## UTAH-COLORADO SERIES

### Series Snapshot

This is Utah's longest series against a Pac-12 team and the fifth-longest rivalry in school history. Colorado leads the 60-game series 31-26-3 overall and 15-11-1 in Boulder. Utah has a 15-14-2 advantage in Salt Lake City. Played annually from 1903-1962 with four exceptions, the rivalry went dormant for 49 years before it resumed in 2011. Utah has won the last two games.

After jumping out a 21-0 first-half lead, Utah hung on to beat Colorado 24-17. Trevor Reilly had a monster game in his Ute finale, intercepting a pass with 2:01 remaining to seal the win and totaling 14 tackles, including a tackle for loss on fourth and goal on the Utah 1-yard line in the first half. Adam Schulz got his first college win, passing for 233 yards and a touchdown. Kelvin York rushed for a career-high 132 yards and two touchdowns.

## STATCHAT

Utah leads the Pac-12 in tackles for loss (93 total/8.5 per game), net punting (42.68) and kick return average (24.48) ... **Tom Hackett** leads the nation in punts inside the 10-yard line (19) and punts inside the 20-yard line (34). He ranks third nationally in punt average (46.5). See sidebar on page 3 for more Utah rankings ... **Devontae Booker**, who has rushed for 1,255 net yards in his first season at Utah, leads the Pac-12 in carries (241), ranks second in rushing yards per game (114.1) and is averaging 134.5 yards in Utah's eight conference games ... **Nate Orchard's** 17.5 sacks is a Utah single-season record. Orchard leads the nation in sacks per game (1.59) and is tied for the national lead in total sacks (17.5) ... Utah's 10 sacks against UCLA ties the most by any team in a game this season and is the most against an FBS team.

## TWO MINUTE DRILL

In the first three quarters, Utah holds a 241-154 scoring advantage over its opponents. Utah has been out-scored 106-57 in the fourth quarter ... Utah is 2-2 against the Pac-12 South (beat UCLA and USC, lost to Arizona State and Arizona) ... The Utes are 2-3 against ranked teams, beating No. 8 UCLA and No. 20 USC, and losing to No. 15 Arizona State (in overtime), No. 5 Oregon and No. 15 Arizona.

## IN THE HUDDLE

Starters lost for the season to injury are receivers **Dres Anderson** and **Tim Patrick**, co-starting quarterback **Kendal Thompson**, safety **Tevin Carter** and linebacker **Gionni Paul** ... Utah has played four quarterbacks: **Travis Wilson**, **Thompson**, **Brandon Cox** and **Conner Manning** ... Making his first start at receiver last week against Arizona was true freshman **Kenric Young** ... 11 true freshmen have played: **Christian Drews**, **Jameson Field**, **Andre Godfrey**, **Wallace Gonzalez**, **Boobie Hobbs**, **Lowell Lotulelei**, **Nick Mika**, **Monte Seabrook**, **Marcus Williams**, **Tavaris Williams** and **Kenric Young**.

## LAST GAME

Utah struggled on both sides of the ball in a 42-10 loss to No. 15 Arizona. The Utes committed four turnovers—two that were returned for Arizona touchdowns—and the defense relinquished a season-high 520 yards. **Devontae Booker** rushed for 142 yards and **Westlee Tonga**, playing in his last home game, had four catches for 68 yards and Utah's only touchdown. Freshman **Conner Manning** (2-of-6 for 28 yards and 1 INT) saw his first action as a Ute, replacing **Travis Wilson** (16-of-29 for 143 yards, 1 TD, 2 INT) in the fourth quarter. **Jared Norris** had 11 tackles (2.0 TFL) and **Nate Orchard** had six tackles and a sack, improving his Utah season sack record to 17.5.

## UTAH'S ALL-TIME RECORD

Utah's all-time football record is 640-446-31. The Utes are 390-185-16 at home (72-28 in Rice-Eccles Stadium, which opened in 1998), 231-244-12 in road games and 19-17-3 in games played at neutral sites.

## UTAH VS. THE PAC-12

Utah is 89-142-6 all-time against Pac-12 schools and 13-22 as a member of the conference. Here's the breakdown: Arizona (20-18-2), Arizona State (6-20), California (4-5), Colorado (26-31-3), Oregon (8-20), Oregon State (7-11-1), USC (4-9), Stanford (4-3), UCLA (3-10), Washington (0-8), Washington State (7-7).

## WHITTINGHAM FILE

Tenth-year Utah head coach **Kyle Whittingham**, the 2008 National Coach of the Year, has an 83-43 career record that includes seven bowl victories—among them a 2009 Sugar Bowl win over No. 4 Alabama. Whittingham is one of 13 coaches on the watch list for the 2014 Dodd Trophy and one of 20 semifinalists for the Maxwell Football Club Collegiate Coach of the Year Award. His teams have played in eight bowl games and the current team is bowl eligible. For more on Whittingham, see sidebar on page 2.

## QUARTERBACK NOTEBOOK

> 6'7" junior **Travis Wilson** has played in all 11 games with nine starts and a 6-3 record. He has been the primary starter since the seventh game of his true freshman season, playing in 32 of 35 games with a 13-12 record in career starts.

> **Wilson** is 148-for-250 (59.2%) passing for 1,701 yards and 14 touchdowns (4 INT).

> **Wilson's** season passing high is 297 yards against Oregon—his second 200-yard passing game this season and the ninth in his career.

> **Wilson's** 4,839 career passing yards ranks seventh in school history. He is 268 yards out of sixth place (5,107, Mike Fouts, 1995-96).

> **Wilson** has 37 career touchdown passes—sixth all-time at Utah and two away from fifth (39 by three others).

> **Kendal Thompson** played in seven games with two starts (1-1) before a season-ending knee injury against Oregon on Nov. 8.

> Redshirt freshman **Conner Manning** made his first appearance as a Ute in the fourth quarter against Arizona, completing 2-of-6 pass attempts for 28 yards and an interception.

> Redshirt freshman **Brandon Cox** saw his only career action in game one against Idaho State, going 3-for-3 passing for 17 yards and rushing twice for 22 yards and a touchdown (16 yards).

> **Thompson** finished his junior season 32-of-52 passing for 324 yards, two touchdowns and two interceptions in seven games played.

> **Thompson** also rushed 56 times yards for 192 yards (second on the team at the time of his injury) and one touchdown.

## RUNNING BACK NOTEBOOK

> Junior college transfer **Devontae Booker** ranks second in the Pac-12 and 18th in the nation in rushing yards per game (114.1).

> **Booker's** 1,255 net yards ranks fourth in school single-season history. He needs 141 yards to tie for third (1,396, Dameon Hunter, 2001).

> **Booker** is the 12th 1,000-yard rusher in school history. It marks the 14th time a Ute has rushed for 1,000 yards in a season, a feat accomplished twice by Eddie Johnson (1984, 1986) and John White (2011-12).

> **Booker** is averaging 134.5 rushing yards in Utah's eight conference games, where more than 80 percent of his production has come: 87% of his carries (210-of-241) and 86% of his net yards (1,076-of-1,255).

> **Booker** leads the team in carries (241), net yards (1,255), yards per carry (5.20) and rushing touchdowns (8). He leads the team in total touchdowns with 10 (2 receiving).

> **Booker** led Utah with 142 rushing yards on 23 carries against Arizona, his sixth 100-yard rushing game, which is tied for the fourth-most in a season in school history.

> **Booker** ran for 100 yards in Utah's first five conference games. That streak tied him for the second-most consecutive 100-yard games in school history.

> **Booker's** 100-yard games have come against Oregon State (229), Washington State (178), UCLA (156), Arizona State (146), Arizona (142) and USC (102).

> **Booker's** 229 yards at Oregon State is the best single-game rushing total in the Pac-12 this season. His 37 carries against Arizona State is the most by a Pac-12 player in a game this season and his 33 carries against UCLA is second.

> **Booker** ranks third in the Pac-12 in all-purpose yards per game (142.9).

> **Booker** is Utah's second-leading receiver with 34 catches for 260 yards (fifth on the team) and two touchdowns. He had a career-high 110 receiving yards and a TD against Oregon.

> Junior **Bubba Poole** started the first four games and ranks third on the team in net yards (199) and fourth in carries (46). He has two touchdowns.

> **Poole** also has 12 receptions for 93 yards.

## RECEIVER NOTEBOOK

> Utah has lost two starting receivers for the season to injury: **Dres Anderson**, the fifth-leading receiver in school history (2,077 yards)—who at the time of his injury was leading Utah in receiving yards (355), yards per catch (16.1) and touchdowns (4)—and junior **Tim Patrick** (16 receptions, 177 yards).

> Junior **Kenneth Scott** leads Utah in receptions (37) and receiving yards (391). He is tied for the team lead in touchdown catches (4).

> **Scott's** top performances this season have come against Fresno State (77 yards), Stanford (71 yards) and Washington State (70 yards).

> **Kaelin Clay** is second on the team in receiving yards (372) and third in receptions (29).

> **Clay** had a 25-yard touchdown reception in the first overtime at Stanford for his second TD catch of the season.

> **Clay** had a career-high 152 receiving yards on five catches against Oregon, his first career 100-yard game.

> Redshirt freshman **Kenric Young** made his first career start against Arizona and has played in five games total.

> Junior **Jeremiah Poutasi** has played and started in every game at left tackle. Since his true freshman season, he has played in 34 games with 33 starts (the last two seasons at left tackle).

> **Poutasi** has played 771 snaps while allowing just three sacks. He has 14 cuts.

> Senior defensive end **Nate Orchard**, a CBS.com and *Phil Steele* Midseason All-American, was a semifinalist for the Rotary Lombardi Award (College Lineman of the Year) and the Chuck Bednarik Award (Outstanding Defensive Player of the Year).

> **Orchard** leads the nation in sacks per game (1.59) and is tied for first in total sacks (17.5). His 17.5 sacks is a school record.

> **Rowe** has 31 career pass breakups, which is third all-time at Utah.

> **Rowe** has 53 tackles (3.0 TFL) in 10 games played (missed Oregon with an injury). He also has a fumble recovery and blocked a kick on special teams.

> **Dominique Hatfield**, who began the season as a receiver, has started all but the first game of the year at corner and has 31 tackles (0.5 TFL) and nine pass breakups (second on the team).

> **Davion Orphey** has played in all 11 games with four starts. He has 20 tackles, 1.5 TFL, five pass breakups and two fumble recoveries.

> **Orphey** is tied for third in the Pac-12 in fumble recoveries (2) and fumbles recovered per game (0.18). He scored on a 53-yard touchdown on a recovered fumble against USC.

> **Justin Thomas** has played in 10 games with seven starts at nickel back.

## PUNTING NOTEBOOK

> Midseason All-American (CBSSports.com, *Phil Steele*) and Ray Guy Award candidate **Tom Hackett** ranks third in the nation and first in the Pac-12 in punt average (46.5). He has 73 punts for 3,396 yards.

> **Hackett** leads nation in punts inside the 10 (19) and punts inside the 20 (34).

> **Hackett** has landed 34-of-73 (46.6%) punts inside the 20 this year (a percentage that leads the Pac-12) and 76-of-174 (43.7%) for his career.

> **Hackett** has 19 punts inside the 10-yard line this season (37 in his career) and six inside the 5-yard line (16 in his career).

> **Hackett** has 23 punts of 50+ yards this season, which is tied for the Pac-12 lead and is second all-time at Utah.

> Against the Pac-12's No. 2 and 3 punt returners, **Hackett** held USC's Nelson Agholor (10.6 average) without a return (USC had 1 return for 2 yards) and UCLA's Ishmael Adams (10.4 average) to one return for one yard. Stanford's Ty Montgomery (19.8 average, two touchdowns) was held to one return for one yard.

> **Hackett** leads the Pac-12 in punts of 50+ yards (23) this season (second-most in a season at Utah) and has 43 in his career to rank fourth all-time at Utah.

> **Hackett's** 3,396 punt yards is a school record, breaking the record that he set last season (3,300).

> **Hackett** has had just 15 touchbacks in his career (8 this season).

> **Hackett** has 174 career punts, which is the fifth-most all-time at Utah.

> **Hackett's** 7,668 career punt yards ranks fifth all-time at Utah.

> **Hackett** has been named the Ray Guy Award Player of the Week three times: vs. Fresno State, UCLA and Stanford. He was the College Football Performance Awards (CFPA) National Punter of the Week vs. UCLA.

> **Hackett** was the Pac-12's leading punter a year ago as a sophomore when he was named first-team all-conference.

## KICKING NOTEBOOK

> Sophomore All-America candidate and Lou Groza semifinalist "Automatic" **Andy Phillips**, a former U.S. Ski Team member (2007-11), had never played in a football game at any level prior to last season.

> **Phillips**, a Midseason All-American by SI.com (2nd team) and *Phil Steele* (3rd team), is a two-time Lou Groza Star of the Week (vs. Michigan and UCLA) and a two-time Pac-12 Special Teams Player of the Week (Michigan and Oregon State).

> **Phillips** ranks second in the nation in field goals of 40+ yards with 11 (11-of-14), with makes of 43 (twice), 44, 45, 46 (twice), 47, 48 (twice) and 50 yards (twice).

> **Phillips** is 2-of-2 in 50-yard field goals this season (Michigan, Arizona State) and 3-of-3 in his career, with a long of 51 yards against Arizona State in 2013.

> **Phillips** is 20-for-24 (83.3%) overall. His 20 field goals leads the Pac-12 and is tied for fifth in the nation. He is second in the conference in field goal percentage.

> **Phillips'** 20 field goals is tied for second-most in a season at Utah with Joe Phillips (2009). The school record is 22 field goals by Louie Sakoda (2008).

> **Phillips** has connected on 37-of-44 field goals in his career (84.1%). His 37 total field goals is third all-time at Utah.

> In his career, **Phillips** is 20-of-25 (80%) from 40+ yards.

> **Phillips** is second in the Pac-12 in field goals per game (1.82) and tied for sixth in the nation.

> **Phillips** is tied for third in the Pac-12 in scoring (8.7 points per game).

> **Phillips** has made at least three field goals in four games this season (Michigan, UCLA, Oregon State, Arizona State).

> **Phillips** made 12 consecutive field goals during one stretch of the season before his streak was snapped on his fourth kick against ASU. It tied the third-longest made field goal streak in school history.

> **Phillips** kicked the game-winning 29-yard field goal with 34 seconds remaining against then No. 8 UCLA. He also recovered his own onside kick against UCLA and is 3-for-3 in successful onside kicks in his career.

- > **Phillips** has made all 36 PATs this season and is 77-of-77 in his career.
- > **Phillips** has 34 touchbacks on 59 kickoffs and a 61.9-yard average.
- > Utah has 61 total kickoffs with 35 touchbacks.

## SPECIAL TEAMS NOTEBOOK

- > Head coach **Kyle Whittingham** is in his first season as the special teams' coordinator.
- > Utah ranks third in the nation and leads the Pac-12 in net punting (42.68).
- > The Utes lead the Pac-12 (12th nationally) in kick return average (24.48) and are sixth nationally and second in the Pac-12 in punt return average (16.17).
- > In his first season, senior Midseason All-American **Kaelin Clay** (CBSSports.com, *Phil Steele*) ranks third in the nation and leads the Pac-12 in punt return average (17.7). He has 19 punt returns for 336 yards and three touchdowns.
- > **Clay** is the only player in the country this season with three punt returns for touchdowns and four total returns (1 kickoff) for a touchdown.
- > Three of **Clay's** 19 punt returns this year have gone for touchdowns (66 yards vs. Michigan, 46 yards vs. Idaho State and 58 yards vs. Washington State). One of his 21 kickoff returns was also for a touchdown (100 yards vs. Idaho State).
- > **Clay's** three punt return touchdowns ties the Utah single-season record set by Steve Smith (currently of the NFL's Baltimore Ravens) in 1999.
- > **Clay** also ranks second in the Pac-12 in kickoff return average (25.4). He has 21 kick returns for 534 yards and one touchdown.
- > **Clay** had seven kick returns for 179 yards against Oregon. His 179 yards in kick returns is the fifth-most ever in a game by a Ute and his seven returns is tied for the third-most all-time in a game.
- > **Clay's** 331 all-purpose yards against Oregon is the sixth-most in a game by an FBS player this season (179 kick return, 152 receiving).
- > **Clay** was named the Pac-12 Special Teams Player of the Week the first week of the season against Idaho State after returning a punt (46 yards) and kickoff (100 yards) for touchdowns.
- > **Clay's** punt return for a touchdown against ISU came on his first touch as a Ute.
- > Sophomore **Chase Dominguez** has handled all of the special teams' snaps since last fall, which includes 149 punt, 44 field goal and 77 PATs for a total of 270 snaps.

## CAPACITY CROWDS

Utah broke the school record for season attendance this fall, averaging 46,436 fans a game. All six home games exceeded Rice-Eccles Stadium's seating capacity of 45,807. Utah has played to 31 straight sellouts in Rice-Eccles Stadium extending back to the 2010 season-opener against Pittsburgh. Of the sellouts, 28 were played before standing-room only crowds that exceeded Rice-Eccles Stadium's seating capacity (45,017 from 1998-13; 45,807 starting this season). The largest home crowd in school history (47,619) saw Utah beat No. 20 USC on Oct. 25, 2014.

## COACHES' CORNER

Three members of Utah's staff have been head coaches at the NCAA level: head coach **Kyle Whittingham**, offensive coordinator **Dave Christensen** (Wyoming) and running backs coach **Dennis Erickson** (Idaho, Wyoming, Washington State, Miami, Oregon State and Arizona State). All three have been recognized as a conference coach of the year: **Whittingham** (Utah/Mountain West), **Christensen** (Wyoming/Mountain West) and **Erickson** (Washington State, Oregon State, Arizona State/Pac-12; Miami/Big East; and Idaho/Big Sky). **Whittingham** (2008/Utah) and **Erickson** (2000/Miami) were National Coach of the Year recipients.

Walk-on offensive lineman **Parker Erickson** is a Rhodes Scholar nominee. The political science major carries a 4.0 cumulative GPA ... **Viliseni Fauonuku** was the first member of his family to graduate from high school ... 21-year-old freshman defensive end **Wallace Gonzalez** spent the past three years as an outfielder in the Houston Astros' farm system. Gonzalez was drafted in the 29th round of the 2011 MLB Draft out of Bishop Amat High School (Calif.) ... **Jared Norris** attended a pro skateboarding camp (Camp Woodward) in high school, and at 6'1", 230 pounds, was the biggest skateboarder ever to attend ... **Eric Rowe** lived in six cities in four states growing up ... Walk-on wide receiver **Ryan Petersen** was "discovered" after being named the MVP of the 2013 and 2014 MUSS flag football games, held annually before the Red-White spring game.
