# **Colorado Head Coach Jon Embree**

#### General

"Congratulations to coach (Jim) McElwain and Colorado State. They found a way to get it done and win the game and congratulations to them. Obviously we didn't play good enough we had too many turnovers we talked about that. Protecting the ball was going to be key for us in a game like this and we didn't do it and they were able to take advantage of it and we weren't effective running the ball. We better get that fixed. It has been too many games of us not running the ball so we will get that figured out."

#### On The Punt Before Half

"Special teams had a block. We were supposed to get and fair catch it and obviously we didn't do that. I don't think it deflated our team by any chance, we had a good mindset coming into halftime."

#### On What To Tell The Team

"We have to go to work on Monday. Nobody is going to feel sorry for you, so we will look at it, we will be critical coaches included. We have to get ready to play another game."

#### On The Reversed Call At The Goal Line

"We actually thought we scored. We thought the ball broke the plane. We had a fourth down call we liked but we were not able to execute it."

## On The Fourth Down Play At The End

"We felt it gave us more options, we had three options. We had a run and two guys to throw it to, and they did a good job of defending it. We felt it was better for us. Tony Jones was out with a shoulder and Malcolm Creer got dinged a little bit on that so, we thought that was our best option."

#### On Ray Polk's Condition

"I don't know, we will have to wait and find out. I guess tomorrow, I think it is going to be a while regardless with him. Same with Greg Henderson, and a couple other guys with some injuries so we will see where we are at."

#### On Colorado State's Unfamiliar Coaching

"There was a decent amount that surprised us, but it's going to be like that in any opener. That is not an excuse. If we just handle our business and do our job, communicate. One was just no communication on the touchdown after the muffed punt. Half the guys heard one call, half the guys didn't, so not to take anything away from that play call execution from them. It will be like that every year you play an opener. You are always going to get new wrinkles and things."

#### On The Young Returners

"Kenneth Crawley mishandled the one but other than that he did good. I thought Crawley did well. I thought Marques Mosley did a decent job of running it up in there on the kick returns. I wasn't overly concerned about those young guys."

#### On Losing Momentum In The Second Half

"We got out of whack. We had some drops and then a couple "almosts" the quarterback and the receivers never quite got in sync. Early on we had some drops, but that was just nerves I wasn't really concerned about it. Kenneth Crawley had a drop in the first half but then bounced back, as well as Nelson Spruce and Tyler McCulloch. They were clicking well in the second quarter and then for whatever reason we just were not in sync."

#### On Trouble Running The Ball

"I don't know what it is, and that is a bothersome issue. You have to be able to run the ball, so we need to look at what we are doing and get it figured out."

#### On The No Huddle Offense

"We will continue to be no huddle as the season goes on. We have a lot of plays we weren't as productive as we need to be. We did not get the production out of it that we need. Part of that was our inability to run the ball; you have to be able to do that in that offense for it to be successful for you. We also have to get faster at it and I think that will happen as we continue to work on it."

#### **On Bowl Game Aspirations**

"I am still hoping for one. Why not? Last year our goal was to win on the road. We have eleven games left and we have a lot of work. We have to keep pushing and striving to try and obtain that goal."

#### On Colorado State's Second Half Defense

"We still had opportunities they did a good job of getting pressure. The ball was a little bit behind or receivers not making a play. It just takes one play when you are throwing it. All of a sudden you get a little bit of momentum and get them on their heels and that helps you. But in our passing game we weren't in good sync."

#### On Lack Of Communication

"Some things we couldn't really prepare for. When they are doing stuff and you have a certain defense call, but sometimes those guys don't get it communicated all the way across the field."

#### On Worried About His Youthful Squad

"No we have to play them. We recruited them here for a reason, these guys played well. Kenneth Crawley had a decent punt return and he will get better as he becomes more confident. The young guys played well, with this being their first game. We will just keep feeding them to the fire."

#### On Jordan Webb's Performance

"I thought Jordan played well. He gave us a chance and the receivers an opportunity to make some plays. He had a real nice pass to Tyler McCulloch for a touchdown. I expect him to continue to play better each week.

ON SPECIAL TEAMS—"We just have to get better mentally. Get out all the jitters and we had to execute more."

ON THE FRESHMEN—"I thought the freshmen played a good game. They took it upon themselves to show what they could do when they got their reps. I think most of them just had fun."

ON THE FUMBLE-"I was back there—it was punt safe. I was supposed to secure it, look it in—make sure that I caught it. Instead, I tried to catch it and run."

ON BEING DISPOINTED ABOUT THE FUMBLE—"It's really disappointing because you know it is a mistake mentally. You could have avoided it."

#### **WR Gerald Thomas**

ON HIS FIRST COLLEGE FOOTBALL GAME-"It was real nerveracking. Just all the people, the fans and family in the stands—I was nervous at first playing in front of all of those people. I kind of settled down as the game went on."

ON HIS JUGGLING CATCH-"The corner was playing tight and I wasn't sure if he was still on me. I picked up on him early instead of focusing on the catch. The ball got away from me, but I was able to then concentrate on it and make the catch."

ON HOW HE FELT THE GAME WENT-"I feel like I could have been better. I feel like I could have made plays instead of bobbling the ball. I was just real nervous with it being my first game and I knew how much the game meant to everybody. Next week, come practice, I'll be more focused for the next game."

ON THE LOSS AFFECTING THE UPPERCLASSMEN-"I could really tell. We only have a handful of seniors and it meant a lot to them to win this game. I could really tell that it affected them. We just have to come back to work next week and not sit on this loss—come back ready to work."

ON THE FRESHMEN HAVING FINALLY PLAYED IN A GAME-"I think we will all do better. I think this game was one of the largest crowds that we will play in front of. This game really helped us settle in and get ready for college football. I feel as the season goes on, we will get better each week."

#### **WR Nelson Spruce**

ON HAVING A GOOD DAY "This being my first game, I was able to see what the rivalry was like in action. It was nice having a good game I guess, but the ultimate goal is a win and we didn't get that. We have to go back and start working again."

ON THE FAILED FOURTH-AND-ONE ON THE GOAL LINE-"We were down two there. We needed the points to get the lead back. It was a big play and they stepped up to the plate and held us."

ON THE FRESHMEN-"I thought all the young guys were really comfortable. Gerald [Thomas] I know on offense being split out with me, he was calm the whole time. You saw him make some plays. I thought all of them (the freshmen) were calm. We'll just have to watch the film and see what our downfall was."

ON COMFORT LEVEL WITH QB JORDAN WEBB-"I think off the bat, right when he came in, he developed a great chemistry with all the receivers. As the season goes on, we'll get more and more comfortable and we'll be able to put it together for four quarters."

#### **DL Chidera Uzo-Diribe**

ON THE GAME-"We put in a lot of work this offseason. It hurts to come out here and lose this one. We'll be ready to rebound. We've got to be on the same page."

ON ISSUES ON DEFENSE-"I think it is just the miscommunication on both parts. The back half was playing a different defense than the front. It's just trying to get both on the same page."

ON MOMENTUM SHIFT LATE IN FIRST HALF-"It definitely hurt us. It was a little bit of a momentum swing for them and it got them going into the second half. That was just part of the game." ON OPENING THE SEASON WITH A LOSS-"It would have been better if we would have gotten the win. We just have to keep improving. This is only week one. We still have more weeks to play football."

#### **WR Tyler McCulloch**

ON THE GAME-"The first half, we were making some big plays down the field, so it obviously started out well. We just didn't finish."

ON THE SECOND HALF-"I've got to give all the credit to CSU. They came out and they played a great game. Defensively, they caught us by surprise a few times and we just didn't execute."

ON THE OFFENSE-"It's obviously frustrating. We need to work out the kinks in the offense. We just need to move forward with it."

#### **HEAD COACH JIM McELWAIN**

#### General statement

"I can't tell you how proud I am of our guys. You have to invest on a daily basis to get what you want. Those who invested are with this program. I'm really proud of those guys; I'm really proud of the way they hung in there. We did not play a good football game by any stretch of the imagination. Plain and simple we have a long way to go. At the end of the day as good as it is for Colorado State, for our students, our faculty, our fans its great but its one game. As excited as I was for them, they have to realize we have a long, long way to go before I consider us a decent ball squad. My hat is off to the guys we played. They played their tails off. That's what a rivalry should be. Those who weren't here missed a heck of a ball game."

#### On Jared Roberts

"He did that all spring. He did it in the fall. The reason you're a kicker is your supposed to make it and he did it. One of the things we preach to our guys, just so everyone understands, is do your job. I don't care what your job is; just do it. That's with everyone who touches the organization, whether you're in the academic department, whether your in the training room, whether you're in the equipment room; do your job and be excellent at what you do. That's just a thing that we have."

#### On the muffed punt at the end of the half

"I tried to screw that up too. There again it goes back to win this play. Whatever you do win this play. Don't worry about anything else. The people who look at the scoreboard are the guys that are getting run over. It's something pretty simple. Don't worry about what happened just win the next play."

### On how surprised he was CU didn't attempt a field goal in the fourth quarter

"I wasn't because you have half a yard to go. They're big guys, bigger than we are. I wasn't surprised by the call at all. I was thankful that they reviewed it because the ball was over the plain before it probably crossed the plain. That's what I'm saying. Win that play; our guys won that play.'

#### On the decision to run the ball on 3-and-10 prior to the Rams' final field goal

"It's one of those deals when we were in that range. Let's face it we weren't throwing the ball well. It's not like Joe Namath was out there slinging it around. Garrett (Grayson) did a great job. He did a great job of managing the game. What we ask our guys to do it let the people around you help you be successful because of how they're playing. We just felt right there our defense was playing pretty darn good. That look in their eyes I felt really comfortable with our defense."

#### On the team's increased confidence

"That's something that we've been preaching. Let me explain, the investment that these guys have put into what we've been doing and the foundation and through this process is something that I am very proud of. They believe. They believe in each other. Somewhere along the line you're going to stumble but the one thing that is constant is your family is always there to pick you up. These guys have done a great job of taking care of each other. Not caring what their area code is. When they get here they are Rams."

#### On the enhanced defensive pressure

"Part of getting after some guy is you're going to have to bring pressure from somewhere. I really thought our game plan going in was not only very sound but our guys did a great job of formation recognition and personnel substitution. They were responsible both physically and mentally to know what to anticipate. I thought the way our guys played defensively they were pretty good."

#### On if he was surprised with CSU's success at stopping the run

"Shocked might be a better statement. We preach gap control. You have to preach trust. To have a great defense you have to know that the defensive lineman is taking care of his responsibility so I can scrape to my responsibility. I thought our guys played very solid gap-control defense."

## On Donnell Alexander's 37-yard run in the third quarter

"We knew that they were going to go start corners over and play man because they needed to get back into it. It was a great call by Dave (Baldwin)."

## On CSU's young players

"All I heard about was how young the other team was. I never heard about how young we were. I was really proud of our guys because our young guys really stepped up and made some plays."

#### On penalties

"We had too many penalties. The things we didn't have were unforced errors; the illegal formations, offsides and all that kind of stuff. Obviously, two critical penalties in the special teams. Pass interference is going to happen; we'll take a look at it. If it was, it was. "

#### On his first win as a head coach

"It's been 27 years. The one thing you learn is it's never about you. I give up myself so others can get better. That's just who I am and how I've always been. I'm disappointed in how we played. I'm disappointed we didn't play crisper and execute how we should. I'm never satisfied that's just how I am. I'm sure 20 years from now when we look up and someone has a picture of the scoreboard I'll think 'that's pretty cool.' Right now I have to get this thing graded because we have a long way to go."

#### On Grayson

"I thought he got rid of it a little quick, which when they're bearing down on your I used to do the same thing. It'll be interesting to see. It'll be a great learning experience. The scheme they played against today has NFL written all over it. He was calm. I liked his eyes on the sideline. The game was not too big for him."

## On the decision to go for it on fourth-and-one

"Stupidest decision ever. My dad was looking down and saying 'boy Jimmy you messed that one up.' The biggest thing is showing faith in your guys. I have faith in them. I told the defense if we don't get it I have trust in you."

## On Chris Nwoke's injury

"There's nothing broken or anything like that. The guy has a bad ankle. Someone else has to step up. That hurt us a little bit because he's a good football player. He wanted to be out there."

#### On the call to go for it on fourth down

"I was excited about it. We figured when we were going empty they were going coverage zero, every time we went empty."

#### On WR Joe Hansley

"What you guys saw today is what he's been doing all camp. We're going to use him in all different ways. We're all excited about him and he has a bright future here."

#### On the win and Coach McElwain

"It is a huge win. And it's a huge win for Coach Mac. First coach in CSU history that's ever beat CU in their first game. Knowing that, that brings more confidence out in us that we've got this coach here and he's with us. He's been coaching for 27 years and this is his first head coaching job so to have him be with us, we're behind him."

#### On his confidence

"I'm more confident than I ever have been before. I told everyone before the game that I've been playing football since I was four and I've never felt like I've had these brothers. And I go out there and I play for them and they play for me and I'm confident in them 100 percent."

#### LB SHAQUIL BARRETT

#### On finishing the game strong

"That's what we've been working on a lot this spring, and this fall, and the summer too. Just finishing the fourth quarter. At halftime they said, we're gonna win this game in the fourth quarter. The coaches said, as long as we believe in each other and they believe in us, we're gonna pull it out.

#### On the change of culture because of this win

"It's a big step forward. I know everybody, like, we had like some incidents off field last spring, and we probably lost a couple fans that week, but Coach Mac has been instilling "do what's right" and we've been working on that since he's been here. That was the first thing he told us, to do what's right. On the field, off the field, go to class, do what's right. It's general, but it's specific too. Attendance for the game was **58,607**; CU accounted for **35,406** of those, CSU 18,169 and the Broncos 5,032 ... CB Kenneth Crawley returned the first punt of the game for 14 yards-matching CU's longest punt return all of last year (by Rodney Stewart); CU had 36 punt return yards as a team (38 by Crawley, minus-2 by Goodson) compared to 56 total last year ... It took 11 minutes to play the first 2 minutes of clock time in the game **WR Nelson Spruce's** first career TD catch also made a little history—it was the 2000th point CU has scored in 84 games against CSU, the first team the Buffs have scored that many against ... The teams combined for 543 total yards, 321 on 58 first down plays (5.5 per); the other 77 plays went for 222 yards, or 2.9 per ...

**RED ZONE STREAK ENDS** Colorado converted on its first two tries in the red zone today, but when it failed to score on 4th-&goal from the 1 in the third quarter, its snapped a 19-of-19 run inside the opponent's 20-yard line dating back to the 2006 season opener.

WR NELSON SPRUCE (8-64, 1 TD) His 9-yard TD reception (on 3rd-&-goal) in the second quarter was the second of his career; he of course is the nephew of former Denver Nuggets PR director Tommy Sheppard (now a vice president with the Washington Wizards); he flew in from D.C. to watch today's game. # Colorado State 22, Colorado 17 Sept. 1, 2012

#### **GAME NOTES**

Colorado State captures the 2012 Centennial Cup by defeating in-state rival Colorado, 22-17, in the Cinch Jeans Rocky Mountain Showdown at Sports Authority Field at Mile High in Denver.

- It marks Colorado State's first victory over Colorado since the 2009 Showdown at CU's Folsom Field in Boulder, Colo. (23-17).
- The win is CSU's first over CU in Denver since the Rams knocked off the Buffs, 14-10, in Game 2 of the 2006 season at then-INVESCO Field at Mile High.
- Since the annual rivalry began again in 1995 (the two schools met just once in 1992 between 1989 and 1995), Colorado State has now captured six victories over CU.
- The Rams' record vs. Colorado in the 12 neutral-site games played in Denver at Mile High Stadium, INVESCO Field and Sports Authority Field is now 5-7, including a stretch of three out of four for the Rams from 1999-2002.
- Five of Colorado State's last six victories over CU have been by six points or fewer, with the exception being the Rams' 41-14 victory over then No. 14-ranked CU to open the 1999 season at Mile High Stadium.

Colorado State Head Coach Jim McElwain, the 20<sup>th</sup> head coach in program history, becomes the first CSU mentor to win his debut game since Jerry Wampfler in 1970.

• Overall, five CSU coaches have now won their debuts with the Rams: Jim McElwain (2012 vs. Colorado, 22-17); Jerry Wampfler (1970 at New Mexico State, 28-9); Bob Davis (1947 vs. Colorado Mines, 20-12); Julius "Hans" Wagner (1942 at Wyoming, 10-0); and Clarence Griffith (1901 vs. Denver, 56-5).

McElwain also becomes the only Colorado State coach to win in his first matchup against rival Colorado.

- Overall, 16 different CSU coaches have led the Rams against the Buffaloes, and seven have picked up wins over the Buffs, but McElwain is the only one to do it in his first attempt.
- Claude Rothgeb, who coached the Rams from 1906-09, led CSU to a 0-0 tie in his first matchup against CU (Nov. 10, 1906), one of two ties in the series.

Sophomore K Jared Roberts, a native of Littleton, Colo., who was awarded a scholarship just nine days ago (Aug. 23), opened up scoring with a 47-yard field goal midway through the first half. Roberts also gave Colorado State its final lead, 19-17, with 6:39 remaining with a 49-yarder at the 6:36 mark of the fourth quarter. He also added a 32-yarder with 2:56 left in the game to cushion the Rams' lead, 22-17.

- Each of Roberts' first two field goals marked the longest for Colorado State since Jason Smith's 52-yarder at Utah on Oct. 18, 2008.
- Roberts became the first Colorado State kicker with three field goals in a game since Ben DeLine went 3-for-4 in the Rams' 43-10 victory over UNLV on Oct. 16, 2010.

Colorado State was 5-of-8 on third-down conversions in the second half after going 0-for-7 in the first half. On the other side of the ball, CSU's defense allowed just one third-down conversion (on seven attempts) by CU in the second half, after the Buffs converted 4-of-9 attempts in the opening half.

• CSU finished the game 5-of-15, while CU was 5-of-16 in the final tally.

Colorado State's defense recorded five quarterback sacks in today's victory over Colorado, led by redshirt freshman LB Cory James who notched three (including a forced fumble).

- It marks the most sacks by CSU's defense in a single game since the Rams racked up nine in a seasonopening victory at New Mexico in 2011.
- James' three sacks are the most by an individual in a single game since Nordly Capi's 3.5 sacks in that same victory over the Lobos.

Eight Colorado State players made their first-career starts today:

- Offense OL Brandon Haynes, OL Jared Biard and WR Dominique Vinson.
- Defense LB Aaron Davis, LB Cory James, DL Lanston Tanyi, DL Alex Tucci and CB Bernard Blake.

The Rams' roster featured 17 players who made their Colorado State debut: freshman RB Donnell Alexander, sophomore K Jared Roberts, freshman DB Jasen Oden, freshman RB Tommey Morris, freshman DB Nick Januska, freshman WR Joe Hansley, senior RB Mark Woodbury, freshman LB Kevin Davis, freshman LB Nu'uvali Fa'apito, junior LB Jedidiah Teofilo, junior DL Calvin Tonga, junior DL Eli Edwards, senior DL Lanston Tanyi, sophomore DL Alex Tucci, freshman DB Kevin Pierre-Louis, freshman LB Cory James and freshman DB Trent Matthews.

Sophomore QB Garrett Grayson went 14-of-21 for 173 yards and two touchdown passes.

- Grayson's touchdown passes were each long strikes a 20-yard pass to senior WR Dominique Vinson just before halftime, and a 32-yarder to freshman WR Joe Hansley midway through the third quarter.
- Grayson threw two touchdown passes in the final four games of the 2011 season after taking over for injured starter Pete Thomas, bringing his career total now to four.
- Three of those touchdown passes have been strikes of 20 yards or longer, including today's pair and the 66-yard touchdown strike at TCU last season.

Freshman WR Joe Hansley, a native of nearby Highlands Ranch, Colo., recorded his first-career receptions against Colorado.

- His first catch, an eight-yard reception for a first down, came on Colorado State's second drive of the game and kept alive CSU's scoring drive that resulted in a 48-yard field goal to take a 3-0 lead.
- Hansley finished with two catches for 40 yards, hauling in a 32-yard touchdown pass from Garrett Grayson with 8:37 left in the third quarter, giving CSU a 16-14 advantage.

Chris Nwoke's streak of consecutive games with a catch is now at 14, after the junior running back hauled in a 13-yard pass out of the backfield for a first down late in the second quarter.

- Nwoke recorded a catch in each of the Rams' 12 games during his sophomore campaign in 2011, and capped his freshman season with three receptions against Wyoming.
- Nwoke, a preseason all-MW selection, also carried the ball 11 times for 47 yards, all in the first half on Saturday. He did not see action in the second half because of an injury to a lower extremity.

With Nwoke limited, three Rams' running backs recorded their first-career carries in today's game.

- Redshirt freshman Donnell Alexander had eight carries for 66 yards.
- Freshman Tommey Morris recorded three carries for just four yards.
- Junior TE/H-Back Joe Brown also carried the ball out of the backfield for the first time in his career, notching 11 carries for 21 yards, including key totes with the Rams backed up against their own goal line late in the third quarter.

Senior P Pete Kontodiakos, a candidate for the Ray Guy Award, booted a 69-yard punt after the Rams' first possession of the game.

- It marks Kontodiakos' second-longest career punt. (76 yards; vs. New Mexico, Oct. 30, 2009).
- The 69-yarder narrowly misses CSU's all-time top-10 list by one yard.

Kontodiakos finished the day with six punts for 287 yards, an average of 47.8 yards.

Senior WR Dominique Vinson, a former Rams defensive back, scored a touchdown just before halftime to cut the CSU deficit to 14-9 (PAT blocked).

• The reception, a 20-yarder, was the first of Vinson's career.

Redshirt freshman LB Cory James recorded three sacks in his first-career game at Colorado State, all in the first half. His third sack of the game also resulted in a forced fumble by CU quarterback Jordan Webb.

• It is the second straight season that a CSU player has recorded three or more sacks in an opener. (Nordly Capi; 3.5 sacks at New Mexico, Sept. 3, 2011)

Actor John Amos (*Roots, The West Wing, The Mary Tyler Moore Show, Coming to America*), a Colorado State alumnus and former football player, spoke to the Rams at the team hotel last night.

Today's captains for Colorado State were: junior RB Chris Nwoke, junior OL Weston Richburg, senior LB Shaquil Barrett, and senior LB James Skelton.
