BIG 12 FOOTBALL QUICK HITS

- Ten Big 12 teams are in action this week with Colorado traveling to Toledo on Friday night while the remaining nine play on Saturday. Baylor and Texas A&M have an open date. Kansas, Kansas State and Texas join CU in road contests.
- Nine of Week 2 games will have television coverage, including three pay-per-view options and an online broadcast.
- The Big 12 went 10-2 in opening week games, with a 1-1 mark vs. Top 25 opponents. The 10 winning squads averaged 47.7 points while holding opponents to an average of 11.9. The two losses were by a combined seven points.
- Kansas, Kansas State, Nebraska, Oklahoma and Texas played in sold-out stadiums in Week 1. KU, OSU and UT enjoyed record home crowds.
- In Week 1 the Big 12 had four quarterbacks throw for 300-plus yards, five receivers and three rushers over the century mark and six double-digit tacklers. Top performances included:
Passing: 405 yards (34-48-3), Taylor Potts, TTU
Rushing: 16-152 yards, Roy Helu, Jr., NU
Receiving: 8-180 yards, Jordan Shipley, UT
Tackles: 15, Jesse Smith, ISU
- Four quarterbacks in Big 12 history have surpassed the 10,000-career passing yards mark. Texas' Colt McCoy became the latest (10,049) joining Texas Tech's Graham Harrell (15,793), Missouri's Chase Daniel (12,515) and TTU's Kliff Kingsbury (12,429).
- Eight Big 12 squads compiled over 400 yards of total offense in Week 1 -- Texas A&M (606), Texas (562), Kansas (547), Nebraska (490), Texas Tech (445), Iowa State (442), Missouri (442) and Kansas State (407).
- Eight Conference squads are ranked or receiving votes in Sept. 8 polls. UT remains second in both while OSU moved into the top 10 at fifth in the AP and sixth in the coaches' edition. Other rankings are 13/14. OU, 22/18. NU, 24/25. KU and 25/RV. MU. BU and TTU received votes in each.
- Big 12 Players of the Week were awarded to - Offense: Blaine Gabbert (Missouri), Defense - Joe Pawelek (Baylor) and Special Teams - Perrish Cox (Oklahoma State).

14th Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

The Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship makes its debut in the newly-opened Cowboys Stadium in Arlington, Texas. The 2009 game takes place on Saturday, December 5, at 7:00 p.m. CT and will be nationally televised by ABC.

In 2009, the North representative will be the home team and utilize the home bench which is opposite the press box. Ticket information will be available at a later date.

Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship Winners

In the 13-year history of the event, there have been six different winners. All-time titlists include Texas (1996, 2005), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), Oklahoma (2000, 2002, 2004, 2006, 2007, 2008), Colorado (2001) and Kansas State (2003).

BCS Sightings

The 2008 season marked the fifth time the Big 12 has advanced two teams to BCS games in the same season (2001, '03, '04, '07, '08). Conference teams have played in 16 BCS games in the 11-year history of the structure, posting a 7-9 mark.

Big 12 Bowl Partners

Again in 2009, the Big 12 will have eight bowl slots guaranteed. With its selection of a Big 12 team in 2008, the Gator Bowl has fulfilled the agreement the Conference has with it and the Sun Bowl of selecting a Big 12 team twice in a four-year period. The Sun Bowl will select a Big 12 team in 2009 - the fourth and final year of the agreement. Following is the 2009 selection order:

Home Win Streaks

Oklahoma owns the nation's longest home win streak at 23. Texas is tied for fifth with 10 while Texas Tech is tied for eighth with nine straight victories at home.

Big 12 Heisman Winners

The Big 12 has four Heisman winners in the league's 13-year history, the most of any conference during this time span. A Big 12 player has captured the trophy four of the last 11 seasons: 2008-Sam Bradford (OU); 2003-Jason White (OU); 2001-Eric Crouch (NU); 1998-Ricky Williams (UT).

In 2008, Texas QB Colt McCoy finished second, 122 points behind Bradford, while Texas Tech QB Graham Harrell and WR Michael Crabtree finished fourth and fifth, respectively. This marked the first time in the award's 74-year history four of the top five finishers hailed from the same conference.

Television Partners

ABC begins its 14th season as the conference's national network television partner. The Big 12 also continues its long-standing relationship with FSN for its cable rights. FSN has sublicensed select television games in 2009 to ESPN and Versus.

Record Ratings

The Big 12 played in six of the top 10, including five of the top seven rated games on ABC in 2008. The top six game telecasts combined for over 38.5 million viewers. The Texas at Texas Tech game was the highest-rated college football game on ABC in 2008. With over 8.5 million viewers, the game ranks fifth all-time for ABC regular season telecasts.

The seven 2008 bowl games involving Big 12 teams drew approximately 49.1 million television viewers. Each game increased its ratings from the previous year. The Fiesta Bowl and National Championship Game registered 29.9 million viewers, while the Rose, Orange and Sugar bowls combined for 28.6 million.

Big 12 Weekly Television Shows

FSN's "Big 12 Showcase" and ESPNU's "Big 12 This Week" are telecast weekly with features on student-athletes, coaches and teams as well as highlights of Conference championships and other events in the league. Check local listings for dates and times.

Big 12 Media Preseason Poll

Media covering the conference have correctly predicted the division champions in four of the last six seasons (OU/NU-06, UT/CU-05; OU/KSU-03, CU/OU-02). Overall, the top spot in each division has been accurately picked by the league's media corps 19-of-26 times.

BAYLOR (1-0, 0-0)

This Week: Open

Next Week: Connecticut

Baylor quarterback Robert Griffin punted on a quick kick play. It went 59 yards and forced Wake Forest to start from its 5-yard line. It was the first collegiate punt for Griffin, who punted for his high school team.

Baylor won its 14th season opener on the road and its first since winning at SMU in 2005. It was also the program's first road non-conference victory against a BCS opponent since 1995 at North Carolina State.

Senior Joe Pawelek was named Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week after he made seven tackles, including five solo stops, in Baylor's 24-21 victory over Wake Forest last weekend.

Baylor received votes in both the Associated Press and the USA Today Coaches' Poll this week following its win at Wake Forest.



COLORADO (0-1, 0-0)

This Week: at Toledo (Friday)

Next Week: Wyoming

Wide receiver Scotty McKnight extended his streak to 25 games with at least one reception - the school record is 27 games.

Will Pericak became the first freshman, true or redshirt, to start the season opener at defensive tackle in Colorado history.

Darrell Scott returned five kickoffs for 138 yards against Colorado State, giving him a 27.6 return average.

Inside linebacker Jeff Smart made his team-best 23rd consecutive start against Colorado State. The CU career record for consecutive starts by a defensive player is 35.



IOWA STATE (1-0, 0-0)

This Week: Iowa

Next Week: at Kent State

Paul Rhoads will look to become the third coach in Iowa State history to beat Iowa in his first attempt. The Cyclones have won four of their last five meetings with Iowa at Jack Trice Stadium.

Junior quarterback Austen Arnaud's 227 yards in the Cyclone season opener moved him to No. 9 in career passing yards (3,286) at ISU. Arnaud also rushed for a career-best 78 yards.

Kicker Grant Mahoney, who made two field goals from 48 yards last season as a freshman, made a career-best 50-yarder vs. NDSU.

The Cyclones' season-opener attendance of 48,831 was the most for a home opener since a crowd of 54,101 attended the Iowa game in 1987.



KANSAS (1-0, 0-0)

This Week: at UTEP

Next Week: Duke

KU has won 17 of its last 19 games against non-Big 12 Conference foes, including three bowl victories.

Kansas gained 328 yards on 47 carries (7 yards/carry) against Northern Colorado. In four non-conference games last season, the Jayhawks gained 476 yards on 138 attempts (3.4 yards/carry).

Senior Kerry Meier has at least two receptions in 22 consecutive games. Meier had five receptions for 115 yards against Northern Colorado last week.

Mark Mangino looks to tie Glen Mason for second on the KU coaches victories list. Mangino enters the UTEP game with 46 wins (Mason notched 47 wins). If Mangino reaches the mark this week it will come in his 88th game, while Mason's victory came in his 99th game at KU.



KANSAS STATE (1-0, 0-0)

This Week: at UL-Lafayette

Next Week: at UCLA

In non-conference regular season road games under Bill Snyder, the Cats have won seven straight, dating back to a 28-16 loss at Utah State in 1992 (7-4 under Snyder all-time in non-conference road games).

Since 2002, Kansas State has blocked 35 kicks, the fifth-highest total in the nation. Last week the Cats blocked a punt and a field goal.

Senior tight end Jeron Mastrud went over the 1,000-yard mark in career reception yards against Massachusetts, the fourth Kansas State player to pass that plateau.

Heading into their fourth meeting (3-0) against the Ragin' Cajuns, the Wildcats are 14-1 all time against current members of the Sun Belt Conference, including an 11-game win streak.



MISSOURI (1-0, 0-0)

This Week: Bowling Green

Next Week: Furman

Senior linebacker Sean Weatherspoon has 311 career stops entering the Bowling Green game, which puts him 15th on the MU charts. He is 123 shy of record-holder James Kinney, who had 434 tackles at the LB position from 2001-04.

Sophomore Blaine Gabbert boasted a quarterback rating of 186.96 in his first career start - the best of the opening weekend for Big 12 signal callers. He was named Big 12 Offensive Player of the Week.

Missouri has won a school record 11 consecutive non-conference games. The last loss in a non-conference game came to Oregon State (39-38) in the Sun Bowl in El Paso, Texas to cap the 2006 season.

Gary Pinkel served a stint at Bowling Green as wide receivers coach under Denny Stoltz for the 1977-78 seasons before moving on to Washington.



NEBRASKA (1-0, 0-0)

This Week: Arkansas State

Next Week: at Virginia Tech

Nebraska claimed its 24th consecutive season-opening victory, the longest streak in the nation.

Junior IB Roy Helu Jr. carried the ball 16 times for 152 yards and a career-high three touchdowns vs. FAU, which leads the Big 12 in rushing and is ranked No. 7 in the nation.

NU ranks nationally at No. 19 in rushing offense (259), tied for No. 14 in scoring offense (49) and No. 27 in total offense (490).

The Huskers will meet Arkansas State for the first time. The Red Wolves will be NU's first opponent from the state of Arkansas since 1965. Nebraska is 7-0 overall against the Sun Belt Conference.



OKLAHOMA (0-1, 0-0)

This Week: Idaho State

Next Week: Tulsa

Sam Bradford became Oklahoma's all-time leading passer with his 96 yards last Saturday, bringing his career total to 7,937 yards. He passed Jason White's previous record of 7,922 yards set from 1999-2004.

Redshirt freshman Landry Jones made his collegiate debut, coming in for the injured Bradford to start the second half. He completed 6-of-12 passes for 51 yards.

Sophomore linebacker Travis Lewis has seven career double-digit tackle games after opening the season with 13 tackles vs. BYU.

Oklahoma and Idaho State match up in their first meeting, the third FCS opponent OU has faced under Bob Stoops. The Sooners defeated Chattanooga, 57-2, in 2008 and Indiana State, 49-0, in 1999.



OKLAHOMA STATE (1-0, 0-0)

This Week: Houston

Next Week: Rice

OSU has won 11 of its last 15 games with all four losses coming to top 15 opponents, including three to teams in the top three of the AP.

Perrish Cox was named Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Week after compiling 97 return yards vs. Georgia, including a 74-yard kickoff return that set up a touchdown.

OSU and Houston will meet for the third time in four seasons with the series locked at 9-9-1. OSU holds a 5-4 advantage at home. OSU won last year's matchup 56-37 after trailing 16-7 in the second quarter. The Cowboys produced 699 total offensive yards, the second-largest total in school history.

In last season's UH game, Zac Robinson was 13-of-21 for 320 yards while Kendall Hunter ran for 210 yards on 22 carries. Dez Bryant posted 311 all-purpose yards with 236 receiving – the second-best receiving game in the country in 2008.



TEXAS (1-0, 0-0)

This Week: at Wyoming

Next Week: Texas Tech

Texas holds a 2-0 series lead over Wyoming, last winning 17-3 in 1978. With its season-opening victory, Texas extended its regular season non-conference win streak to 11.

Colt McCoy became the first Texas quarterback and the fourth Big 12 quarterback to surpass 10,000 yards in career passing yardage with 10,049. McCoy extended his streak to 18 consecutive games with a TD pass, which ranks second on UT's all-time list.

Jordan Shipley leads the Big 12 in receiving and all-purpose yardage as he logged a career-high 180 yards on eight catches. Shipley is also tied for No. 4 in the NCAA for total receiving yards.

Texas ranks nationally at No. 6 in passing offense (363), No. 5 in scoring offense (59) and No. 9 in total offense (562).



TEXAS A&M (1-0, 0-0)

This Week: Open

Next Week: Utah State

Texas A&M recorded 606 yards of total offense, 245 rushing and 361 passing, to lead the Big 12 and rank No. 6 nationally. It tied for the 11th-most in school history.

Jerrold Johnson's 406 total yards, 57 rushing and 349 passing, against New Mexico rank No. 1 in the Big 12 and No. 3 in the NCAA in total offense.

Junior Von Miller leads the Big 12 and the nation in sacks with three.

Sophomore receiver Jeff Fuller caught a career-high 10 passes for a career-best 111 yards and one touchdown vs. New Mexico. His previous bests were eight receptions against Iowa State and 95 yards against Iowa State and Colorado.



TEXAS TECH (1-0, 0-0)

This Week: Rice

Next Week: at Texas

Texas Tech and Rice play for the 48th time. The Red Raiders lead the series 25-20-1. Tech hasn't lost at home to the Owls since 1985.

Since Mike Leach's arrival in 2000, the Red Raiders boast a 21-1 non-conference record at Jones AT&T Stadium. Overall, Texas Tech is 35-8 in non-conference match-ups, including five bowl wins.

Taylor Potts led the Big 12 and came in second nationally in passing, completing 34-of-48 passes for 405 yards and two touchdowns against North Dakota.

The Red Raiders rank No. 1 in the Big 12 and No. 4 in the nation in pass offense (405 ypg).
