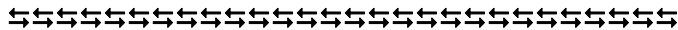

**QUICKLY** Colorado won the coin toss and then elected to receive for the fifth straight game in 2014 ... The game time of 4:01 was the longest in CU history, topping the previous by 1 minute (4:00 vs. Missouri, also in OT, in Boulder on Oct. 9, 1999) ... The **56** points were the most ever scored by Colorado in losing a game (old: at Kansas in 2010 in a 52-45 loss) ... The **115** combined points are the third most in a CU game (trailing 124 in an 82-42 loss to Oklahoma on 10/4/1980, and 116 in a 65-51 win over Nebraska on 11/23/2007—both games in Boulder) ... CU tied its record for the most first downs in a game with **39** (matching the mark set against Northwestern in 1978) ... This was just the fourth time CU ran 100 or more plays in a game, as the **110** today were the most in its history; the old high was 105 against Kansas State in a 54-7 win in 1992 (the last time the Buffs hit triple digits; CU did have 100 at the end of regulation) ... With 629 yards of total offense, it marked the first time CU topped 600 in a game since rolling up **634** against Miami-Ohio on 9/22/2007 (359 rush, 275 pass) ...

The Buffs have recorded **400**-plus yards in four straight games for the first time since the first four games of the 2001 season ... Colorado's **21** first quarter points were its most since Oct. 8, 2005, when it also scored 21 in an eventual 41-20 win over Texas A&M in Boulder... it was the most in a quarter since scoring 22 in the fourth quarter against USC last Nov 23 ...

Colorado had one of its busses experience some motor trouble on the way to the stadium (Bus No. 2, offense); halfway to the stadium from the Walnut Creek Marriott, all three pulled over while the occupants on it transferred to Bus No. 3 (staff); the delay only was about 5 minutes ...

**OVERTIME** Colorado is now 5-6 all-time in OT (last was also against Cal, in Boulder on Sept. 10, 2011—Cal won, 36-33); this was the sixth time CU won the coin toss (3-3, on defense first all six times). It was just CU's second multiple OT; it lost 34-31 to Baylor in Boulder in 3OT in 2006.


 **WR NELSON SPRUCE (19-176, 3 TD)** He broke the single-game reception record he established just last week, and now has at least one receiving touchdown in **seven** straight games, adding to his school mark as well. He is just the third player to snare three TDs in a game, joining Richard Johnson against Kansas (11/13/1982 in Boulder) and Rae Carruth (11/9/1996 at Missouri). He also added to his school marks for the most consecutive games with seven receptions (five) and six catches (six). He has 32 receptions in the last two games, the two highest games in CU history:

Spruce has 56 catches for 694 yards and 10 TDs in 2014; he now has **155** career catches, moving into fourth all-time at Colorado; he is ninth with **1,790** receiving yards; and with **17** career TDs, he is now tied for sixth.

**25,000:** Spruce's 6-yard TD reception that gave CU a 42-35 lead with 3:23 remaining enabled him to score CU's 25,000th point in its history; the Buffs had 24,999 prior to the play.

 **TB TONY JONES (13-69 RUSHING, 1-13 RECEIVING)** He became the **51st** Colorado Buffalo to rush for 1,000 career yards (ending the game with 1,041). He has 437 career receiving yards, needing 63 more to join CU's 500/500 club in both (done just 12 times) and the 1,000/500 club (done just eight times).

 **QB SEFO LIUFAU (67-46-1, 449, 7 TD; 10-72 RUSH)** He set numerous single-game records this afternoon: passing attempts (**67**; old: 64 Cody Hawkins at Toledo 9/11/2009), completions (**46**; old: 38, Joel Klatt vs. Kansas in OT, 10/11/2003), touchdown passes (**7**; old: 5 on three occasions, John Hessler twice, Koy Detmer once); and total offensive yards (**521**; old: 500 twice, Mike Moschetti v. San Jose State, 9/11/1999; Tyler Hansen vs. Cal, 9/10/2011-OT). His 449 yards were the fourth-most in a single game at Colorado. He now has thrown 2 or more TD passes for eight consecutive games (adding to his own CU record and one shy of the mark of nine straight games with at least one, held by Detmer and Hawkins). His 39-yard run in the first quarter was the longest by a CU quarterback since Tyler Hansen ran the same length against Georgia on Oct. 2, 2010 (in Boulder).

**Liufau-to-Spruce:** they have connected for **10** touchdown plays this season (old record: 8, on two occasions), and for 13 in their careers (record: 15, Cody Hawkins-to-Scotty McKnight).

**INDIVIDUAL LINER NOTES**

► **SS Tedric Thompson** made his third interception of the season, that's the most by a CU strong safety in a SEASON since Michael Lewis had five in 2001.

► **PK Will Oliver** did extend his streak to **81** consecutive extra points made.

# Cal-Colorado Postgame Notes

With today's 59-56 California win over Colorado in double overtime, the Golden Bears now lead the all-time series, 5-3. The teams combined for the most points (115) scored in a single-game in Cal history in the modern era. The previous modern era record was 111 when Cal beat Arizona in overtime in 1996. The all-time record is 127 against Saint Mary's in 1920.

This game was the second overtime meeting in the series history with Cal winning the other meeting in Boulder, 36-33. The last overtime game at Cal was in 2006 when the Bears beat Washington, 31-24.

The 92-yard touchdown pass from [Jared Goff](#) to [Daniel Lasco](#) in the second quarter was the longest pass play in school history, surpassing the previous record of 90 yards from [Zach Maynard](#) to [Keenan Allen](#) at Washington in 2011. The 99-yard drive also tied for the most in school history.

Goff ended the night 23-for-41 for 449 yards, seven touchdowns and a 199.6 passer rating. The seven touchdown passes are a career high, and the most since Pat Barnes threw eight touchdowns in overtime vs. Arizona in 1996. The 449 passing yards ranks fifth all-time in school single-game history, and Goff owns four top-10 totals in the category.

Goff now has 10 career multi-touchdown games and seven games with three or more touchdown passes. He is also tied for fifth now all-time at Cal with nine 250-yard passing performances and second with six 300-yard passing performances. It was also the fourth time Goff threw for 400 yards or more in his career, first time this year. He is tied with Rich Campbell for 10th in school history in career passing touchdowns with 35.

Both Goff and Colorado quarterback Sefo Liufau threw for 449 yards and seven touchdown passes. The 14 combined passing touchdowns was a Cal single-game record for combined touchdown passes.

[Stephen Anderson](#) was Cal's leading receiver with career highs in receptions (7), receiving yards (136) and longest reception (75-yard touchdown). It was his second career touchdown in as many games.

[Kenny Lawler](#) caught a 22-yard touchdown strike for Goff's third touchdown pass of the day in the third quarter. He later added a second score. It was Lawler's fourth multi-touchdown game of his career and his second this season. It was the ninth and 10th career receiving TDs for Lawler, and his fourth and fifth of the season.

Lasco led the Bears in rushing with 18 carries for 108 yards and a rushing touchdown in addition to his record-setting receiving TD. He set a personal best in all-purpose yards with 200. It was his second straight game of rushing for over 100 yards.

Goff's first touchdown pass was caught by [Lucus Gingold](#). It was Gingold's first career touchdown on his fourth career catch. [Jake Kearney](#) picked up his first career interception in the fourth quarter.

Cal posted four plays of at least 40 yards vs. Colorado after entering the game with a total of nine plays of 40 or more yards through the Bears' first three games. In addition to Lasco and Anderson's long-play scores, and a 41-yard reception by [Khalfani Muhammad](#), [Chris Harper](#) hauled in a 40-yard touchdown reception.

[Bryce Treggs](#) was on the receiving end of Goff's seven passing touchdown that happened in the first overtime.

Cal converted on four of five redzone attempts after entering the game leading the Pac-12 in redzone efficiency (12-12, 1.000). [Cameron Walker](#) led the Bears in tackles with 12, one shy of his career high, while [Michael Barton](#) tied his personal best with eight tackles for loss.

The last time Cal won its conference home opener was in 2010 against UCLA. The last time Cal overcame a 14-point deficit en route to victory was in 2009 when Cal overcame a 14-0 deficit against Stanford and beat the Cardinal, 34-28.

## CALIFORNIA HEAD COACH SONNY DYKES

### **General comments:**

"Wow, I think I have aged 100 years in the last two weeks. After last week's loss it's nice to be on the other side this week and win a hard-fought, tough football game. You have got to give our players a lot of credit for bouncing back. When things went south in this ballgame they never panicked, they just kept hanging in there. Defense gave up a lot of plays, but they made a play at the end of the game when we needed one. That fourth down stop was huge. We had a lot of guys that made some big plays. [James Langford](#) making that kick was huge for us. He's a guy that hasn't made a kick like that in the past because he hasn't been in those situations. It was great to see him come through like that for us, and I am really proud of him for doing that. Our guys persevered. I told them at halftime, if there has ever been a team that knows about perseverance, sticking together and battling through adversity, it's these guys. They did a great job in the second half finding a way to win a football game, so I am really proud of them for that."

### **On the defense in OT:**

"There are a lot of plays in a football game and they are all important. If you go back to last week's loss, there are a couple of plays in the third quarter where, if we had converted third down, or didn't bust an assignment, we probably would have won that game. It just shows you that every single play is critical. Part of the maturation of a football team is understanding that playing those plays out and playing hard when your back is up against the wall. It was a heck of an effort on that fourth down to get that stop. That was critical in us winning the ballgame."

### **On [Jared Goff](#):**

"I'll say this about Jared – he always seems to make the plays when we need him to and he certainly did that down the stretch. He probably wasn't as sharp today as he had been, but I didn't think we played particularly well up front. We got pressured a little bit more than we should have and we didn't play very clean football offensively. We were out of sync at times. We have to give Colorado credit because they really challenged us. They played a lot of man coverage and forced us to win on the outside. Their corners are good and we knew coming in those guys were good players. They are two of the better corners we are going to play against this season. We've got to give credit to Jared. Like the rest of our guys, he is incredibly resilient, believes in his receivers and he did a great job giving them opportunities to make plays."

### **On hitting various milestones:**

"When you are not very good, which we weren't last year, then a lot of the wins you get are first this and first that. I am ready for that to be over because that means we have won enough games and we don't have to worry about that stuff anymore. We still believe that we have the chance to build a good program here. I believed that when I came here. We believe in our players and believe in their work ethic and character. I think that when a lot of good people care about each other, work incredibly hard and are unselfish, they get things to happen. I really like these kids. They work hard, they are conscientious, they care about each other, they love this university and what it represents and I am really proud to coach them."

### **On [Daniel Lasco](#):**

"He is running so physical. When he has a run like that, it obviously gives us a ton of energy and you could feel the sideline, the excitement. He is really playing well and running so hard. He is doing so many different things for us. He brings a physical element to the run game that we need. Two weeks in a row, he has had over 100 yards. He had another great ball game today."

### **[Jared Goff](#), QB**

#### **On whether this is the craziest game he has been a part of:**

"It's probably up there with last week as the craziest game I've ever been a part of, but obviously it feels a lot better this time and I'm just so proud of the guys. I was confident going into overtime and we knew what we were going to do. The defense making that fourth down stand for us is what did it. It was just a whole team effort today. That's just the best way to describe it. Everyone had to do something at some point to help us win, and fortunately we came out on top."

#### **On halftime adjustments for the offense:**

"We really didn't change much; we just kept doing what we were supposed to do. In the first half, everything that could have gone wrong went wrong. We had a lot of penalties, I started the game off with an interception and nothing seemed to be going right. We knew there was a whole second half of football to go."

#### **On [Stephen Anderson](#)'s emergence:**

"Stephen played a great game for us, especially with Darius (Powe) out. We needed him to play well and he did. That touchdown when I was rolling out and he was going across was big time."

### **[James Langford](#), PK**

#### **On what he was thinking lining up for the potential game-winning field goal:**

"I definitely wasn't thinking about my miss earlier because you can't dwell on the past, especially as a kicker. It's kick-by-kick and you just have to have a short-term memory whether you make it or miss it. The next kick is the most important one that matters. It's pretty hard to remove yourself from the situation because you know what is at stake, but you're not focused on that in the moment. It all happens pretty fast, but you are focusing on your technique and trying to visualize it going through the uprights."

#### **On after hearing the crowd's reaction to his game-winner:**

"It is just a huge rush of happiness obviously and being around your best friends and teammates for one of the best moments of your life is totally priceless."



## **Bryce Treggs, WR**

### ***On his overtime touchdown and the team's first conference win in nearly two years:***

"On the touchdown, I had a post route and the safety came down. It was sort of a cover one coverage and the corner was playing outside shade on me, so I stemmed him inside and pressed the vertical leaving the post wide open. It's very exciting to get our first conference win in a while. We are just ecstatic right now."

## **Colorado HEAD COACH Mike MacIntyre**

### ***General comments:***

"If you're a fan, that was a fun one to watch. If you're the losing team, it's absolutely gut wrenching. Our players played their heart out. We could have done a couple things better as a coaching staff. Our young men could have made some more plays. We should have done it right in regulation, but we didn't. I tip my hat to Cal. They got it done. What a gorgeous day to play football, and they found a way to win it."

### ***On the team's performance:***

"We just didn't make a few plays in regulation. We would have won. In overtime, we didn't get in down there, which was tough. We stopped them and made them kick a pretty long field goal, and they made it. You can look at a million different things. I could have done things differently, but they had good plays. I think they've learned that they have to keep on fighting and trying to win. They're never down and out. They never say die; they really don't. That's the thing that I've seen with these guys, we've changed completely. If they keep doing that, which they will, and we keep coaching them in certain situations and these young kids keep playing despite all their situations. we'll get those wins."

### ***On the last play:***

"We miscommunicated that. It was a mess up at a tough time. That play did not lose the football game, though. We could have made a bunch of other plays during the regulation, that's something we have got to do a better job at as coaches, as players, just executing that. We would have executed that. I think the play would have walked right in. Miscommunication was on the whole team, staff, coaches, everyone. We just didn't execute it right. Cal made a couple scramble plays, the quarterback made a couple good plays. We didn't execute some stuff as well as we would have liked. We made a lot of the same mistakes and they made a lot of the same plays. We had a couple busts, you just hope they don't find them, but they did. There was no dramatic change by either team. They made a couple plays and we didn't."

### ***On overtime:***

"I didn't go for the two-point conversion because if I went for two and I didn't make it people would say 'why go for two?' Sometimes you can go for two and make it. I feel like we could go in overtime to see what was going to happen and we just didn't get it done. I don't think Cal could have gone for the Hail Mary. I don't know, maybe they thought it was too long. I don't know what they were thinking. I don't know what other teams are thinking. Everybody has different thoughts on that. I considered going for the field goal, but when we got to the half line, I thought we could do it. I thought what we had would have worked, but we just didn't execute it right. The Cal defense did a good job, we just couldn't get much push."

### ***On kicker, Will Oliver:***

"He'll make them next week. I was really hoping he was going to get a chance to hit a winner. I was telling him, 'You're going to hit a winner.' He'll bounce back. It was just a tough day for all of us. He had a tough day."

## **Sefo Liufau, QB**

### ***On the loss***

"It hurts a lot. It'll hurt for any team. Losing in overtime, in a game of that magnitude, it was a close game throughout. Give credit to Cal, they're a really good team and we just came one mistake short. I'm proud of the guys for fighting for four quarters. We'll definitely bounce back from this starting Monday."

### ***Did you think you'd be able to pass for a lot of yards heading into the game?***

"It's not about the statistics; it's just what the defense gives us. They we're coming up and trying to play a bunch of cover one and we had to make them pay for that. I think we did that for the most part and everyone played a great game on the outside. We spread it around for the most part. Obviously Nelson (Spruce) had a bunch of catches for us. Sometimes you have to go to your playmaker and that's what Spruce is."

### ***Was your plan to throw to Nelson Spruce all game?***

"Sometimes he's the last read in the progression. Sometimes it's just what the defense gives us, it comes back to him. It's not by design to get Spruce the ball 50 times. He's a playmaker, playmakers make plays and that's what Spruce is. He's going to make a lot of plays like that."
