PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OFFENSE

Josh Rosen, Fr., QB, UCLA

Completed 28-of-35 for 351 yards and 3 TDs in 34-16 win over Virginia. First true freshman QB to start season-opener for the Bruins. Was 14-of-14 on passing attempts during UCLA's four touchdown scoring drives.

DEFENSE

Justin Thomas, Jr., DB, UTAH

In 24-17 win over Michigan, Thomas returned an interception 55 yards for a touchdown in the fourth quarter that gave the Utes a 24-10 lead. He also had four tackles, including three tackles in the fourth quarter.

SPECIAL TEAMS

Dante Pettis, So., WR, WASH

With Washington trailing 16-3 at No. 23 Boise State, Pettis took a punt at the 24 and raced 76 yards for a touchdown, changing the momentum of the game. It was the second time in his seven games that he returned a punt for a score.

QUICK HITS

IT'S EARLY, BUT...: After one game, the Pac-12 boasts the top passing team and top rushing team in the FBS with CALIFORNIA (471.0 yards passing per game) and OREGON (485.0 rushing yards per game). In addition, Oregon tops all FBS teams in total offense (731.0 ypg).

NFL ROSTERS: The Pac-12 was third among all conferences with 218 former players listed on NFL rosters (active players only) for opening-day, trailing only the SEC (306) and ACC (230). USC led all Pac-12 schools with 33 players on active rosters, followed by OREGON (27), CALIFORNIA (26) and STANFORD (26). (Source: www.nfl.com)

The Pac-12 posted has posted a winning record outside league for 30 consecutive seasons . . . The Pac-12 recorded a 37-9 record in non-conference action last season, posting the most wins ever outside of conference play. Since 1934, only one other season witnessed the Conference capture more than 29 wins in non-league play - 2002 (32-15) when the league played an eight game conference schedule, allowing an additional 10 non-conference games to be played.

AROUND THE PAC-12

THIS WEEK'S PAC-12 OPPONENTS: The Pac-12 has three games this week against Big Ten foes, all on the road - OREGON at Michigan State, OREGON STATE at Michigan, and WASHINGTON STATE at Rutgers. The Pac-12 has won seven of the last 10 meetings with the Big Ten, including a 1-1 mark in the opening week ... Four games are on tap vs. the Mountain West - ARIZONA at Nevada, San Diego State at CALIFORNIA, UCLA at UNLV, and Utah State at UTAH. While the Pac-12 was 11-3 vs. the Mountain West last season, it dropped both games against the Mountain West in the opening week.

IMPRESSIVE DEBUT: Several Pac-12 freshmen and other newcomers to the Conference stood out during the opening weekend. Here's a quick recap of those stellar performances:

RETURNING SIGNAL-CALLERS: Despite losing the services of Arizona State's Taylor Kelly (ASU career record with 10,223 yards of total offense), Oregon's Marcus Mariota (Heisman Trophy winner and Pac-12 career record-holder with 13,023 yards in total offense), Oregon State's Sean Mannion (Pac-12 career record-holder 13,600 passing yards), UCLA's Brett Hundley (UCLA's all-time leader in total offense - 11,713 yds) and Washington State's Connor Halliday (WSU's all-time leader with 11,304 passing yards and 90 TD passes), the Pac-12 is in good hands with six returning signal callers, while two others picked up three starts each last season for injured starters. Here's what's back behind center:

In the opening weekend, those eight combined to complete 184-of-284 (.648) for 1,783 yards, 14 TDs, 4 INT and 133 yards rushing. The other four first-time FBS starters didn't do so bad themselves as Oregon's **Vernon Adams Jr.**, Oregon State's **Seth Collins**, UCLA's **Josh Rosen** and Washington's **Jake Browning** combined to complete 77-of-112 (.688) for 839 yards, 7 TDs, 1 INT, 248 yards rushing.

PAC-12 CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION

#100Pac12: The Pac-12 Conference is set to celebrate 100 years of excellence. The yearlong celebration of the Conference centennial, including marking the date of the official formation 100 years ago on December 2, will kick off with the start of the football season and continue throughout the 2015-16 academic year.

The Conference's storied history dates back 100 years to Dec. 2, 1915 when four schools - the University of California, Oregon Agricultural College (now Oregon State University), the University of Oregon and the University of Washington - gathered at the historic Imperial Hotel in Portland, Ore., to form the Pacific Coast Conference.

Since that day, the Conference has been known for its widespread excellence - on the field, in the classroom, and with the contributions its graduates make in the world. No other Conference can match the collective achievements and distinctions accomplished over the last century.

The Conference has been home to some of sports' legendary athletes and coaches. Dubbed the "Conference of Champions," Pac-12 schools have won 478 NCAA titles, by far more than any other conference, as well as over 2,000 individual national championships.

The Pac-12 Network will commemorate the Centennial with special programming that will recognize the greatest athletes in the storied history of the Conference on linear and digital platforms throughout the year, including a special 60-minute program to unveil the Pac-12 All-Century Football team.

THIS WEEK'S GAMES

Utah State at UTAH

Fri., Sept. 11 • 7 p.m. MT • ESPN 2

UTAH: With the 24-17 win over Michigan, Utah has now defeated the Wolverines three consecutive times ... Utah set a Rice-Eccles Stadium record with an attendance mark of 47,825 fans. The Utes have now sold out 32-consecutive home games ... Senior LB **Gionni Paul** tied his career-high with 14 tackles for his third career game with double-digits in tackles. He also had 14 tackles against Michigan and Oregon State last season ... The Utes were successful in each of their three red zone attempts with two touchdowns and a field goal ... Senior All-American P **Tom Hackett** had four punts for 192 yards (48.0 average), including a career-long 74-yard boot ... Senior QB **Travis Wilson** completed 24-of-33 for 208 yards, and ran for 53 yards and one score. He connected with eight different receivers ... Freshman WR **Britain Covey** was on the receiving end of five passes for 58 yards.

OREGON STATE at Michigan

Sat., Sept. 12 • 12 noon ET • ABC

OREGON STATE: Captured its first win in the head coach Gary Andersen era, besting Weber State 26-7 at Reser Stadium ... The Beavers started their first true freshman quarterback since 1996, with **Seth Collins** getting the starting nod behind center. Collins rushed for 152 yards with two touchdowns, becoming the first quarterback to rush for 100 yards for the Beavers since Tim Alexander (205 yards vs. Northern Illinois) in 1996 ... On the other side of the ball, the OSU defense limited the Wildcats to 178 total yards and didn't allow a point, as Weber State's lone score came off an interception ... Junior LB **Rommel Mageo** led the defense with nine solo tackles, one sack, a broken up pass and a forced fumble.

Sacramento State at WASHINGTON

Sat., Sept. 12 • 11 a.m. PT • PAC12

WASHINGTON: Freshman QB **Jake Browning** became the first true freshman to win the starting QB spot, as well as the first true freshman QB to start for head coach Chris Petersen. Browning went 20 of 35 in passing for 150 yards and an interception in the 16-13 loss to No. 24/23 Boise State ... Sophomore WR **Dante Pettis** was the lone Husky to find the endzone, coming off a 76-yard punt return for a touchdown in the second half ... Sophomore LB **Victor Azeem** leads the Conference in solo tackles (11) and finished with 14 total tackles after week one.

Massachusetts at COLORADO

Sat., Sept. 12 • 12 noon MT • PACMT

COLORADO: The Buffs limited Hawai'i to 99 total rushing yards (2.9 yards per attempt). Much improved over last year's average of allowing 204.8 rushing yards per game at 5.6 yards per attempt. The last time Colorado allowed less than 100 yards rushing was vs. Colorado State (28 rushes/94 yards) on Sept. 1, 2013 ... On the flip side, CU rushed for 215 yards led by junior TB **Michael Adkins II** who carried the ball 22 times for 90 yards and 2 TDs. The 215 yards rushing were the most in a season opener since having 255 against Colorado State in 2004 ... Senior WR **Nelson Spruce** had 8 catches for 69 yards and now has 213 career catches, second only to 215 by Scotty McKnight (2007-10). His 2,365 career receiving yards are sixth, but he's now 186 yards out of first ... Junior PK **Diego Gonzalez** made his first two field goal attempts of his career, both from 40 yards out.

WASHINGTON STATE at Rutgers

Sat., Sept. 12 • 3:30 p.m. ET • ESPNU

WASHINGTON STATE: Sophomore QB **Luke Falk** completed 27-of-41 for 289 yards and two TDs, upping his career total to 15, in the 24-17 loss to Portland State ... Junior WR **Gabe Marks**, who redshirted last season, caught six passes for 76 yards and one touchdown, he now has 10 career touchdowns ... Senior LB **Jeremiah Allison** made a team-high 12 tackles against Portland State, his fourth career double-digit tackle game ... Despite falling to Portland State, the Cougars outgained PSU 411-294 in total offense.

San Diego State at CALIFORNIA

Sat., Sept. 12 • 2 p.m. ET • PAC12

CALIFORNIA: The 73 points scored in the 73-14 win over Grambling State were the second most scored in school history ... The Golden Bears amassed 656 yards of total offense in the process ... Junior QB Jared Goff completed 24 of 32 passes for 309 yards, three touchdowns and one interception. Goff connected with Jr. WR **Kenny Lawler**, who made six catches for 69 yards and equaled a school record three touchdown receptions ... 13 different receivers hauled in a pass, nine had two or more receptions ... Cal scored two defensive touchdowns in a game for the first time since Sept. 11, 2010 against Colorado. The defense also intercepted four passes and forced five turnovers.

ARIZONA at Nevada

Sat., Sept. 12 • 4 p.m. PT • CBSN

ARIZONA: Arizona is 10-0 in regular season non-conference play under coach Rich Rodriguez ... After starting at slot receiver last season, redshirt junior **DaVonté Neal** made his debut starting at cornerback and registered a team-high tying 11 tackles ... On the flipside, redshirt senior **Johnny Jackson**, who was a free safety last season, moved to receiver and led the Cats with 8 rec/101 yards and 1 TD ... The Wildcats picked up 14 points off turnovers in the 42-32 win over UTSA. Arizona had 110 points last season off turnovers ... Neal's blocked field goal in the fourth quarter marked the first time Arizona had blocked a field goal attempt since 2002 ... Sophomore QB **Anu Solomon** completed 22-of-36 for 229 yards and 4 TDs. It was the sixth time in 15 games that Solomon has thrown three or more TD passes.

Idaho at USC

Sat., Sept. 12 • 5 p.m. ET • PAC12

USC: The Trojans won their 18th consecutive season-opener with the 55-7 win over Arkansas State ... Senior QB **Cody Kessler** picked up where he left off last season as he completed 19-of-26 for 236 yards and 4 TDs with no interceptions for an opening weekend passing efficiency of 200.1 (he finished at 167.1 last season) ... Senior TB **Tre Madden**, who has missed two of the last three seasons with injury, rushed for 106 yards on 12 carries (8.8 avg) ... The Trojans led all Pac-12 teams with 13 true freshmen seeing action in the first week ... As the Pac-12 celebrates its centennial, Idaho can be recognized as a former member of the Conference as it participated in the Pacific Coast Conference for 37 years from 1922-1958.

OREGON at Michigan State

Sat., Sept. 12 • 8 p.m. ET • ABC

OREGON: The Ducks catapulted to a 61-42 win over Eastern Washington, with senior QB **Vernon Adams Jr.** making his debut against his former team. Adams went 19-of-25 for 246 yards in the start and tossed a pair of touchdowns ... Oregon has now gone 69 straight games with a touchdown pass, tying Texas Tech (2006-11) for the longest streak in NCAA history ... Oregon's ground game was impressive, with sophomore RB **Royce Freeman** rushing for 180 yards on 21 carries with three touchdowns. Oregon had 731 total yards in the win, reaching the 700-yard plateau for the sixth time since 2010 ... The Ducks have now won 11 consecutive home openers by an average of 50 points.

UCF at STANFORD

Sat., Sept. 12 • 7:30 p.m. PT • FOX Sports 1

STANFORD: The Cardinal fell 16-6 to Northwestern, losing a season opener for the first time in eight years. Stanford recorded 240 offensive yards and made only two trips inside the 20-yard line. Stanford went without a touchdown for the first time since 2007, and its national-best streak of scoring at least 10 points in 95 consecutive games was snapped ... Sophomore RB **Christian McCaffrey** totaled 171 all-purpose yards, rushing for 66 yards on 12 carries ... Senior LB **Blake Martinez** recorded 14 tackles (seven solo).

UCLA at UNLV

Sat., Sept. 12 • 7:30 p.m. PT • CBSN

UCLA: Freshman QB **Josh Rosen** was tabbed the Walter Camp National Player of the Week after his debut performance in the win over Virginia ... 11 different players were on the receiving end of Rosen passes, with nine catching at least two passes. It marked the most players to catch a pass in a game for the Bruins since Sept. 21, 2013 against New Mexico State when 16 different players caught passes ... Junior LB **Myles Jack** played both ways as he rushed twice for seven yards and a touchdown, while adding seven tackles ... Junior DL **Kenny Clark** also saw action on both sides of the ball. In addition to his seven tackles, he added a three-yard touchdown reception ... Jack and Clark provided the 16th and 17th offensive touchdowns for a defensive player since 2012.

Cal Poly at ARIZONA STATE

Sat., Sept. 12 • 8 p.m. PT • PAC12

ARIZONA STATE: Senior WR **D.J. Foster** extended his streak of at least one reception to 41 games, the longest active streak in FBS. He matches Derek Hagan for second on ASU's all-time list of consecutive games with a reception and trails only John Jefferson's school record of 44 ... With six receptions, Foster now has 169 in his career, and stands alone in third all-time on ASU's career list. He trails John Jefferson (188) for second and the school record is 258 by Derek Hagan ... Foster surpassed 4,000 career all-purpose yards on a nine-yard reception in the second quarter, and now has 4,026 career all-purpose yards (2,088 rushing, 1,922 receiving, 16 return) ... ASU enters the Cal Poly game having won 16 consecutive home-openers.

PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS

The Pac-12 is in the second year of a six-year agreement with seven bowl partners that should provide the Conference with a competitive postseason bowl experience. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl Game presented by Northwestern Mutual, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion. In 2015-16, the Cotton Bowl and Orange Bowl are slotted as the College Football Playoff semifinal games. If the Pac-12 champion is ranked among the top four of the College Football Playoff poll following the 2015 season and play in either the Cotton or Orange Bowl, the Pac-12 would back-fill the Rose Bowl game.

USC TABBED TO WIN PAC-12 TITLE IN PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

USC was chosen as the favorite to win the 2015 Pac-12 Conference football title in a preseason poll vote of 45 media members. The Trojans received 21 of 45 votes to earn the preseason favorite pick. USC collected 254 points for the top spot in the South Division, holding 32 of 45 first-place votes. Defending Pac-12 champion OREGON holds the second-most Championship votes, as they garnered 17 votes for the Pac-12 title. The Ducks also picked up 262 points to lead the Pac-12 North. Additionally, ARIZONA STATE tallied three votes for the Pac-12 crown and amassed 200 points for second in the Pac-12 South.

STANFORD was picked to finish second in the Pac-12 North Division, collecting 231 points with eight first-place votes. The Cardinal garnered one vote as the Pac-12 Champion. In the South Division, UCLA was picked to finish third with 180 points and collected six first-place votes, ahead of reigning South Division winner ARIZONA, which tallied 155 votes for fourth place.

The media poll has correctly selected the Conference Champion in 29 of 54 previous polls, including 12 of the last 15. Following are the results of the preseason media poll (points 6-5-4-3-2-1, first-place votes in parentheses):
