### OFFENSE

**Vernon Adams, Sr., QB**  
Oregon

Completed 23-of-40 passes for 315 yards and 4 TDs in 61-55 triple-overtime win at Arizona State. Connect on 8-yard TD pass with only 12 seconds remaining in regulation to send game into overtime, and a 20-yard TD pass in the third overtime for the game winner.

### DEFENSE

**Travis Feeney Sr., LB**  
Washington

Led a Husky defense that held Arizona to just 3 points (38.8 points below its season average) and 330 yards of total offense (205 yards below season average). Notched 11 tackles (9 solo), including 4.5 tackles for loss and two sacks. Forced two fumbles.

### SPECIAL TEAMS

**Charles Nelson, So., DB/KR,**  
Oregon

Four kick returns for 185 yards (46.3 avg), including a 100-yard return to cut ASU's leads to 31-27. A game-high 15 tackles and played a role in Oregon allowing only 66 yards on five returns.

## PAC-12 QUICK HITS

**ROAD WARRIORS:** In 31 Conference games played to date, the visiting team is 17-14.

**CAMPBELL FINALIST:** UCLA C **Jake Brendel** has been named one of 12 finalists for the William V. Campbell Trophy recognizing the top football scholar-athlete in the nation.

**PAC-12 SCORING RECORD:** The career scoring record is within reach for UCLA PK Ka'imi Fairbairn. With 378 points, he's closing in on former Bruin John Lee's 390 points (1982-85).

The Pac-12 posted has posted a winning record outside league for 30 consecutive seasons . . . The Pac-12 recorded a 37-9 record in non-conference action last season, posting the most wins ever outside of conference play. Since 1934, only one other season witnessed the Conference capture more than 29 wins in non-league play - 2002 (32-15) when the league played an eight game conference schedule, allowing an additional 10 non-conference games to be played.

## AROUND THE PAC-12

**POLL WATCHING:** STANFORD remains in the Top 10 of this week's polls. The Cardinal are the fifth different Pac-12 team this season to be ranked in the AP Top 10 ... UTAH remains at No. 13 in this week's AP poll ... UCLA jumped two spots in the AP Top 25, coming in at No. 22 ... Over the last two seasons, nine different Pac-12 teams have been ranked among the AP Top 25, while six different Conference teams have been ranked among the Top 10.

**DIVISION TIE-BREAKERS:** While the South Division continues to battle, the North Division race is starting to clear up. Basically, STANFORD controls its own destiny and can lock up the North Division with a win and an OREGON loss.

**O-LINE DURABILITY:** Tackle-to-tackle, two teams have started the same five offensive linemen in each game this season - STANFORD and WASHINGTON STATE.

**ALL-PURPOSE:** STANFORD sophomore RB **Christian McCaffrey** continues to lead the FBS with 244.25 all-purpose yards per game, nearly 25 yards over the next player (Tyler Ervin, San Jose State, 219.50 ypg) ... McCaffrey has rushed for 100 or more yards in six straight games. His 1,954 all-purpose yardage breakdown is as follows: 1,060 rushing, 310 receiving, 559 kick return, 9 punt return ... Since 1978, only four other Conference players have averaged 200 or more all-purpose yards per game for an entire season - USC's Marcus Allen in 1981 (232.6 avg), Stanford's Glyn Milburn in 1990 (202.0 avg), USC's Reggie Bush in 2005 (222.3 avg) and USC's Marqise Lee in 2012 (206.4 avg). Coincidentally, Milburn's teammate in 1990 was Ed McCaffrey (father of Christian), who had 61 receptions for 917 yards and a Conference-leading 91.7 receiving yards per game that season ... In addition to McCaffrey (10th, 132.5 ypg), the Pac-12 boasts OREGON's **Royce Freeman** (8th, 138.6 ypg) and UTAH's **Devontae Booker** (14th, 120.8 ypg) among the FBS all-purpose yardage leaders.

**PAC-12 NETWORK TO TAB ALL-CENTURY TEAM:** The Pac-12 Network will honor the Conference's 100-year anniversary with the selection of an All-Century team. Each Tuesday on the Network's Inside Pac-12 Football show, the finalists/top 10 vote getters for each position as selected by a panel comprised of media, former players, coaches and administrators will be unveiled. ## PAC-12 CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION

**#100Pac12:** The Pac-12 Conference is set to celebrate 100 years of excellence. The yearlong celebration of the Conference centennial, including marking the date of the official formation 100 years ago on December 2, will kick off with the start of the football season and continue throughout the 2015-16 academic year.

The Conference's storied history dates back 100 years to Dec. 2, 1915 when four schools - the University of California, Oregon Agricultural College (now Oregon State University), the University of Oregon and the University of Washington - gathered at the historic Imperial Hotel in Portland, Ore., to form the Pacific Coast Conference.

Since that day, the Conference has been known for its widespread excellence - on the field, in the classroom, and with the contributions its graduates make in the world. No other Conference can match the collective achievements and distinctions accomplished over the last century.

## THIS WEEK'S GAMES

### STANFORD at COLORADO

Sat., Nov. 7 • 11 a.m. MT • PAC12

**STANFORD:** Senior QB **Kevin Hogan** rushed for 112 yards and 2 TDs to help the Cardinal outlast Washington State, 31-28 ... Hogan is now tied with Michigan State's Connor Cook for the most active career wins by a starting quarterback with 31 ... The Cardinal opened Pac-12 play 6-0 for the first time in four years ... Hogan became the first Stanford quarterback to rush for over 1,000 career yards ... With 1,062 rushing yards, sophomore RB **Christian McCaffrey** became the fastest Stanford running back ever to reach 1,000 yards rushing ... Senior ILB **Blake Martinez** collected 11 tackles. He is tied for second nationally and averages 11.4 per game. The Cardinal heads to its last regular-season road game, taking on the Buffs in Boulder.

**COLORADO:** In its 35-31 loss at UCLA, the Buffs set a Pac-12 record with 114 plays ... Senior WR **Nelson Spruce** had 11 receptions for 90 yards. He became the Pac-12's all-time leader in the receptions with his fourth catch of the game; he finished the game with 267. He also continued to add to his school mark in career yards (2,947) ... Junior QB **Sefo Liufau** became CU's all-time career leader in completions with 672, moving from third to first in passing Cody Hawkins (667) and Joel Klatt (666). With 357 yards of total offense, he moved from fourth into second at Colorado (7,576), trailing only Kordell Stewart (7,770; 1991-94).

**Last Meeting (11/3/12):** Redshirt freshman Kevin Hogan replaced quarterback Josh Nunes and ignited the 15th-ranked Cardinal to a 48-0 rout of Colorado, the Buffaloes' first shutout at home in 26 years. Hogan completed 18 of 23 passes for 184 with 2 TDs and ran for 48 yards in two quarters of work. Stanford put up 436 yards of total offense, while the its defense held Colorado to 76 yards total offense.

### ARIZONA STATE at WASHINGTON STATE

Sat., Nov. 7 • 12:30 PT • FS1 and FOX Deportes

**ARIZONA STATE:** The Sun Devils finished with 742 yards of total offense in the 61-55 loss to Oregon, the highest total since ASU recorded 773 total yards against Northwestern on Sept. 17, 2005. It is the third-highest total in school history ... ASU held the Ducks to 186 yards on the ground. Oregon came into the game averaging 297.4 rushing ypg, the sixth-highest mark in the country ... Prior to Thursday, the highest combined scoring game in ASU history was 111 points (a 56-55 double-overtime loss to Oregon in 2000 ... With six receptions on Thursday, **D.J. Foster** tied Kareem Kelly's Pac-12 record of 48 consecutive games with a reception.

**WASHINGTON STATE:** The Cougars had their three-game win streak snapped, falling 30-28 to then-No. 8 Stanford. Sophomore QB **Luke Falk** was 35-of-61 through the air for 354 yards and 2 TDs ... Junior WR **Gabe Marks** caught his 11th TD of the season, tied for fifth-most in single-season school history. His 20 career TD receptions are fifth most on the school career list ... In Falk's last four games, he's 171-of-247 (.731) for 1,780 yards and 18 TDs ... Sophomore K **Erik Powell** tied a school record with 5 field goals in the 30-28 loss to Stanford ... WSU held Stanford to 312 yards in total offense, the second-lowest total allowed by the WSU defense this season and the second-lowest total produced by Stanford this season.

**Last Meeting (11/22/14):** Taylor Kelly completed 15-of-25 for 232 yards and 4 TDs as No. 13 Arizona State dominated the second half for a 52-31 victory over Washington State. D.J. Foster rushed for 95 yards and 3 TDs, while Cameron Smith caught six passes for 131 yards and 2 TDs. WSU's Luke Falk, in his second start, completed 45-of-74 for 601 yards but was intercepted four times and fumbled the ball away once. Arizona State converted all five Cougars' turnovers into touchdowns.

### UCLA at OREGON STATE

Sat., Nov. 7 • 1:30 p.m. PT • PAC12

**UCLA:** UCLA is 30-0 under coach Jim Mora when ahead at the half ... Junior RB **Paul Perkins** posted the 10th 100-yard rushing game of his career, running for 118 yards. He also had four receptions to give him 67 for his career, tying Chris Markey (2004-2007) for the school mark for most receptions by a running back ... Senior C **Jake Brendel** started his 47th game, placing him solo second on UCLA's all-time list. With his next start, Brendel will equal Spencer Havner's 48 from 2002 to 2005 ... Over the last five games, senior WR **Jordan Payton** and junior WR **Thomas Duarte** have combined for 61 receptions for 939 yards and 7 TDs.

**OREGON STATE:** Sophomore QB **Nick Mitchell** went 19-of-35 for 204 yards and his first career TD in the 27-12 loss to Utah ... Junior WR **Victor Bolden** hauled 7 receptions for 34 yards and a TD and rushed for 45 yards as well ... Freshman LB **Jonathan Willis** had a career high 11 tackles in his first career start ... The Beavers have allowed only 51 points in the last 10 quarters of play, dating back to halftime of the Washington State contest on Oct. 17.

**Last Meeting (9/22/12):** Sean Mannion completed 24 of 35 passes for a then-career-high 379 yards and two TDs as Oregon State put the clamps on No. 19 UCLA's offense by topping the Bruins 27-20. Redshirt freshman Brett Hundley completed 27 of 42 passes for 372 yards and a touchdown for UCLA,

### UTAH at WASHINGTON

Sat., Nov. 7 • 4:30 p.m. PT • FOX

**UTAH:** Senior RB **Devontae Booker** rushed for 121 yards on 25 carries and added a 1-yard TD run. It was his fifth 100-yard rushing game of the season and the 12th of his career, which is tied for second in school history. Booker also added 25 receiving yards (three catches) and ended with a team-high 146 all-purpose yards ... Senior QB **Travis Wilson** made his seventh start of the season and broke the school record with his 34th career start. Wilson was 14-of-17 passing for 198 yards and one TD. His .824 completion percentage was the sixth-highest for a single game in school history ... Junior PK **Andy Phillips** went 2-for-2 in field goals with makes from 49 and 45 yards. He is now 13-for-16 this season, including 6-of-9 from 40+ yards.

**WASHINGTON:** Freshman QB **Jake Browning** completed 16-of-24 for 263 yards and 4 TDs in Washington's 49-3 win over Arizona. His four TD passes went to four different receivers. He added another score on the ground with a 12-yard rush ... Senior LB **Travis Feeney** totaled 11 tackles (nine solo), including 4.5 tackles for loss ... The Husky defense picked up three interceptions against Arizona, which had tossed only one pick in 278 attempts coming into the game ... The Huskies have outscored their opponents in every quarter this season, including a 104-28 third-quarter advantage over their opponents.

**Last Meeting (11/10/12):** Keith Price completed 24 of 33 passes for 277 yards and 2 TDs, and ran for one score as Washington defeated Utah in Seattle, 34-15. Bishop Sankey rushed for 162 yards on 36 carries and became just the 10th 1,000-yard rusher in Washington history. Utah's John White rushed for 145 yards and scored both touchdowns for the Utes.

### ARIZONA at USC

Sat., Nov. 7 • 7:30 p.m. PT • ESPN

**ARIZONA:** Senior RB **Jared Baker** ran for 67 yards on 19 carries on Saturday night, giving him 559 rushing yards for the season. He's the third UA rusher to accumulate 500-plus yards this season (**Nick Wilson**-691, **Jerrard Randall**-685). It's the first time the Wildcats have boasted three or more 500-plus yard rushers in a season since 1991 ... Before **Anu Solomon**'s first quarter interception he had thrown 232 straight passes without an interception. That's now a new school record. The previous record was held by Nick Foles (2010-11), as he threw 208 straight passes without an interception.

**USC:** In the 27-21 win at California, junior QB **Cody Kessler**'s 195 total yards of offense (186 passing, 9 rushing) puts him in fourth on USC's all-time career total offense list with 8,742 total yards. He passed Rodney Peete who had 8,640 career yards. ... Sophomore CB/WR/RET **Adoree' Jackson** collected his first career interception, a pick six for 46 yards. Jackson is the only player in the country with 300 yards receiving, 300 yards in kick runbacks, 100 punt return yards and 10 tackles ... USC has scored 65 points off 15 turnovers in 2015, while opponents have scored just 10 points off their seven gained turnovers ... TB **Ronald Jones II**, among 15 Trojan true freshmen who have played in 2015, continues to lead USC in rushing (533 yards, 66.6 ypg).

**Last Meeting (10/11/14):** Javorius Allen ran for 205 yards on 26 carries (7.6 avg) and 3 TDs, and USC escaped with a 28-26 victory over No. 10 Arizona when Casey Skowron pushed a last-second 36-yard field goal wide right. USC's Cody Kessler was 20-of-30 for 185 yards and 1 TD, while Arizona's Anu Solomon was 43-of-72 for 395 yards and 1 TD.

### CALIFORNIA at OREGON

Sat., Nov. 7 • 7:30 p.m. PT • ESPN2

**CALIFORNIA:** In the loss to USC, junior QB **Jared Goff** went 23-of-31 for 272 yards and 2 TDs, en route to becoming the 92nd player in FBS history to throw for over 10,000 career yards now at 10,018. Goff's Cal record 75 career TD passes ties him for 14th on the Pac-12 career list ... Junior LB **Hardy Nickerson** led all players with a career-high 13 tackles, five coming solo. The Golden Bears heads to the Conference's No. 1 scoring offense as they take on the Ducks.

**OREGON:** In Oregon's 61-55 3OT win over ASU, sophomore RB **Royce Freeman** rushed for 112 yards on 15 carries (7.5 avg) to become the fourth player in school history to rush for 1,000 yards in back-to-back seasons ... Sophomore WR **Darren Carrington** has at least 100 receiving yards and a touchdown in four-straight games, going back to the 2014 season. Since his return to action this season, Carrington has caught 10 passes for 232 yards (23.2 avg) in just two games ... The Ducks look for their first home Conference win this season.

**Last Meeting (10/24/14):** Marcus Mariota became Oregon's all-time leading passer in the course of a night on which he completed 18-of-30 passes for 326 yards with 5 TDs as the Ducks used 24 points in the second quarter to break out to a 38-28 halftime lead. Oregon went on to a 59-41 victory at Levi's Stadium in Santa Clara, Calif. California's Jared Goff completed 32 of 52 passes for 360 yards and 2 TDs.
