AROUND THE PAC-12

- Veterans Day is Friday, Nov. 11. In honor of our military veterans, pregame and halftime ceremonies will be held at Pac-12 stadiums Saturday to recognize and thank all who served in the United States Armed Forces. In addition, the Conference will help celebrate the 70th anniversary of the Tuskegee Airmen, the first unit of African American military pilots who flew in World War II.
- ESPN's College Game Day visits The Farm on Saturday for the third trip to a Pac-12 campus in five weeks. This week's featured game pits No. 6 OREGON at No. 3 STANFORD. Since 1986, it's the 13th time that a pair of Associated Press Top 10 Pac-12 teams have squared off (see complete list on page 2). Both teams can put up the points - Stanford ranks third nationally (48.2 points per game), Oregon fifth nationally (46.0 points per game). Key matchups in the contest could come down to Stanford's run defense (3rd nationally/78.9 yards per game) against Oregon's rushing offense (5th nationally/298.4 yards per game); or Stanford's passing game (5th nationally/174.2 passing efficiency) against Oregon's pass defense (16th nationally/110.6 passing efficiency defense).
- UCLA travels to UTAH where the victor becomes bowl eligible. CALIFORNIA also looks to become bowl eligible as it hosts OREGON STATE Saturday.
- The national awards lists are starting to pare down to semifinalists. Among those recently released are the Maxwell Award semifinalists (16), which include USC QB **Matt Barkley**, OREGON RB **LaMichael James**, STANFORD QB **Andrew Luck**, WASHINGTON RB **Chris Polk**, and USC WR **Robert Woods**. In addition, the Bednarik Award semifinalists (16) tab ARIZONA STATE LB **Vontaze Burfict** and STANFORD LB **Chase Thomas**.

WALNUT CREEK, Calif.--Quarterback **Matt Barkley** of USC, rover **Eddie Pleasant** of OREGON and punter **Sean Sellwood** of UTAH have been named Bank of the West Pac-12 Players of the Week in football.

Barkley, a junior from Newport Beach, Calif., threw a school-record six touchdown passes in USC's 42-17 win at Colorado. He completed 25-of-39 passes for 318 yards with one interception to earn College Football Performance Awards National Performer of the Week and National Quarterback of the Week honors. On the year, Barkley has completed 229-of-342 passes (67.0%) for 2,608 yards and 28 touchdowns. He ranks fourth on USC's career passing and total offense lists with 675 completions and 8,104 yards. Barkley is the only Trojan to have thrown at least five touchdowns four times in his career.

Pleasant, a senior from La Palma, Calif., had two interceptions for 65 yards in the 34-17 win at Washington. Both first-half interceptions led to Oregon touchdown drives that gave the Ducks a slim 17-10 halftime lead. Pleasant also added five tackles, including two unassisted, as Oregon held Washington to 278 yards of total offense (82 rush/196 pass).

Sellwood, a junior from Salt Lake City, Utah, averaged 50.5 yards on four punts in the Utes' 34-21 win at Arizona. He tied his career-long with a 67-yard punt in the first quarter. Sellwood dropped two of his punts inside the 20-yard line in the fourth quarter with Utah nursing a 27-14 lead. The Utes came up with take-aways after both of those punts, the latter of which led to a Utah touchdown with 2:50 remaining to seal the win.

Wildcat Notes: Senior QB **Nick Foles** needs 83 yards of total offense to match Willie Tuitama's school record of 8,727 set from 2005-08. . . Foles needs 67 passing yards to match Jason Johnson's 3,327 yards set in 2002 as second-most in a season. . . Senior WR **David Douglas** had 10 receptions for a career-best 156 yards and two TDs in the 34-21 loss to Utah. It was the second 100-plus yard receiving game of his career. . . Senior WR **Juron Criner** has 2,510 career receiving yards, which ranks No. 4 in school history. He needs one more receiving TD to match the school record held by Theopolis Bell who snagged 30 TDs from 1972-75. . . Since making his first career start vs. UCLA, freshman LB **Tra'Mayne Bondurant** is making the most of his opportunity as he has recorded eight tackles in each of the last three games.

Buffalo Notes: Senior WR **Tony Clemons** continued his recent solid play with five catches for a career-high 112 yards and two touchdowns in the loss to USC. His 37-yard reception for a TD put CU up 7-0 early, the Buffs' first lead in five games (244:10 of game time). Clemons has 13 catches for 209 yards and 3 TDs over the last two games. . . Freshman PK **Will Oliver** tied the school freshman record for the most field goals made in a season with his 10th; that ties the mark set by Tom Field in 1979 he now has 51 points, second-most for a frosh (PK Mason Crosby scored 52 in 2003). . . Colorado went from committing five turnovers last week at Arizona State to having none vs. USC. . . Senior RB **Rodney Stewart** posted 155 all-purposes yards (88 rushing, 67 receiving) giving him 4,466 for his career, as he passed his position coach, Eric Bieniemy (4,351, 1987-90) for CU's all-time record.

Husky Notes: Sophomore QB **Keith Price** connected for his 25th touchdown of the season in the third quarter to tie Brock Huard (1997) for second most all-time in UW single-season history. The all-time record is 28 by Cody Pickett (2002). . . Freshman WR **Kasen Williams** set a career high with 79 receiving yards, a week after having previous best of 60 vs. Arizona. . . Junior RB **Chris Polk** was held under 100 yards rushing for just the second time this season. His 80 yards vs. Oregon give him 1,096 for the season and 3,657 for his career. . . Washington was held under 100 yards rushing for the first time this season. . . For the third time this season UW gave up less than 200 yards passing – all losses. In UW's six wins, they have allowed 300-yards passing five times. . . UW held the Ducks to 381 total yards, 145 below its average.

Trojan Notes: The Trojans blocked a pair of kicks at Colorado, giving the team six blocked kicks in 2011. . . Junior QB **Matt Barkley** completed 25-of-39 for 318 yards and set a USC record with six TD passes in a game; he snapped a five-way tie he had shared with Rodney Peete, Carson Palmer, Matt Leinart and Mark Sanchez. . . Second time this year both Sophomore WR **Robert Woods** and freshman **Marqise Lee** topped 100 yards in receiving. Lee had 9 catches for 124 yards and 2 TDs. It's the second 100-yard receiving game of his career. Woods posted 9 receptions for 130 yards and 2 TDs. It was his sixth 100-yard game of the season and eighth of his career; he went over the 1,000-yard mark for the season (90 - 1,121 yards, with 11 TDs).

Beaver Notes: Senior WR **James Rodgers** scored his 18th career receiving touchdown in the second quarter. That ties him with Robb Thomas (1985-88) for fourth in school history. Rodgers tallied six catches, giving him 212 for his career. He is now one shy of tying James Newson (2000-03) for second-most in program history and needs nine to break Mike Hass' program-record of 220. . . Freshman QB **Sean Mannion** threw for 252 yards after completing 18-of-30 pass attempts. He has now thrown for 200 or more yards in eight consecutive games, the most since Derek Anderson did so in 13 straight games in 2003. . . Oregon State became the first team this season to hold Stanford scoreless in the first quarter.

Golden Bear Notes: Sophomore WR **Keenan Allen** posted eight catches for 85 yards in the 30-7 win over Washington State. Allen moved up on Cal's single-season top-10 lists in two categories - receptions (75, T-3rd) and yards (1,074, 4th). The 75 receptions are the most since Geoff McArthur caught 85 in 2003. He also extended his streak of consecutive games with a catch to 20, all his games at Cal. Allen also became the sixth receiver in school history to register 1,000 yards receiving in a single season. The nine games it took Allen to reach 1,000 yards in a season are the quickest in school history. The 1,074 receiving yards are the fourth most in a single season in school history. . . Junior RB **Isi Sofele** rushed 23 times for a career-high 138 yards with a touchdown. It was the third time he topped 100 yards this season. . . Entering the game, the Washington State passing game was ranked second in the Pac-12, while the Cal pass defense was ranked first in the conference and 32nd in the nation. The Cal defense held the Cougar passing attack to 155 yards.

Bruin Notes: Senior RB **Derrick Coleman** rushed for 119 yards on 17 carries and two touchdowns in the upset win over No. 20 Arizona State. Coleman had 81 yards in the second half of the game and 65 yards came on seven carries during the game-winning touchdown drive on which he scored from one yard out with 49 seconds remaining in the game. It was his third 100-yard game of the season. . . Coleman has 11 touchdowns (all rushing) on the season now which is the most by a Bruin since Maurice Jones Drew scored 20 in 2005 (13 rushing). . . Junior QB **Kevin Prince** connected on 11-of-17 for 196 yards passing, and put up 61 yards rushing. . . A week after picking off three passes, freshman S **Tevin McDonald** recorded a career-best 11 tackles.

Ute Notes: The Utes need one victory to become bowl eligible. Utah has been to a bowl game in each of the last eight seasons, posting a 7-1 record in that span. . . Junior RB **John White** became the 11th Utah player to gain 1,000 yards in a season with a 109-yard night (27 carries) in the win at Arizona. He is the fourth first-year Ute to reach the milestone, joining Eddie Johnson (1984), Keith Williams (1991) and Mike Anderson (1998). It was his fifth 100-yard rushing game of the season. Utah is 5-0 when White has at least 100 yards rushing. . . The Ute defense remains stout inside the 20 as it held Arizona scoreless in two trips in the red zone. Utah is tied for 5th nationally in red zone defense at 68.0 percent, allowing 17 scores in 25 opportunities. . . Junior QB **Jon Hays** is 3-2 as Utah's starting quarterback. In the three wins, Hays has thrown five TDs and no interceptions.

Duck Notes: Junior RB **LaMichael James** had 156 rushing yards at Washington, marking the 22nd 100-yard rushing game of his career to extend his own UO record. He also became the first Duck with three 1,000-yard rushing seasons (1,061) and surpassed 5,000 (5,057) all-purpose yards to move to second all-time in that category. . . James rushing touchdown on UO's opening drive was his 44th career, tying Toby Gerhart (Stanford) and Anthony Davis (USC) for seventh all-time in Pac-12 history. . . Junior QB **Darron Thomas** had one touchdown pass, giving him at least one TD toss in 21 straight appearances (every start of his career). . . Oregon has won 18 straight conference games, dating to a 2009 road loss to Stanford. . . Senior ROV **Eddie Pleasant** had a career-high two interceptions, giving him three on the season and in his past two games. . . Oregon had a season-high six sacks in the win at Washington and now lead the Pac-12 with 3.22 per game.

Cardinal Notes: Stanford has its first 9-0 start since 1951. . . The Cardinal won its 17th-straight game, extending its own school-record and the nation's longest streak. . . Junior QB **Andrew Luck** added three touchdowns in the 38-13 win over Oregon State and now has 71 in his career, one behind Steve Stenstrom (1991-94) for second place all-time. John Elway (1979-82) owns the school mark with 77. . . With a 5-0 road record in 2011, it is the first unbeaten true road season since the 1971 season (5-0). . . Senior WR **Griff Whalen** continues to be a primary target for Luck as he's caught 27 passes for 443 yards over the last five games. Whalen leads all Cardinal receivers with 36 catches/534 yards. . . Five different receivers have caught 20 or more passes this season. . . The Cardinal continue to lead the nation in red zone efficiency with a perfect 52-of-52.

Sun Devil Notes: Junior RB **Cameron Marshall** turned in a career day rushing for a career-high 168 yards on 27 carries in a narrow 28-27 loss to UCLA at the Rose Bowl Saturday. Marshall scored on a 14-yard run, which now gives him the outright lead for touchdowns (13) in the Pac-12. He collected 184 all-purpose yards and averaged 6.2 yards per carry. Coincidentally, Marshall's previous career-high rushing yards was 147 yards against UCLA last year. Marshall now has 800 rushing yards on the season. . . The ASU record for rushing touchdowns in a season is 18, set by Woody Green (1972) and Terry Battle (1996). . . Over the last four games, junior QB **Brock Osweiler** has connected on 94-of-153 for 1,187 yards with 9 TDs and just 2 interceptions. . . Senior DT **Bo Moos** will get to play this weekend in front of his father, Washington State Director of Athletics **Bill Moos**. The younger Moos has started each game this season and has posted 19 tackles.

Cougar Notes: Sophomore WR **Marquess Wilson** ranks third in the Pac-12 (12th nationally) with 108.2 receiving yards per game. He needs 26 yards to reach 1,000 receiving yards for the second consecutive season. Only one other receiver in WSU history has posted a pair of 1,000 receiving yard seasons - Jason Hill (2004 and 2005). . . Senior WR **Jared Karstetter** has caught a pass in 36 straight games. . . Wet weather hampered the Cougar passing attack at California where they threw for 155 yards, marking the first time this season that WSU threw for less than 200 yards in a game. The Cougars still rank second in the Pac-12, averaging 298.2 passing yards per gamer. . . Sophomore PK **Andrew Furney** has been named one of 20 semifinalists for the 2011 Lou Groza Collegiate Place-Kicker Award. He's connected on 11-of-13 (.846) this season and is perfect from 40 yards out (5-of-5).

OREGON TABBED TO WIN PAC-12 TITLE IN PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

LOS ANGELES -- Defending Pac-12 champion OREGON is the choice to win the 2011 Pac-12 Conference football title in a preseason poll of media members who regularly cover the league. The Ducks were listed in the top spot in the North Division by 29 of the 42 voters participating in the poll, collecting 239 points. Twenty-eight of those pollsters tabbed the Ducks to come out on top in the inaugural Pac-12 Championship Game. STANFORD was picked to finish second in the North Division, collecting the other 13 first-place votes in the balloting for the division race, with 11 of those members of the media casting a vote for the Cardinal to capture the Pac-12 title.

USC was picked to win the South Division with 230 points, edging out ARIZONA STATE, which tallied 207 points. Due to NCAA sanctions, USC is on probation and ineligible to participate in the postseason. Therefore, the Trojans would not be able to represent the South Division in the Pac-12 Championship Game. Should USC capture the South Division crown, the team finishing second would be the South Division's representative in the Pac-12 Championship Game. Arizona State collected 13 first-place votes in the division race, with three of the pollsters predicting a Pac-12 Championship crown for the Sun Devils.

The media poll has correctly selected the Conference Champion in 27 of 50 previous polls, including 10 of the last 11. Following are the results of the preseason media poll (points 6-5-4-3-2-1, first-place votes in parentheses):

PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

The inaugural Pac-12 Championship Football Game will take place Friday, December 2 at 8 p.m. ET/5 p.m. PT and telecast to a national audience on FOX. The Championship game will match the winner of the North Division vs. the winner of the South Division. The game will be played on the campus of the division winner with the best overall conference record. The winner of the inaugural Pac-12 Championship will earn the league's automatic BCS berth.

TIE-BREAK PROCEDURES TO DETERMINE DIVISION CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP GAME HOST

The Division Champion will be determined by the record in all games played (both divisional and cross-divisional) within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game representatives

Two-Team Tie.

1. Head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
 - a. If no game is played between the two tied teams or that game ends in a tie, the following tie-breaking procedures would be applied:
2. Record in games played within the division
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (Based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.
6. Total number of wins in a 12-game season. The following conditions will apply to the calculation of the total number of wins:
 - a. Only one win against a team from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision or lower division will be counted annually.
 - b. Any games that are exempted from counting against the annual maximum number of football contests per NCAA rules (current Bylaw 17.9.5.2) shall not be included.
7. Coin toss.

Multiple-Team Ties.

The following procedures will only be used to eliminate all but two teams, at which point the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

1. Head-to-head (Best record in games among the tied teams).
2. Record in games played within the division.
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.

Pac-12 Championship Game Host

The Pac-12 Championship Game Host will be determined by the record in all games played within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game host.

Tie-breaking Procedure.

1. Head-to-head, if applicable.
2. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of Pac-12 regular-season games.
3. Record against the next highest-placed common opponent in the conference (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the conference.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Coin toss.

PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS - 2011-12

The second year of a four-year bowl cycle kicks in this season and the Pac-12 welcomes a new addition to the lineup. The Gildan New Mexico Bowl in Albuquerque will feature the Pac-12's seventh selection against an opponent from the Mountain West Conference. The Pac-12 Conference has agreements with seven bowl partners. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion, unless said champion is ranked No. 1 or No. 2 in the final Bowl Championship Series rankings. If that were the case, the Pac-12 champion would play in the BCS National Championship Game hosted by the Allstate Sugar Bowl. Regardless of the disposition of the Pac-12 champion, a second Pac-12 team may be selected for an at-large berth in the Bowl Championship Series in any given year and other Pac-12 bowl partner arrangements provide for that occurrence. In addition to the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, Pac-12 bowl partners include, in order of selection, the Valero Alamo Bowl in San Antonio, Bridgeport Education Holiday Bowl in San Diego, Hyundai Sun Bowl in El Paso, the MAACO Bowl Las Vegas, the Kraft Fight Hunger Bowl in San Francisco, and the Gildan New Mexico Bowl in Albuquerque.
