PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - WEEK TEN

OFFENSE: Kenjon Barner, RB, Oregon

DEFENSE: Eric Kendricks, LB, UCLA

SPECIAL TEAMS: Reggie Dunn, KR, Utah

WALNUT CREEK, Calif.-- Running back **Kenjon Barner** of OREGON, linebacker **Eric Kendricks** of UCLA and wide receiver/kick returner **Reggie Dunn** of UTAH have been named Pac-12 Players of the Week in football.

Barner, a senior from Riverside, Calif., rushed for a school-record 321 yards on 38 carries (8.4 average) and five touchdowns as the Ducks defeated USC, 62-51. His five rushing touchdowns, which came on runs of 27, 5, 9, 5 and 22 yards, tied the Pac-12 single-game record. Additionally, his 321 rushing yards represent the fourth-highest single-game total in Conference history and are the most ever allowed by USC. Barner, who was named the Walter Camp Foundation's National Offensive Player of the Week, has rushed for 100 yards or more in five straight games. He leads the Pac-12 and ranks second in the FBS in rushing (143.89 ypg), and his 13.33 scoring average is tied for the national lead.

Kendricks, a sophomore from Fresno, Calif., collected 13 tackles, including seven in the third quarter, to help the Bruins to a 66-10 win over Arizona. UCLA held the nation's fourth-ranked offense to just 257 yards of total offense, 296 yards below its season average. He registered a career high two sacks (-13 yards) and helped limit Arizona running back Ka'Deem Carey who entered the game averaging 120.1 yards per game, to just 54 yards rushing. He also forced a fumble in the third quarter that set up a UCLA touchdown on the next play. Kendricks leads the Pac-12 and ranks 25th in the FBS in tackles per game (9.67).

Dunn, a senior from Compton, Calif., returned a kickoff 100 yards for a touchdown in a 49-6 win over Washington State to earn a second-consecutive Pac-12 special teams player of the week honor. It was his third 100-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in four attempts in the last two weeks. He also caught two passes for 15 yards and rushed twice for 15 yards. He now owns the NCAA record for career 100-yard kickoff returns with four. He also set a Utah record for career kickoff returns for touchdowns (4) and set a school single-season record for kickoff return touchdowns (3). Last week against California, Dunn set the NCAA record for kick return average in a game (74.0), returning three kicks for 222 yards, and he set a school record for kickoff return touchdowns in a game.

Also nominated for offensive player of the week honors were quarterback **Matt Barkley** of USC, running backs **C.J. Anderson** of CALIFORNIA, **Johnathan Franklin** of UCLA, **John White** of UTAH and **Bishop Sankey** of WASHINGTON and wide receiver **Markus Wheaton** of OREGON STATE. Also nominated on defense were defensive backs **Reggie Topps** of UTAH and **Shaq Thompson** of WASHINGTON, linebacker **Nick Forbes** of CALIFORNIA and defensive end **Scott Crichton** of OREGON STATE. Also nominated on special teams were punters **Josh Hubner** of ARIZONA STATE and **Jeff Locke** of UCLA, placekicker **Trevor Romaine** of OREGON STATE and wide receiver/kickoff returner **Marqise Lee** of USC.

AROUND THE PAC-12

ANOTHER RECORD-SETTING DAY: USC senior QB **Matt Barkley** set the Pac-12 career records for completions and total offense in the 62-51 loss to Oregon. His 961 completions moved him past Arizona's Nick Foles (930, 2009-11). With 476 yards total offense in the loss to Oregon, he passed former Trojan Carson Palmer (11,621 from 1998-2002) and now has 11,701 yards total offense... Barkley has posted 2,500 or more yards of total offense in each of his four seasons. No other Pac-12 quarterback in history has accomplished that feat... USC sophomore WR **Marqise Lee** set a Pac-12 single-game kickoff return record with 251 yards, passing the old mark of 240 yards set by Tony Cherry of Oregon (vs. Washington State, 1984)... Utah senior KR Reggie Dunn returned a kick 100 yards for a TD against Washington State, giving him an NCAA record for career 100-yard kickoff returns with four... With 162 yards rushing in the win over Arizona, UCLA senior RB **Johnathan Franklin** set the school's career rushing mark with 3,873 yards, passing former Bruin Gaston Green's mark of 3,731 yards (1984-87).

FRESHMEN SIGNAL CALLERS: Here's one thing that may have gone unnoticed during Saturday's games... The three Pac-12 freshmen QBs who started yesterday combined to complete 60 passes in 71 attempts (.845) for 763 yards, 9 TDs, and just one interception. Utah's **Travis Wilson** (17-21-1, 171 yards, 2 TDs). Oregon's **Marcus Mariota** (20-23-0, 304 yards, 4 TDs). UCLA's **Brett Hundley** (23-28-0, 288 yards, 3 TDs)

COLORADO (1-8) at ARIZONA (5-4)

Sat., Nov. 10, 11:30 a.m. MT - FX
COLO leads, 13-1-0. Last game: COLO, 48-29 (2011)

The 48-0 loss to Stanford marked a rare home shutout for Colorado. The Buffaloes had scored in 150 straight games at home with the last shutout being a 28-0 loss to Oklahoma on Nov. 15, 1986. This was just the third time CU was shutout at Folsom Field over the course of the last 288 games (all the way back to 1963); the other was in 1979 to LSU, 44-0.

ILB **Brady Daigh** and DT **Justin Solis** made their first career starts against Stanford; that's 18 players making their first career starts in 2012, tied for fourth most in the nation behind Hawaii (26), Air Force (21) and Temple (20); TCU also has 18... Senior DE **Will Pericak** started his 46th straight game Saturday (every game of his career, dating back to his first in the '09 opener); already the mark for most consecutive starts on offense or defense; his next start will match him for most starts overall at CU (47 - OL Ryan Miller, 2007-11).

Sophomore RB **Ka'Deem Carey** surpassed the 1,000 yard rushing mark in the loss at UCLA. His 1,015 rushing yards this season rank 12th on Arizona's single-season list... Sophomore WR **Austin Hill** needs six receiving yards to eclipse 1,000 yards for the season. He'll become the seventh Wildcat all-time to reach that mark... Senior QB **Matt Scott** moves up the Arizona single-season charts. His 2,848 passing yards rank sixth, while his 20 TD tosses are tied for fourth on the school's single-season lists.

ARIZONA STATE (5-4) at No. 21 USC (6-3)

Sat., Nov. 10, 12 noon PT - P12N
USC leads, 18-10-0. Last game: ASU, 43-22 (2011)

Arizona State has scored first in eight of its nine games this season. The latest coming after **Junior Onyeali's** fumble recovery in the endzone just 21 seconds into the Oregon State game. It was ASU's third defensive TD of the season... The Sun Devils have outscored their opponents 111-27 in the first quarter.

With a first quarter score at OSU, ASU senior RB **Cameron Marshall** moved into sole possession of second on the school's all-time rushing touchdown list with 35. The ASU career mark is 43 set by Woody Green (1971-73)... Marshall's 2,508 career rushing yards move him into 10th on the school's all-time list.

USC sophomore WR **Marqise Lee** had 408 all-purpose yards (16th most in NCAA history), including a Pac-12 record 251 yards on a school-record 8 kickoff returns and 157 receiving yards with 2 TDs (including a 75-yarder) on 12 receptions... Lee has accumulated 877 all-purpose yards over the last two games, and his 223.0 average tops all FBS players... Senior QB **Matt Barkley** has thrown for 977 yards over the last two games.

The Trojans will look to avoid a third straight loss for the first time since Pete Carroll's first season in 2001 when USC dropped four straight after winning the season opener... While USC had an 11-game winning streak over ASU snapped last year in Tempe, the Sun Devils have not won in the Coliseum since 1999... The Trojans are seeking win No. 800.

No. 17 UCLA (7-2) at WASHINGTON STATE (2-7)

Sat., Nov. 10, 7:30 p.m. PT - ESPN2
UCLA leads, 39-18-1. Last game: UCLA, 28-25 (2011)

UCLA senior RB **Johnathan Franklin** posted his 17th career 100-yard rushing game with 162 yards against Arizona. He now owns UCLA's career rushing record with 3,873 yards. The 17th career 100-yard game ties Freeman McNeil for second place on that school list, three behind Gaston Green's mark of 20... The 308 yards rushing vs. Arizona was the third contest this season with at least 300. UCLA has won 24 straight games when rushing for at least 250 yards.

Freshman QB **Brett Hundley** completed 16 straight passes at one point, falling one shy of tying the school record (Rick Neuheisel, 17, 1983 vs. Washington)... Hundley's 21 touchdown passes this season are tied for the fifth most in a single year at UCLA (Tom Ramsey, 1982).

For his career, WSU senior QB **Jeff Tuel** has thrown for 5,388 yards, good for seventh on the school's career list... The Cougars are second in the Pac-12 and 11th nationally averaging 324.2 passing yards per game. Tuel has thrown for 1,543 yards this season, while sophomore **Connor Halliday** has posted 1,375 yards.

WSU freshman LB **Darryl Monroe** is second on the team with 60 tackles (6.7 avg), has forced two fumbles, recovered one and made three sacks. Monroe leads all Pac-12 freshmen in tackles.

No. 2 OREGON (9-0) at CALIFORNIA (3-7)

Sat., Nov. 10, 7:30 p.m. PT - ESPN
ORE leads, 39-33-2. Last game: ORE, 43-15 (2011)

Oregon has scored 30 or more points in 22 straight games, the longest streak in the FBS. The Ducks are 40-2 when scoring 30-plus in the Chip Kelly era, which is only 49 games long. Oregon has scored 42 or more points in 12 straight games, averaging 52.7 points in that stretch... Oregon has scored 132 points over the last two games (66.0 avg).

Over the last three games, freshman QB **Marcus Mariota** has completed 39 of 49 pass attempts (.796) for 486 yards, 7 TDs and no interceptions... Senior TB **Kenjon Barner** has 19 rushing TDs and needs two to tie former Duck LaMichael James' school single-season mark of 21 rushing TDs. His 39 career rushing TDs rank third all-time at Oregon and are tied for 12th all-time in the Pac-12.

Cal senior RB **C.J. Anderson** paced the Bears in rushing for the fifth time this season with a career-high 160 yards against Washington. It was his third game of rushing for over 100 yards this season.

The Cal defense has now forced 15 turnovers in the past five games. Cal's 13 interceptions this season are one more than the Bears had all last season.

No. 13 OREGON STATE (7-1) at No. 16 STANFORD (7-2)

Sat., Nov. 10, 12 noon PT - FOX
STAN leads, 50-25-2. Last game: STAN, 38-13 (2011)

Oregon State held Arizona State to 4-of-17 on third-down conversions. Opponents have converted on just 27-of-112 (24.1 percent) on third down conversions against the Beavers this season.

The Beavers finished with one 100-yard rusher and two 100-yard receivers for the second time this season. OSU saw senior WR **Markus Wheaton**, sophomore WR **Brandin Cooks** and sophomore RB **Terron Ward** achieve the feat against ASU. Ward posted a career-high 146 yards rushing on 19 carries. His previous best was 43 yards against Washington in 2011... Wheaton tallied 108 receiving yards and Cooks finished with 116. It marked the third time this year the duo had 100-yard efforts in the same game.

Junior RB **Stepfan Taylor** needs 53 yards to reach 1,000 yards for the third season in his career. He'd join former Cardinal Darin Nelson as the only Stanford players to accomplish that feat, and 12th player to do so in Pac-12 history.

Stanford junior S **Ed Reynolds** moved into a tie for the FBS lead with three interception returns for touchdown when he returned one in the first quarter of Sunday's win over Colorado. He is one shy of the FBS all-time single-season mark of four set by former Cal Bear Deltha O'Neal in 1999. Additionally, he is tied for first in the Pac-12, tied for third in the nation, with five interceptions.

Stanford, which boasts the nation's top rushing defense (57.78 ypg), has held opponents to negative rushing outputs in each of its last two games (-18 vs. Washington State, -21 vs. Colorado).

UTAH (4-5) at WASHINGTON (5-4)

Sat., Nov. 10, 7:30 p.m. PT - P12N
WASH leads, 7-0-0. Last game: WASH, 31-14 (2011)

Utah senior RB **John White** rushed for 101 yards and a pair of TDs vs. Washington State. The Utes are 11-0 when White rushes for 100 or more yards.

Utah's combined 98 points in the last two games is its best two-game total since it put up 124 total points in back-to-back games against Iowa State (68) and San Jose State (56) in 2010... Utah held WSU to minus-4 rushing yards, the fifth-fewest yards ever gained by a Ute opponent. The fifth time in Utah history, and the first since 1981, that Utah held an opponent to negative rushing yards.

Washington sophomore TE **Austin Seferian-Jenkins**, who leads all FBS tight ends with 48 receptions (5.3 per game) has tied the school single-season record by a tight end set by Jerramy Stevens in 2000. He also established a career receiving yards record for Husky tight ends with 1,170 yards.

Sophomore TB **Bishop Sankey** rushed for a career-high 189 yard on a career-high 29 carries while also matching a career-high with two touchdowns in the Huskies' road victory at California. Sankey had rushed for 95 yards by the end of the first quarter and for 124 yards by halftime. With 855 yards this season, he needs 145 over the next three games to reach the 1,000-yard mark. It would be the fifth time in six seasons a Husky has rushed for 1,000 yards in a season.

USC TABBED TO WIN PAC-12 TITLE IN PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

UNIVERSAL CITY, Calif. - USC is the favorite to win the 2012 Pac-12 Conference football title in a preseason poll of media members who cover the league. The Trojans were listed in the top spot in the North Division by 117 of the 123 voters participating in the poll, collecting 729 points. 102 of those pollsters tabbed the Trojans to come out on top in the Pac-12 Championship Game. Utah was picked to finish second in the South Division, collecting one first-place vote in the balloting for the division race. Arizona State claimed three of the other five first-place votes, with each of those members of the media casting a vote for the Sun Devils to capture the Pac-12 title.

Oregon was picked to win the North Division, garnering 732 points and 117 first place votes, while Stanford, which tallied five of the other six first place votes, was pegged to finish second in this year's poll. California, predicted by the voters to finish fourth in the North Division, claimed the remaining first place vote.

The media poll has correctly selected the Conference Champion in 28 of 51 previous polls, including 11 of the last 12. Following are the results of the preseason media poll (points 6-5-4-3-2-1, first-place votes in parentheses):

PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

The Pac-12 Championship Football Game will take place Friday, November 30 at 8 p.m. ET/5 p.m. PT and telecast to a national audience on FOX. The Championship game will match the winner of the North Division vs. the winner of the South Division. The game will be played on the campus of the division winner with the best overall conference record. The winner of the Pac-12 Championship will earn the league's automatic BCS berth.

TIE-BREAK PROCEDURES TO DETERMINE AND CHAMPIONSHIP GAME PARTICIPANTS & HOST

The division winner will be determined by the record in all games played (both divisional and cross-divisional) within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game representatives from each division:

Two-Team Tie.

1. Head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
 - a. If no game is played between the two tied teams or that game ends in a tie, the following tie-breaking procedures would be applied:
2. Record in games played within the division
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (Based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.
6. Total number of wins in a 12-game season. The following conditions will apply to the calculation of the total number of wins:
 - a. Only one win against a team from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision or lower division will be counted annually.
 - b. Any games that are exempted from counting against the annual maximum number of football contests per NCAA rules (current Bylaw 17.9.5.2) shall not be included.
7. Coin toss.

Multiple-Team Ties.

The following procedures will only be used to eliminate all but two teams, at which point the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

1. Head-to-head (Best record in games among the tied teams).
2. Record in games played within the division.
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.

Pac-12 Championship Game Host

The Pac-12 Championship Game Host will be determined by the record in all games played within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game host.

Tie-breaking Procedure.

1. Head-to-head, if applicable.
2. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of Pac-12 regular-season games.
3. Record against the next highest-placed common opponent in the conference (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the conference.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Coin toss.

PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS - 2012-13

The Pac-12 is in the third year of a four-year bowl cycle. The Pac-12 Conference has agreements with seven bowl partners. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion, unless said champion is ranked No. 1 or No. 2 in the final Bowl Championship Series rankings. If that were the case, the Pac-12 champion would play in the BCS National Championship Game hosted by the Discover Orange Bowl. Regardless of the disposition of the Pac-12 champion, a second Pac-12 team may be selected for an at-large berth in the Bowl Championship Series in any given year and other Pac-12 bowl partner arrangements provide for that occurrence. In addition to the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, Pac-12 bowl partners include, in order of selection, the Valero Alamo Bowl in San Antonio, Bridgeport Education Holiday Bowl in San Diego, Hyundai Sun Bowl in El Paso, the MAACO Bowl Las Vegas, the Kraft Fight Hunger Bowl in San Francisco, and the Gildan New Mexico Bowl in Albuquerque.
