- No. 6/4 STANFORD puts the nation's longest winning streak (11 games) to test at home against UCLA.
- Pac-12 youth continues to shine... Three Pac-12 sophomore receivers rank among the top five in the nation in receiving yards - WASHINGTON STATE WR **Marquess Wilson** (143.0 ypg) is the national leader, followed by CALIFORNIA's **Keenan Allen** (No. 4/124.5 ypg) and USC's **Robert Woods** (No. 5/123.0 ypg). The fourth-leading receiver in the Pac-12 also is a sophomore - COLORADO's **Paul Richardson** (99.5 ypg).
- With his OREGON single-game record of 288 rushing yards at Arizona, junior RB **LaMichael James** has posted 3,890 career rushing yards. That moves him into sixth all-time on the Pac-12 charts. Up next for James is former Washington Husky Napoleon Kaufman (4,106 yards, 1991-94). James, who has rushed for 492 yards over the last two games, gets to rest his legs this week as the Ducks have an open date.

BANK OF THE WEST PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

LaMICHAEL JAMES, OREGON - OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK SHELLY LYONS, ARIZONA STATE - DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK JORDAN POYER, OREGON STATE - SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

WALNUT CREEK, Calif.--Running back **LaMichael James** of OREGON, linebacker **Shelly Lyons** of ARIZONA STATE and punt/kick returner **Jordan Poyer** of OREGON STATE have been named Bank of the West Pac-12 Players of the Week in football.

James, a junior from Texarkana, Texas, ran for an Oregon single-game record 288 yards and scored two touchdowns in the 56-31 win at Arizona. James also broke the school's one-game record for all-purpose yardage with 363. His two touchdown runs brought his career total to 43 rushing touchdowns and broke the Ducks' record of 42. James also moved into sixth place on the Pac-12 all-time list with 3,890 career rushing yards.

Lyons, a senior from Corona, Calif., led the Sun Devils' defensive effort in the 43-22 victory over No. 23 USC. He snagged the first interception of his career with 6:37 remaining in the game and returned it 41 yards for a touchdown. Lyons also added a tackle for loss for minus two yards and collected four tackles, including three solo stops.

Poyer, a junior from Astoria, Ore., recorded 156 returning yards in the Beavers' 27-19 loss to UCLA. He had over 100 yards in punt returns, including an 85-yard touchdown in the first half which was the second-longest in Oregon State history. Poyer also made a pair of tackles. He ranks second in the country for punt return average at 25.3 yards per attempt.

Also nominated for offensive player of the week honors were running backs **Cameron Marshall** of Arizona State and **Derrick Coleman** of UCLA, wide receivers **Keenan Allen** of California and **Robert Woods** of USC and quarterback **Keith Price** of Washington. Also nominated on defense were linebackers **Mychal Kendricks** of California and **Cort Dennison** of Washington, free safety **John Boyett** of Oregon, defensive tackle **Andrew Seumalo** of Oregon State and cornerback **Aaron Hester** of UCLA. Also nominated for special teams play were kickers **Giorgio Tavecchio** of California and **Andre Heidari** of USC, punter **Jackson Rice** of Oregon and kick returner **Josh Smith** of UCLA.

Series: USC leads 27-7-0. Last: USC, 24-21 (2010)

Wildcat Notes: While the Wildcats look to snap an eight-game skid vs. FBS opponents, six of those eight opponents were ranked 14th or better. . . Arizona's passing offense ranks fifth nationally at 372.5 yards per game. . . Senior QB **Nick Foles**, the Pac-12's total offense leader, has connected on 70.5% of his pass attempts and has yet to throw a pick this season in 183 attempts. In fact, dating back to last season, Foles has not thrown a pick in his last 200 attempts. . . Senior IR **David Douglas** caught seven passes for 120 yards in the loss to Oregon. He is the fourth different UA receiver to record 100 or more receiving yards this season. He joins **Austin Hill** (128 yards at Oklahoma State); **Dan Buckner** (142 yards at Oklahoma State); **Juron Criner** (151 yards vs. Northern Arizona). . . Senior DB **Trevin Wade** has a league-best seven pass break ups, including six over the last two games.

Trojan Notes: Senior RB **Marc Tyler** ran for a game-best 149 yards on 22 carries (123 of those yards came in the second half) in the loss at Arizona State. Tyler has posted a pair of 100-yard rushing performances this season and is fourth in the league, averaging 101.0 yards per game. . . Sophomore WR **Robert Woods** had 208 all-purpose yards at Arizona State (including 131 yards on 8 catches and 75 yards on a pair of kickoff returns). . . Freshman LB **Dion Bailey** had a game-best 10 tackles at ASU and now leads the team with 26 tackles (6.5 per game). . . Freshman PK **Andre Heidari** nailed three field goals (41, 29, 33 yards) at Arizona State. He is now 5-of-6 on field goals overall.

OREGON STATE (0-3) at 25/28 ARIZONA STATE (3-1)

Tempe, Ariz. • Sun Devil Stadium (71,705)

7:30 p.m. PT • FS AZ/FCS-Pacific/(Sirius 92/XM 192)

Series: ASU leads, 24-12-1. Last: OSU, 31-28 (2010)

Beaver Notes: The Beavers are looking for their first win of the season and avoid their first 0-4 start since 1996. . . Nearly one year after sustaining a devastating knee injury at Arizona, senior WR **James Rodgers** made his season debut and responded with five receptions for 76 yards. . . Junior LB **Feti Unga** had a game-high 14 tackles in the loss to UCLA. He leads the league, averaging 10.3 tackles per game. . . Thanks to **Jordan Poyer's** 85-yard punt return for touchdown against UCLA, the Beavers now rank fifth nationally, averaging 20.0 yards per punt return. . . OSU's kickoff coverage is among the league's best, with a net of 46.9 yards. They'll be challenged by Arizona State's kickoff return unit, which averages a Pac-12 best (10th nationally) 28.4 yards per return.

Sun Devil Notes: ASU now has two wins vs. ranked teams at home in the same season (37-30 in overtime over No. 21 Missouri and 43-22 over No. 23 USC) for the first time since its 1986 Rose Bowl championship season. . . ASU's two wins over ranked teams this year is the most by a Sun Devil squad since the 1997 team led by Pat Tillman had three wins over ranked teams (wins at No. 13 Miami, at No. 25 Stanford, and vs. No. 10 Washington State). . . Junior RB **Cameron Marshall** rushed 25 times for 141 yards and three touchdowns in the win over USC. On the game's fourth play from scrimmage, he raced 70 yards for the game's first touchdown, his third-longest run from scrimmage in his career. . . In the victory over USC, junior WR **Jamal Miles** got his hands on the ball four different ways for 135 all-purpose yards (1 rush, 55 receiving, 73 kick return, 6 punt return).

WASHINGTON STATE (2-1) at COLORADO (1-3)

Boulder, Colo. • Folsom Field (53,613)

Series: COLO leads, 4-2-0. Last: COLO, 20-12 (2004)

Cougar Notes: Washington State makes its first appearance in Boulder since 2004 when it knocked off 17th-ranked Colorado, 47-26. . . Senior QB **Marshall Lobbestael** has led the Cougars to a Pac-12 best passing offense (380.0 yards per game), but will now face the league's best pass defense in Colorado (183.5 yards allowed per game). Lobbestael leads the Pac-12, and is sixth nationally, with a 180.17 passing efficiency rating. . . In three previous seasons combined, Lobbestael completed just 48.8 percent of his passes in 19 games for 1,287 yards, 7 TDs and 12 interceptions. In just three games this senior season, he's completed 62.4 percent of his passes for 959 yards, 10 TDs and just two interceptions.

Buffalo Notes: Freshman PK **Will Oliver** remained perfect on the season (he is 6-of-6 on FG and 11-of-11 on PAT, 29 points). Only Jeremy Flores has made more field goals without missing to start a career at CU than Oliver; Flores made his first seven over the 2001 and 2002 seasons. . . Senior TB **Rodney Stewart** moved into third place on CU's all-time rushing yards list with 3,022 yards; he passed Bobby Purify (2000-04; 3,016) and is right behind Rashaan Salaam (1992-94; 3,057) for second. He is second in career rushes with 692 (Eric Bieniemy leads with 699). His five receptions gives him 71 career receptions, now second most by a running back at Colorado as he passed Lawrence Vickers (2002-05; 68) today. His 702 receiving yards are also second by a running back, with Herchell Troutman (1994-97, 725) now within his sights. His 151.2 all-purpose yards per game ranks third in the Pac-12.

UCLA (2-2) at 6/4 STANFORD (3-0)

Series Record: STAN leads, 45-33-3. Last: STAN, 35-0 (2010)

Bruin Notes: Senior RB **Derrick Coleman** rushed for 100 yards on 20 carries (5.0 ypc) in the win at Oregon State. It was his second 100-yard performance this season as he picked up 135 yards against San Jose State (Sept. 10). Coleman is averaging 6.2 yards per carry. . . Junior QB **Richard Brehaut** has been making a case to secure the starting spot for the Bruins. In four games, he's completed 44-of-79 (55.7%) for 705 yards with four touchdowns and no interceptions. He's also rushed for 140 yards and one touchdown. . . Senior KR **Josh Smith** had three kickoff returns for 77 yards at Oregon State. He also had two receptions from his wide receiver position for another 76 yards, including a 62-yard pass from Brehaut. . . The Bruin rushing attacking (2nd in the Pac-12 at 214.0 ypg) will face a Stanford run defense that leads the nation (36.0 yards allowed per game).

Cardinal Notes: After an idle weekend, the Cardinal dropped one stop from No. 5 to No. 6 in the AP poll, but moved up one slot from No. 5 to No. 4 in the Coaches poll. . . The Cardinal has won each of its last three games following bye weeks, including a memorable upset of seventh-ranked Oregon in 2009. . . Stanford's defense has allowed just two offensive touchdowns this season and just nine touchdowns in as many games dating back to last season. The defense has posted eight scoreless quarters this season and ranks seventh nationally in scoring defense, allowing just 9.0 points a game. . . Junior PR **Drew Terrell** leads the league in punt return average (15.7 yards). He'll look to take advantage of a UCLA punt return unit that allows a league-low 7.7 yards per return. . . Freshman PK **Jordan Williamson** has connected on each of his six field goal attempts.

Salt Lake City, Utah • Rice-Eccles Stadium (45,017)

Series: WASH leads, 6-0-0. Last: WASH, 41-7 (1979)

Husky Notes: Washington visits Salt Lake City for the first time in the series history as all six victories over the Utes have come in Seattle. . . Sophomore QB **Keith Price** led the Huskies to a 31-23, Pac-12 opening win over Cal, completing 19 of 25 pass attempts (.760) for 292 yards and three touchdowns, with no interceptions. Among his three TDs was a 70-yarder to junior RB **Chris Polk**. For the year, Price has thrown 14 TDs and only three interceptions. . . Price will test the Utah defense, which has four interceptions and leads the league in pass defense efficiency (114.8). . . Sophomore DE **Hau'oli Jamora** will miss the remainder of the season after tearing the anterior cruciate ligament in his knee early in the California game. . . Senior LB **Cort Dennison** led the Husky defense with 11 total tackles in the win over Cal. Dennison and the UW defense put the game away in the closing seconds thanks to a goal-line stand that ended at the UW two-yard line. . . Washington is looking to start 4-1 for the first time since 2006.

Ute Notes: Utah's red zone defense will get tested this Saturday. The Utes rank first in the Pac-12 allowing just three touchdowns in six red zone appearances by their opponent. They'll face a Husky squad that has scored 13 touchdowns and added three field goals in 18 trips in the red zone. . . **Kyle Whittingham** is 6-0 coming off regular-season byes, with victories over Wyoming (2005, 2007), Colorado State (2006, 2009), New Mexico (2008) and Iowa State (2010). Utah has won 10 games in a row following regular-season byes, last losing in 2002 at San Diego State. Utah's last home loss following a bye was in 1996 (to Brigham Young). . . Utah is tied for the national lead in fumbles recovered (8), is tied for sixth nationally in turnovers caused (12) and ranks third in turnover margin (3.00; 12 takeaways to 3 turnovers).

OREGON TABBED TO WIN PAC-12 TITLE IN PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

LOS ANGELES -- Defending Pac-12 champion OREGON is the choice to win the 2011 Pac-12 Conference football title in a preseason poll of media members who regularly cover the league. The Ducks were listed in the top spot in the North Division by 29 of the 42 voters participating in the poll, collecting 239 points. Twenty-eight of those pollsters tabbed the Ducks to come out on top in the inaugural Pac-12 Championship Game. STANFORD was picked to finish second in the North Division, collecting the other 13 first-place votes in the balloting for the division race, with 11 of those members of the media casting a vote for the Cardinal to capture the Pac-12 title.

USC was picked to win the South Division with 230 points, edging out ARIZONA STATE, which tallied 207 points. Due to NCAA sanctions, USC is on probation and ineligible to participate in the postseason. Therefore, the Trojans would not be able to represent the South Division in the Pac-12 Championship Game. Should USC capture the South Division crown, the team finishing second would be the South Division's representative in the Pac-12 Championship Game. Arizona State collected 13 first-place votes in the division race, with three of the pollsters predicting a Pac-12 Championship crown for the Sun Devils.

The media poll has correctly selected the Conference Champion in 27 of 50 previous polls, including 10 of the last 11. Following are the results of the preseason media poll (points 6-5-4-3-2-1, first-place votes in parentheses):

PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

The inaugural Pac-12 Championship Football Game will take place Friday, December 2 at 8 p.m. ET/5 p.m. PT and telecast to a national audience on FOX. The Championship game will match the winner of the North Division vs. the winner of the South Division. The game will be played on the campus of the division winner with the best overall conference record. The winner of the inaugural Pac-12 Championship will earn the league's automatic BCS berth.

TIE-BREAK PROCEDURES TO DETERMINE DIVISION CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP GAME HOST

The Division Champion will be determined by the record in all games played (both divisional and cross-divisional) within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game representatives

Two-Team Tie.

1. Head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
 - a. If no game is played between the two tied teams or that game ends in a tie, the following tie-breaking procedures would be applied:
2. Record in games played within the division
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (Based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.
6. Total number of wins in a 12-game season. The following conditions will apply to the calculation of the total number of wins:
 - a. Only one win against a team from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision or lower division will be counted annually.
 - b. Any games that are exempted from counting against the annual maximum number of football contests per NCAA rules (current Bylaw 17.9.5.2) shall not be included.
7. Coin toss.

Multiple-Team Ties.

The following procedures will only be used to eliminate all but two teams, at which point the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

1. Head-to-head (Best record in games among the tied teams).
2. Record in games played within the division.
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.

Pac-12 Championship Game Host

The Pac-12 Championship Game Host will be determined by the record in all games played within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game host.

Tie-breaking Procedure.

1. Head-to-head, if applicable.
2. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of Pac-12 regular-season games.
3. Record against the next highest-placed common opponent in the conference (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the conference.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Coin toss.

PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS - 2011-12

The second year of a four-year bowl cycle kicks in this season and the Pac-12 welcomes a new addition to the lineup. The Gildan New Mexico Bowl in Albuquerque will feature the Pac-12's seventh selection against an opponent from the Mountain West Conference. The Pac-12 Conference has agreements with seven bowl partners. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion, unless said champion is ranked No. 1 or No. 2 in the final Bowl Championship Series rankings. If that were the case, the Pac-12 champion would play in the BCS National Championship Game hosted by the Allstate Sugar Bowl. Regardless of the disposition of the Pac-12 champion, a second Pac-12 team may be selected for an at-large berth in the Bowl Championship Series in any given year and other Pac-12 bowl partner arrangements provide for that occurrence. In addition to the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, Pac-12 bowl partners include, in order of selection, the Valero Alamo Bowl in San Antonio, Bridgeport Education Holiday Bowl in San Diego, Hyundai Sun Bowl in El Paso, the MAACO Bowl Las Vegas, the Kraft Fight Hunger Bowl in San Francisco, and the Gildan New Mexico Bowl in Albuquerque.
