PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OFFENSE: De'Anthony Thomas, RB, Oregon
DEFENSE: Damante Horton, CB, Washington State
SPECIAL TEAMS: Jake Smith, PK, Arizona

Running back **De'Anthony Thomas** of OREGON, cornerback **Damante Horton** of WASHINGTON STATE and kicker **Jake Smith** of ARIZONA have been named Pac-12 Players of the Week in football.

Thomas, a junior from Los Angeles, Calif., had 11 carries for a game-high 124 yards rushing and three touchdowns in the Duck's 59-10 road win over Virginia on Saturday. He had touchdown runs of one, 40 and eight yards and reeled in one catch for another 28 yards. Thomas is averaging 8.7 yards per carry and is tied for 20th in the nation in rushing yards per game (126.0 ypg).

Horton, a senior from Oakland, Calif., led a spirited defensive effort by Washington State in the Cougars 10-7 win over No.22/25 USC Trojans in the first Conference game of season. The cornerback stepped in front of a USC pass and returned it 70 yards for a touchdown to even the score at 7-7 just before halftime. Horton collected his second interception with less than a minute remaining to seal the victory for Washington State, ending the game with two interceptions for 75 return yards and a career-best two tackles for a loss for 12 yards. He was also tasked with covering USC All-American receiver Marquise Lee, who was limited to 27 yards on seven catches.

Smith, a senior place-kicker Philadelphia, Pa., set a school record with 16 points by kicking to help lead Arizona past UNLV 58-13 on Saturday night in Las Vegas. The first-year kicker collected his first made field goal from 41 yards to put Arizona up 3-0 and went on to convert three of four on the night in addition to making all seven extra points he attempted. Smith also kicked off 11 times in the game with five touchbacks and a 63.3-yard average.

Also nominated for offensive player of the week honors were quarterbacks **Travis Wilson** of UTAH, **Taylor Kelly** of ARIZONA STATE, **Sean Mannion** of OREGON STATE, and **Jared Goff** of CALIFORNIA; running backs **Ka'Deem Carey** of Arizona, **Tre Madden** of USC and **Tyler Gaffney** of STANFORD; and wide receiver **Paul Richardson** of COLORADO. Also nominated for defensive player of the week honors were linebackers **Jake Fischer** of Arizona, **Grandville Taylor** of Arizona State, and **Hardy Nickerson** of California, safeties **Jared Bell** of Colorado, **Ed Reynolds** of Stanford and **Dion Bailey** of USC; defensive end **Tony Washington** of Oregon and defensive tackle **Tenny Palepoi** of Utah. Also nominated for special teams player of the week honors were kickers **Vincenzo D'Amato** of California and **Andrew Furney** of Washington State and Oregon State punter **Keith Kostol**.

AROUND THE PAC-12

PICK SIX: Pac-12 defenses stepped up to add points of their own to the scoreboard. Five interceptions were returned for touchdowns last week. COLORADO returned a pair of picks for touchdowns (55 yds and 39 yds). The Buff's defense had just three interceptions all of last season. ARIZONA also returned a pair of interceptions for touchdowns (52 yds, 49 yds), including **Tre'Mayne Bondurant's** second return for a score this season. WASHINGTON STATE added a pick six for its only touchdown in its 10-7 win over USC. UTAH's defense also got into the scoring column with a fumble return for a touchdown (21 yds).

QB KEEPER: Last season, four different Pac-12 quarterbacks accounted for 10 rushes of at least 30 yards each, with half of those coming from OREGON QB **Marcus Mariota**. Just two weeks into the 2013 season, five different Pac-12 quarterbacks have accounted for eight rushes for at least 30 yards. The list this season includes: ARIZONA's **B.J. Denker** (30, 35) and **Javelle Allen** (61); Oregon's Mariota (46, 71); UCLA's **Brett Hundley** (37); UTAH's **Travis Wilson** (38, 51). Each of the eight rushes resulted in touchdowns. Both Mariota (5th/117.5 ypg) and Denker (10th/65.5 ypg) are among the league's top ten in rushing.

THESE GUYS HAVE CLASS: Thirty NCAA Football Bowl Subdivision student-athletes who excel both on and off the field were selected as candidates for the 2013 Senior CLASS Award® in collegiate football. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I FBS senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition. The Pac-12 was represented by six student-athletes: **Vincenzo D'Amato** (CAL), **Alden Darby** (ASU), **Jake Fischer** (ARIZ), **Andrew Furney** (WSU), and **Will Sutton** (ASU).

PAC-12 WELL REPRESENTED ON NFL ROSTERS: According to NFL.com, 266 former Pac-12 football players were listed on team rosters (active, reserve, practice squads) for the opening weekend of the NFL season. That was the third most by any conference, trailing the SEC (371) and ACC (291). USC led all Pac-12 schools with 45 former Trojans listed on NFL rosters, while CALIFORNIA was next with 35. No. 5 STANFORD (1-0) at Army (1-1)
Sat., Sept. 14, 12 noon ET - CBSN

STANFORD: Senior FS **Ed Reynolds** had a game-high 12 tackles (9 solo) to go with an interception in Stanford's 34-13 victory over San Jose State. His interception extended Stanford's streak of consecutive games with a takeaway to 25. The streak is the longest in the nation . . . Stanford's current streak of being in the Top 5 of the AP poll for three consecutive ranking periods is one week shy of the school's best of four weeks achieved during the 1940 season.

No. 16 UCLA (1-0) at No. 23 Nebraska (2-0)
Sat., Sept. 14, 11 a.m. CT - ABC

UCLA: With 4,014 career passing yards, sophomore QB **Brett Hundley** needs 74 yards to move into UCLA's top ten list, passing former Bruin and 1967 Heisman Trophy winner Gary Beban (4,087 yards). In the season-opener, Hundley connected with 10 different receivers with senior **Shaquelle Evans** pulling in 6 rec/81 yards and 1 TD . . . Junior RB **Jordan James** rushed for 155 yards in the opener as UCLA rushed for 345 yards against Nevada . . . In last year's win over Nebraska, the Bruins had 653 yards in total offense (344 rush/309 pass).

Fresno State (2-0) at COLORADO (2-0)
Sat., Sept. 14, 12 noon PT - P12N

COLORADO: Junior WR **Paul Richardson** has been Mr. Consistency posting nearly identical numbers in each of the first two games this season. He grabbed 10 receptions for 208 yards in the season opener, then tallied 11 receptions for 209 yards in the win over Central Arkansas. It's the first time in Pac-12 history that a receiver has posted back-to-back games with 200 or more yards receiving . . . The Buffs look to start the season 3-0 for the first time since 2008.

Boston College (2-0) at USC (1-1)
Sat., Sept. 14, 12 noon PT - P12N

USC: The Trojan defense held Washington State to seven yards rushing and now leads the nation in rushing defense allowing 15.0 ypg, as well as sacks with 11 (5.5 per game) . . . The offense saw a breakout performance by sophomore TB **Tre Madden** who has posted back-to-back games with 100 or more rushing yards. He's the first Trojan since Marcus Allen in 1981 to open the season with consecutive 100-yard rushing games. Madden's grandfather is NFL All-Pro RB Lawrence McCutcheon who set the since-broken Los Angeles Rams career rushing record (6,186 yards).

Tennessee (2-0) at No. 2 OREGON (2-0)
Sat., Sept. 14, 12:30 p.m. PT - ABC

OREGON: Through two games, the Ducks have posted five 100-yard rushing performances - two by **De'Anthony Thomas**, two by **Marcus Mariota** and one by **Byron Marshall**. Mariota is the first Oregon QB to rush for 100 or more yards in back-to-back games . . . Strike fast, strike often. Eight of Oregon's nine scoring drives last week against Virginia were accomplished in under two minutes. That's 17 of 19 scoring drives this season in less than two minutes (the other two drives were 2:11 and 3:08) . . .

No. 19 WASHINGTON (1-0) vs. Illinois (2-0)
Sat., Sept. 14, 5 p.m. CT - BTN

WASHINGTON: The Huskies appear in back-to-back AP polls for the first time since the 2003 season . . . Senior QB **Keith Price** has 56 TD passes in his career, most in school history and ranks 25th all-time in the Pac-12 . . . Junior TB **Bishop Sankey** has rushed for 100 or more yards in five of the last six games. He's gained 368 yards over his last two games.

Southern Utah (2-0) at WASHINGTON STATE (1-1)
Sat., Sept. 14 - 3:30 p.m. - P12N

WASHINGTON STATE: With its 10-7 win over USC, WSU snapped an eight-game losing streak to the Trojans. It was the first win at USC since 2000 . . . The Cougar pass defense held USC to 54 yards on 11 completions (4.9 ypc), while limiting All-American Marqise Lee to 27 yards on seven catches . . . WSU leads the Pac-12, and is sixth in the FBS, allowing just 72.8 passing yards per game.

No. 4 Ohio State (2-0) at CALIFORNIA (1-1)
Sat., Sept. 14, 4 p.m. PT - FOX

CALIFORNIA: Freshman QB **Jared Goff** has thrown for 930 yards in two games, completing 72 of 115 pass attempts (62.6 percent). His two-game total is just eight yards shy of the Pac-12 record two-game total of 938 yards set by former Cal Bear Pat Barnes in 1996. Barnes posted 435 yards vs. UCLA, then followed with a school-record 503 yards vs. Arizona . . . The last time Cal hosted a non-conference foe ranked among the top five was No. 4 Nebraska in 1998 (lost, 24-3).

OREGON STATE (1-1) at UTAH (2-0)
Sat., Sept. 14, 8 p.m. MT - FS1

OREGON STATE: Junior QB **Sean Mannion** threw for 372 yards and 4 TD in the win over Hawai'i. It was fifth time he's thrown for 350 or more yards in a game, while it was the sixth time he's tossed three or more TD passes in a game . . . Mannion connected with 10 different receivers against Hawai'i. Sophomore RB **Storm Woods** had 7 rec/95 yds, while junior WR **Brandin Cooks** had 7 rec/92 yds and 2 TDs.

UTAH: The Utes are coming off a game in which they set a school mark for points in a quarter with 35 in the second quarter of a 70-7 win over Weber State . . . It's the second time in school history it has amassed 100 points in the first two games (1973; 29-22 loss at Texas Tech, 82-6 win vs. UTEP) . . . Sophomore QB **Travis Wilson** has connected on 31-of-47 for 566 yards and 5 TDs this season and his 202.2 passing efficiency rating ranks eighth in the FBS.

UTSA (1-1) at ARIZONA (2-0)
Sat., Sept. 14, 7:30 p.m. - P12N

ARIZONA: After serving a one-game suspension, junior RB **Ka'Deem Carey** returned to post 171 rushing yards on 16 carries (10.7 ypc) and 2 TDs, including a 56-yard TD run on his first carry of the season . . . Carey has 31 rushing TDs, second on the school's career list. (UA record is 44 by Art Lupino, 1953-56) . . . Junior S **Tra'Mayne Bondurant** added his FBS-leading third interception of the season with a pick he returned 52 yards for a TD, his second return this season for a touchdown.

No. 20 Wisconsin (2-0) at ARIZONA STATE (1-0)
Sat., Sept. 14, 7:30 p.m. - ESPN

ARIZONA STATE: ASU is 8-0 vs. the Big Ten at Sun Devil Stadium . . . The Sun Devils continue to play discipline football as they committed just one penalty for five yards in their season-opening win over Sacramento State. ASU led the Pac-12 last season with just 55 penalties (4.2 per game) for 454 yards (34.9 ypg) . . . Junior QB **Taylor Kelly** completed 23 of 31 passes for 300 yards and a career high-tying five TDs. He has a streak of 102 straight pass attempts without an interception dating back to last year, which currently stands fourth nationally. His touchdown passes of 16, 41, 24, 33 and 26 yards, all went to five different receivers. Dating back to the final three games of the 2013 season, Kelly has gone 76-of-102 (.745) with 13 touchdowns and zero interceptions on 1,005 yards.

2012 PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME: Stanford 27, UCLA 24

OREGON TABBED TO WIN PAC-12 TITLE IN PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

CULVER CITY, Calif. - OREGON is the favorite to win the 2013 Pac-12 Conference football title in a preseason poll of media members who cover the league. The Ducks were listed in the top spot in the North Division by 15 of the 26 voters participating in the poll, collecting 145 points. Fourteen of those pollsters tabbed the Ducks to come out on top in the Pac-12 Championship Game. STANFORD was picked to finish second in the North Division, collecting 11 first-place votes in the balloting for the division race.

UCLA was picked to win the South Division, garnering 135 points and 12 first-place votes, while ARIZONA STATE, which tallied 10 first-place votes, and collected 130 points, was pegged a close second in this year's poll. USC was predicted by the voters to finish third in the South Division, claiming the remaining four first place votes.

PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

The Pac-12 Championship Football Game will take place Saturday, December 7 at 8 p.m. ET/5 p.m. PT and telecast to a national audience on ABC/ESPN. The Championship game will match the winner of the North Division vs. the winner of the South Division. The game will be played on the campus of the division winner with the best overall conference record. The winner of the Pac-12 Championship will earn the league's automatic BCS berth.

TIE-BREAK PROCEDURES TO DETERMINE DIVISION CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP GAME HOST

The Division Champion will be determined by the record in all games played (both divisional and cross-divisional) within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game representatives

Two-Team Tie.

1. Head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
 - a. If no game is played between the two tied teams or that game ends in a tie, the following tie-breaking procedures would be applied:
2. Record in games played within the division
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (Based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.
6. Total number of wins in a 12-game season. The following conditions will apply to the calculation of the total number of wins:
 - a. Only one win against a team from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision or lower division will be counted annually.
 - b. Any games that are exempted from counting against the annual maximum number of football contests per NCAA rules (current Bylaw 17.9.5.2) shall not be included.
7. Coin toss.

Multiple-Team Ties.

The following procedures will only be used to eliminate all but two teams, at which point the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

1. Head-to-head (Best record in games among the tied teams).
2. Record in games played within the division.
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.

Pac-12 Championship Game Host

The Pac-12 Championship Game Host will be determined by the record in all games played within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game host.

Tie-breaking Procedure.

1. Head-to-head, if applicable.
2. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of Pac-12 regular-season games.
3. Record against the next highest-placed common opponent in the conference (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the conference.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Coin toss.

PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS - 2013-14

The Pac-12 is in the final year of a four-year bowl cycle. The Pac-12 Conference has agreements with seven bowl partners. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion, unless said champion is ranked No. 1 or No. 2 in the final Bowl Championship Series rankings. If that were the case, the Pac-12 champion would play in the BCS National Championship Game hosted by the Discover Orange Bowl. Regardless of the disposition of the Pac-12 champion, a second Pac-12 team may be selected for an at-large berth in the Bowl Championship Series in any given year and other Pac-12 bowl partner arrangements provide for that occurrence. In addition to the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, Pac-12 bowl partners include, in order of selection, the Valero Alamo Bowl in San Antonio, Bridgeport Education Holiday Bowl in San Diego, Hyundai Sun Bowl in El Paso, the Las Vegas Bowl, the Kraft Fight Hunger Bowl in San Francisco, and the Gildan New Mexico Bowl in Albuquerque.
