in the win over Colorado, becoming just the third ASU quarterback with 5 TD passes in multiple games ... The ASU defense has now forced its opponent to under 100 rushing yards for the third consecutive game (USC-76, UCLA-62, Colorado-49) ... ASU had 12 tackles for loss and improved its nationally ranking in that category to fourth with a Pac-12 best 9.3 tackles for loss.

UTAH: Utah's 5-0 start is its best since opening the 2010 season with eight-straight wins ... The Utah defense came up with six turnovers in the win over California. The five interceptions were the most in a single game since picking off five against BYU in 2008 ... Senior RB **Devontae Booker** had a season-high 222 rushing yards on a season-high 34 carries. He added 45 receiving yards to lead the Utes with 267 all-purpose yards ... Utah has allowed just two sacks, which is tied for fourth in the nation and leads the Pac-12 ... Senior P **Tom Hackett** is averaging 48.4 yards a punt (19 punts, 920 yards) and opponents have returned just four of them for 21 yards.

Last Meeting (11/1/14): No. 15 Arizona State and No. 18 Utah locked up in a defensive battle before the Sun Devils prevailed in overtime, 19-16. The Sun Devil defense limited Utah to 241 yards total offense and relied on the leg of Zane Gonzalez to boot four field goals, including the game-tying 30-yarder in the 4th quarter and the 36-yarder in overtime. Utah's Andy Phillips booted a pair of field goals as well, including a 50-yarder to put the Utes on the board.

OREGON at WASHINGTON

Sat., Oct. 17 • 7:30 p.m. PT • ESPN2

OREGON: After posting a career-high 246 yards (9.1 ypc) against Washington State, sophomore RB **Royce Freeman** is averaging 143.2 rushing yards per game, ranking sixth nationally. It was his 10th 100-yard rushing performance of his career ... With two TD passes thrown in the game, UO extended its NCAA-record streak to 72 consecutive games with a TD through the air ... Oregon has an 11-game winning streak over Washington, the longest streak in the 107-game series.

WASHINGTON: The Huskies lead the Pac-12, and are 14th in the FBS, in scoring defense (15.0 ppg) ... The Husky defense held USC to 1-of-13 on third down conversions ... Freshman TB **Myles Gaskin** rushed for 134 rushing yards in the win at USC. He's one of three freshman ranked among the Pac-12's top 10 in rushing ... The Husky defense combined for five sacks and held USC to 156 yards passing ... Senior WR **Jaydon Mickens** sits third all-time in UW history with 164 receptions.

Last Meeting (10/18/14): Oregon extended its winning streak over long-time rival Washington to 11 games, the longest by either team in the history of the series, as the No. 9 Ducks beat the Huskies 45-20. Royce Freeman ran for three first-half TDs as the Ducks built a 28-6 halftime lead and the Ducks ran for 218 yards. Marcus Mariota completed 24-of-33 passes for 336 yards and two TDs.

PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS

The Pac-12 is in the second year of a six-year agreement with seven bowl partners that should provide the Conference with a competitive postseason bowl experience. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl Game presented by Northwestern Mutual, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion. In 2015-16, the Cotton Bowl and Orange Bowl are slotted as the College Football Playoff semifinal games. If the Pac-12 champion is ranked among the top four of the College Football Playoff poll following the 2015 season and play in either the Cotton or Orange Bowl, the Pac-12 would back-fill the Rose Bowl game.

USC TABBED TO WIN PAC-12 TITLE IN PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

USC was chosen as the favorite to win the 2015 Pac-12 Conference football title in a preseason poll vote of 45 media members. The Trojans received 21 of 45 votes to earn the preseason favorite pick. USC collected 254 points for the top spot in the South Division, holding 32 of 45 first-place votes. Defending Pac-12 champion OREGON holds the second-most Championship votes, as they garnered 17 votes for the Pac-12 title. The Ducks also picked up 262 points to lead the Pac-12 North. Additionally, ARIZONA STATE tallied three votes for the Pac-12 crown and amassed 200 points for second in the Pac-12 South.

STANFORD was picked to finish second in the Pac-12 North Division, collecting 231 points with eight first-place votes. The Cardinal garnered one vote as the Pac-12 Champion. In the South Division, UCLA was picked to finish third with 180 points and collected six first-place votes, ahead of reigning South Division winner ARIZONA, which tallied 155 votes for fourth place.

The media poll has correctly selected the Conference Champion in 29 of 54 previous polls, including 12 of the last 15. Following are the results of the pre-season media poll (points 6-5-4-3-2-1, first-place votes in parentheses):
