UCLA head coach Rick Neuheisel

opening remarks

"It was one of those games where you're nervous all week about it because you know they're coming off a win, and they're excited about playing at the Rose Bowl and all these relationships with guys on the other sideline. You've got all these other things going on. It was a frustrating week for me to just keep concentrating on our team getting better and so forth. I was very pleased with how we started the game. We're going to talk long and hard the next couple of days. We're going to play a game where we can't afford to have missed opportunities.

"I'm very pleased with the ability that our team has shown over the course of the season, that we have been able to respond and come back to work and not point fingers. We have played complete games the next time out. We find ourselves at 6-5 and, more importantly, with a chance to win the South Division. There weren't very many people in this room who believed that to be possible at the start of the season. Say all you want about the lack of great teams on this side of the division or blah blah blah, but the bottom line is that we're playing for a championship. I know our players will be excited about the opportunity. We certainly have great respect for the next opponent. We're looking forward to a whale of a ballgame. We finished tonight and that's within reach now.

on addressing the crowd after the win

"It was something I wanted to do after the last game of the season. If I'm fortunate enough to be here, I'll continue to do that at the end of the year. It's nice to do that to people who are so loyal. They get mad at you when things aren't going well and are elated when things do go well. We went 5-1 at home this year. That's a heck of a record. Since I've been here, that's the best record that we have had at home. I wanted to say thank you because they deserved it."

on not getting too excited after taking an early 14-0 lead

"It's one of the jobs of whoever is in charge to make sure that the focus is such that we are not celebrating too early. You don't want to take celebration away from your young people. You want to enjoy it and have fun. But the fun can't dissipate from the focus of what's going on on the field. I'm 50 now and I've got to be responsible with that. When I was 33, I would have been celebrating with them."

on playing Colorado after having coached there before

"Seeing those uniforms out there was a little different. When I left Colorado to go to Washington, we played them the next two years. There were still a lot of hard feelings, if you will, and players that certainly I'd been involved in recruiting. That was much more difficult. Coaching against guys where you had been in their living rooms and had convinced them to come and be a part of the program. It was fun and surreal to see Jon Embree as the head coach and a number of guys on that staff that I grew up with in this business. I was excited with how we were able to handle our end of the deal."

on quarterback Kevin Prince

"You know what, a complete game. He wants the one pass back where he missed Shaq [Evans] over the top. That's exactly what the quarterback in this offense needs to do. He needs to handle both parts of the job and take advantage of big plays when they're available. I'm happy for him. And now I want more. That's just the way it is."

on being able to play USC for the chance to win the Pac-12 South

"We're playing 'SC for the championship. That's the way it should be. That's the way it used to be. When I was in school, this was the game you always pointed to. In 1981, if we had beat them, we would have gone to the Rose Bowl. My senior year, we needed to beat them to go to the Rose Bowl. It's the nature of the beast. When I first got back here, that's what I longed for. It's not just the championship of L.A. but also for the championship of much bigger stakes."

on the importance of a strong offensive line

"Always it results in great success. If you're stout up front, and do a great job, you'll have an opportunity to play well. For Kai Maiava, it was an important game for him. He wanted to play well and I thought he played great up front. Certainly, it was a complete effort."

Colorado head coach Jon Embree

opening statement

"We had the turnover early that hurt our defense. We missed some protections and some pressures that we should have been able to pick up. We didn't do that. Playing from behind like we did, we couldn't sustain anything and couldn't get any first downs. We had to stay on the field to give us a chance. I think our defense played well in spurts, but at the end we just couldn't tackle. The last two or three drives we had there was just poor tackling."

on optimism about his running attack

"I felt that we were starting to find our rhythm up front with the offensive line so that we could run the ball. Coming in, I felt that we could be balanced, be able to run and throw."

on his team's confidence level after last week's win

"You have to come out and match their energy and passion and we didn't do that. We were OK early, but the first pick that turned into six and having a chance to come back and do something after that, we just couldn't sustain anything. Every time we got a turnover or a stop from them, we went three and out. We can't do that."

on playing against his son, UCLA wide receiver Taylor Embree

"Never want to do it again. I'm just glad it's a one-time deal. It's very awkward. You're cheering against him. After the game, I told him I loved him. I told him congratulations for getting bowl eligible, because that was his goal going into his senior year. He didn't want to finish by not going to a bowl."

on finishing out the season on a high note

"We have one game left at Utah to try to end our road streak. It's something our seniors and myself have talked about, finding a way to do that. They have one game left. We have three practices left and four days of football left for the majority of those guys and then they never play again. We've already started on Utah because it's a short week, so we'll see what happens in Salt Lake."

on the program's foundation

"There has been a foundation built, but there hasn't been the consistency. We'll evaluate everything after the season. I'm sure there will be some things on both sides of the ball that we will tweak and try to improve on."

QUICKLY UCLA now lead the series **4-3 (2-2** in Los Angeles/Pasadena), snapping a two-game CU win streak ... The Buffs are now **2-13-1** all-time in the state of California, dropping both two appearances this year (lost 48-7 at Stanford on Oct. 8), the first time CU played in the state twice in the same season; Colorado will travel here twice in 2012, with games at Fresno State and USC ... It was CU's **23rd** straight road loss (17 in league games), dating back to its last win in 2007 (at Texas Tech) ... The Buffs drop to **50-11** dating back to 1985 against unranked opponents in November ... Colorado wore black helmets for just the third time in its history, the first time on the road, thus the inaugural black-white-black look from head-to-toe (these particular black helmets debuted for the USC game back on Nov. 4) ... Hollywood: CU officials invited the South Park creators, Trey Parker and Matt Stone, along with animator Eric Stough, all CU alums, to the game but their schedules didn't allow for them to attend; former CU hoopster-turned-actor, **Poncho Hodges**, did attend; he's been in a few movies and cameo appearances on shows such as *Law & Order*; he's waiting to see if he'll get a gig on Season 5 of *True Blood* (he was in two episodes in Season 4) ... The last time CU played in a game with the Goodyear (or any) blimp overhead was in 2002 (against UCLA at the Rose Bowl) ... UCLA gained 160 of its 260 first half yards on second down, when it converted 7-of-11 times for first downs (including 6-of-9 times on 2nd-&-5 or longer) ... Colorado now has at least one quarterback sack in **42** of the last **44** games ... UCLA's 339 rushing yards marked the second time the opponent topped 300 this season (Oregon, 371) ... CU will close a regular season with two road games for the first time since 1989 next week at Utah.

BURGER TIME CU coach Jon Embree arranged for the **In & Out Burger Cookout Trailer** to be at the team hotel (Hilton Glendale) upon the Buffs' arrival after a quick walk through at

the Rose Bowl Friday afternoon; the entire CU contingent were treated to the trendy burgers.

PHOTO OPP Jon Embree posed pregame with son **Taylor**, a UCLA senior wide receiver, for a senior day portrait since the elder Embree couldn't be present at the pregame ceremonies; spied by UCLA coach **Rick Neuheisel** during the shot, Neuheisel yelled toward Taylor, "Hey... no talking to the enemy!" forcing both to laugh. Many in Embree's family attending the game wore half-jerseys: half Colorado, half UCLA.

INDIVIDUAL LINER NOTES

—**P Darragh O'Neill's** second punt, from the UCLA 45, went for a touchback, just the second time this year he had a kick go into the end zone; he came into the game with the third best ratio in the nation of inside-the-20 punts to touchbacks (17-to-1); his first six kicks inside opponent territory had all been placed inside-the-20.

—**OG Ryan Miller**, who played all but one snap in the first 11 games (724/725), was called for just his second and third penalties all year.

TB RODNEY STEWART (21-77 RUSH, 7-36 RECEIVING) Stewart took over the all-time lead at Colorado in receptions by a running back, as he now has 91; he passed Lee Rouson, who had 86 from 1980-84. He has 959 career receiving yards, already the CU best, and he needs 41 yards at Utah next week to become the 27th player in the NCAA (FBS) history to have 3,000 rush/1,000 receiving in a career.

WR TONEY CLEMONS (3-50-1 TD RECEIVING) He caught a touchdown pass for the fourth straight game; the school record is five, set by **WR Rae Carruth** during the 1996 season.

QB TYLER HANSEN (31-16-3, 127, 1 TD) He moved into fourth place in career passing yards (5,441; passing Koy Detmer, 5,390) and in total offense (5,915; trails Darian Hagan, 5,808). He is tied John Hessler (1994-97) with his 34th career touchdown pass.

UCLA Notes

--With the win, the Bruins earned their sixth of the season and have qualified for a bowl game for the 10th time in the last 12 seasons.

--The Bruins are now 5-2 all-time against Colorado and 1-1 in games at The Rose Bowl.

--The Bruins went 4-0 in Pac-12 home games this season, the first time they have gone undefeated in conference home contests since they went 4-0 in 2005.

--The 45 points scored were the most since the Bruins had 45 in a win at Stanford on Sept. 1, 2007. The 553 yards of total offense were one short of a season high (554 vs. Houston). The 328 yards rushing were a season high and the most since Oct. 2, 2010 against Washington State (437). The Bruins posted their fifth 200-yard rushing game this season and the ninth over the last two years.

--The 39-point margin of victory was the largest since the Bruins beat Rice by 42 (63-21) on Sept. 10, 2005.

--The six points allowed by the Bruins were the fewest since Oct. 4, 2008 against Washington State (3 pts.). The 229 total yards allowed and the 87 yards rushing were the fewest allowed this season by UCLA's defense.

--The Bruins are 14-0 under head coach Rick Neuheisel when holding an opponent under 20 points.

--The Bruins have held an opponent to less than 100 yards rushing 10 times during Neuheisel's tenure and have a 9-1 record.

--Redshirt junior quarterback Kevin Prince had a career-high four touchdown passes. The four TD's were the most for a Bruin since Ben Olson had five at Stanford on Sept. 1, 2007. Prince now has 293 completions in his career, which is eighth on UCLA's all-time list.

--Redshirt junior running back Johnathan Franklin recorded his 10th-career, 100-yard rushing game. He has 2,550 rushing yards for his career, which moves him past Maurice Jones-Drew into 10th on UCLA's all-time list.

--The fourth-quarter touchdown by sophomore running back Malcolm Jones was the first of his career.

--Senior wide receiver Nelson Rosario posted his fifth-career, 100-yard receiving game and became the 10th UCLA receiver to surpass 2,000 yards (has 2,091 for his career, which ranks seventh in UCLA history). His 130 career receptions are eighth all-time, two behind fellow senior Taylor Embree, who is seventh with 132. Rosario also has the ninth-best, single-season receiving mark with 890.

--Redshirt junior tight end Joseph Fauria had his fifth and sixth touchdown catches of the season in the first and fourth quarters, the most TD receptions since Mercedes Lewis had 10 in 2005.

--Redshirt junior cornerback Andrew Abbott recorded his first-career, two-interception game.

--Senior linebacker Sean Westgate posted his third interception of the season in the first quarter.

--Redshirt freshman linebacker Eric Kendricks posted his second sack of the season in the first quarter.
