Washington State Head Coach Mike Leach

Thoughts on the game...

"The biggest thing is our mentality. We are a mentally weak team, and that has got to change. The thing is that it is a decision. I think it starts with us as coaches. We need to change the mentality of this team. We are afraid to be successful, so when we get ahead we want to relax and enjoy it, which is crazy. If you consider the offseason, if you consider practices, and you consider how long you have worked at getting a handful of plays in a season or even in a career, to not make the most of them is unfathomable."

On what the problem is...

"Physically we aren't that bad. But mentally, we are afraid to be successful. We are afraid to win, and I don't know if we are afraid of the responsibility that comes with winning, but we need to go out there and take pride in our individual battles and winning. Right now we don't do that. We let setting – time, place, score – impact us, and that's crazy. Unless we get that changed, our results will be the same."

"There has to be a core of guys on the team that it means a great deal to. Travis Long played really well. It meant a lot to him, he invested a lot out there on the field, and it meant a lot to him to not be successful."

"We have too many people that losing and not being successful is too easy to brush off - 'that's how the cookie crumbles.' That's not good enough. We have plenty of opportunities ahead of us and we need to go out there and maximize our reputation and our plays, and take a lot of pride in it. It needs to mean more to us than it does to the other team."

"Physically, we can run and we can hit people. It needs to look like Tuesday and Wednesday's practices. We haven't had a game yet that looks like Tuesday and Wednesday's practices. If you can do it then, I don't know why you can't do it Saturday."

Washington State Quarterback Connor Halliday

Thoughts on the game...

"Like we have been talking about for three weeks now, we need to play better in the second half. We need to not have stupid penalties, we need to catch the football, we need to make better reads, the running backs need to run better. As a whole offense we need to play better."

"I don't think it is so much complacency, I just think it's stupid plays. It's all mental."

On play calls late in the game, and if time makes a difference...

"That definitely plays a factor. With that, you can't get passive. You have to stay aggressive and take shots when they are there."

On interception on fourth down...

"I thought I could fit it in that hole, obviously it didn't happen."

On if the loss will affect the confidence of the team...

"I think we are fine. As you have seen, we are a pretty darn good football team when we play together, as we have in the first half for that last couple of weeks, but it's just a matter of putting full games together."

On personality of the team...

"I don't think it has anything to do with the personality. Wanting to win is not a personality. The personality of the team will always be what it is. I just think we need to quit playing stupid in the second half. Dropping balls, bad checks by me, turnovers – just stupid plays."

Washington State Defensive End Travis Long

On last offensive play by Colorado...

"They had five spread, no one in the backfield. A draw is always an option in that situation. We just weren't prepared for it."

On what made the difference...

"We just have got to finish. We played well until it got late in the game. We have to get that cleaned up."

On substitution penalty...

"We were just trying to get a different personnel group in, and we didn't get it in quick enough. They caught us in the middle of a substitution."

On personal performance...

"I played fine. Obviously I could have played better, but I just want to win. I don't really care how I play."

On what can be done to fix the problem...

"It's a personal decision. It's an individual decision for each member of this team. It's got to get changed."

QUICKLY Colorado is now **7-3-1** in games played in the state of Washington (3-0 versus WSU, in three different cities: Spokane, Seattle, Pullman) ... CU now leads the series **5-3** ... Colorado is now 79-38-2 in conference openers (1-1 in the Pac-12; CU snapped a four-game losing streak in league lid-lifters with the win) ... This is sort of payback for the '81 game, when WSU scored twice in the last two minutes on botched CU punts to win, 14-10 ... CU's last one-point win was by the same score, **35-34**, over Texas A&M in Boulder on Nov. 7, 2009 ... Colorado scored on its opening drive for the second time in four games (8 plays, 75 yards), matching the distance it went for 7 points against Sacramento State ... CU had eight first downs in the first quarter (4 rush/4 pass); it had 10 (5 rush/5 pass) against Fresno State last week (not including 1 penalty) ... The team on offense drove into plus territory of the first eight drives of the game (exception was when CU lost the ball on a fumble at its 39) ... Colorado had scored in eighth straight second quarters until being shutout today ... With TB Tony Jones (4-105) and WR Nelson Spruce (8-103) both gaining 100 yards rushing and receiving, respectively, CU is now **25-8** in its history with a 100-yard rusher and receiver ... Colorado had **255** yards in the fourth quarter, after netting just 276 in the first three ... CU's defense was not flagged for a penalty Saturday and has just six in four games ... CU has now played all four games well in excess of 3 hours; averaging 3:27:20 coming in, today's game went **3:47**.

TE NICK KASA (3-87, 1 TD) He scored his first career touchdown in this, his fifth game at the position (he moved over from defensive end with five games left in 2011, but only played at the position in the season finale at Utah). But his biggest play may have come in the final seconds—he recovered Christian Powell's third down fumble to give CU a chance at the fourth down play it tied the game on.

- The 70-yard touchdown catch from **QB Jordan Webb** was the second longest reception by a tight end in CU history, eclipsing a 68-yard TD pass from **QB Cody Hawkins** to **TE Riar Geer** at Nebraska in 2008 and a 68-yard reception **TE Jon Embree** caught from **QB Mark Hatcher** against Arizona in 1986. However, it is the longest in the regular season; in the 2004 Houston Bowl, **QB Joel Klatt** hit **TE Joe Klopenstein** with a 78-yard TD pass.

TB TONY JONES (4-105, 1 TD) His 84-yard touchdown run tied for the eighth longest rush (and 17th longest overall) from scrimmage in school history. Also in CU history, he used the second fewest carries to gain 100 yards; Cliff Branch (2-100, 1 TD) did it in fewer at Kansas on Nov. 6, 1971; the last to do with under 10 attempts was **TB Cortlen Johnson**, also against Kansas but in Boulder on Sept. 22, 2001 (8-113-0) – 11 years ago to the day.

WR NELSON SPRUCE (8-103, 1 TD) He enjoyed his first 100-yard receiving game, with seven of his eight receptions earning first downs.

RED ZONE DEFENSE Colorado limited WSU to just one score (TD) in three trips in the red zone; making two interceptions on the other two occasions. The Cougars ran five plays for a net 2 yards on plays run inside-the-20.

FIRST DOWN DEFENSE In the first half, Washington State had 18 first down plays for 132 yards, or 7.3 per play; but in the second half, the Buff "D" really buckled down—WSU had 17 first down plays for 31 yards (1.8), and that wasn't skewed by long sacks; it had three plays (9, 7, 7) over five yards and 12 between 2 yards gained and 2 lost. And in the second half, while WSU was 6-of-12 on third downs, it was only 2-of-17 on second down (after converting 7-of-10 times on second in the first half).

COMEBACKS CU rallied from a 17-point deficit to win, tying its fourth-largest comeback in school history; it was the second largest rally from a fourth quarter deficit ever and the largest in a road game. The top comebacks:
