Postgame Quotes

Arizona head coach Rich Rodriguez

On the victory:

"I'm glad we pulled out the win. I wasn't comfortable until the last 30 seconds. I'm thankful we were able to run the ball, Ka'Deem Carey was Ka'Deem Carey. B.J. (Denker) was good for us today and I thought he ran the offense really well. Our defense is what it is but I'm glad we got to six wins."

On Ka'Deem Carey's performance:

"Ka'Deem runs as hard and as angry as any running back in the country. We did a good job up front today for him but he's in great shape and he can take some of those hits. He always has really good vision but today you could see it with some of those cutbacks he had."

On B.J. Denker's performance:

"B.J. made good decisions today. I really liked the two speed options we ran; he was sharp. We played well up front; I wouldn't say we dominated because we aren't big enough or strong enough but we executed well. B.J. is unflappable; he's been through the junior college games. We had an idea of what we were going to do but we didn't know how they were going to play us. We ran the ball well and it was safer. We probably should have thrown a little more and there are some throws that B.J. probably wants back. But when you have a guy as hot as Ka'Deem Carey was, you have to feed him."

On the defense's performance:

"We have to be better in terms of technique; we didn't tackle well. We know what we are defensively; we're undersized and we have true freshmen and redshirt freshmen playing. Are they playing before they are ready? Probably but you need 11 guys on the field. They are playing and we need them to play better. We need our guys to get in the weight room and get bigger."

Arizona sophomore running back Ka'Deem Carey

On the number of rushing yards:

"When you go from long run to long run and your linemen are really happy, you know you must be doing something right."

On breaking the school record :

"When I woke up this morning I knew I was going to try and break a school record. I didn't tell anybody but I wanted to get it."

On being run up behind by Colorado players:

"Everybody is going to give me grief for running out of breath. Next week I'll show them it won't happen again."

Arizona junior quarterback B.J. Denker

On Ka'Deem Carey:

"I had the best seat in the house for that. I had a great time handing Ka'Deem the ball and watching him work. I did try blocking for him once but I failed at that."

On Colorado's game plan:

"They were either going to let me or Ka'Deem (Carey) run and they let Ka'Deem run. I told him during the game that we may run for 500 yards together by the end of the game."

On the first play of the game:

"They did some sort of twist that I didn't recognize, and I was hit before I could make a decision. It was a weird play and I just wanted to move on right after it happened."

Arizona senior receiver Dan Buckner

On the play of B.J. Denker:

"I think B.J. did pretty well. He did throw three passes to me for two touchdowns so that was very good. I thought that he managed the game well, too. I just told him before the game that he didn't need to do too much, just do what he needed to do."

On being bowl eligible as a senior:

"It's a great feeling. I'm nearing the end of my college career and it feels great to get that extra win to get bowl eligible. I love these seniors and it feels good to be able to continue our college career a little longer."

Colorado head coach Jon Embree

Opening statement:

"We stopped Arizona twice and they fumbled on one of them. We just didn't get it done today."

On Arizona running back Ka'Deem Carey:

"He's an All-Pac-12 back. It's pretty simple. I don't know where he ranks, but he, Kenjon Barner and Johnathan Franklin are all really good. He fits through tight seams and breaks arm tackles. Their zone read was very effective."

On the season:

"We haven't played well. It's been different factors and different reasons. We've got two games left to put together a complete game."

On the defensive effort:

"I don't know if it's an effort issue or a getting blocked and being out of position issue. On a couple of (Ka'Deem) Carey's long runs, we didn't give up and chased him down."

On the game plan against a backup quarterback:

"We were playing the run. There weren't any surprises."

On quarterback Nick Hirschman:

"Nick played well all week. There were a couple of mistakes today with the clock and he made a mistake on the interception but he did his job. He gave a chance on that side of the ball."

On quarterback Connor Wood:

"Wood was fine when he got in there. I'm pleased overall with how that position played."

On the offense:

"We ran it well. It would have been nice to have that screen back early. I thought the offense did do well. We were patient and I thought our quarterbacks handled the pressure well, for the most part."

Colorado freshman tailback Christian Powell

On success gaining yards:

"Gaining yards was the game plan for this week. We knew by the structure of their defense that we were going to have success running the ball so we were working that set all week."

On the attitude towards losing:

"It's disappointing to lose but Coach tells us just to come out and have fun, which is what I'm trying to do. You'd obviously rather win but you are out here with all of your boys so you try to make the most of the opportunities given to you."

Colorado junior linebacker Derrick Webb

On the amount of yards the defense gave up:

"We've become familiar with the type of zone read offense that Arizona plays over the course of our season and we've had some of the same issues the entire season. It's always important to get the edge taken care of and the cutback. (Ka'Deem) Carey is a great player and was able to get the cutback. There were a couple of times where our guys could've been in our gaps better, and played with better gap assignment. Ten guys can be out there playing their butts off, and all it takes is one gap."

On Ka'Deem Carey:

"Carey was able to find our gaps and go a long way. He's aggressive and explosive on tape and he showed it today. He can see a gap, burst through it and then it is off to the races."

On the attitude of the defense after losing season:

"We put it all out there every game and we will continue to do that the last two games. I think all of our bodies are holding up really well, and we have a couple of people coming back into the lineup. We have a lot more to give and we are going to come back strong and work hard every game. It has been a tough season but it only makes us stronger. We have been through a lot and we just have to continue to come back and play hard the next game. We won't give up."

Colorado freshman running back Donta Abram

On the mindset:

"From an offensive standpoint we are looking to score on every drive. Our mindset doesn't change, we just go out and do what we do."

On having a breakout game:

"It felt great to get out on the field and show what I've got. There was great blocking from the wide receivers and offensive line."

On the mood in the locker room:

"It's been a tough year for us. We just need to keep fighting. Keep our heads up and keep fighting."

On Ka'Deem Carey

"He's a great player. He made plays and got in the end zone."

Colorado sophomore quarterback Connor Wood

On his performance:

"I feel good about some of the things I did but in the red zone we gave up some points that should have been there. Overall I'm unhappy but I'm going to get better from it. I think I moved the chains well with the opportunities I had. I just need to improve on that last drive."

On the pass to tight end Scott Fernandez:

"That was awesome. He deserves it. He works hard and always has a great attitude."

On the mood of the team:

QUICKLY Colorado now leads the series by a 13-2 count (8-1 in Tucson, 5-2 when coming off a loss); CU is now 9-0 overall in Tucson counting the '99 Insight.com Bowl, the last time before today the Buffaloes visited the city (a 62-28 CU win over Boston College) ... This was game number 200 for Buff head coach Jon Embree: he has 23 as head coach (4-19), 121 as a full-time assistant coach (81-39-1), 12 as a volunteer coach (8-3-1) and 44 as a player (17-27; he missed the ninth and 10th games of his freshman season in 1983 with mono). He is 110-88-2 overall ... The Buffaloes are 56-34-1 in their last 90 November games (50-22 not including the Nebraska rivalry games), and are 51-12 against unranked teams in the month ... Colorado is now 3-7 in the coin toss this season and opened on offense for the fifth time ... When the Buffs took a 7-0 lead, it marked their first lead since holding a 7-6 edge over Arizona State in the second quarter on Oct. 11 (or a span of 219:30)... The first quarter field goal drive matched the longest drive in terms of plays (15) and was the longest drive of the year (8:18; old: 6:52 vs. USC, a 16-play drive for a FG) ... Colorado's time of possession for the game (41:48) was its second most in history; record is 42:17 against Indiana in 1980 (a 49-7 loss in Boulder) ... This was the 57th time in school history the Buffaloes rushed and passed for 200 or more yards in a game; CU is now 51-6 in such situations (and 43-3 in the last 46) ... The 31 points by the Buffs were their second most this season ... CU had a season-high 224 rushing yards.

QB Breakdown: Hirschman (7 drives, 47 plays, 246 yards); Wood (4, 28-202), Schrock (1, 1-(-1)).

Ka'Deem Carey (25-366, 5 TD) set an opponent record for the most rushing yards against Colorado, breaking the old record of 268 by Kansas' David Winbush in Lawrence on Oct. 24, 1998.

P DARRAGH O'NEILL (3-40.7, 2 IN20) His first punt of the game, a "rugby rollout", was his first left-footed punt of the year (he had four in 2011); it went for 61 yards which was also his career long. He also now has 44 career punts inside-the-20, tied for fourth all-time t CU.

- **QB John Schrock** (Fr.-RS) saw his first action, appearing on the final drive; he is the 22 CU frosh to play in 2012.
- **DE Will Pericak** has now started all 47 games in his career; tying the most starts overall (set by OL Ryan Miller, 2007-11). The most games played by a defensive player is 48 (held by 4).

Arizona Postgame Notes

- Arizona, with its sixth win, assures bowl eligibility for the fourth time in the last five seasons. The Wildcats appeared in three-consecutive bowl games from 2008-10.
- Ka'Deem Carey rushed for a Pac-12 Conference and Arizona school record 366 yards (25-366, 5 TD). His five rushing scores set a new single-game school record and tied the conference single-game record established multiple times, including by Oregon's Kenyon Barner last week against USC.
- Carey's 366 rushing yards are the most by any player in the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) this season, surpassing New Mexico's Kasey Carrier's 341 yards against Air Force on Oct. 12. The total ranks No. 9 all-time for single-game yardage in the FBS ranks and is the most since Central Michigan's Robbie Mixon collected 377 against Eastern Michigan on Nov. 2, 2002.
- Carey's 30 total points scored in the game are the second-most by an individual player in Arizona history. Art Luppino holds the school record with 32 against New Mexico State set in 1954 (5 TD – four by rushing, and two extra points).
- Carey also set a new school record with exactly 400 all-purpose yards (366 rushing, 34 receiving). The previous mark was set by Art Luppino against New Mexico State in 1954 (359 yards).
- Carey secured his seventh 100-yard rushing game of the season (and of his career) in the first half, rushing for 121 yards and three touchdowns on 10 attempts by halftime.
- Carey increased his season rushing total to 1,381 yards, the second-highest single-season total in program history. He now has 1,678 all-purpose yards, which ranks No. 8 in single-season school history.
- Arizona's 438 rushing yards in the game tie for the eighth-most all-time in a single game (438 vs. UTEP in 1973). The total was the most in game for the Wildcats since rolling up 460 against at Oregon State on Nov. 13, 1999.
- Arizona gained 574 yards on 52 plays (11.0 yards per play), which challenged but did not break the school record for yards per play set in 1945 against UTEP (13.3 ypp, 45 plays-599 yards).
- Austin Hill's 29 receiving yards pushed him over the 1,000-yard mark for the season. Hill now has 62 catches for 1,023 yards, good enough for the sixth-most yards in single-season school history.
- Hill and Carey become the school's second set of players to post 1,000-yard receiving and rushing seasons in the same year. The only other tandem to do so was Dennis Northcutt and Trung Canidate in 1999.
- Senior place-kicker John Bonano converted all eight PAT kicks, improving his season total to 45-of-45. Combined with a 24-of-24 success rate last season, Bonano has made all 69 PAT tries in his career. That broke the school record of 68-consecutive made kicks set previously by Max Zendejas (1982-84) and Jason Bondzio (2007-08).
- Regular backup quarterbacks B.J. Denker (Arizona) and Nick Hirschman (Colorado) started and turned in strong first halves. The two combined for just two incompletions in the opening two quarters, collecting 234 yards on 19-of-21 passing. Hirschman's only incomplection was an interception. Denker threw his second touchdown of the season in the half.
- Denker finished 12-of-14 passing for 136 yards and two touchdowns with no interceptions, producing a pass efficiency rating of 214.5. That figure bests Matt Scott's 212.3 rating against Washington on Oct. 20 for the top mark this season for a UA quarterback.
- Arizona was out-first-downed by the Buffaloes (24-21) but the Wildcats outgained CU, 574-437 in total yardage and averaged 11.0 yards per play to the visitor's 5.8 yards per play.
- Colorado dominated the time of possession, holding the ball for 41:48 of the available 60 minutes. The Wildcats possession covered 18:12 of the game.
- Arizona had three true freshmen make their first career starts, including defenders Vince Miles (safety) and C.J. Dozier (linebacker). On offense, true freshman Cayman Bundage made his first start at left guard.
- An Arizona opponent scored first in a game for the seventh time in the last nine games. UA has scored first in three games this season – Toledo, South Carolina State and vs. USC. The Cats are 3-0 when scoring first and 3-4 when allowing an opponent to strike first.
- Tra'Mayne Bondurant intercepted his second pass of the season in the second quarter. Bondurant had an interception return for a 29-yard touchdown last year against Colorado in Boulder.
- Johnny Jackson's first career kickoff return went for 25 yards in the first quarter.
- Garic Wharton's 19-yard rush on an end-around in the second quarter was his longest career carry.

- Dan Buckner finished with an Arizona game-high 38 receiving yards on three receptions, including two for touchdowns. It was Buckner's first career multiple-touchdown game at Arizona.
- Colorado was penalized 11 times for 89 yards, bringing UA's season opponent penalty yardage total near 1,000 yards (now 998 yards) which surely continues to lead the nation.
- Arizona's 56 points marked the fourth time in seven home games this year that the Wildcats broke the 50-point barrier.
- This year is the first time since 1954 that the Wildcats have scored 50-plus points in a game three or more times.
