Colorado Head Coach

Mike MacIntyre

General

"I thought our kids played hard today, and in the first half if we could have held them on a couple third downs I don't think they would have been able to hang around as well. That option offense is a good offense, they did a good job with it, but I thought our two freshmen, Sefo (Liufau) and Michael Adkins did some good things today. I'm very thankful that Charleston Southern wanted to play us or we wouldn't have been able to play today, that was great for the city of Boulder, great for our campus and great for our football team. I really appreciate those guys they're a good football team, they're a very, very good (FCS) football team there's no doubt.

On Where The Team Is At

"We're 3-3 with three bowl (eligible) wins, we need to go get the one next week and if we do that it means November matters in Colorado which is great, that's what our kids want to have happen. We have to play better in the Pac-12, I have to coach better, our guys have to play better and that's what we plan on doing. I think we play better at home too, I think they enjoy playing at home, so I'm excited about us playing next Saturday against a good Arizona team with a running back that can really run."

On The Defense

"I think it was very important in the second half. We made a couple mistakes in the first half on a couple line stunts where it opened up a gap and he (Kyle Copeland) was able to scramble. I thought they played hard."

On QB Sefo Liufau's Recognition

"I thought Sefo (Liufau) did a good job with recognition. That first play of the game we had a little throw there to get him going and he threw it in the dirt and I was like 'Oh crud,' but he didn't let it affect him. He made a lot of good throws, he made one really good third down play where he jumped and threw it and I was pleased with a lot of things he did. Are there a couple things he can do better? No doubt, but he can see it on the film."

On TB Michael Adkins

"I think he's a very good player. He has power, he has speed, he has vision, and he's very bright. That one run he made today over on the sidelines when it looked like it was all clogged up and he just crept in there, broke two tackles and then outran everybody to me was a really impressive run and I was excited to see that."

On The Running Backs

"You've got to have more than one. You really have to have three. Tony (Jones) came in and did a good job too. So we'll keep using those guys and of course we'll use Michael (Adkins) more and more as we go."

On The Touchdown Reversal

"In a situation like that I said, 'I'm going to give you more time to look at it.' I might as well, it's a timeout on a touchdown play at that point in the game. I called a timeout, and sure enough about halfway through the timeout they came over to

me and said 'Yup we missed it, so we'll overturn it.' So that was a good deal for us."

On Michael Adkins Upstaging Sefo Liufau

"I was glad that Michael (Adkins) did that. And there's nobody happier in that locker room than Sefo (Liufau) because if you get a running game going that makes you comfortable as a quarterback."

On QB Sefo Liufau

"He's able to move in the pocket and still be accurate. He did a good job of throwing the ball away a few times today, and didn't really force the ball. He did some good things; he just needs to keep improving with the rest of the guys."

On DL De'Jon Wilson

"De'Jon (Wilson) made some good plays, he showed some explosion out there and we've seen that in practice. He's starting to learn how to play and De'Jon (Wilson) will keep playing in every game now."

On CSU QB Kyle Copeland

"I didn't know until he came out there. He's a better runner than the other guy and I felt like they wanted to ground the clock out, and they were right there for a second."

On The Time Of Possession Discrepancy

"Well we had some big plays. In the second half I don't think there was that big of a discrepancy, in the first half is where there was a discrepancy but we had some big plays for scores which was exciting to see."

On His Frustration With The Defensive Line

"We had three third down plays where we had stuff called and worked on, and one of the young men was supposed to go under the tackle instead of outside the tackle and it opened it wide up so I was just upset about that at the time."

On Next Week's Game Against Arizona

"We need to get better for Arizona, they're a true spread football team, excellent running back, their quarterback is really athletic, so we need to be ready to stop them and slow them down. Offensively we need to consistently move the ball and go score. I know all that sounds relative but it's true. We haven't played as well as we like in the Pac-12 games and that's something we need to go do, we need to get over that mental hump and go do it."

On DE Chidera Uzo-Diribe

"Chidera (Uzo-Diribe) made a real big play, he's caused a lot of fumbles this year. I should just start calling him the 'Honey Badger' because he just causes fumbles all the time."

On CU's Pac-12 Struggles

"There's always talent situations every team you play, but I really think it's a mental hurdle with us, and I really think that we're closer to beating it."

On Overcoming The Mental Hurdle

"They have to keep believing and keep doing the right things under pressure. When the guy makes a play or the guy is really quick and fast you can't throw everything out the window, you got to keep doing what you're coached to do and you need to do it harder and better and that's part of it."



Charleston Southern Head Coach **Jamey Chadwell**

On Overall Impressions of the Game

"All year long, how we have won games has been by not giving away turnovers and by keeping the ball away from the opponent. We did a great job of keeping it away from [Colorado] during the first half, but then we had a turnover. It felt like we got a couple of reverse calls in there that kind of went against us, too. During the second half, they took it to us and we couldn't get anything past them. When we were on the offensive, we had that huge interception. We had to win with a certain recipe, and when they got us out of that, we weren't good enough to beat them."

On the Overtaken Touchdown

"I didn't see a replay. When I was upset was when they took a time out, they reviewed the play, it was fine, then the other review took an hour. They didn't go by their protocol. Then, when we got the low fumble, they called it a fumble and I said, 'I want to review that.' I just felt like it was a huge deal momentum-wise, because that could have meant a touchdown for us, and those were huge plays. I couldn't tell whether the throw was incomplete or not, I couldn't tell you. It was a huge deal at the time, though, because it was at the point where the score was 15-7 or whatever it was at the time. We still had a chance in the second half, though, and we didn't do that either."

On Going Into Next Week

"This week, we had a change-up when we lost our starting quarterback, and our back-up quarterback didn't play because of his concussion last week. What we did today, though—besides the turnover—is pretty much how we play. [Colorado] is just a better team than us. We had seven wins before today, and I don't think that is going to change. The only difference is that we won't play quite as good of a team. They made some good adjustments during the second half, and as for us, we are going to keep doing what we do."

On Freshman QB Kyle Copeland

"I thought [Copeland] did extremely well, given the situation. Especially during the first half, he made some great runs on the third down. I thought he did a great job today. In the second half, he tried to force a couple of things, which caused us some turnovers. Overall, though, I thought he did a great job and handled the game well. There were a couple of mistakes that he made, which cost us some things, but other people made mistakes, too."

On Getting the Chance to Play an Extra Game

"Getting to play a Pac-12 team, even when the stadium was not necessarily packed full, was definitely an experience for us. We also wanted to see if we could compete at this level. For the first half, we did that. In the second half, we did not. What we can take from this is that if we play well and to our capabilities, then we can compete with some really good teams; that is what we are going to sell. We got beaten by a team that was better than us. I don't know how good [Colorado] is in their league—probably not very good—but they are better than us. They beat us, and I am not going to be upset at our guys about that. I am upset about the fact that we did not do some things that we normally do, which cost us. We will look at this as a positive. We hate losing, and we are not used to that right now. I think that this helps us focus for these teams we have coming up. If we had won this game, it would have been unbelievable, but the challenge next week would have been huge. At least now, first of all, we have their attention. Now, we will just see how they respond. Our guys handled it the right way, and I expect us to learn from this experience."

WR Paul Richardson

ON THE WIN – “It was very big. We needed to not go too far below .500 and we needed this win. We can get three more.”

ON GAINING COMFORT WITH QB SEFO LIUFAU – “Definitely [comfortable]. This game was big for him [Liufau]; it was big for his confidence and it was a good first game for him to come in and start. It was also a good game for Michael Adkins to have his break out game.”

ON LIUFAU’S DEFENSIVE RECOGNITION – “I think he does a very good job on it. They try to keep everything pretty simple for him to build his confidence, and then we threw some things in there to challenge his IQ and he responded well.”

ON TOUCHDOWN – “Once I started running, I wanted to split it and just go down the field but I didn’t have that gear; so I was smart and I just cut across the field and out ran the defender’s angle.”

ON CHARLESTON SOUTHERN’S OFFENSE – “In the first half, we missed a couple tackles and I feel like we tackled better in the second half and shut them up.”

ON PREPARING FOR THE OPTION – “We have been preparing for the option for about two weeks now, so we were well prepared. We knew we just had to see the backfield sets and that’s where the ball was going.”

ON WHAT THE WIN MEANS FOR THE DEFENSE – “It means a lot. We have our confidence up and we have six Pac-12 games ahead of us. We have to play hard, play aggressive, and do our assignment.

QB Sefo Liufau

ON FIRST COLLEGIATE START – “It feels good. It was really fun to be out there with the guys and just play and have fun. It’s just like any other game and we’re already getting ready for Arizona.”

ON CONFIDENCE PROGRESSING THROUGH GAME - “That confidence is attributed to the team. The offensive line blocking, the receivers running their routes, and especially on some of our run-pass option plays, you know, Paul had a great play over on the side. So I definitely had confidence that kept growing throughout the game.”

THOUGHTS ON “BURNED” REDSHIRT – “I just had to be prepared and ready to do whatever is necessary that the coaching staff wanted because they have the best knowledge and know what is best for me and team.”

ON HAVING A SOLID RUSHING ATTACK – “It helps. It keeps the defense honest because we can both run and pass the ball. Once they started manning up our guys, we ran the ball and we had big runs by Michael [Adkins].”

ON HIGH AMOUNT OF CARRIES – “My reps have been increasing every week, so I just took advantage of the carries that I got. It got me into a rhythm, just stay in the holes and keep having that consistent pounding that eventually turned into long runs.”

ON FORCING MISSED TACKLES – “Our line blocked well and I just kept grinding and fighting for yards.”

ON CONFIDENCE FROM TODAY’S GAME – “It gave me a lot of confidence. I didn’t score in my first three games, so it gave me a lot of confidence moving forward.”

THOUGHTS ON HAVING TWO COMPETING RUNNING BACKS – “Obviously having that 1-2 punch and competition between the two backs helps out a lot in practice. Obviously, we want to see which one is going to do better but, we want to play together and do what we have to do to help the team win. It’s not really a competition thing; it’s more of a team thing.”

FOLSOM FIELD WIN #299 In improving to 2-1 at home this season, Colorado is now **299-158-10** in its 90th season playing its home games at Folsom Field. The first game at Folsom was Oct. 11, 1924 (then known as Colorado Stadium, built at a cost of \$75,000); previous, CU was **73-17-6** at Gamble Field and **19-5** on other grass areas of campus; the Buffs are **391-180-16** all-time at home.

QUICKLY Colorado is now **0-6** on the coin toss in 2013 ... The first half took **1 hour, 16 minutes** to play ... The final game time was **2:50**, CU's first sub-3:00 game since 2011 at UCLA (2:54), and the fastest since Nov. 23, 1991 at Iowa State (a 17-14 win in a blizzard) ... Colorado is now **3-2** all-time vs. FCS programs, Charleston Southern fell to **0-23** against FBS teams ... **TB Michael Adkins** and **QB Sefo Liufau** made their first collegiate starts today; junior **DE Andre Nichols** saw his first college action (FG/PAT unit) ... Colorado held CSU to 46 yards and just two first downs in the second half (0-of-6 on third downs) ... There were just **111** total plays in the game (CU averaged 8.0 on its 52, CSU 3.3 on its 59 (which ate up 36:47 on the clock); the previous low for combined plays in a CU game this year was 145 last week at Arizona State.

WEIRD NOTE OF THE DAY The two-point conversion was added to college football in 1958; today marked the first time a CU punter played a role in converting one when **Darragh O'Neill** ran it in.

► Colorado is **3-of-5** on two-point conversions this year; that is the most makes since 2002 (4-of-4) and the most attempts since 2003 (0-of-5).

COLORADO INJURIES OT **Marc Mustoe** (broken fibula); he is out for the remainder of the season. No other significant injuries reported by the training staff.

WR PAUL RICHARDSON (8-122-1 TD) Now officially at the midway points of the season, **P-Rich** now has **43** catches for **782** yards, 18.2 per, with six touchdowns. That is over halfway to CU's season records 78 (**D.J. Hackett**, 2003), 1,149 (**Charles E. Johnson**, 1992) and 11 (**Derek McCoy**, 2003). His 60-yard TD reception was the fifth play of 50 yards or longer this season and the 11th of his career. It was his fourth 100-yard game of the season, giving him seven for his career (records are six and 12, respectively); the latter is fourth all-time at CU.

► His six TD catches this year have covered **330** yards (55.0 per), and his 17 career have spanned **701** yards (41.2).

QB SEFO LIUFAU (20-14-0, 198, 1 TD, 169.7 RATING) In making his first career start, he passed for the fourth most yards by a freshman in a first career start (third most by true frosh). rushed for the fifth most yards by a freshman (fourth-most by a true frosh) in his a first career start.
