**BUFFALO GAME DAY**

GAME NOTES STILL "GREEN" Instead of running up to 50 pages of notes and statistics each game, Colorado has gone "green" to conserve paper; all seats in the press box receive the CU "short stack," a front-and-back cover page plus stats; we have full sets of in-depth game notes for those who would like them. Just ask at the Colorado SID area of the press box!

THE QUICK OF IT The Colorado Buffaloes (2-4, 1-1 Big 12), fresh off their first conference win of the year, have traveled east to middle America to take on the **Kansas State Wildcats** (4-3, 2-1 Big 12) in an 11:40 a.m. CDT kickoff at Bill Snyder Family Stadium/Wagner Field ... Though conference play has just really begun, this is an early battle for first place in league's North Division, the winner guaranteed at least a share of the top spot and continued control of their own fate (CU and KSU's losses are to South teams) ... The Buffs are bidding for back-to-back conference wins for the first time since the opening two games of the 2007 season (27-24 vs. No. 3 Oklahoma; 43-23 at Baylor) ... CU is looking to beat both Sunflower State schools in the same season for the first time since 2005; this is the ninth straight year the Buffs have played both in back-to-back weeks: CU swept four encounters, the Kansas schools swept twice and there have been two splits ... **TB Darrell Scott** has arthroscopic knee surgery on Thursday and will be out 2-3 weeks/games depending on his rehab; he is targeting a Nov. 7 return against Texas A&M ... KMGH-TV (Ch. 7) will air a feature on its Sports Extra program this Sunday night on former **ILB Sean Tufts**, who returned to CU after a brief career in the NFL to attend grad school—and become the first former football player to become a Ralphie Handler ... CU is wearing all white for the first time since last year's Florida State game in Jacksonville.

ROAD WOES Colorado is **2-16** on the road in three-plus seasons under Dan Hawkins, though over the last 22 seasons, CU stills owns the 13th best road record in the nation (**59-46-1**; 56.1), though the recent woes have eight teams now on CU's heels. Colorado's last road win was at on Oct. 27, 2007 at Texas Tech (31-26); the Buffs have dropped nine straight road games since, including against Florida State in Jacksonville last year but not including the '07 Independence Bowl against Alabama or the 2008 CU-CSU game in Denver. If including the latter, CU has dropped eight straight away from Folsom Field.

TODAY'S PUNCH vs. PUNCH Colorado is ranked fourth in the nation in kickoff return defense, allowing 16.6 yards per return; Kansas State is ranked seventh in the nation in kickoff return average, with a 27.9 average for 30 returns (and 3 TDs, all by Brandon Banks; CU last allowed a KOR for score last year versus Colorado State.

THE LOOKOUT Here are some things to look for in today's game from the Colorado perspective:

- ✕ **WR Scotty McKnight.** He has caught a pass in a school record 30 consecutive regular season games and is seventh all-time in receptions (124) and ninth in receiving yards (1,377). He needs four receptions to pass Charles E. Johnson (127) into sixth and needs 60 yards to vault Monte Huber (1,436) into eighth.
- ✕ **TE Riar Geer** is 22nd all-time with 76 receptions, but the sixth tight end; he can crack the top 20 overall with four catches, and with five, can take over with the fourth most by a tight end. He needs 48 yards to move into the top 25 all-time in receiving yards (he has 856), the seventh most by a TE.
- ✕ **TB Rodney Stewart** has 1,040 career rushing yards, 45th all-time, and needs 103 to break into the top 40.
- ✕ **ILB Jeff Smart.** He is 25th all-time at Colorado with 256 career tackles, and is now just 16 away from cracking the top 20 (that spot is held by Bill Roe, 1977-79, with 272). Three of the names between him and the top 20 are Dick Anderson (266), Alfred Williams (263) and Phil Irwin (258).

THE WEEK AHEAD Colorado will return to Boulder immediately following the game, scheduled back at the Dal Ward Athletic Center around 6:15 p.m. The players will have conditioning, meetings and video review from 1:00-5:30 but will not practice; dinner will be around 5:45, so the best time to haphazardly catch any players is 12:30-1 and after 5. Monday is the required NCAA day off (nothing football related, including orchestrated interviews); CU will practice in the 4:15-6:15 range on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday and will have a walk-through Friday (3-4 p.m.) ahead of next Saturday's Missouri game (11:30 a.m.; 9,500 tickets remain). **Dan Hawkins' weekly press luncheon is on Tuesday, with lunch at 11:30 a.m. followed by Hawkins and a selected player at Noon.**

LOCKERROOM POLICY... Colorado's lockerroom is closed; Dan Hawkins will speak to the media outside the CU lockerroom after the standard 10-minute cooling off period (if not sooner). Associate SID **Curtis Snyder** and grad assistant SID **Nick Bernal** will solicit player requests (no deadline to submit); SID **Dave Plati** will coordinate postgame notes and the injury report.
