COACHES:

CLINT CONQUE is in his 14th season at the helm of the UCA football program. He has an **99-54-0** overall record and is the winningest coach in the long history of UCA football, dating back to 1908.

Conque came to UCA from the offensive coordinator position at Louisiana Tech in 2000. He passed UCA Sports Hall of Famer Harold Horton as the winningest coach in school history with a victory over Eastern Illinois in 2010. Conque and Horton are the only two coaches in school history to reach the 70-win mark.



Conque led the Bears to their first-ever

NCAA Playoff appearance in 2001. UCA finished 9-3 that season, the most wins in a year since the 1992 season. He took them back to the playoffs in 2005, winning two straight road games and advancing to the national quarterfinals.

His Bears finished the 2008 season with the best record in the Southland Conference at 6-1 but were ineligible for the official league title due to their transition. Conque was named the SLC Coach of the Year that season and again in 2012.

Two years ago, Conque took the Bears to their first-ever Division I Playoff appearance, and won the first road playoff game by a Southland Conference team since 2004, beating Tennessee Tech in Cookeville, Tenn. The Bears made the second round of the playoffs again last season, finishing 9-3 and Conque was a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award for a third time.

Conque, 52, is a Louisiana native who played collegiately at Nicholls State after graduating from Catholic High School in Baton Rouge and playing two years at Southwest Mississippi Community College.

Conque was a first-team AP All-American as a outside linebacker at Nicholls State. He was inducted into the Nicholls State Athletic Hall of Fame in 2006. His previous coaching stops were at Louisiana Tech, Samford University and McNeese State.

MIKE MACINTYRE is in his first season as the head coach of the Buffaloes.

MacIntyre came to Colorado from San Jose State, where he put together a 16-21 record over four seasons. The Spartans had their first 10-win season in 25 years in 2012 (10-2), beating Bowling Green 29-20 in the Military Bowl and finishing No. 21 in the nation.

MacIntyre, a Georgia Tech graduate, is a 22-year veteran of the coaching ranks, including stops at Duke, Ole Miss, Georgia, Davidson, UT Martin and Temple on the collegiate level, and with the New York Jets and Dallas Cowbovs in the NFL.

MacIntyre was a two-year letterman at Georgia Tech as a free safety

2008, 2012 SLC Champions 100 All-Americans 61 NCAA All-Academic picks and punt returner for Coach Bobby Ross. He also played two years at Vanderbilt under his father, Coach George MacIntyre.

THE SERIES:

The Bears and Buffaloes have never met on the football field. UCA has also never faced a Pac-12 team in football.

LAST YEAR:

The Bears went 9-3, winning nine games for the second straight season and for the third time since moving to Division I in 2006. UCA reached the second round of the FCS Playoffs for the second straight season, losing to perennial power Georgia Southern on the road. The Bears have yet to host an FCS playoff game in two seasons

UCA finished first in the Southland Conference last season for the second time since 2008. The Bears were a league-best 6-1 in 2008 but were ineligible for the league title because of the transition from Division II. UCA (6-1) was co-champion with Sam Houston State last season, a team the Bears beat 24-20 in Conway on Sept. 22 to earn the league's automatic bid to the playoffs.

UCA won four of the seven individual postseason awards given by the SLC, including Coach of the Year, Freshman of the Year (DE Jonathan Woodard), Offensive Player of the Year (QB Wynrick Smothers) and Offensive Lineman of the Year (Corey Howard).

LAST WEEK:

The Bears opened the 2013 season with an easy 58-7 victory over Southland Conference newcomer Incarnate Word on "The Stripes."

UCA rolled up 537 yards of total offense and scored on its five possessions of the game, and six of its first seven. Senior QB Wynrick Smothers was a model of efficiency, completing his first 11 straight passes en route to a 27-for-31 performance, for 267 yards and a TD. Backups Ryan Howard and Taylor Reed combined to complete 7 of 10 for 114 yards and another

The UCA defense held UIW to just 231 yards of offense, with 68 yards of that coming on the Cardinals' only scoring drive late in the fourth quarter. UCA freshman Jatavious Wilson quickly answered that drive with a 93-yard kickoff return for a TD that set the final margin.

The victory was UCA's 13th consecutive at home, and 12th in a row since the installation of the purple-gray turf in 2011.

FIRST TIMERS:

Four Bears scored their first career touchdowns in Saturday's win, and another threw his first career TD pass in the purple and gray.

Sophomore running back Blake Veasley scored UCA's first two TDs, from 11 and 18 yards, in the first quarter. Freshman receiver/returner Jatavious Wilson scored three times, on the kickoff return and on TD passes of 29 yards from Smothers and 36 yards from Reed, his first at UCA.

Sophomore RB Danzel Williams, a transfer from Oklahoma, had 1and 3-yard rushing TDs for his first UCA scores. Redshirt freshman WR Desmond Smith fell on a blocked punt in the end zone for his first TD.

FBS WINS:

Seven FCS schools recorded victories over FBS schools on the opening week of the 2013 season, including SLC member McNeese State's 53-21 road win over South Florida.

The victories included: Eastern Washington 49, #25 Oregon State 46; North Dakota State 24, Kansas State 21; Towson 33, UConn 18; Northern Iowa 28, Iowa State 20; Eastern Illinois 40, San Diego State 19; Southern Utah 22. South Alabama 21.

Six Southland Conference schools will play FBS opponents again this week, including UCA at Colorado.

CENTURY MARK:

UCA coach Clint Conque is one victory away from his 100th career victory as head coach of the Bears. His record, in his 14th season, is 99-54. His teams have won at least 8 games eight times, including an 11-3 mark in 2005, which tied the school record for victories.

The Bears have recorded back-to-back nine-win seasons over the past two years, advancing to the second round of the FCS Playoffs both vears.

MISSING IN ACTION:

The Bears will have five players suspended to begin the 2013 season, including starting running back Willie Matthews for the opening game against UIW.

Matthews missed the season opener, while junior offensive lineman C.J. Simon, junior receiver Jacoby Walker, junior offensive lineman Jordan Kersh and redshirt freshman receiver Wyatt Hikins will miss the first two games. All are due to violations of team rules, according to head coach Clint Conque.

BY THE NUMBERS:

The Bears converted 10 of 14 third-down attempts last week, and were 1 of 1 on fourth downs as well. UCA had a time of possession advantage of 33:24 to 26:36, including 10:11 in the first period when the Bears scored three times.

UCA punted for a 45.0-yard average and averaged 55.0 yards per kickoff return. UCA guarterbacks completed passes to 10 different receivers, with sophomore Blake Gardner grabbing a career-high 10.

The Bears averaged 7.2 yards per play (75 for 537) and totaled 25 first downs to UIW's 12.

UCA played 60 players, including four true freshmen (OL Bryan Manley, WR Jatavious Wilson, DL Terrence Partee, DL Jordan Toliver).

Junior PK Eddie Camara was 7 of 8 on PATs (missed first one) and also made a 42-yard field goal, after making a 37-yarder that was nullified

THE LEAGUES:

The Bears have been members of the Southland Conference since they moved to Division I FCS in 2006. UCA's record in SLC games is officially 30-13. The Bears also beat two SLC teams (Sam Houston & Stephen F. Austin) in their first year in the league when they did not play a full league schedule.

The Buffaloes are in their third year as members of the Pac-12 after moving from the Big 12. UCA has never faced a team from the Pac-12 in football.

NATIONAL POLLS:

The Bears, who closed the 2012 season ranked 10th in the two national FCS polls, were ranked No. 6 and No. 7 in the FCS preseason polls this summer. UCA moved up to No. 5 in the FCS Coaches Poll this week and remained No. 7 in The Sports Network poll.

UCA will play seven teams this season that were either ranked or receiving votes in the preseason polls. That includes two-time national runnerup Sam Houston State in the regular-season finale on Nov. 23. The Bears also face FBS Colorado on the road in Week 2.

UCA has finished in the Top 25 in four of its seven seasons at the NCAA Division I level.

PRESEASON ALL-SLC:

UCA had 12 student-athletes selected overall and a league-high nine first-team selections on the preseason All-Southland Conference football team selected by the coaches.

The Bears, co-champions in the SLC last season, were led by reigning SLC Offensive Player of the Year Wynrick Smothers, a senior quarterback from Destrehan, La., and last year's Freshman of the Year, defensive end Jonathan Woodard of Brentwood. Tenn.

Both were on the first-team squad, along with junior wide receiver Dezmin Lewis, junior offensive lineman Cole Caruthers, junior placekicker Eddie Camara, senior defensive lineman Matt Hornbuckle, senior linebacker Justin Heard and senior defensive back Radarius Winston.

Second-team selections were senior offensive lineman Dominque Allen, sophomore offensive lineman Kyle Stouffer and senior defensive back Marcus Peters.

SIX PACK:

The Bears won six conference games last season for the third time since 2006, the only school in the Southland to do that. UCA was 6-1 in 2008, 2011 and 2012.

UCA is the only SLC team to have three nine-win seasons during that time period.

SOMEBODY'S WATCHING ME:

Five UCA players were named to preseason Watch Lists at the FCS level. They include: senior quarterback Wynrick Smothers (Walter Payton Award); senior safety Jestin Love (Buck Buchanan Award), and sophomore defensive end Jonathan Woodard, senior tight end Chase Dixon and junior placekicker Eddie Camara

TOP FRESHMEN:

Coach Conque has indicated that at least four true freshman are expected to see action early this season, with as many as 6 to 8 possible throughout the season.

Those expected to play early include wide receiver Jatavious Wilson (Bastrop, La.), defensive lineman Terrence Partee (Memphis), offensive lineman Bryan Manley (Stephenville, Texas). and noseguard Jordan Toliver (Duncanville, Texas).

Others that could see action are offensive linemen Stockton Mallett (Yellville) and Gilberto Garcia (Morrilton) and safety Tirell Wellmaker (Lake Charles, La.).

NATIONAL RANKINGS:

Then-junior quarterback Wynrick Smothers finished last season ranked 12th in total offense (296.0 yards per game) and 15th in passing efficiency (145.6) among FCS schools.

UCA was 10th in scoring offense (34.83), 10th in tackles for loss (7.58), 13th in punt returns (13.65) and 17th in passing efficiency (146.28) as a team. The Bears were also 22nd in passing offense (266.58), 25th in turnover margin (.50) and 26th in sacks (2.5).

ON THE STRIPES:

Through two+ seasons, the Bears are a perfect 12-0 on "The Stripes", their unique purple & gray striped turf field. UCA hosts six games at home this season at First Security Field at Estes Stadium, including two Southland Television Network games and one on ESPN3.

Over the past seven seasons, UCA's home record is 34-6, including 7-0 in 2008, 5-0 in 2011 and 6-0 last season.

The turf is GeoSurface, the same that was put down on UCA's baseball field (Bear Stadium) and softball field (Farris Field) over the past three years. The field features alternating purple and gray panels every five yards, with a large midfield logo and two large logos behind both end zones.

UCA was the last team in the Southland Conference to change from natural grass to artificial turf in 2011.

NEW FACES:

The Bears have two new coaches on the staff this season, but they certainly aren't new to the program.

Former UCA offensive lineman Robert "Boomer" Cunningham and former UCA linebacker Seth Allison have joined the staff. Cunningham, from St. Louis, played for the Bears from 2006-2008 and was a graduate assistant the past two seasons. Cunningham is director of football operations and recruiting coordinator.

Allison, from Jonesboro, was a first-team All-SLC linebacker in 2011 and 2012. He earned his MBA from UCA in 2012. Allison is assistant defensive backs coach.

PLAYING UP:

The Bears faced their first BCS opponent and their first Southeastern Conference foe in Ole Miss to open last season, losing 49-27 after leading 20-14 at halftime. The crowd of 50,545 at Vaught Hemingway Stadium in Oxford was the largest to ever watch a UCA athletic team.

The Bears will travel to Boulder, Colo., this week for their second FBS matchup against the Colorado Buffaloes. The Buffs averaged 45,372 at home in 2012.

APR LEADERS:

The Bears led the Southland Conference in APR (Academic Progress Rate) for the third straight year in 2012, with a score of 960. UCA was one of only two FCS schools nationally to lead its respective league three consecutive years.

The Bears also led all Division I football teams in the state of Arkansas as well. The University of Arkansas and Arkansas State had scores of 938, while UA-Pine Bluff scored 907.

The UCA football program had a 960 score for the 2012-13 school year, with the numbers always a year behind. UCA's past four scores have been 936, 942, 951 and 960 for a 947.25 average over the four-year window used by the NCAA.

THE OFFENSE:

The Bears' offense has been consistently prolific during their time in the Southland, averaging 3,139 passing yards and 25 touchdowns per season since joining the league, with a 3,000-yard passer in four of the past six seasons and three different quarterbacks throwing for 30 or more touchdowns in a season during the last five years.

SENIOR CLASS:

UCA has 14 seniors on the roster for the 2013 season. They include: OL Dominique Allen; DB Karl Brady; DB Dominique Brown; TE Chase Dixon; DE Markeith Gaines; LB Justin Heard; DL Matt Hornbuckle; DB Josh Jones; DB Jestin Love; LS/SS Kirby O'Meara; DB Marcus Peters; QB Wynrick Smothers, and DB Radarius Winston.

SMOTHERS' SEASON:

UCA senior quarterback Wynrick Smothers put his name in the record books last season in his first year as a starting quarterback. Smothers, who had started just one game entering last season, set the school record for pass completions with 277, and tied for second with 31 touchdowns and 427 pass attempts. His 3,103 passing yards was the fourth-best in a single season at UCA.

Ironically, UCA's career leader in passing yards, pass attempts, completions and touchdowns is Nathan Brown, who happens to be UCA's quarterback coach. Brown had 10,558 yards and 100 touchdowns from 2005-08, completing 856 of 1,267 for his career.

SEASON OPENERS:

The Bears are now 10-4 in season openers under the direction of 14th-year head coach Clint Conque after last week's 58-7 win over Incarnate Word. The last season-opening loss prior to last season at Ole Miss was at Hawaii in 2009, a game the Bears had won until the Warriors scored the go-ahead touchdown with 1:22 remaining.

THE SUITES:

First Security Field at Estes Stadium debuted a dozen new luxury suites for the home opener last season.

The 12 suites are located above the stands on the east side of the stadium. UCA's athletic administration offices moved into the floor just below the suites last September, also with a view of Estes Stadium.



LR TOUCHDOWN CLUB:

UCA head coach Clint Conque will be the featured speaker at the Little Rock Touchdown Club on Monday, Oct. 7.

Conque will address the club for the sixth consecutive year. He is among a list of prestigious speakers for the 2013 season, including Gene Chizik, Lou Holtz, Tom Osborne, Dan Hampton, Cliff Harris, Houston Nutt and Bret Bielema.

IN-STATE PLAYERS:

The Bears have 25 players from the state of Arkansas on the 2013 roster, including 13 listed on this week's depth chart.

UCA's No. 2 returning tackler is Jestin Love of West Memphis, while UCA All-SLC tight end Chase Dixon is from Fort Smith.

UCA has no players from the state of Colorado.

ARE YOU EXPERIENCED:

UCA had one of its most experienced offensive backfields in recent history last season, but this year a new crop of running backs will handle the duties.

The lone returnee with any experience is junior Willie Matthews of Bartlettt, Tenn. Matthews rushed for 236 yards on 35 carries, with 1 touchdown a year ago. Matthews got 153 of those yards against Bacone College, on just 10 attempts.

The other RBs in the mix include sophomore returnee Blake Veasley, Oklahoma transfer Danzel Williams and freshmen Jeff Anderson of Conway, Kelton Warren of Arlington, Texas, and Darrien Daniels of St. Louis.

On the other side of the ball, the defensive secondary is one of the most experienced in years. Five seniors, including All-SLC selections Jestin Love and Marcus Peter, are featured, along with Dominique Brown, Josh Jones and Karl Brady. Junior Marvin Mitchell and sophomore Dillion Winfrey both played a lot of football in 2012 as well.

Love, the 2010 SLC Freshman of the Year, has 12 career interceptions, including three returned for touchdowns.

HOME RECORD:

Over the past six seasons, the Bears have the most home victories (30) and the highest home winning percentage (.833) among all Southland Conference schools. UCA is also the only team to go undefeated at home three different times (2008, 2011, 2012) during that time.

UCA is 34-6 at home since moving to NCAA Division I in 2006.

WINNING SEASONS:

UCA has recorded 32 winning seasons in the past 37 years, dating backt o 1976.

UCA tied the school record with 11 victories in 2005, and have won nine games in each of the past two seasons. The Bears are a combined 65-31 over the past eight seasons, with seven of those at the Division I level

Head coach Clint Conque has had 10 winning seasons in 13 years at UCA.

SCORING STREAK:

The Bears have scored in 199 straight games, dating back to the 1995 season. UCA lost 19-0 at Delta State for their last shutout loss. The Bears have scored in 305 of their last 306 games, dating back to the 1986 season.

500 AND COUNTING:

The victory over Quincy in 2008 was win No. 500 for the Bears in the 103-year history of the program. UCA's all-time record is 536-364-40.

CALLING COACH CONQUE:

For the sixth consecutive year, UCA head coach Clint Conque and statewide radio personality Justin Acri will host a live call-in show every Thursday night from The Draft on Dave Ward Dr. in Conway.

Acri is the color commentator for Bears' radio broadcasts and the program director at The Buzz 103.7 in Little Rock. Acri also hosts the UCA Football Report, the weekly coach's show that runs on KATV, the ABC affiliate in Little Rock at 11:30 p.m. Sundays. The show will also air locally on Conway Corporation Channel 5 at 8:30 p.m. Wednesdays.

The Central Arkansas Football Report will also be broadcast at 11 a.m. on Comcast Sportsnet Houston in the Texas/New Mexico/Oklahoma/Louisiana/Arkansas area. A 6 p.m. Wednesday airing on Fox College Sports Central will cover the entire United States.

Acri and Conque will answer questions each Thursday from 7 to 8 p.m. from the live audience at The Draft and also field calls from fans (433-1037 or 1-800-477-1037).

WINNING WAYS:

UCA enters the 2013 season as the winningest college football team in the state of Arkansas since 2001. Their best outing was an 11-3 record back in 2005 when they reached the quarterfinal round of the NCAA Division II Playoffs and tied the school record for victories. Here are the records since 2001

ON THE TUBE:

UCA will have five games televised on the SLC TV Network and/or ESPN3 and/or CSN-Houston this season, with three of those at home at First Security Field at Estes Stadium.


UCA's most famous non-football alum is Scottie Pippen, a six-time NBA champion and two-time Olympic Dream Teamer.
