#FIRSTFIVE

• The Nicholls Colonels (0-2) will make their second trip to Colorado in as many years as they take on the FBS Colorado Buffaloes (2-1) on Saturday at 12:30 p.m. on the Pac-12 Networks. Nicholls will have its hands full as the Buffaloes will be playing in front of its home crowd for the second time this season, hoping to duplicate their performance in their home opener in a 48-14 victory over UMass.

• After playing three FBS teams in each of the last three seasons, Nicholls is scheduled to play only two this season – ULM and Colorado. Following back-to-back trips to the Pacific Northwest to take on Oregon State and Oregon in 2012 and 2013, the Colonels will be making their second consecutive trip to Colorado after opening the season against Air Force last year. Nicholls has three wins all-time against FBS programs, with its last coming in 2013 at Western Michigan.

• The meeting with Colorado will be the third matchup against a Pac-12 program for the Colonels in the last four seasons. In 2012, Nicholls was supposed to open at Oregon State, but Hurricane Isaac caused travel problems and the game was postponed until the end of the season, which OSU won 73-7. In 2013, Nicholls and Colorado had a common opponent as the Colonels opened the season at top-ranked Oregon, falling 66-3 to the Ducks. Just over a month later, Colorado hosted Oregon and was defeated 57-16.

• The Colonels played a total of 17 freshmen through their first two contents. Making starts as rookies have been WR Jarrell Rogers, OLs Chandler Arceneaux and Kevin Pierce, DEs Tank Johnson and Devin Simoneaux, DBs Tyler Green, Corey Abraham and Ahmani Martin and long-snapper Wesley Barnett.

• The Colonels are coming off their third winless campaign in program history. The team went 0-11 in 1995, but put together one of the best turnarounds in FCS history, going 8-4 in the next season which included an appearance in the FCS Playoffs. Coincidentally, Coach Rebowe was part of the staff in '96 that led the Colonels to the remarkable improvement after going winless in the prior season.

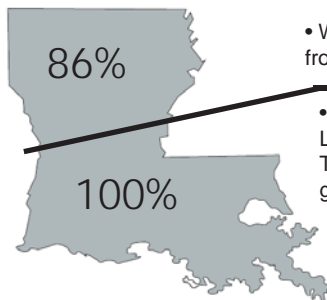

SCOUTING

• Colorado, located in Boulder, is in its fifth season in the Pac-12 after a 15-year tenure in the Big XII. In its first four years in the new conference, Colorado compiled a 10-39 record.

• The Buffaloes put an end to their own losing streak, stopping a nine-game skid with a win in their home opener against UMass. CU started the season with a loss at Hawaii, but won two straight to push its record to 2-1 after an overtime win against rival Colorado State in Denver last Saturday.

- Colorado comes into the matchup averaging 243.3 yards rushing, which ranks third in the Pac-12. Leading the rushing attack is Michael Adkins II with 218 yards on 5.05 yards per carry.

- One player on defense to keep an eye out for is Kenneth Olugbode, who was recently named Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Week. In the win vs. CSU, Olugbode had 13 tackles and returned an interception 60 yards for a TD to give Colorado the lead in the fourth quarter.

- Surprisingly, Colorado has not had a winning season since 2005 when the Buffaloes finished with a 7-6 record after their bowl game victory over Clemson.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

QUARTERBACKS

• Tuskani Figaro made the start in the first two games, accounting for 214 yards passing and a touchdown on 23 of 35 passing (65.7%). Figaro was flawless on the Colonels' opening drive at UIW, going 5 for 5 and capped the drive with a 5-yd TD pass to C.J. Bates. After his second INT; however, he was sent to the sidelines for the rest of the game.

• Seeing his first action at QB since 2012, Landry Klann directed the offense for the final 23 minutes of last week's game, completing 3 of 5 passes for 23 yards. Klann was a bit rusty in his debut as he also threw a pair of interceptions.

• While the Colonels lost both quarterbacks who logged starts last season, redshirt junior Tuskani Figaro returned to direct the offense. Before redshirting last season due to a coaches' decision, Figaro received the majority of the snaps in 2013, going on to pass and rush for over 1,000 yards. Figaro's 1,103 yards rushing yards set the Colonels' single-season mark, and he also matched the team record with five 100-yard rushing games in one season, highlighted by a program-record 281 yards against Arkansas Tech.

• A starter in 2012, Klann missed 2013 with a shoulder injury and made the switch to linebacker last season before suffering another season-ending injury. In 2012, he threw for 2,049 yards and 8 TDs in 11 games as he became the first Colonel QB to throw for over 2,000 yards since 1998.

RUNNING BACKS

• Michael Henry carried the ball 12 times for 40 yards in the loss at UIW, which was his lowest output since becoming the starter last season. All four of Henry's 100-yard efforts and six TDs in 2014 came in SLC play. His career high came at NSU as he finished with 146 yards rushing.

• Tobias Lofton led Nicholls vs UIW with 64 yards rushing on 12 carries. Lofton transferred from the juco ranks last season and put together a solid year, rushing for 434 yards and 4 TDs at 5.4 yards per tote. His breakout game came against SFA where he rushed for 104 yards on seven carries, highlighted by a 66-yard touchdown.

• For the first time in program history, the Red and Gray will have the luxury of having two 1,000-yard rushers in the same backfield. After Figaro accomplished the feat in 2013, running back Michael Henry became the third Colonel in program history to surpass 1,000 yards after rushing for 1,005 yards in his junior campaign last season. A Second Team All-Southland honoree, Henry was an automatic preseason first-team selection this season.

• Alabama transfer Altee Tenpenny joined the team in fall camp, but his playing status for the season is still pending.

RECEIVERS AND TIGHT ENDS

• Nicholls added a pair of Louisiana-Lafayette transfers at receiver in C.J. Bates and Jarrell Rogers, who both started the first two games. Bates had a breakout first half at UIW, catching 4 passes for 55 yards with a 5-yd score. Rogers ended up leading the team with 5 catches for 37 yards.

• Senior Terry Lucas Jr. put together a career-game at ULM, catching 5 passes for 51 yards. His night was highlighted by a 31-yard catch he made near the sideline while sliding on his knees. Against UIW, Lucas added 3 grabs for 29 yards.

• Despite returning a wealth of receivers, only two returning members of the receiving core had double digit receptions last season. Xavier Marcus had 19 receptions for 201 yards and a touchdown, while Darryl Watson hauled in 18 catches for 233 yards and a score. However, the running backs played a significant role in the passing game as Michael Henry was second on the team in receptions (28) and yards (253), and Tobias Lofton added 15 catches for 87 yards as well.

• With the graduation of Nick Scelfo, assuming the tight end role are Dorian Durald and Stephen LeBouef, who have combined for 11 receptions. Also at tight end is Denzel Flemings, who played four games for the Colonel basketball team last season.

OFFENSIVE LINE

• Anchoring the offensive line is three-year starter Brandon Holmes, who is once again at center. After playing guard as a freshman, Holmes took over in the middle and has been a mainstay on the offensive line, playing in 33 games.

• Nicholls added LSU transfer Jonah Austin, who started both games at left tackle. Austin, at 6-6, 330, recently graduated from LSU and had one year of eligibility remaining. While at LSU, Austin appeared in 12 games as a backup lineman.

• Starting at guard will be redshirt sophomore Brian Hernandez and junior Jared Breaux. Both earned significant playing time in 2014, combining for a total of 12 appearances.

• Chandler Arceneaux earned the starting spot at right tackle as a redshirt freshman. True freshman Ryan Hanley has also played significant time, as has redshirt freshman Kevin Pierce, who started at UIW.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

DEFENSIVE LINE

• The Colonels sport one of the youngest defensive lines as six of the eight players listed on the depth chart are underclassmen. Tyler "Tank" Johnson and Devin Simoneaux start on the edges as redshirt freshmen, while sophomore Lazarus Ona plugs up the middle at nose for the second straight season. Simoneaux led the group with 3 tackles and a 0.5 tackle for loss at ULM, while Johnson had 2 stop and a four-yard loss vs UIW.

• The D-line will be looking to generate more pressure on the opposing quarterbacks as the group came up with just one sack last season. The group forced pressure on UIW's QB several times in the loss, but could not record a sack.

LINEBACKERS

• Returning to the lineup was sophomore Hezekiah White, who had 9 tackles in each of the first two games. At Arkansas last season, White saw his season cut short after suffering a knee injury against the Razorbacks.

• Junior Seth Keller led the Colonel defense against UIW with a career-high 11 tackles. Keller contributed with a tackle for loss as well, accounting for 2 yards.

• Redshirt sophomore Geoffrey Hebert was credited with the Colonels' first sack of the season as he chased ULM starting QB Garrett Smith out of bounds for a yard loss. Last season, Nicholls had just two sacks on the year.

• After missing the ULM game, Kevin Fontenot added another big body in the middle against UIW. Fontenot, a true freshman, is 6'4 and a few beignets (ben-yays) shy of 300 lbs.

• Taking over the defensive line coach is Baton Rouge native Anthony Camp. A graduate of McNeese State, Camp spent the last six years coaching in the high school ranks.

• The linebackers are the most experienced group returning for the defense. Of the eight players listed on the depth chart, only one player, true freshman Adrian Richardson, did not see significant playing time. Richardson had 2 tackles in his debut and tipped a pass that almost led to a Colonel interception.

SECONDARY

• The Colonel secondary tallied two interceptions against UIW. The first came on a trick play when UIW tossed a half back pass deep into the endzone and it was picked off by freshman Ahmani Martin. The second was a potential game-changer as Darius Knight intercepted a pass and returned in 93 yards for a touchdown late in the fourth quarter. The return was negated by a penalty, however, keeping the score at 13-10 UIW.

• B.T. Sanders tied defensive back Josh Singleton, who switched to receiver, for the team lead with two interceptions last season. Nicholls picked off 10 passes in 2014, including a 22-yard score by Joel Dullary. Sander led the Colonels against ULM with 12 tackles.

• Two additions to the secondary are former Colonel baseball player Darius Knight and Colorado transfer Jeff Hall. Knight was a starting outfielder for Nicholls for two years and after an impressive fall camp, earned one of the starting spots at cornerback. Hall comes to Nicholls after playing 12 games as a sophomore at CU. Knight made a huge hit on the game's first play, resulting in a 4-yard loss on a wideout screen.

• Four freshmen are listed on the depth chart - two redshirt and two true. Tyler Green started the opener at ULM while Corey Abraham and Ahmani Martin made a start at safety.

SPECIAL TEAMS

• Senior Francisco Condado connected on his first field goal of the season, making good on a 42-yarder at UIW. Last season, Condado made 5 of 8 field goal attempts, including a career-long 47 yarder at McNeese State.

• The Colonels looked to have had a breakthrough return to open the second half against UIW as Charles Henderson took the ball into Cardinal territory, but the play was called back on an illegal block.

• Tyler St. Germain has been busy in the first two games, punting a total of 15 times for an average of 39.9 yards per punt. He's had five inside the 20, with four being inside the 10.

• Joining the kicking crew is former LSU baseball player Chris Sciambra. A starting outfielder for the nationally-ranked Tigers, Sciambra kicked in high school and was a walk-on at LSU last season. Sciambra struggled a bit in his debut, shanking a 16-yd punt and had another blocked for a safety.

LAGNIAPPES

SO YOU'RE SAYING THERE'S A CHANCE?

Although the Colonels have three FBS wins since 2000, none have come against a Power 5 Conference. However, Colorado was upset by an FCS team in 2012, falling to Sacramento State, 30-28. And the last time the Buffaloes took on a team from the Southland Conference was in the 2013 season. CU had its hands full with Central Arkansas as the game was tied in the fourth quarter at 24-all before the Buffaloes pulled out a 38-24 victory. The matchup was similar to this season, sandwiched between an emotional win over rival Colorado State and CU's conference opener.

FBS TRANSFERS

While head coach Tim Rebowe believed that there was plenty of talent coming back from 2014, he was able to add in several FBS transfers into the mix. On offense, joining Nicholls are WRs C.J. Bates (UL-Lafayette), Charles Henderson (Utah), Jarrell Rogers (UL-Lafayette) and Daijuan Stewart (SMU); running back Atlee Tenpenny (Alabama); and left tackle Jonah Austin (LSU). Only one transfer came on defense, DB Jeff Hall (Colorado), and K Chris Sciambra (LSU) joins the specialists after playing baseball for the nationally-ranked Tigers.

SHUTOUT

For the first time in 30 games, Nicholls failed to crack the scoring column after its loss at ULM. Despite the current program-long losing streak, Nicholls had always scored at least a field goal in its losses. The non-shutout streak dated back to the Colonels' homecoming 41-0 loss to Sam Houston State on Oct. 13, 2012. It was also the first shutout against an FBS opponent since Sept. 4, 2010 (San Diego State, 47-0), breaking a string of 12 consecutive FBS games without a shutout.

DIAMOND TO THE GRIDIRON

Starting cornerback Darius Knight joined the football team over the summer after playing two seasons with the Colonel baseball team. A junior college transfer, Knight logged 64 starts in his two seasons with the Nicholls baseball team, helping lead the Colonels to back-to-back top three finishes in the Southland. He was third on the team in batting average in 2015, hitting .275 with 12 RBIs, 25 runs scored and led the conference with 12 sacrifice bunts.

ON THE AIRWAVES

ESPN Radio New Orleans, KLRZ 100.3 FM will be the home for Colonel football for all 11 games. KLRZ is an 89,000 watt FM station devoting 27 hours a week to live, local programming. In addition to live coverage of each game, ESPN Radio New Orleans will conduct interviews with Colonel coaches and players throughout the season. Bryant Johnson will cover play-by-play and will be joined by Seth Thomas (color) and Kyle Carrier (sideline).

THE TIM REBOWE SHOW

The Tim Rebowe Radio Show debuted Tuesday night of last week on ESPN New Orleans 100.3 FM. The two-hour show, hosted by Ken Frielander and Voice of the Colonels, Bryant Johnson, will take place at Walk-On's in Houma every Tuesday night from 6-8 p.m. Rebowe will be featured in the weekly show from 6:30-7:30 p.m.

CLASS ACT

Redshirt sophomore Geoffrey Hebert is one player who defines student-athlete. Last season, Hebert recorded 30 tackles as he played in all 12 games. He is also one of the brightest players in the classroom, posting a 4.0 GPA as a double major in accounting and finance.

Football SID Jamie Bustos will accompany the Colonels on every road trip to handle any day-of-game needs that may arise. Following the NCAA mandated 10-minute cooling off period, Tim Rebowe and selected Colonel student-athletes will be made available to the media in the offensive meeting room located in the Barker Hall for home games. For away games, Nicholls will follow host SID procedures in how they handle post game interviews. With five minutes remaining in the game, Nicholls will poll the media as to who they want to interview after the game. The Nicholls lockerroom is closed to all media members.

LAGNIAPPES PART II

THE ROAD

Like Cormac McCarthy's novel, Nicholls' first half of the schedule pitted the Colonels on a long dreary road as the Red and Gray play 4 of its first 5 games away from home. Nicholls did snap a 14-game road skid with its win at Western Michigan in 2013, but the Colonels have not won a road conference game since their 37-7 win at Northwestern State on 11/13/10 (16 games).

LARDARIUS WEBB

Former Colonel and current Baltimore Raven Lardarius Webb was voted into the Nicholls Athletics Hall of Fame after appearing on the ballot for the first time in 2014. Webb, who became the second Colonel in the last five seasons to win a Super Bowl ring after his Ravens defeated San Francisco in Super Bowl XLVII, 34-31, had a storied career at Nicholls, earning All-American honors in both of his seasons as he racked up nearly 40 individual awards. Webb is entering his seventh season with the Ravens.

PAPER NOR PLASTIC

The Colonels were unable to get to the opposing quarterback last season, tallying only two sacks on the year. In the first game of 2015, LB Geoffrey Hebert was able to force the quarterback out of bounds for a 1-yd sack. Despite applying pressure on several passing plays at UIW, the defense was held without a sack.

MAKING THE SWITCH

Two returnees from last season made position changes as C.J. Okpalobi and Josh Singleton are now lining up on the other side of the ball. Okpalobi had 10 carries for 43 yards in his two years as a running back, while Singleton led the team with two interceptions at cornerback in 2014. In his debut at cornerback, Okpalobi had six tackles against ULM. Singleton caught his first pass against UIW, but it went for 0 yards.

NEW DC

Nicholls entered the season with its third defensive coordinator in as many years. After ranking near or at the bottom of the FCS in several defensive categories last season, first-year coordinator Tommy Rybacki will have the task of revamping the defense. Rybacki has familiar ties to the Southland as he comes to Nicholls after coaching three seasons at Central Arkansas.

APRIL IN THE APPLE

Former Colonel Bobby April, who played four seasons at linebacker including for Nicholls' first team in program history in 1972, is in his first season as the special teams coordinator for the New York Jets. April, a 25-year veteran in the coaching ranks, has been considered one of the NFL's most highly regarded special teams coaches. Before joining New York, he previously coached for the Raiders, Philadelphia Eagles, Buffalo Bills, St. Louis Rams, New Orleans Saints, Pittsburgh Steelers and Atlanta Falcons.

THE MANNING CAMP

Over the summer, Nicholls State University hosted The Manning Passing Academy for the 11th consecutive year. The four-day camp, put on by the Manning family - Archie and his sons, Cooper, Eli and Peyton - brought in close to 1,200 high school campers from all over the country. In addition to the Manning's, every year some of the most elite NCAA quarterbacks act as camp counselors. Current NFL starting quarterbacks that were recently counselors include Andrew Luck, Andy Dalton and Marcus Mariota.

SOUTHLAND CHAMPIONS

The program will be celebrating its 10-year anniversary of its Southland Conference Championship. In 2005, the Colonels went 5-1 in Southland play which included a win over co-champion Texas State. Nicholls went on to play Furman in the playoffs and was defeated, 14-12.

NEW STAFF

The 2015 Colonel coaching staff will not only have a new person at the helm, but the entire staff is different from last season.

ROB CHRISTOPHEL (OC/QB)

Christophel will direct the offense and coach the quarterbacks. He comes to Nicholls after eight seasons at Missouri State. He also served as the OC at Louisiana-Lafayette from 2001-06.

TOMMY RYBACKI (DC/LB)

Rybacki will oversee the defense after spending one season at UCA as cornerbacks coach where the Bears were second in interceptions with 16. Also coached at ULL as a GA from 2011-13.

ANTHONY CAMP (DL)

Camp will coach the defensive line after coaching six years in the local high school ranks. His last stint was as DC at Catholic in Baton Rouge, helping the team to a 26-8 record during his tenure.

RUSS GISCLAIR (TE)

Gisclair joins Nicholls after lettering four seasons with the Colonels from 2010-13. At fullback, Gisclair appeared in 38 career games for the Colonels. Following graduation, he worked at Vandebilt Catholic in Houma and in 2015, joined the McNeese State staff as a defensive assistant.

SEAN MURPHY (WR)

Murphy comes to Nicholls after spending three seasons at Louisiana-Lafayette as a graduate assistant. In the last two campaigns, he served as an assistant coach for the wide receivers and was the scout team coordinator.

ALAN RICARD (RB)

Ricard joins Nicholls after coaching the running backs for one season at The Apprentice School, a Division III program in Virginia. Prior to the season, he completed an internship with the NFL's New York Jets during the summer which lasted through training camp. A former fullback in the NFL, Ricard is a graduate of ULM.

LEE ROUSSEL (OL)

Roussel joins Nicholls after coaching at Archbishop Rummel for five seasons. Along with coaching the o-line, he took over as OC in 2014 as the Raiders finished the regular season at 10-0 and ranked No. 1 in the state in Class 5A.

MARCUS SCOTT (DB)

Scott comes to Nicholls after serving as head coach at West Jefferson High (La.) from 2008-13. During his tenure, the Buccaneers posted a 38-26 record, reached the playoffs in each season and claimed two district titles - in 2008 and 2009.

BRIAN WALLACE (LB)

Wallace comes to Nicholls after coaching at his alma mater, Louisiana College, for three seasons. While at LC, he served as co-defensive coordinator, linebackers coach and recruiting coordinator.

TIM REBOWE

0-2, 0-1 SLC
FIRST SEASON AS HEAD COACH
LSU, 1987

Tim Rebowe was named head football coach at Nicholls State University on Nov. 21, 2014.

Rebowe, a 52-year old native of Norco, La., is the 10th head coach in the program's history. Rebowe, who coached at Louisiana-Lafayette as an assistant for 11 seasons and was a former assistant coach

at Nicholls for six years, not only brings a wealth of experience coaching at the collegiate level, but has strong ties to the state of Louisiana having coached within the borders his entire career.

Rebowe helped lead the Ragin' Cajun program to four consecutive New Orleans Bowl victories and a conference championship under head coach Mark Hudspeth. During his tenure at ULL, Rebowe has served as the safeties coach (2004-07, 2011-14) and linebackers coach (2008-10).

Last season, ULL's defense ranked first in the Sun Belt in rushing yards allowed and red zone defense, while ranking second in points allowed. The defense finished with seven interceptions on the year, including two by cornerback Corey Trim, who was named All-Sun Belt Second Team Defense.

Under Rebowe's tutelage in 2013, the Cajuns tied for the conference lead with 14 interceptions. Two years prior, his safeties combined for five interceptions, with three returned for touchdowns.



Rebowe's group had a stellar year in his first season as defensive backs coach in 2004 as the defense ranked 11th in the nation in passing yards allowed. Both of his starting safeties that year, C.C. Brown and Antwain Spann, would go on to the NFL. The following season, the pass defense finished 23rd in the nation in yards allowed.

As a linebackers coach, Rebowe guided the team's leading tackler in all three seasons and also had two players earn All-Sun Belt recognition.

In 1995, Rebowe took his first collegiate job, joining Darren Barbier's staff at Nicholls. From '95-'99, he served as defensive backs coach and special teams coordinator before coaching the receivers in 2000. Rebowe was part of the biggest turnaround in FCS history as the Colonels went 0-11 in '95 before earning a playoff spot the very next season with an 8-4 mark.

Rebowe began his coaching career in 1988 at his alma mater, Destrehan High School. While at Destrehan, he coached future NFL Hall of Famer Ed Reed.

Following his stint with Nicholls, Rebowe coached the cornerbacks at ULM from 2001-03.

Rebowe earned his bachelor of science in physical education from LSU in 1987. He is married to the former Kim Robichaux and they have a daughter, Samantha, and a son, Tyler, who is an infielder on the Colonel baseball team.

NICHOLLS FOOTBALL 2015 GAME NOTES - @ COLORADO

GAME 1: ULM 47, NICHOLLS 0 SEPT. 12, 2015 IN MONROE, LA. JPS FIELD AT MALONE STADIUM

MONROE, La. – The ULM Warhawks put together a 30-point second quarter to pull away from the Nicholls State University football team as the Colonels fell in their season opener, 47-0, Saturday night at Malone Stadium.

The loss spoiled the debut of Nicholls head coach Tim Rebowe and pushed the Colonels' overall losing streak to 19 games. ULM (1-1), which plays at the FBS level, improved its all-time record to 23-3 against the Colonels and has won the last nine meetings. Saturday night's matchup was the first contest between the instate schools since 2000.

Nicholls was limited to 260 yards on offense and gave up 593 yards. Michael Henry had a solid first half for the Colonels, rushing for 74 yards on 11 carries. He added four more carries after the break, finishing with 77 yards. Tuskani Figaro got the start under center, passing for 101 yards on 10 of 17.

ULM set the tone early by scoring on its first two drives. Following a field goal on the game's opening drive, the Warhawks took a 10-0 lead after Devontae McNeal scored on a 3-yard touchdown. Nicholls went three-and-out in each of its first three drives in the quarter.

The Warhawks broke open the game in the second quarter, led by quarterback Garrett Smith who accounted for all four touchdowns in the stanza. Smith started the scoring with a 10-yard touchdown run and followed up with his first of three passing TDs before the half with a 13-yard strike to Ajalen Holley. Holley had a big night for ULM, catching eight balls for 155 yards.

Down 24-0, Nicholls pieced together a 9-play, 57-yard drive, but came up empty on the scoreboard. On a 4th-and-3 from the ULM 24, Rebowe elected to go for it, but the Warhawks hit Figaro in the backfield and forced the ball loose.

ULM then closed out the half with 16 points. Smith hit Harley Scioneaux for a 17-yard score and the defense blocked a punt into the end zone for a safety. After the free kick, Smith connected with Holley for a 47-yard touchdown for a 40-0 lead. Smith finished with 370 yards and completed 26 of 33 passes.

The Colonels had their best drive of the night early in the third quarter, going 82 yards on 14 plays. Figaro and Terry Lucas Jr. hooked up for a 31-yard pass, but after the ULM defense held strong inside the 10-yard line, Francisco Condado missed on a 21-yard field goal. Lucas led the team with five receptions for 51 yards.

ULM added a rushing outchdown in the fourth to make the final. The Warhawks racked up 202 yards on the ground, while Nicholls finished with 159. Tobias Lofton added 39 yards on 10 carries for the Colonels.

B.T. Sanders led Nicholls with 12 tackles and Hezekiah White added nine.
