Colorado Interim Head Coach Brian Cabral Postgame Quotes

Opening Statement

"In all reality, the Buffaloes just ran out of emotional gas. It's been a very emotional three weeks, including this week as well. This week, getting ready for this game really has been an emotional deal. They put everything into this game and into this week. I could not be more proud. I'm honored, and I am blessed to have had the opportunity for three weeks to lead these guys. It is so awesome. It's a great group of guys and the staff.

"My hat is off to the Nebraska Cornhuskers. They outplayed us. They made more plays and we didn't. We didn't make the plays we needed to make, so my hat is off. They rebounded from their loss in great fashion. My hat's off to them."

On Nebraska's defensive vulnerability

"We knew they were strong up front. We knew they were No. 1 against the pass. We had to win the game up front and it had to come down to that. We put our best O-line against their pretty darn good defensive front. We had to control the line of scrimmage and block them up to move the ball and throw the ball. They, shoot, my hats off to the Blackshirts.

On NU's touchdown before the end of the first half

"That was big. You don't want to go into the locker room with that much momentum on the other side. So that was big. I still thought if we could come out and take the first drive (of the second half) and take it down there, start us off and get that score down, we'd have a chance. But obviously it went the other way. That's a great defense."

On Colorado's confidence with NU missing quarterback Taylor Martinez and receiver Niles Paul

"I fully expected to see (Taylor) Martinez, their (No.) 17 (Cody Green), he did a great job. He did what they needed him to do, just running the ball as well as throwing the ball. They made plays. It was a power football game, and they obviously overpowered us to their credit, and [Nebraska offensive coordinator] Shawn Watson's credit. "I think our team showed resiliency over and over for a long time. A lot of people tried to tear this team apart, and we weren't going to let it happen. Enough said on that."

On getting takeaways this week

"It was a different type of football game than the one in College Station. They were putting the ball in the air, our guys went and attacked the football. There were some really good plays made out there, a couple tipped balls. (DeJon) Gomes' interception, that was a tremendous football play. The guys played well."

On Joe Broekmeier getting catches today

"He's been practicing with us for a while now. When you have a guy like Niles (Paul) it's kind of hard to crack the lineup and get in there. His name went to the top of the list when Niles had the injury. Nothing that Joe does surprises me, he's a good football player. (He) really stepped up today, I'm happy for him. He's a great kid."

On the chances Pelini thinks the team has next week

"I'm not worried about next week right now. I like our chances. I think we can win any game. I have a lot of confidence in our football team and these kids. Enough said on that."

On if he'll watch tomorrow night's Oklahoma-Oklahoma State game

"I won't watch the Oklahoma-Oklahoma State game. I'll see that on film on Sunday. You guys can watch it. (I'll) see if there is a good basketball game on."

"It doesn't really feel any different. It is just kind of cool to be able to be up there with some of those great guys."

On if he seems himself in the same mold as former Husker kicker Kris Brown

"I always try to picture myself up there with them. It is just a huge acknowledgment. It's really cool."

On his teammates' reaction to tying the record

"They were excited. They all wanted to kick (a field goal) at the end but it wasn't the right thing to do at that point in the game."

On the emotions going through his mind as a senior

"It's good to get a win. It was exciting and fun. I've had a good time here."

On if he would rather break the record on a PAT or a field goal

"I don't know. Either one."

On how much of a factor the wind was today

"It wasn't too bad. The wind died a little bit. My first punt I almost missed because of a big gust. Other than that, it didn't affect me too much."

Redshirt Freshman Offensive Lineman Jeremiah Sirles

On what was working on offense today

"We just knew with the quarterback situation that we just wanted to pound the rock. We didn't want to go back to basics, but use everything in our power. We called the bronco and wildcat (formations) with (I-back) Rex (Burkhead). He had a great day running the ball. We came out there and controlled the tempo."

On the importance of the wildcat formation

"It's huge. Having Rex (Burkhead) back there is a huge threat, and we showed tonight that he can throw the ball. Rex is just a great football player, and you have to respect him in every way. He is a huge, huge, huge asset to our offense."

"Monday. (Receivers) Coach (Ted) Gilmore told me to be ready which he has said the past few weeks. Once Niles (Paul) went down, I knew for sure I'd be in this week."

On what his first catch was like

"I was just glad I didn't drop it. I got hit right away. It happened fast but it was a lot of fun."

On if he was worked up

"I really wasn't ever too rattled. I couldn't be. I had to think of what I was doing assignment wise. That's the big battle. That helped to take the pressure away."

"To send out the seniors with a 'W'. I'm a huge, huge fan of doing things for older guys, so that's something where that really warms me up inside—knowing that I left the seniors with something they'll never forget."

On if it helped knowing all week he would start

"It basically helped out about as much as if they would've just said, 'Hey, you're going in.' Our whole mindset is to basically practice like you're a starter. Doing that, it really molds us into believing that at any point in time, we can start. Thanks to (Offensive Coordinator Shawn) Watson and Coach Bo (Pelini) and the (staff), it really turned us that way. When they do give us the green light to go, we're ready."

On the team's mindset this week after a tough loss

"Really, it was almost scary how focused people were. As a whole unit, we started off on Monday flying around, even though everybody was still banged up. It was kind of like everybody had an inner clock, an inner drive in them that just made them go. That carried on throughout the week. We didn't have a setback, didn't have a bad practice—even a bad period. Things just kept going and kept going, and a good practice week turns into a good game."

On I-back Rex Burkhead's impact on the game

"He ran like a man possessed. For a guy his size, you kind of look at him and say, 'Oh, what can he do?' That little guy has a knack for getting yards, not going down and playing so tenaciously."

On what the key was to his two turnovers

"Probably the preparation this week in practice. Also, I think we were flying around and being more aggressive than we have been for most of the season."

On how the team prepared for this game

"It was just making sure we were focused, especially on a short week like this, you have to make sure you prepare well. You get one less day of preparation, so you have to make the most of every practice and every snap."

On why there were fewer turnovers created in the past few games

"I don't know if you could really pinpoint anything. Maybe this offense was more aggressive than the offenses have been in the past couple weeks. We knew that they threw the ball up, and we'd have our opportunities so we'd just have to make the most of them, and we did tonight."

"It means a lot. It's still kind of in the back of our minds (what happened last year), I'm not gonna lie. Just to get back, it's kind of a hometown as well—Plano's not that far from there. It'll be good, just to be in that state again and probably see some friends and family as well. We've got one thing on our mind, and whoever we play, they're going to be ready to play as well. We're gonna have to have a great week of practice, and (Coach) Bo (Pelini) and the rest of the coaching staff will have us ready to play."

On his sense of satisfaction after winning the North Division

"It feels good, especially to send the seniors out the way we did. We have a tremendous class of seniors, they've been great leaders all year, and it was a big win. Just to see those guys go out the way they did, smiling in the locker room and really enjoying it was huge."

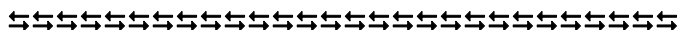

QUICKLY Colorado finishes the 2010 season with a 5-7 record, with an 0-3 mark against ranked opponents; just the fifth season in the last 23 that CU did not beat at least one ranked team ... The Buffaloes are now 6-7 in regular season finales when needing a win to become bowl-eligible (1-4 versus Nebraska) ... Colorado finished 60-60 all-time in Big 12 Conference league games, officially bidding the league goodbye in football today ... CU has now lost a school-record 17 consecutive road games, ending Big 12 play by dropping its last 13 conference games away from home (both school records) ... Colorado's streak of scoring in 12 straight quarters came to an end when CU didn't score in the first stanza today ... Not including center snaps (which four players did), CU only had five players touch the football in the first half: Stewart (14 carries, one lateral), Hawkins (8 passes), Walters (1 reception), Jaffee (1 KOR) and J.Smith (1 PBU) ... CU had one sack this afternoon (Forrest West), giving the Buffs at least one in 30 of the last 31 games, and 34 for the year (including four for zero, NFL style, which CU has always counted), the most since the 1995 team racked up 37 sacks ... The Buffs allowed 40 or more points in a game this year four times, the most since five in 2003 (all those were in a row).


CAREER FROSH TACKLE HIGHS—CB Terrel Smith (11 UT, 6 AT—17) and ILB Liloa Nobriga (7 UT, 7 AT—14) recorded career highs—Smith's 17, if it holds up under coaches' video review, will set a CU true freshman as it would top the 15 J.J. Billingsley had against San Diego State in 2002; it would tie the overall frosh mark of 17 by Matt Russell at Oklahoma State in 1993.


THE O-LINE—Colorado's offensive line allowed no sacks today (second time this year), but dating back to last year's NU game, allowed Nebraska's renowned defense just one sack (and that was on an intentional grounding call where the ball was tipped).

 **TB RODNEY STEWART (20-88, 0 TD)** He finished the season with 1,318 yards on the year, the fifth highest single-season total in CU history and he most since **Chris Brown** had 1,744 in 2002. His 88 yards enabled him to pass **Hugh Charles** (2,659) and Brown (2,690) into fifth place on CU's all-time rushing yards list, as he will enter his senior year with 2,744 (the third most yards by a CU junior, behind **Rashaan Salaam** and **Chris Brown**, who both left early for the NFL).

—Stewart finished the year with 290 carries, second only to Salaam's 298 in 1994.

 **QB CODY HAWKINS (26-10-2, 163, 2 TD)** He earned the last two major records within his grasp, moving into first all-time in passing yards (7,409) and completes (667), overtaking **Joel Klatt** in both (7,375, 666). *(Some have asked about including bowl stats, which CU does not; if we were to do, Hawkins had 7,731 yards, while Klatt had 7,708).* He also finished first in attempts (1,214), touchdowns (60) and interceptions (41) and finished second in total offense (7,250; he passed Klatt, 7,245, into second but was well behind **Kordell Stewart's** 7,770).

 **WR SCOTTY MCKNIGHT (3-10, 0 TD)** He fell short in his bid to take over CU's all-time lead in receiving yards, finishing his career in third place with 2,521, in the shadow of the top two (Michael Westbrook 2,548 and Rae Carruth 2,540). He did finish as CU's all-time leader in receptions (215) and receiving touchdowns (22). He extended his NCAA-active best regular season streak to 48 games with at least one reception (every game of his career, 49 including postseason); he became just the 10th player in NCAA history to catch at least one pass in every game he played in his career (and the sixth to do so without missing any games due to injury). His fourth quarter fumble technically was the second of his career; his other was against CSU last year on a play the Big 12 Conference later informed the school was ruled incorrectly and should have been an incomplete pass.

 **WR PAUL RICHARDSON (2-62, 1 TD)** He set the record for the most receiving yards in a season by a freshman (true or redshirt) when he caught a 50-yard pass for a TD in the third quarter, and then added 12 more to give him 514 for the year; that broke McKnight's record of 488 in 2007. It was his fourth play for over 50 yards, the first Buff to have four over 40 yards since **WR Derek McCoy** had four in 2003. Nebraska Post-Game Notes

Nebraska vs. Colorado—Nov. 26, 2010

- ▶ Nebraska clinched its second straight trip to the Big 12 Championship Game with today's victory. This year will mark Nebraska's sixth appearance in the conference championship game, and marks the first time Nebraska has made back-to-back Big 12 title game appearances since the first two games in 1996 and 1997.
- ▶ Nebraska improved to 10-2 on the season, its first 10-win regular season since 2001. It is the 25th 10-win season in school history, including the second straight under Head Coach Bo Pelini. The two 10-win seasons in three years makes Pelini just the second coach in NU history to have two 10-win seasons in his first three years, joining Frank Solich. Pelini improved to 30-10 as Nebraska's head coach.
- ▶ Nebraska finished Big 12 play with a 6-2 record, the same mark it recorded last season. This is the first time NU has had back-to-back six-win conference seasons since 2000 and 2001.
- ▶ Today's game marked Nebraska's 120th and final Big 12 Conference regular season game. Nebraska finished with a 15-year regular season Big 12 record of 81-39, including 46-14 at home (with a win).
- ▶ Nebraska posted its third consecutive win over Colorado and its fifth in the past six games in the series.
- ▶ Nebraska finished with a 6-1 home record, its best single-season record at Memorial Stadium since also posting a 6-1 record in 2006.
- ▶ Sophomore I-back **Rex Burkhead** rushed 19 times for 101 yards in today's game, including numerous direct snaps in the Wildcat formation. Burkhead rushed seven times for 54 yards in the first quarter and had 98 yards before half, including a three-yard TD run early in the second quarter.
- ▶ Burkhead topped 100 yards for the third time this season (104 at Washington, 129 at ISU) and for the fourth time in his career, including 100 yards last season at Colorado. Burkhead pushed his season rushing total to 822, giving Nebraska three rushers with more than 800 rushing yards, including Roy Helu Jr. at 1,120 yards and Taylor Martinez at 974 yards. Nebraska has never had three 1,000-yard rushers in a season, and has had a pair of 1,000-yard rushers three times previously.
- ▶ Burkhead also threw a pair of touchdown passes on his first two career pass attempts. He threw a 26-yard touchdown pass to **Brandon Kinnie** on his first career pass attempt late in the second quarter on a halfback pass to give Nebraska a 17-3 halftime edge. Burkhead later threw a four-yard TD pass to **Kyler Reed** out of the wildcat formation in the third period to give NU a 31-3 lead. Burkhead is believed to be the first non-quarterback in the modern era to throw for more than one touchdown pass in a game.
- ▶ Nebraska senior I-back **Roy Helu Jr.** rushed 15 times for 77 yards in today's game. Helu Jr. moved his season total to 1,120 yards. Helu Jr. also pushed his career rushing total to 3,289, moving him within 145 yards of Eric Crouch who sits in third place at 3,434 career yards.
- ▶ Nebraska rushed for 265 yards in today's game, marking its 10th 200-yard rushing effort in 12 games. Nebraska is 10-0 when rushing for 200+ yards this season.
- ▶ Junior receiver **Brandon Kinnie** caught two touchdown passes in today's game a 26-yarder from Burkhead in the second quarter and a 16-yarder from Cody Green in the third quarter. Kinnie has five touchdown receptions this season, including three at Oklahoma State and two in today's game. Kinnie finished the game with four receptions for 48 yards. Kinnie pushed his season receptions total to 40, just two shy of the single-season top 10.
- ▶ Sophomore tight end **Kyler Reed** caught his sixth touchdown pass of the season on a 1-yard reception from Cody Green in the third quarter, after hauling in a four-yard flip from Rex Burkhead earlier in the quarter. Each of Reed's first four touchdown receptions of the year covered at least 33 yards. He has scored a touchdown on six of his 17 receptions this season and his six TD catches are one shy of the top 10 on the NU single-season list.
- ▶ Senior receiver **Joe Broekemeier** made his first three career receptions today, covering a total of 34 yards.
- ▶ Nebraska did not commit a turnover in today's game, while gaining three Colorado turnovers which the Huskers turned into 21 points. It is the fourth time this season Nebraska did not commit a turnover and the +3 turnover margin is the best this season (previously +2 vs. Idaho).
- ▶ Senior place-kicker **Alex Henery** connected on a 42-yard field goal in the first quarter, and added six extra points in today's game to push his career scoring total to 388 points. He tied former NU place-kicker Kris Brown for first on the NU career list at 388 career points.
- ▶ Henery improved to a perfect 51-of-51 on PATs this season and to 16-of-17 on field goals. Henery is 8-of-9 this season from beyond 40 yards. Henery improved to 66-of-74 in his career on field goals.
- ▶ Junior linebacker **Lavonte David** finished with eight tackles, pushing his season tackle total to 128, moving him up to a tie for sixth with Demorrio Williams on the NU single-season chart. David is 21 tackles from the Nebraska single-season record of 149 tackles by Barrett Ruud in 2003. David added two pass breakups to push his season total to nine.
- ▶ Senior defensive back **Eric Hagg** intercepted his team-leading fifth pass of the season in the third quarter of today's game, and returned it 26 yards to the CU 4 to set up a touchdown. Hagg's five interceptions ranks in a tie for eighth on the NU single-season list.
- ▶ Senior defensive back **DeJon Gomes** intercepted a third-quarter pass for his third interception of the season and the seventh of his career.
- ▶ Gomes also returned a fumble 19 yards to the Colorado 3 in the fourth quarter to set up a Nebraska touchdown for a 45-17 lead.
- ▶ **Prince Amukamara** contributed two pass breakups to move into a tie for seventh on the NU season chart with 13. He ranks seventh on the NU career list with 27.
- ▶ Nebraska pushed its season interception total to 18, and the two picks today marked the fifth time this season Nebraska has had at least two interceptions in a game.
- ▶ Nebraska extended its streak of not allowing a touchdown to 10 quarters before the Buffs scored a touchdown in the third quarter. The touchdown also ended a streak of 14 consecutive quarters at home without allowing a touchdown in a November home game (3 points each by OU and KSU last year and 3 by KU this season).
- ▶ Former Nebraska defensive tackle Ndamukong Suh became the 17th Husker to have his jersey retired at halftime of today's game.
- ▶ Today's game captains were Nebraska's entire senior class. **Prince Amukamara, Pierre Allen, Alex Henery** and **Keith Williams** were present for the coin flip.
