On the team's struggles:

"It really started special teams-wise, when we missed the field goal and then had the blocked field goal, so that confined us offensively. We thought our defense played really well. [Starting defensive end Josh] Hartigan did really well, played really hard, and did a nice job. [The defense] gave us a short field a lot in the third [quarter]."

On his decision to switch quarterbacks in the third quarter:

"I don't think it was so much on what [Tyler Hansen] was not doing, but I was just trying to get something going."

On his disagreement with the safety call:

"We were throwing the ball on time, and we had a route that way but that guy got tackled and couldn't get there and get the ball on time. That was my contention."

On whether Mizzou's fake punt was a turning point:

"They did a good job executing, and we did a good job defending it. I don't know if that was a turning point, but it was one of those specialty plays in the first half that were problems."

On trying to run up the middle as they did against Georgia:

"At times we did okay. We started with some okay times there in the second half. By and large, though, it was not good. They did a good job stunting and looping and stemming in there and giving us some problems."

On the special teams breakdowns:

"I think it had to do more with just being able to get off on a good foot, whether it's at home or on the road. You saw that when we played Hawaii, which was a great thing where we were able to come back and get some things going in the second half when we weren't so productive in the first half."

On the Colorado defense:

"I thought they did a great job. Their backs were against the wall several times, and they did a nice job. They got a couple turnovers in there, and had some good coverage."

ON THE SHUT OUT VICTORY

"I thought it was a really good team victory. It's nice to see our defense step it up. As you all know the turnover we had in the second quarter was in about the worst field position you could get. It says an awful lot about them [the defense], and I'm glad we could preserve it [the shut out] at the end too."

ON THE SPECIAL TEAMS

He had a pick at the end, which was unfortunate to not get a touchdown or a field goal at the end of that drive."

ON COLORADO'S DEFENSE

"We also got to run the football. We've got to give them credit—we struggled a little bit up front in handling some of their stuff and finishing blocks. They had a good plan and they did a good job."

ON THE FIRST CONFERENCE WIN

"It's a great win. We've got a big game next week. So I'm focused on that, I'm always thinking about fixing things. I'm very proud of our football team. Any time you can get a shutout, certainly with the adversity we have on that field, it was good."

ON FACING TEXAS A&M

"There's going to be a lot of tests. This is the next one up, that's conference play. You know that when you start the season. That's what it's all about. Like I told the players, there are a lot of guys that are sore. When you play this caliber of opponent and you're beat up a little bit, that's what you should be. Then you wake up and you start getting all the treatment, rehab stuff, get the soreness out, hit the hot tubs, and you get prepared for battle next week. That's the way it is. And that's the beauty of it—if you can do it and survive it. Then that's how you play your best."

On initial mistakes

"There was some inconsistency there and we really shot ourselves in the foot a couple of times, whether it was with a penalty or there was a misplay here and there. The safety that started off the game was a situation in which Tyler was never in before and obviously you got to come out in any situation you're in. We just have to be able to learn from our mistakes. "

On the safety

"We had a receiver that was going to go out there, but he did not get out. That was just a rough play call and just a tough spot to be at. Paul Richardson was the main guy on the play and he was double teamed so that was no good. In the end zone you cannot really take any chances in getting out of the pocket."

On what needs to be improved

"You just got to keep your head up. I know there were certain things we cut ourselves on, such as the drives and penalties. It's just dumb stuff that we keep doing, especially on the road that we need to clean up. It's just easy stuff, such as the one penalty on the false start. It's just stuff you need to clean up; we got to know the play clock is. It's just little stuff we need to clean up on and focus. We'll clean it up and get better."

On Big 12 Conference Play – “We always expect in the Big 12 that’s its going to be a four quarter battle and we’ve got to be ready to fight for all four quarters. You expect to be sore afterwards, I know I am right now.”

On winning the first game of conference play – “It’s nice. We worked so hard to get through the non-conference schedule and we go 4-0. We start out the Big 12 with a win tonight and it sets us in the right direction. It leaves a good taste in your mouth. We keep working hard and we go for the next opponent which is Texas A&M.”

QUICKLY Colorado finished **7-8** in Big 12 Conference openers (**2-5** on the road) ... This was CU's fifth straight Big 12 opener against a ranked opponent ... With no future games scheduled, the CU-Missouri series stalls at 75 games, with MU ahead **40-32-3**; CU has only played Colorado State (82 games) in its history more than the Tigers ... The Buffs have now lost 13 straight road games (CU's last road win was at Texas Tech on Oct. 27, 2007) ... In the 2007 game between CU and MU in Boulder, the Buffs led 10-7 early in the second quarter. But since the Tigers took a 14-10 lead with 14:04 to go in that first half, MU finished up the series leading for 211:20 of the next 224:04 ... **First Action: PK Justin Castor** saw his first career action (his first FGA was blocked); he is the sixth true freshman to play this year for CU; **TB Quentin Hildreth** also played for the first time in a Buff uniform (he's a redshirt frosh) ... **First Career Start: TE/UB Scott Fernandez** made his first career start ... **SS Travis Sandersfeld** traveled on his own to join the team tonight; he's not officially on the travel squad and is still 2-to-4 weeks away from an ankle fracture being completely healed ... The Buffaloes had at least one quarterback sack for the **25th** straight game ... **QB Cody Hawkins** saw his first action of the season at quarterback; he's played in every game as he is also the holder on special teams ... This was just the **ninth** time in CU's last **495** games that the Buffs were shutout; Missouri has administered the last two, and the only two, in CU's last 262 games dating back to 1988 ... All eight of CU's penalties tonight were on the offense ... The 26-yard rush on the fake punt was the opponents first conversion on fourth down this year; CU

came in as the national leader as the enemy had been 0-for-5 ... The Buffs also came in tied for 11th in the nation in "three-and-outs" with 18, and forced Mizzou in that predicament on five occasions ... **DE Josh Hartigan** made his first career interception in the fourth quarter, the first by a Buff defensive lineman since 2007, when **DT Curtis Cunningham** snared one at Florida State.

TONIGHT'S PUNCH VS. PUNCH WINNER: COLORADO. The third quarter has been a strong suit for both teams in 2010. Colorado has outscored its opponent by 46-10, with a hefty edge in offense 487-249. Missouri has a 50-3 command on the scoreboard for the quarter and a 505-207 advantage in offense. But tonight, while there were no points scored in the period, CU did own a 97-17 edge in total offense, thus holding MU some 109 yards under its average for the quarter (126.3).

TB RODNEY STEWART (18-91, 0 TD) With 1,921 yards, he is now 20th all-time at CU in rushing yards, passing **Byron White** (1,864) and **Bob Stransky** (1,868) to crack the top 20. Stewart was stopped on 3rd-&-1 on CU's first drive after coming into the game **7-for-7** on 3rd-&-1 and 4th-&-1 attempts (now 18-of-21 in his career). His 22-yard rush on 3rd-&-22 for a first down late in the first half improved CU to 9-of-92 on 3rd-&-20 or longer since 1993, a span in which the opponents is 4-of-93 in the same situations.

WR SCOTTY MCKNIGHT (5-72, 0 TD) He extended his regular season streak to 41 games with at least one reception (every game of his career, 42 including postseason); that is an active player best in the NCAA. He continued to add to his all-time school mark in receptions (186), and upped his receiving yards total to 2,150, inching closer to fourth position (Phil Savoy, 2,176). He remains tied for fourth in TD receptions (17); Derek McCoy and Rae Carruth lead with 20, Michael Westbrook had 19 and Javon Green also caught 17.

COLORADO INJURIES **DE Forrest West** did not play (pulled a hamstring conditioning on Thursday), and **TB Brian Lockridge** played sparingly (ankle) No other significant injuries reported or expected.



MIZZOU GAME NOTES

- The punting game continued to quietly shine against Colorado, as senior punter Matt Grabner downed his first punt of the game at the Colorado 2-yard line and junior Trey Barrow downed his first at the 1-yard line. Of Grabner's 20 punts this season, 8 have been inside the 20-yard line.
- The Mizzou defense notched its second safety of the year with 7:52 remaining in the 1st quarter, as pressure forced Colorado quarterback Tyler Hansen into an intentional grounding penalty in the endzone.
- Jerrell Jackson's 30-yard touchdown reception in the second quarter was his second and longest of the season. He had previously scored on a 24-yard reception against McNeese State.
- Terrell Resonno blocked a 39-yard field goal attempt by Colorado midway through the second quarter. It was his first blocked field goal and the first of the season for the team. Mizzou also blocked a punt in the first quarter, thanks to the hustle of tight end Eric Waters.
- The Tigers' 97-yard scoring drive, capped off by a 10-yard touchdown reception by tight end Michael Egnew, marked the longest scoring drive of the year for the Mizzou offense. The previous long was a 94-yard drive against Miami of Ohio in Week 4.
- Mizzou ended the second half up 19-0. In the past five years against Colorado, the aggregate halftime score has been 138-19; in the last three, it has been 86-3.
- James Franklin had a career game after replacing Blaine Gabbert early in the fourth quarter. His 34-yard rush for a first down marked the longest of his career (his previous was a 10-yard rush against McNeese State). He also notched his first career passing touchdown with a 7-yard pass to Michael Egnew to put the Tigers up 26-0 with 9:16 remaining in the game.
- The Mizzou defense continued their trend of third quarter success, and is now one of only two defenses in college football this year that has yet to allow a touchdown in the third quarter (Iowa is the other, with a bye this week).
- Redshirt sophomore back Kip Edwards notched his first interception of the year (and second of his career) on a snagged pass from Colorado quarterback Cody Hawkins in the fourth quarter. His interception was the ninth of the year for the Tigers.
