The Pac-12 posted has posted a winning record outside league play for the 30th consecutive season . . . Since 1934, only one season witnessed the Conference capture more than 29 wins in non-league play - 2002 (32-15) when the league played an eight game conference schedule, allowing an additional 10 non-conference games to be played.

PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OFFENSE: Ka'Deem Carey, RB, Arizona

DEFENSE: Jordan Richards, SS, Stanford

SPECIAL TEAMS: Zane Gonzalez, PK, Arizona State

Running back **Ka'Deem Carey** of ARIZONA, safety **Jordan Richards** of STANFORD and ARIZONA STATE kicker **Zane Gonzalez** have been named offensive, defensive and special teams Pac-12 Players of the Week in football.

Carey, a junior from Tucson, Ariz., carried the ball a school-record 40 times for 236 yards and a game-clinching touchdown as Arizona beat Utah 35-24 on Saturday night at home. He gained 30-yards on his first carry of the game and ran for a 44-yard touchdown on his last carry with 90 seconds remaining to secure the Wildcats' first Conference win. The 236 rushing yards is Carey's second-highest career tally and third-highest in Arizona single-game history. The reigning national rushing champion now leads the nation with 161.0 rushing yards per game.

Richards, a junior from Folsom, Calif., intercepted two passes, broke up another pass and recorded a team-leading 10 tackles as Stanford rebounded after its first loss of the season to take down No. 9 UCLA 24-10 on Saturday afternoon. Both of Richards' interceptions set up Stanford touchdowns, which proved to be the difference in the game. It was his first multi-interception game of his career.

Gonzalez, a freshman from Deer Park, Texas, set a career-high for field goals, going 4-for-4 in the Sun Devil's 53-24 win over No. 20 Washington at Sun Devil Stadium on Saturday. He has connected on 11-straight field goal attempts and is 15-of-18 on the season. Gonzalez scored 17 points in the game, bringing his season total to 80 points and ranks No. 5 nationally in scoring at 11.4 ppg.

Also nominated for offensive player of the week honors were quarterbacks **Sean Mannion** of OREGON STATE and **Connor Halliday** of WASHINGTON STATE; running backs **Marion Grice** of Arizona State, **Byron Marshall** of OREGON, **Tyler Gaffney** of Stanford, and **Silas Redd** of USC and tailback **Michael Adkins** of COLORADO. Also nominated for defensive player of the week honors were defensive linemen **Sione Tuihalamka** of Arizona, **Will Sutton** of Arizona State, **Scott Crichton** of Oregon State, **Leonard Williams** of USC and **Trevor Reilly** of Utah; and safety **Randall Goforth** of UCLA. Also nominated for special teams player of the week honors were kickers Conrad Ukropina of Stanford and **Ka'imi Fairbairn** of UCLA, UTAH punter **Tom Hackett**; wide receiver/punt returner **Nelson Agholor** of USC; and Arizona running back **Terris Jones-Grigsby**.

AROUND THE PAC-12

GAME THEMES: UTAH travels to Los Angeles where it last defeated USC in 1916. The Utes will face a Trojan defense that allows just 110.3 rushing yards per game and is 16th nationally in total defense (333.9 yards per game). . . Within a stretch of 45 miles in Oregon, two games with major implications on the Pac-12 North Division race will feature Heisman hopefuls and explosive offenses. No. 12 UCLA visits No. 2 OREGON where the Bruins' **Brett Hundley** (324.7 yards total offense/game) looks to rebound following UCLA's first defeat of the season. Oregon QB **Marcus Mariota** (363.4 yards total offense/game) continues to have the Ducks moving on all cylinders as they are now averaging 643.1 yards in total offense (2nd in the FBS) and 57.6 points per game (2nd in the FBS). . . Meanwhile, in Corvallis, OREGON STATE and the nation's leading passer in **Sean Mannion** (427.4 yards per game) will get tested by No. 8 STANFORD whose defense ranks fourth in the Pac-12 in total defense (363.4 ypg) and are posting 2.71 sacks per game. . . ARIZONA looks to pick up its second league victory when it travels to COLORADO. Wildcat RB **Ka'Deem Carey** leads the FBS in rushing (161.0 yards per game) and is coming off a season-best 236 yards in Arizona's win over Utah. Colorado, coming off its win over Charleston Southern, is looking to get over .500 this late in the season for the first time since 2008. . . CALIFORNIA and WASHINGTON meet in Seattle with both teams looking to snap a couple of streaks of their own. The Bears have dropped four straight (and nine straight conference games), while the Huskies have dropped three straight. Cal's pass offense (359.9 ypg) will test the Washington's Pac-12-leading pass defense (194.9 ypg).

THE RECORD BOOK: WASHINGTON STATE junior QB **Connor Halliday** set multiple Pac-12 records in WSU's 62-38 loss at Oregon.

THE RECORD BOOK, PART II: With his 481 passing yards at California, OREGON STATE junior QB **Sean Mannion** set a Pac-12 consecutive-game passing record with 971 yards (school record 493 yards vs. Washington State in his previous game).

UTAH (4-3, 1-3) at USC (4-3, 1-2)

UTAH: Sophomore LB **Jared Norris** and senior LB/DE **Trevor Reilly** each posted 14 tackles in the loss at Arizona, with Reilly adding 3.0 tackles for loss, including two sacks. Reilly (58 tackles) and Norris (56) rank 1-2 on the Utes in tackles this season. . . During Saturday's game at USC, Norris will have the opportunity to meet up with former high school teammate and USC starting QB Cody Kessler (Centennial HS, Bakersfield, Calif.). . . 33 players on Utah's roster hail from California. . . Utah leads the Pac-12 and rank 11th nationally in sacks (3.14 per game).

USC: Senior TB **Silas Redd** rushed for 112 yards at Notre Dame - his 11th career 100-yard game. . . Sophomore DE **Leonard Williams** posted a game-best nine tackles at Notre Dame as the USC defense limited the Irish to 295 total yards, including just 47 yards in the second half. USC's defense leads the Pac-12 and ranks 16th in the FBS allowing 333.9 yards per game. . . USC has won eight of the last nine meetings with Utah, and have dropped just one home game to the Utes back in 1916 (27-12).

LAST MEETING: The Trojans quickly found themselves in a 14-0 deficit in the first three minutes after a couple miscues, but Matt Barkley responded by connecting on 23 of 30 passes for 303 yards and 3 TDs in the 38-28 win in Salt Lake City. Marqise Lee added 12 receptions for 196 yards.

No. 12 UCLA (5-1, 2-1) at No. 2 OREGON (7-0, 4-0)

UCLA: The UCLA defense has held its first six opponents to less than 30 points for the first time since the 2001 season. . . Sophomore S **Randall Goforth** had a career-high 19 tackles at Stanford. Most tackles by a Bruin since LB Reggie Carter recorded 20 against BYU in 2008. . . The Bruins were held to 10 points at Stanford, snapping a streak of five games in which they scored 34 or more points. UCLA is one of four Pac-12 teams among the top 20 in scoring, currently 20th in the FBS at 39.8 points per game. . . The 14 points allowed to Stanford in the third quarter were the first points the Bruins have allowed in the third quarter all season as it has now outscored the opposition in the opening frame of the second half, 74-14.

OREGON: Sophomore QB **Marcus Mariota** has thrown at least one TD pass in all 20 games of his career, and extended his streak of passing and rushing for scores to nine straight games. . . Mariota has now gone 265 attempts without an interception, extending his Pac-12 record. His last pick came in the first half vs. Stanford in 2012. . . Sophomore RB **Byron Marshall** had a career-high 192 yards rushing, his fifth 100-yard rushing game this season and sixth of his career. . . The Ducks have eclipsed 50 points for the sixth time in seven games and currently rank second in the FBS in scoring (57.6 ppg). . . Autzen Stadium sellout streak was extended to 93 games.

LAST MEETING: The Ducks captured the inaugural Pac-12 Championship in Eugene with a 49-31 victory over the Bruins. LaMichael James rushed 25 times for 219 yards and scored 3 TDs, while Darron Thomas completed 20-of-33 passes for 219 yards and 3 TDs, while rushing for 60 yards and 1 TD.

ARIZONA (4-2, 1-2) at COLORADO (3-3, 0-3)

ARIZONA: Junior RB **Ka'Deem Carey** moved into the national lead in rushing with 161.0 yards per game. He posted 236 rushing yards on an Arizona single-game record 40 carries against Utah, which ranks as his second-highest career tally and the third-highest in Arizona single-game history. . . Carey is fifth on the UA career rushing list with 3,159 yards and is five yards away from moving up to fourth. . . He also leads and is just one of two FBS players to average over 100 rushing yards per game in his career (108.9). . . Senior LB **Marquise Flowers** returned an interception 14 yards for a TD against Utah. It was the team's ninth interception this season, and the fourth time the Wildcats posted a pick-six. . . In comparison, senior QB **B.J. Denker** has thrown just two interceptions in 164 attempts.

COLORADO: Freshman RB **Michael Adkins II** rushed for 137 yards (10.5 avg) for a CU freshman record 4 TDs in the win over Charleston Southern. The last Buffalo to score four rushing TDs in a game was Lawrence Vickers vs. Missouri in Boulder in 2005. . . Despite a 3-3 record on the field, the Buffs haven't been so successful in the pre-game coin toss as they have come up on the wrong side of the coin in all six games this season. . .

LAST MEETING: Arizona's Ka'Deem Carey rushed for a Pac-12 record 366 yards and 5 TDs in a 56-31 win over the Buffs in Tucson. B.J. Denker, who made his first career start, was 12-of-14 for 136 yards and 2 TDs.

No. 8 STANFORD (6-1, 4-1) at OREGON STATE (6-1, 4-0)

STANFORD: Senior RB **Tyler Gaffney** rushed for a career-high 171 yards on a career-best 36 attempts in the win over UCLA. It was his fourth game rushing for 100 or more yards this season, fifth of his career. Of Gaffney's 144 rushing attempts this season, only four carries resulted in a loss of yardage. He's gained 746 yards, netting 741 yards this season. . . Stanford extended its home winning streak to 13 games. It is 34-3 at Stanford Stadium since the final home game of 2007. . . In four home games this season, the Cardinal have out-rushed the opposition, 808-298. . . With the win over UCLA, the Cardinal have now won six straight in the series for the longest such streak in the 85-game series. Three of Stanford's last nine wins have come over UCLA. . . Including its Rose Bowl victory over Wisconsin, Stanford has won 30 of its last 31 games played in California (only loss came against No. 6 Oregon in 2011).

OREGON STATE: The Beavers remain undefeated in league play and look to keep pace with Oregon in the North Division. . . Junior QB **Sean Mannion** continues to post big numbers through the air as he has now thrown for 350+ yards in an OSU record seven straight games as he put up 481 yards in the 49-17 win at California. . . Junior WR **Brandin Cooks** was the recipient of 13 passes for 232 yards (second most in a game in OSU history). Cooks' 76 receptions this season already rank eighth on OSU's single-season chart, while his 1,176 receiving yards are seventh on the single-season list, and 25 more yards than he collected all of last season. . . Cooks leads the nation with 12 TD receptions. . . Starting with No. 8 Stanford this Saturday, OSU's next five opponents have a combined record of 26-9.

LAST MEETING: In his first collegiate start, Kevin Hogan completed 22-of-29 passes for 254 yards and 3 TDs as No. 16 Stanford rallied past No. 13 Oregon State, 27-23. Stepfan Taylor added 116 yards on the ground.

CALIFORNIA (1-6, 0-4) at WASHINGTON (4-3, 1-3)

CALIFORNIA: The Bears head to Seattle in search of their first conference win of the season and to snap a nine-game skid in Pac-12 play dating back to last season. . . Since 2002, the Bears have won seven of their last 10 games played in the State of Washington. . . Sophomore WR **Chris Harper** pulled in six catches for 93 yards in the loss to Oregon State. He is currently second in the league in receptions (7.4 per game) and third in receiving yardage (99.7 per game). . . Freshman RB/KR **Khalfani Muhammad** garnered a personal-best 52-yard kick return in the third quarter vs. Oregon State and had five returns in the game for 148 yards. He's currently second in the Pac-12, averaging 24.4 yards per return.

WASHINGTON: Legendary Washington coach Don James passed away Sunday. James spent 18 seasons leading the Huskies to a 153-58-2 record, six Pac-10 titles and a shared national title in 1991. . . The Huskies look to snap a three-game losing streak - those three opponents have a combined record of 18-3. Washington's next five opponents have a combined record of 19-15. . . Senior LB **Princeton Fuimaono** led the Huskies with 12 tackles at Arizona State. His 56 tackles/8.0 per game rank him seventh in the league. . . Senior QB **Keith Price** now has 7,746 career passing yards and occupies the No. 2 spot on the school's all-time list for passing yardage. Cody Pickett (1999-03) owns the UW career mark with 10,220 yards. . . Junior TE **Austin Seferian-Jenkins** has 17 career touchdown receptions, easily the most in UW history by a tightend, but also tied for fourth-most in Husky history among all players.

LAST MEETING: Washington posted a 21-13 victory in Berkeley as both teams were plagued by turnovers. The Huskies were led by the rushing of Bishop Sankey, who posted 189 yards on 29 carries and 2 TDs. Cal's C.J. Anderson rushed for a career-best 160 yards on 22 carries.

PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

The Pac-12 Championship Football Game will take place Saturday, December 7 at 8 p.m. ET/5 p.m. PT and telecast to a national audience on ABC/ESPN. The Championship game will match the winner of the North Division vs. the winner of the South Division. The game will be played on the campus of the division winner with the best overall conference record. The winner of the Pac-12 Championship will earn the league's automatic BCS berth.

TIE-BREAK PROCEDURES TO DETERMINE DIVISION CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP GAME HOST

The Division Champion will be determined by the record in all games played (both divisional and cross-divisional) within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game representatives

Two-Team Tie.

1. Head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
 - a. If no game is played between the two tied teams or that game ends in a tie, the following tie-breaking procedures would be applied:
2. Record in games played within the division
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (Based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.
6. Total number of wins in a 12-game season. The following conditions will apply to the calculation of the total number of wins:
 - a. Only one win against a team from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision or lower division will be counted annually.
 - b. Any games that are exempted from counting against the annual maximum number of football contests per NCAA rules (current Bylaw 17.9.5.2) shall not be included.
7. Coin toss.

Multiple-Team Ties.

The following procedures will only be used to eliminate all but two teams, at which point the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

1. Head-to-head (Best record in games among the tied teams).
2. Record in games played within the division.
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.

Pac-12 Championship Game Host

The Pac-12 Championship Game Host will be determined by the record in all games played within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game host.

Tie-breaking Procedure.

1. Head-to-head, if applicable.
2. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of Pac-12 regular-season games.
3. Record against the next highest-placed common opponent in the conference (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the conference.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Coin toss.

PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS - 2013-14

The Pac-12 is in the final year of a four-year bowl cycle. The Pac-12 Conference has agreements with seven bowl partners. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion, unless said champion is ranked No. 1 or No. 2 in the final Bowl Championship Series rankings. If that were the case, the Pac-12 champion would play in the BCS National Championship Game hosted by the Discover Orange Bowl. Regardless of the disposition of the Pac-12 champion, a second Pac-12 team may be selected for an at-large berth in the Bowl Championship Series in any given year and other Pac-12 bowl partner arrangements provide for that occurrence. In addition to the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, Pac-12 bowl partners include, in order of selection, the Valero Alamo Bowl in San Antonio, Bridgeport Education Holiday Bowl in San Diego, Hyundai Sun Bowl in El Paso, the Las Vegas Bowl, the Kraft Fight Hunger Bowl in San Francisco, and the Gildan New Mexico Bowl in Albuquerque.
