OFFENSE

Kevin Hogan, Sr., QB
Stanford

Completed 18-of-23 for 279 yards and 2 TDs in 41-21 win at USC. It was his fourth-best passing efficiency game of his career (208.9) as he helped the Cardinal maintain a 2:1 time of possession battle and converted 8 of 12 third downs.

DEFENSE

Kenneth Olugbode, Sr., LB,
Colorado

In 27-24 OT victory over Colorado State, posted team high 13 tackles, including five solo stops, and returned an interception 60 yards for a touchdown that gave CU a 24-17 leads with 8:50 remaining in the game.

SPECIAL TEAMS

Cory Butler-Byrd, Jr., DB
Utah

Posted a 98-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in the fourth quarter of the 45-24 win over Fresno State. He also contributed four tackles on defense.

PAC-12 QUICK HITS

ZERO TO 60: Pac-12 teams have scored 60 or more points four times this season - OREGON twice, ARIZONA and CALIFORNIA once each. Four Pac-12 teams are ranked among the FBS top 12 in scoring offense - No. 3 Arizona (54.3), No. 7 California (51.0), No. 9 Oregon (50.0) and No. 11 USC (48.3).

DAWG POUND: Despite having four defensive players taken among the first 44 players in the 2015 NFL draft, WASHINGTON is seventh in the FBS in scoring defense (11.0 ppg), 13th in total defense (267.7 ypg), and 15th in rush defense (93.0 ypg).

The Pac-12 posted has posted a winning record outside league for 30 consecutive seasons . . . The Pac-12 recorded a 37-9 record in non-conference action last season, posting the most wins ever outside of conference play. Since 1934, only one other season witnessed the Conference capture more than 29 wins in non-league play - 2002 (32-15) when the league played an eight game conference schedule, allowing an additional 10 non-conference games to be played.

AROUND THE PAC-12

POLL WATCHING: For the second time this season the Pac-12 has six teams ranked among the Top 25. It's the 15th time that Conference has had six teams ranked among the Top 25, with nine of those occurring over the last two seasons ... Two games on the docket this week pit Top 25 ranked foes against one another - No. 9 UCLA at No. 16 ARIZONA, and No. 18 UTAH at No. 13 OREGON ... Last season, there were 12 games where both Pac-12 teams were ranked in the Top 25 at game time. In those 12 meetings, the higher ranked team was victorious nine times, while the home team prevailed six times.

RARE AIR: ARIZONA sophomore QB **Anu Solomon** and USC senior QB **Cody Kessler** are the only two FBS signal-callers to have 10 or more touchdown passes with no interceptions. Solomon has completed 71-of-104 for 778 yards and 10 TDs, while Kessler has completed 70-of-89 for 922 yards and 10 TDs.

PAC-12 CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION

#100Pac12: The Pac-12 Conference is set to celebrate 100 years of excellence. The yearlong celebration of the Conference centennial, including marking the date of the official formation 100 years ago on December 2, will kick off with the start of the football season and continue throughout the 2015-16 academic year.

The Conference's storied history dates back 100 years to Dec. 2, 1915 when four schools - the University of California, Oregon Agricultural College (now Oregon State University), the University of Oregon and the University of Washington - gathered at the historic Imperial Hotel in Portland, Ore., to form the Pacific Coast Conference.

Since that day, the Conference has been known for its widespread excellence - on the field, in the classroom, and with the contributions its graduates make in the world. No other Conference can match the collective achievements and distinctions accomplished over the last century.

#COMPLETE12

COMPLETE CAMPAIGN: Pac-12 students are known for their success on the field, but they are also impressive, complete people with outside interests, diverse backgrounds, extracurricular activities, interesting families, busy schedules, and full lives. Here's a look at some of the off-field accomplishments:



GIVING BACK: California senior safety **Stefan McClure** has consistently been involved in community service throughout his Cal career and has worked with several organizations including the Alameda Juvenile Hall, Children's Hospital Oaklan, Cleveland Middle School, High Street Boys and Girls Club, John F. Kennedy Elementary School, Martin Luther King Middle School, Playworks, Rise Community School, Sage Mentorship Program and the S.Q.U.I.R.E.S. program at San Quentin State Prison. McClure is also heavily involved as a peer advisor and mentor.

THIS WEEK'S GAMES

STANFORD at OREGON STATE

Fri., Sept. 25 • 7 p.m. PT • FS1

STANFORD: The Cardinal overcame an 11-point second-quarter deficit to grab a 41-31 victory over then-No. 6 USC. Stanford's offense came out strong, scoring on seven of its 10 possessions and totaled 475 yards of offense. It was 8-of-12 on third-down conversions, dominated the time of possession (39:29 to 20:31), and was 6-of-6 from the red zone ... Sophomore RB **Christian McCaffrey** had 249 all-purpose yards (115 rush, 37 receiving, 97 kick return). He leads the Conference in all-purpose yards, averaging 195.3 yards per game ... Defensively, senior LB **Blake Martinez** tied his career high with 14 tackles, and is currently leading the Pac-12 with 38.

OREGON STATE: The Beavers tallied 21 unanswered points in the third quarter to beat San Jose State, 35-21. Freshman QB **Seth Collins** (114) and senior RB **Storm Barrs-Woods** (151) each rushed for 100 yards. It was the 15th time in school history that two or more Beavers rushed for 100 yards in the same game. The Beavers rushed for 305 yards. It was their first time over the 300-yard mark since they gained 323 in a Oct. 11, 2008 win over Washington State ... The Beaver defense forced two turnovers and shut out the Spartans in the second half. Sophomore LB **Manase Hungalu** had a career-high 11 tackles in his first start. He had three in OSU's first two games.

Last Meeting: Kevin Hogan threw for two touchdowns and ran for another, Ty Montgomery returned a punt for a score and Stanford's offense busted out of its slump in a 38-14 rout of Oregon State. Hogan completed 18 of 28 passes for 277 yards as the Cardinal outgained Oregon State 438 to 221 yards. The Stanford defense recorded six sacks and limited Oregon State to 12 yards rushing.

Nicholls at COLORADO

Sat., Sept. 26 • 11:30 a.m. MT • PAC12

COLORADO: CU has won two games in a row for the first time since coach Mike MacIntyre's first two games in Boulder (2013); CU will be going for three straight for the first time since winning the first three games of the 2008 season ... QB **Sefo Liufau**, who was 15-of-28 for 220 yards and 2 TDs, moved into fifth place in all-time passing yards with 5,523 (skipping by Koy Detmer's 5,390), and passed Darian Hagan into fifth all-time in total offense with 5,831 (Hagan had 5,808). ... With six receptions for 63 yards, senior WR **Nelson Spruce** moved into fourth place all-time in receiving yards with 2,490; he is now 59 yards shy of the top spot (he added to his all-time lead in receptions with 225). ... OLB **Kenneth Olujobode** had the first interception of his career and returned it 60 yards for a touchdown, which came on his 20th birthday (Sept. 19) ... For the second straight game, CU did not commit a turnover or allow a quarterback sack.

CALIFORNIA at WASHINGTON

Sat., Sept. 26 • 2 p.m. PT • PAC12

CALIFORNIA: With the 45-44 win over Texas, Cal starts the season 3-0 for the first time since 2011. It looks to move to 4-0 for the first time since starting the 2007 season with five straight wins ... Junior QB **Jared Goff** went 27 of 37 for 268 yards and three touchdowns, en route to breaking three school records in the contest, including career passing yards (8,379), total offense (8,266) and career completions (704) ... Junior RB **Khalifani Muhammad** rushed for a career high 164 yards on 10 carries with a 74-yard touchdown run. Muhammad averages an impressive 12.1 yards per carry this season as he has rushed for 266 yards on 22 carries ... Cal, the Conference's second-best team in scoring offense heads to Washington to face the Conference's leader in total defense.

WASHINGTON: Freshman QB **Jake Browning** completed his second-straight 300-yard passing performance in the 31-17 win over Utah State. Washington fared well in all three phases, with junior TB **Dwayne Washington** totaling 131 yards on five carries and two touchdowns, sophomore PK **Tristan Vizcaino** ran for a 2-yard TD and completed the extra point, and junior DB **Brandon Beaver** had a 96-yard interception return (longest ever in UW history) ... One of two teams in the nation to yet allow a passing touchdown, the Huskies will face California who has 10 passing touchdowns (2nd Pac-12) and averages 353.8 passing yards per game.

Last Meeting: Shaq Thompson returned a fumble 100 yards for a touchdown to open the scoring, but it was the arm of Husky quarterback Cyler Miles that led Washington to a 31-7 victory at California. Miles connected on 22-of-29 for 273 yards and three TDs, including an 86-yard connection with John Ross. California's Jared Goff completed 35 of 51 for 304 yards, but Cal's ground game was kept in check by the Husky defense as it gained just 64 yards on 33 carries (1.9 ypc).

UCLA at ARIZONA

Sat., Sept. 26 • 5 p.m. PT • ABC

UCLA: The Bruins are 5-1 in last six games vs. ranked opponents, and 10-6 vs. ranked teams under Jim Mora ... PK **Ka'imi Fairbairn** has connected on 34 straight field goals from 35 yards and in, and 19 of his last 21 overall attempts ... Junior RB **Paul Perkins** now has eight 100-yard rushing games in his career after rushing for a career-best 219 yards vs. BYU. Perkins is currently 11th on the UCLA career rushing list with 2,577 yards. He needs seven yards to crack the top 10 (Kevin Nelson, 2,583 – 1980-83) ... Senior WR **Jordan Payton** has caught a pass in a team-best 19 straight games ... Junior LB **Isaako Savalinæa** had 14 tackles vs. BYU. He had eight tackles in 13 appearances last season.

ARIZONA: The Wildcats set a school record scoring 77 points against Northern Arizona, recording a school-best 792 yards of total offense in the process. 10 of UA's 11 TDs were accomplished in less than 3:00 ... Has scored 40-plus points in five of its last seven contests going back to last season ... Senior QB **Jerrard Randall** made the most of his minutes in relief of starter Anu Solomon. Randall had touchdown runs of 72 and 73 yards. ... Through 17 career games, sophomore QB **Anu Solomon** has thrown for 4,571 yards/38 TDs and compiled 4,915 yards of total offense. Sophomore RB **Nick Wilson** has rushed for 1,899 yards/21 TDs in 16 career games.

Last Meeting: Brett Hundley keyed the Bruin offense with 189 yards passing and a season-high 131 rushing yards as No. 22 UCLA bested No. 12 Arizona, 17-7. UCLA limited the Wildcats to 255 total yards, including 80 on the ground, while blanking the visitors over the final three quarters. Jordan Payton caught six passes for 119 yards, including a 70-yard TD pass from Hundley to give the Bruins a 10-point cushion late in the third quarter.

UTAH at OREGON

Sat., Sept. 26 • 5:30 p.m. PT • FOX

UTAH: The Utes scored a pair of special team TDs in their 45-24 win at Fresno State as junior **Cory Butler-Byrd** returned a kickoff 98 yards for a score, and freshman **Britain Covey** returned a punt 77 yards for another score ... The 45 points were the most points scored by the Utes in a road game since posting a 54-10 victory at BYU in 2011 ... Senior RB **Davontae Booker** had 212 all-purpose yards (156 rush, 56 receiving) ... The Utes have eighth takeaways (5 interceptions, 3 fumbles) and lead the Pac-12 with a +4 turnover margin (1.33 per game) ... The Utes look to move to 4-0 to start the year for the first time since starting the 2010 season with eight straight wins.

OREGON: In their 61-28 victory over Georgia State, the Ducks recorded more than 60 points for the 12th time since 2009 (second to Baylor—15 in FBS) ... Junior QB **Jeff Lockie** made his first career start, finishing 23 of 31 for 228 yards and two touchdowns ... Oregon's defense scored two touchdowns in the win. The Ducks now have an FBS-high 35 non-offensive touchdowns since 2010. Sophomore RB **Royce Freeman** ran for 101 yards on 10 carries and a touchdown in the first half. Freeman now has eight 100-yard rushing games to his career ... Oregon faces Utah, a team that ranks second in the Pac-12 in rushing defense at 105.7.

Last Meeting: With Utah holding an early 7-0 lead and on the verge of adding another score, Ute receiver Kaelin Clay fumbled before crossing the goal line after a 78-yard reception. The fumble was returned 100 yards for a TD by Oregon's Joe Walker. The 14-point swing sparked the fifth-ranked Ducks to a 51-27 victory over No. 17 Utah. Marcus Mariota, who became the first UO quarterback ever to pass for 9,000 yards in his career, completed 17-of-29 on the night for 239 yards and three TDs.

USC at ARIZONA STATE

Sat., Sept. 26 • 7:30 p.m. PT • ESPN

USC: Senior QB **Cody Kessler**, a 2015 Heisman Trophy candidate who is in the Top 3 nationally in completion percentage (78.7%), passing TDs (10) and passing efficiency (he has not thrown a pick in his last 101 aerials) ... Sophomore WR **Juju Smith-Schuster** is fifth in the FBS with 144.7 receiving yards per game ... The Trojans are striking quickly this season. Their 16 offensive scoring drives have taken an average of 1:50 ... USC leads the Pac-12 in red zone offense with scores in 14 of 15 possessions (93.3%) inside the 20 yardline with 12 TDs and 2 FGs.

ARIZONA STATE: Sophomore RB **Demario Richard** turned in an impressive performance as he rushed for 104 yards (6.9 avg) and caught four passes for 151 yards, including a 93-yard catch and run for a TD in the 34-10 win over New Mexico. He's the first running back in the FBS with 100 rushing yards and 150 receiving yards in the same game since North Texas' Lance Dunbar in 2011 ... Senior WR **D.J. Foster** extended his streak of at least one reception to 43 games, the longest active streak in FBS. He trails only John Jefferson's school record of 44.

Last Meeting: QB Mike Bercovici threw a 46-yard Hail Mary TD pass to WR Jaalen Strong as time expired to help Arizona State overcome a 9-point deficit in the final three minutes and upset No. 16 USC, 38-34. Bercovici was 27-of-45 for 510 yards and 5 TDs, including three to Strong who finished with 10 receptions for 202 yards.

PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS

The Pac-12 is in the second year of a six-year agreement with seven bowl partners that should provide the Conference with a competitive postseason bowl experience. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl Game presented by Northwestern Mutual, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion. In 2015-16, the Cotton Bowl and Orange Bowl are slotted as the College Football Playoff semifinal games. If the Pac-12 champion is ranked among the top four of the College Football Playoff poll following the 2015 season and play in either the Cotton or Orange Bowl, the Pac-12 would back-fill the Rose Bowl game.

USC TABBED TO WIN PAC-12 TITLE IN PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

USC was chosen as the favorite to win the 2015 Pac-12 Conference football title in a preseason poll vote of 45 media members. The Trojans received 21 of 45 votes to earn the preseason favorite pick. USC collected 254 points for the top spot in the South Division, holding 32 of 45 first-place votes. Defending Pac-12 champion OREGON holds the second-most Championship votes, as they garnered 17 votes for the Pac-12 title. The Ducks also picked up 262 points to lead the Pac-12 North. Additionally, ARIZONA STATE tallied three votes for the Pac-12 crown and amassed 200 points for second in the Pac-12 South.

STANFORD was picked to finish second in the Pac-12 North Division, collecting 231 points with eight first-place votes. The Cardinal garnered one vote as the Pac-12 Champion. In the South Division, UCLA was picked to finish third with 180 points and collected six first-place votes, ahead of reigning South Division winner ARIZONA, which tallied 155 votes for fourth place.

The media poll has correctly selected the Conference Champion in 29 of 54 previous polls, including 12 of the last 15. Following are the results of the preseason media poll (points 6-5-4-3-2-1, first-place votes in parentheses):
