Junior, QB, 6-3, 205
Limon, Colo./Limon
Brown led the Orediggers to a school-record 749 yards of total offense en route to an RMAC-opening 62-22 victory at Black Hills State. The junior finished 31-of-40 for 380 yards and six touchdowns in 2-1/2 quarters, while also adding 85 rushing yards on six carries (14.2 YPC). The national leader in total offense entering the game (469.0), Brown recorded his second-straight game with 465 yards of total offense. Brown's six TD passes sit tied for the second-most in program history. Through three games, Brown has already amassed 1,403 yards of total offense and 15 total touchdowns (4 rush, 11 pass).

ADAMS STATE UNIVERSITY (3-0, 1-0 RMAC)

Team Notes: Adams State notched their third straight win last week, defeating Western State 16-14. ASU will play at CSU-Pueblo this Saturday.

COLORADO MESA UNIVERSITY (1-2, 0-1 RMAC)

Team Notes: Colorado Mesa dropped a 30-24 decision at Chadron State last Saturday. CMU will play at home against Black Hills State this week.

COLORADO SCHOOL OF MINES (2-1, 1-0 RMAC)

National Football Foundation - Colorado Chapter Player of the Week

Team Notes: Colorado Mines improved to 2-1 overall and 1-0 in the RMAC with a 62-22 win over Black Hills State on Saturday in Spearfish, S.D., to improve to 3-0 all time against the YellowJackets. Mines posted a school-record 749 yards of total offense to break the program mark of 727 set in the squad's season-opening 72-6 win over South Dakota Mines. The Orediggers carried 40 times for 228 yards (5.7 YPC) while also finishing 45-of-61 for 521 yards and eight touchdowns through the air.

COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY (1-3, 0-0 MWC)

Team Notes: Colorado State played at Alabama last week and lost 31-6. The Rams will play host to UTEP this week.

COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY - PUEBLO (3-0, 1-0 RMAC)

Paul Browning (Junior, Wide Receiver, 6-3, 222, Colorado Springs, Colo./Widefield HS)

Browning became the first ThunderWolf in school history to record 100-plus receiving yards in three consecutive games. He caught three passes for 121 yards and a score Saturday afternoon against Western New Mexico.

Team Notes: CSU-Pueblo claimed its 29th straight regular season win, the longest such streak in Division II. CSU-Pueblo claimed its 23rd straight RMAC win, all dating back to 2010. CSU-Pueblo set a first in scoring 40-plus points in three consecutive games.

FORT LEWIS COLLEGE (1-2, 0-1 RMAC)

Dewaun Wesley (Junior, Running Back, 5-8, 183, Los Angeles, Calif./Centennial/Los Angeles Harbor College)

For the second straight game, Wesley rushed for more than 100 yards in a game. In a 31-20 set back at New Mexico Highlands, Wesley carried the ball 21 times for 112 yards. His touchdown in the first quarter knotted the game at 7-7. His longest rush of the game was for 16 yards. Wesley also caught two passes for 23 yards. He totaled 135 all-purpose yards against the Cowboys.

UNITED STATES AIR FORCE ACADEMY (1-3, 0-3 MWC)

Team Notes: Air Force lost 56-23 to Wyoming last week. They will play at Nevada on Saturday.

UNIVERSITY OF COLORADO (2-0, 0-0 PAC-12)

Team Notes: Colorado had a bye week this past week. They will travel Oregon State on Sept. 28.
