BIG 12 FOOTBALL QUICK HITS

- Three conference games and three non-league contests are on the Week 6 schedule with all six televised. Kansas, Oklahoma and Texas are idle.
- Action gets started on Thursday when No. 6/7 Nebraska travels to Kansas State. The Big 12 also has a game on Friday as No. 21/22 Oklahoma State travels to UL-Lafayette in non-conference play.
- The remaining four games are on Saturday with two at neutral sites in the DFW metroplex. Baylor takes on Texas Tech in Dallas' Cotton Bowl Stadium while Texas A&M entertains No. 13/11 Arkansas in Arlington's Cowboys Stadium. Colorado travels to No. 22/24 Missouri while Iowa State hosts No. 10/10 Utah.
- The Big 12 is 35-6 (.854) in non-conference games. Every team will complete the non-conference slate with a .500 or better record for the fourth time in Conference history. It also occurred in 2002, 2004 and 2008.
- Nebraska (6/7), Oklahoma (7/6), Oklahoma State (21/22) and Missouri (22/24) are ranked in both polls. Baylor, Kansas State and Texas received votes in each.
- Big 12 teams continue to rack up points on defense with two more touchdowns in Week 5 for a total of 13 on the season.
- The Texas A&M at Oklahoma State game drew a rating of 2.73, which is the best for a Thursday night game on ESPN so far this season.
- Big 12 Players of the Week were awarded to Offense: Robert Griffin III (Baylor); Defense: B.J. Beatty (Colorado) and Ugo Chinasa (Oklahoma State); and Special Teams: Jeremy Reeves (Iowa State).
- The Big 12 is home to five of the top 10 national leaders in passing completions per game - 1. Taylor Potts (TTU), 29.75; 5. Landry Jones (OU), 26.60; 7. Jerrod Johnson (TAMU), 26.00; 8. Blaine Gabbert (MU), 25.75; and 9. Brandon Weeden (OSU), 25.50).
- The league also has four of the nation's top five leaders in receptions per game - 1. T.J. Moe (MU), 9.25; 2. Ryan Broyles (OU), 9.20; 3. Justin Blackmon (OSU), 8.50 and 5. Michael Egnew (MU), 8.25.
- Texas A&M is third nationally in rushing defense - allowing 68.50 yards an outing while Nebraska is third in passing defense - giving up 126.26 yards per contest.

15th Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

The Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship returns to Cowboys Stadium in Arlington, Texas for the second consecutive year. The 2010 game takes place on Saturday, December 4, at 7:00 p.m. CT and will be nationally televised by ABC. In 2010, the North representative will be the home team.

Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship Winners

In the 14-year history of the event, there have been six different winners. All-time titlists include Texas (1996, 2005, 2009), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), Oklahoma (2000, 2002, 2004, 2006, 2007, 2008), Colorado (2001) and Kansas State (2003).

BCS Sightings

The 2009 season marked the Conference's 17th BCS game in the 12-year history of the structure. The Big 12 is 7-10 all-time in BCS games and has advanced two teams in the same season five times (2001, '03, '04, '07, '08).

Television Partners

ABC begins its 15th season as the Conference's national network television partner. The Big 12 also continues its long-standing relationship with FSN for its cable rights. FSN has sublicensed select television games in 2010 to ESPN.

Television Selections

Television selections will be announced on either a 12-day or six-day advance by the Conference office. The 12-day advances will be released on Mondays while the six-day will be available on Sunday's prior to that week's games.

Home Win Streaks

Oklahoma's nation-leading home win streak is at 33 games. The Sooners' next home game is Oct. 16 vs. Iowa State.

BAYLOR (4-1, 1-0)

This Week: vs. Texas Tech (Dallas)

Next Week: at Colorado

The Bears are 4-1 for the first time since 2005. This is the earliest they have reached the four-win mark since 1994. BU is looking for its second consecutive win away from home for the first time since 1996.

BU and TTU meet for the 69th time Saturday with each of the last two meetings decided by seven points — 35-28 (2008) and 20-13 (2009). The Bears led 28-14 in 2008 before the Red Raiders scored 21 unanswered points to win 35-28.

QB Robert Griffin III set the school record with 444 total yards in Baylor's win over KU last week, including a career-best 380 pass yards to earn Big 12 Offensive Player of the Week honors.

BU has allowed only two TDs and five FGs in its four wins, holding opponents to a 7.3 points-per-game average, while ranking third in the Big 12 in scoring defense (14.8 points per game).



COLORADO (3-1, 0-0)

This Week: at Missouri

Next Week: Baylor

With its 29-27 victory over Georgia last week, Colorado improved to 3-1 for the first time since 2008, which also is the last time the Buffs won back-to-back games.

RB Rodney Stewart, who had the second-best rushing game of his career (149 yards), converted on third-and-one and fourth-and-one carries. He is seven-for-seven this season in those situations and 18-of-20 in his career.

Colorado has rushed for 200 or more yards in back-to-back games. The last time that happened was 2006.

QB Tyler Hansen had a 39-yard run on Colorado's first scoring drive against UGA. It's the longest run by a CU quarterback since Bernard Jackson's 62-yard TD run against Kansas State on Nov. 4, 2006.



IOWA STATE (3-2, 1-1)

This Week: Utah

Next Week: at Oklahoma

ISU and Utah have met just four times, with the Cyclones winning each contest. Iowa State beat Utah 44-14 in Ames in 1976 - the last meeting between the two teams.

Jeremy Reeves made a career-high 10 tackles last week and preserved Iowa State's win over Texas Tech by returning an onside kick 42 yards for a TD after TTU had cut ISU's lead to seven. Reeves collected Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week honors.

The Cyclones had two 100-yard rushers (Alexander Robinson, 103 yards; Shontrelle Johnson, 104) in a conference game for the first time since Nov. 18, 2000 (Ennis Haywood, 190, and Michael Wagner, 102, vs. Kansas).

QB Austen Arnaud threw a career-high four touchdown passes last weekend.



KANSAS (2-3, 0-1)

This Week: Idle

Next Week: Kansas State (Thursday)

Wide receiver Daymond Patterson caught six passes for 53 yards last week. He has at least four catches in every game this season.

KU snapped a three-game winning streak in conference openers with its loss to BU last week. The Jayhawks have dropped eight consecutive Big 12 games.

Punter Alonso Rojas had two punts downed inside the 20-yard line in the first half. He now has seven on the season.

Last week, Baylor's 678 yards of total offense were the most against Kansas since it surrendered 680 yards to Auburn in 1988.



KANSAS STATE (4-0, 1-0)

This Week: Nebraska (Thursday)

Next Week: at Kansas (Thursday)

Kansas State has started a season 4-0 15 times in its history; 10 have come under coach Bill Snyder. This is the first 4-0 start for the Wildcats since 2003 when they finished 11-4 overall and appeared in the Fiesta Bowl. Their last 5-0 start came in 2000.

William Powell ranks 8th nationally and second in the league in kickoff returns, averaging 31.88 yards per return.

KSU has scored 79 of its 123 points in the second half, with 45 coming in the fourth quarter.

RB Daniel Thomas ranks fifth nationally and first in the league in rushing with 157.00 yards per game. As a unit, Kansas State is averaging 378 yards of offense per game and has the second-best Big 12 rushing total (216.0).



MISSOURI (4-0, 0-0)

This Week: Colorado

Next Week: at Texas A&M

MU has defeated CU in the past four contests and has held the Buffs to 17 points or fewer in each of those games.

With a win over the Buffs, the Tigers will secure their fourth season of at least a 5-0 start in the last five years - a feat which had never happened in consecutive seasons at MU prior to the 2006 and 2007 seasons. Missouri has started 5-0 just nine previous times.

Sophomore wide receiver T.J. Moe's 37 receptions are the most in school history through the first four games by a Missouri receiver.

Missouri's eight interceptions in four games matches its total for last year's 13-game season. MU is 10th in the nation with 13 turnovers gained.



NEBRASKA (4-0, 0-0)

This Week: at Kansas State (Thursday)

Next Week: Texas

Nebraska has been successful in league openers, winning 33 of their 35 conference-opening games since 1975.

Nebraska leads the series 77-15-2 all-time against the Wildcats, including a 34-7-2 edge in Manhattan. NU has won each of the last four matchups.

Through four games, NU is averaging 309.3 rushing yards per game to rank first in the Big 12 and fourth nationally. Behind QB Taylor Martinez, NU's offense averages 7.66 yards per play, the fourth-best yards per play average in the nation.

In two seasons, Nebraska's sack total has increased from 13 to 35 to 44 in 2009. Through four games this season, NU has nine sacks, including a seven-sack effort against Idaho.



OKLAHOMA (5-0, 1-0)

This Week: Idle

Next Week: Iowa State

Against Texas, OU suffered no turnovers while intercepting a pass and recovering a fumble. Oklahoma has 14 takeaways and just four giveaways.

RB DeMarco Murray scored two touchdowns and picked up 115 yards on 25 carries, while also catching four passes for 31 yards against Texas. He has 55 career touchdowns as a Sooner, putting him second on the all-time list, two behind Heisman Trophy winner Steve Owens.

DE Jeremy Beal has six sacks this season and his 26.5 career sacks is second behind Cedric Jones' school record of 31.5.

Oklahoma is 5-0 under Bob Stoops for the seventh time. Five of those 5-0 starts (2000, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2008) resulted in five Big 12 Championships and one National Championship.



OKLAHOMA STATE (4-0, 1-0)

This Week: at UL-Lafayette (Friday)

Next Week: at Texas Tech

OSU leads the series with UL-Lafayette, 5-0, including a 2-0 record in Lafayette. Oklahoma State is 22-2 all-time against members of the Sun Belt Conference.

Oklahoma State is 4-0 for the 14th time in school history and for the second in three seasons. Mike Gundy has been part of four of those 4-0 starts-two as OSU's starting quarterback and two more as head coach.

Ugo Chinasa earned Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week honors after his performance against TAMU, where he recorded six tackles, two quarterback sacks for 15 yards in losses, a pass deflection, an interception that he returned 22 yards, and three total tackles for loss.

Only twice since 1975 has OSU played its first road game after Oct. 8. In 1975, the Cowboys opened road play Oct. 11 at Missouri and last season OSU did not play a road game until Oct. 10 at Texas A&M.



TEXAS (3-2, 1-1)

This Week: Idle

Next Week: at Nebraska

The Longhorns will have a bye before facing the undefeated Cornhuskers. They have won five straight against Nebraska dating back to the 2002 season.

Against OU last weekend, QB Garrett Gilbert had a career-high 266 yards passing, besting the 264 yards he had in UT's previous game.

Emmanuel Acho recorded 17 tackles against Oklahoma, more than doubling his previous career high of seven set against UTEP last season. Acho's fourth-quarter sack of Landry Jones was his second of the season and fourth of his career.

UT's defense held OU to 92 second-half yards and one touchdown.



TEXAS A&M (3-1, 0-1)

This Week: vs. Arkansas (Arlington)

Next Week: Missouri

TAMU and Arkansas each enter this weekend's matchup with 3-1 records, both losses to top 25 teams. Arkansas leads the series 39-24-3. Last season, the Razorbacks defeated the Aggies, 47-19, in Arlington.

Senior quarterback Jerrod Johnson has a school record 7,338 career passing yards. He is 617 passing yards away from cracking the Big 12's career passing yards top-10 leaderboard.

Junior wide receiver Jeff Fuller had two touchdown catches against Oklahoma State and has 21 in his career, which breaks Bob Long's 42-year old record of 19.

Texas A&M set a school record with 106 offensive plays against the Cowboys. The Aggies gained 535 yards, the 10th time in the last 17 games they've gained 500 or more yards.



TEXAS TECH (2-2, 0-2)

This Week: vs. Baylor (Dallas)

Next Week: Oklahoma State

The Red Raiders are 14-0 against BU in the Big 12 era. The two teams last competed on Nov. 28, 2009, where Tech topped the Bears, 20-13.

Senior quarterback Taylor Potts set the Jack Trice Stadium record for completions (42) and attempts (62) against Iowa State last weekend. He moved into seventh on the school's all-time lists for completions (483) and passing yards (5,296), and is sixth in career touchdown passes (40).

With three touchdown receptions against Iowa State, WR Lyle Leong has moved into fifth place on the school's all-time TD reception list with 22.

The Red Raiders attempted 62 passes and didn't allow any sacks against Iowa State. Tech passed for 377 yards and rushed 25 times for 131 yards.
