Led ASU to a 38-23 road win at No. 7 UCLA as he completed 27 of 44 pass attempts to seven different receivers for 273 yards and 2 TDs. He added 37 yards on the ground and another score for 310 total yards. Converted 17 of the team's 25 first downs.

DEFENSE

Stefan McClure, Sr., S
California

In Cal's 34-28 victory over Washington State, McClure recorded six tackles, his first career sack (-9 yards) and had a 45-yard fumble return for a touchdown off a Washington State attempted fake punt.

SPECIAL TEAMS

Matt Haack, Jr., P
Arizona State

Helped ASU win the field position battle in 38-23 win at UCLA as he dropped five of eight punts inside the 20-yard line and finished with 345 yards (43.1 avg), including a long 63 yards. Final punt of the game pinned UCLA at its own one-yard line, which led to a safety on UCLA's ensuing drive.

The Pac-12 posted has posted a winning record outside league for 30 consecutive seasons . . . The Pac-12 recorded a 37-9 record in non-conference action last season, posting the most wins ever outside of conference play. Since 1934, only one other season witnessed the Conference capture more than 29 wins in non-league play - 2002 (32-15) when the league played an eight game conference schedule, allowing an additional 10 non-conference games to be played.

AROUND THE PAC-12

POLL WATCHING: The Pac-12 has five or more teams in the AP Top 25 for the eighth consecutive week ... CALIFORNIA moves up to No. 23, the Golden Bears highest ranking since Nov. 29, 2009 (No. 19) ... UTAH moves up to No. 5 in this week's AP poll, matching the highest ranking ever for the Utes during the regular season. Utah appeared at No. 5 in four straight ranking periods to close out the 2004 regular season. The Utes had final AP rankings of No. 2 (2004) and No. 4 (2008) following postseason play ... Utah is the fourth different Pac-12 team this season to be ranked in the Top 10 ... Over the last two seasons, nine different Pac-12 teams have been ranked among the AP Top 25, while six different Conference teams have been ranked among the Top 10 ... With OREGON falling out of the AP poll earlier this season, the Ducks had their streak of Top 25 appearances snapped at 98 weeks. It had been the nation's second-longest active streak.

ALL-PURPOSE: STANFORD sophomore RB **Christian McCaffrey** is currently averaging a FBS-best 229.8 all-purpose yards per game. Since 1978, only four other Conference players have averaged 200 or more all-purpose yards per game for an entire season - USC's Marcus Allen in 1981 (232.6 avg), Stanford's Glyn Milburn in 1990 (202.0 avg), USC's Reggie Bush in 2005 (222.3 avg) and USC's Marqise Lee in 2012 (206.4 avg). Coincidentally, Milburn's teammate in 1990 was Ed McCaffrey (father of Christian), who had 61 receptions for 917 yards and a Conference-leading 91.7 receiving yards per game that season.

EFFICIENT: Four Pac-12 quarterbacks rank among the FBS top 20 in passing efficiency.

IN NO RUSH: Entering last weekend's action, ARIZONA led the Pac-12 in rushing (329.0 yards/game), COLORADO was third (272.0 yards/game) and UCLA was fourth (233.8 yards/game). On the flipside, STANFORD's rush defense was the only one among the four winners last weekend ranked in the top half of the league against the rush as CALIFORNIA was seventh (168.0 yards allowed/game), OREGON eighth (173.5 yards allowed/game) and ARIZONA STATE was 10th (180.5 yards allowed/game). However, those defenses stepped up last week to stop the run on the way to victory. In four Pac-12 games last weekend, Stanford, California, Oregon and Arizona State were able to control the opponent's rushing game as they combined to allow just 271 yards on 123 carries (2.2 yards per rush).

California limited Washington State to 14 yards on 25 carries (0.6 avg)
Arizona State held UCLA to 62 yards on 28 carries (2.2 avg)
Oregon held Colorado to 77 yards on 36 carries (2.1 avg)
Stanford held Arizona to 118 yards on 34 carries (3.5 avg)

STYLE GUIDE: UTAH will wear throwback uniforms for Saturday's game against California. The interlocking UU logo on the throwback helmet, jerseys and pants is from the 1960s, the font for the numbers is from the 1970s and the stripes on the jerseys adorned Utah uniforms from the 1970s-1990s ... OREGON will Salute the State as it introduces the new Oregon Pioneers uniform against Washington State, which emphasizes Oregon state history. A silhouette of Meriwether Lewis and William Clark appears on the helmet.

PAC-12 CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION

#100Pac12: The Pac-12 Conference is set to celebrate 100 years of excellence. The yearlong celebration of the Conference centennial, including marking the date of the official formation 100 years ago on December 2, will kick off with the start of the football season and continue throughout the 2015-16 academic year.

The Conference's storied history dates back 100 years to Dec. 2, 1915 when four schools - the University of California, Oregon Agricultural College (now Oregon State University), the University of Oregon and the University of Washington - gathered at the historic Imperial Hotel in Portland, Ore., to form the Pacific Coast Conference.

Since that day, the Conference has been known for its widespread excellence – on the field, in the classroom, and with the contributions its graduates make in the world. No other Conference can match the collective achievements and distinctions accomplished over the last century.

#COMPLETE12

COMPLETE CAMPAIGN: Pac-12 students are known for their success on the field, but they are also impressive, complete people with outside interests, diverse backgrounds, extracurricular activities, interesting families, busy schedules, and full lives. Here's a look at some of the off-field accomplishments:



READ BETWEEN THE OFFENSIVE LINE: OREGON STATE's starting offensive line has nearly a 3.00 cumulative GPA (2.99). Sophomore OL **Will Hopkins** (Austin, Texas) boasts a 4.00 cumulative GPA in marketing and is in OSU's Honors College. Fall term class load includes Organizational Behavior, Principles of Marketing and Financial Analysis and Planning ... Redshirt freshman OL **Drew Clarkson** (Camas, Wash.) was diagnosed with testicular cancer following his junior year of high school. He endured four rounds of chemotherapy, follow-up treatment and rehab. While successfully fighting the cancer, Clarkson wasn't done with cancer yet. He organized an "Everyone Walk" fundraising event for testicular cancer research as his senior project at Camas High, and he continues to take an active, but not outspoken, role in the fight against the disease.

THIS WEEK'S GAMES

WASHINGTON at USC

Thurs., Oct. 8 • 6 p.m. PT • ESPN

WASHINGTON: The Huskies lead the Pac-12 in scoring defense (15.8 ppg), but now face a USC squad that paces the league in scoring (46.8 ppg) ... The Huskies have given up just 20 points in the second half all season, outscoring opponents 65-20 ... The Huskies start upwards of 12 underclassmen, including QB **Jake Browning**, just the second UW true freshman to start at QB (the other will be on the opposite sideline Thursday night - current USC assistant Marques Tuiasosopo) ... Senior WR **Jaydon Mickens** sits fifth all-time in UW history with 158 receptions and is nearing No. 4 Paul Skansi (161) and No. 3 Kasen Williams (162).

USC: Senior QB **Cody Kessler** remains in the Top 3 nationally in completion percentage (89-of-122, 73.0%), passing TDs (15) and passing efficiency (201.2), is above Russell Wilson's NCAA season record for pass efficiency rating (191.8) and above Andrew Luck's Pac-12 mark for completion percentage (71.3%). In the USC record book, he's third for career TD passes (74). Kessler has now thrown for at least one TD pass in 27 of 31 starts, at least two TDs 19 times, at least four TDs nine times and has thrown for five or more TDs four times ... Sophomore WR **Juju Smith-Schuster** has three straight 100-yard receiving games. He currently leads the Pac-12 with 134.2 receiving yards/game, averaging 19.9 yards/catch.

Last Meeting (10/13/12): Anthony Brown blocked a punt and returned it 21 yards for a touchdown, Jawanza Starling forced a key fourth-quarter fumble, and No. 11 USC used big plays from its defense and special teams to overcome an inconsistent offense in a 24-14 win over Washington. USC's Silas Redd had 155 yards on 26 carries, including first half totals of 108 yards and a TD. Keith Price led Washington by completing 20 of 28 pass attempts for 198 yards and 2 TDs.

OREGON STATE at ARIZONA

Sat., Oct. 10 • 1 p.m. MT • FS1

OREGON STATE: The Beavers lean on freshman QB **Seth Collins** and sophomore WR **Jordan Villamin** who connected for 138 yards last time out against Stanford. Defensively, junior LB **Caleb Saulo** had a career-high 13 tackles in his last contest and has recorded 32 tackles this season (8.0 tackles/game). Junior LB **Rommel Mageo** has 36 tackles and ranks fourth in the league with 9.0 tackles/game. Saulo (6 tackles) and Mageo (23 tackles) combined for 29 tackles all of last season.

ARIZONA: Senior QB **Jerrard Randall** earned his first career start on Saturday night. He set new career highs in passing yards (178), completions (15), and pass attempts (28). He posted 245 yards in total offense ... Senior S **Jamar Allah** recorded a new career-high 11 tackles vs. Stanford. His previous best was nine tackles in the opener vs. UTSA. He is third on the team with 32 tackles (6.4 avg) after having all of 29 tackles for the entire 2014 season ... The Wildcat rushing game features sophomore RB **Nick Wilson**, who leads the Pac-12 at 123.2 rushing yards/game, and Randall, who is sixth in the Pac-12 with 101.0 yards per game.

Last Meeting (9/29/12): Sean Mannion passed for 433 yards and 3 TDs, including a game-winning 9-yard TD strike to Connor Hamlett with 1:09 left in the game and No. 18 Oregon State held off Arizona to win 38-35. The Beavers put up 613 yards of total offense. OSU's Storm Woods rushed for a game-high 161 yards and a TD, while Markus Wheaton had 10 catches for 166 yards and two TDs. Arizona's Matt Scott threw for a 403 yards on 31-of-53 passing with 3 TDs.

WASHINGTON STATE at OREGON

Sat., Oct. 10 • 1 p.m. MT • FS1

WASHINGTON STATE: In the loss at Cal, sophomore QB **Luke Falk** threw for 389 yards, two TD passes and ran for a TD. It was his third 300+ passing game of the season ... The Cougars lead the league in passing offense at 369.2 yards/game ... The Cougars recorded three sacks, pushing their season total to 12. WSU is tied for 17th in the FBS with 3.00 sacks/game ... Washington State has led at halftime in all four games this season ... Junior WR **Gabe Marks** caught 10 passes for 141 yards at Cal, his second 100-yard game of the season and sixth of his career. He leads the Pac-12 with 8.3 receptions per game, while averaging 91.0 receiving yards/game.

OREGON: Oregon avoided losing back-to-back regular season contests for the first time since 2007, downing Colorado on the road, 41-24 ... Sophomore RB **Royce Freeman** recorded his ninth 100-yard rushing performance of his career, going 163 yards on 27 carries ... Defensively, the Ducks had a season-high five sacks from five different players ... With two touchdown passes thrown in the game, UO extended its NCAA-record streak to 71 consecutive games with a TD through the air.

Last Meeting (9/20/14): Oregon's Marcus Mariota finished 21-of-25 passing for 329 yards and five TDs, shrugging off the pressure put on Oregon's inexperienced offensive line, to lead the Ducks to a 38-31 win at Washington State. Mariota was sacked five times in the first half as the Cougars fought to a 21-21 halftime tie. WSU's Connor Halliday completed 43 of 63 pass attempts for 436 yards and 4 TDs.

COLORADO at ARIZONA STATE

Sat., Oct. 10 • 7 p.m. PT • PAC12

COLORADO: The 24 points CU scored in the 41-24 loss to Oregon were its most in the series since a 51-43 win over the Ducks in the 1998 Aloha Bowl ... Junior PK **Diego Gonzalez** is now 9-of-12 in field goals, including a pair of 52-yarders. Will Oliver was 2-of-5 from 50 yards-plus in 2013; the last to make more than two in a year was Mason Crosby (5-of-7 in 2005) ... Senior WR **Nelson Spruce** continues to add to his school marks in career receptions (236) and yards (2,657). Needs 24 to become the Pac-12's all-time leader in catches. He has caught at least one pass in 30 straight games (multiple in 25 straight) ... Junior CB **Ahkello Witherspoon** is the seventh Buff to pick off a pass in 2015, the most in a season since seven players had interceptions in 2010.

ARIZONA STATE: Is 21-1 under Coach Todd Graham when holding the opposition scoreless in the first quarter and 3-0 this season ... 184 of ASU's 251 offensive scoring drives under offensive coordinator Mike Norvell have come in three minutes or less, including 15 of ASU's 21 this season ... Senior WR **D.J. Foster** had a 28-yard reception in the first quarter at UCLA to set the school record for consecutive games with at least one reception at 45. This is the longest streak in the FBS and broke the ASU record previously held by John Jefferson from 1974-77 ... The Devils recorded their first safety since Colorado in 2013. The second safety of the game made it the first two-safety game for ASU since Nebraska in 1996.

Last Meeting (9/13/14): ASU outgained Colorado 222-22 in total yards and 11-1 in first downs in the first quarter en route to building a 14-0 edge. The Buffs turned the tables and wound up outgaining the Sun Devils 545-426 in total offense, but turnovers negated CU's statistical advantages. ASU's D.J. Foster accounted for 206 yards of total offense (147 rush, 59 receiving) and 2 TDs. Colorado's Sefo Liufau finished 31-of-46 passing for 278 yards and three TDs.

CALIFORNIA at UTAH

Sat., Oct. 10 • 8 p.m. MT • ESPN

CALIFORNIA: 5-0 for the first time since 2007, and looks to move to 6-0 for the first time since the 1950 squad won its first nine games during a 9-1-1 campaign ... With four TD passes vs. WSU, junior QB **Jared Goff** set the school record for career TD passes, now with 68, surpassing the mark of 64 by Kyle Boller (1999-2002). Goff completed 33-of-45 passes for 390 yards. It was his fifth career game of four touchdowns or more ... Junior WR **Kenny Lawler** had a season-high 112 receiving yards on seven catches (he's caught a pass in all 27 games he's played at Cal) and a pair of TDs. His 8-yard TD reception in the third quarter gave him 19 career TD receptions ... Cal's defense forced four turnovers vs. WSU, giving the Bears an FBS-leading 18 turnovers gained on the season ... Cal boasted 7.0 sacks vs. WSU (most since 2005 vs. Stanford) and is now seventh in the FBS (3.60 avg).

UTAH: Utah's 4-0 start is its best since opening the 2010 season with eight-straight wins ... The Cal game will be Utah's 34th-consecutive home sellout dating back to the 2010 season opener. Of the 33-straight previous sellouts, 30 were played before standing-room only crowds, including a school-record 47,825 for this year's season-opener against Michigan. The largest crowd ever to attend a Ute home football game prior to Utah's 2011 entry into the Pac-12 was 46,768 for a 2003 win over California ... Utah has allowed just one sack, which is tied for third in the nation and leads the Pac-12 ... Consensus All-American P **Tom Hackett** is averaging 47.8 yards a punt (15 punts, 717 yards) and opponents have returned just three of them for 19 yards.

Last Meeting (10/27/12): Reggie Dunn's two TDs off 100-yard kickoff returns tied the NCAA single-game record and helped Utah defeat Cal 49-27. The Utes built a 28-6 first-half lead before playing out the second half in a 21-21 stalemate. Freshman Travis Wilson passed for 156 yards and rushed for a touchdown to pick up his first win as the starter, while John White ran for 105 yards and two TDs.

OPEN DATE

STANFORD: Over its past three games, Stanford has rushed for 834 yards and averaged 5.8 per rush ... The Cardinal exceeded 40 points for the third consecutive game, its' longest streak in 14 years ... Sophomore RB **Christian McCaffrey** is the only FBS player with 600+ yards rushing and 160+ yards receiving this season, and paces the FBS in all-purpose yards (229.8 avg) ... Over Stanford's past three games, senior RB **Remond Wright** has more rushing touchdowns (7) than the Cardinal has punts (6) ... Senior LB **Blake Martinez** recorded his fifth-straight 10+ tackle game with 13 tackles vs. Arizona and leads the FBS with 12.6 tackles per game.

UCLA: Junior WR **Thomas Duarte** hauled in six receptions for 101 yards and 2 TDs in the loss to Arizona State ... Over the last two games, senior WR **Jordan Payton** and Duarte have combined for 23 receptions for 375 yards and 4 TDs, while nine other receivers have been targets for 18 receptions and 189 yards ... UCLA is off this weekend but returns to action Oct. 15 at No. 16 Stanford, then home vs. No. 23 California the next week. That'll be four ranked opponents in five games for the Bruins.

PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS

The Pac-12 is in the second year of a six-year agreement with seven bowl partners that should provide the Conference with a competitive postseason bowl experience. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl Game presented by Northwestern Mutual, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion. In 2015-16, the Cotton Bowl and Orange Bowl are slotted as the College Football Playoff semifinal games. If the Pac-12 champion is ranked among the top four of the College Football Playoff poll following the 2015 season and play in either the Cotton or Orange Bowl, the Pac-12 would back-fill the Rose Bowl game.

USC TABBED TO WIN PAC-12 TITLE IN PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

USC was chosen as the favorite to win the 2015 Pac-12 Conference football title in a preseason poll vote of 45 media members. The Trojans received 21 of 45 votes to earn the preseason favorite pick. USC collected 254 points for the top spot in the South Division, holding 32 of 45 first-place votes. Defending Pac-12 champion OREGON holds the second-most Championship votes, as they garnered 17 votes for the Pac-12 title. The Ducks also picked up 262 points to lead the Pac-12 North. Additionally, ARIZONA STATE tallied three votes for the Pac-12 crown and amassed 200 points for second in the Pac-12 South.

STANFORD was picked to finish second in the Pac-12 North Division, collecting 231 points with eight first-place votes. The Cardinal garnered one vote as the Pac-12 Champion. In the South Division, UCLA was picked to finish third with 180 points and collected six first-place votes, ahead of reigning South Division winner ARIZONA, which tallied 155 votes for fourth place.

The media poll has correctly selected the Conference Champion in 29 of 54 previous polls, including 12 of the last 15. Following are the results of the pre-season media poll (points 6-5-4-3-2-1, first-place votes in parentheses):
