BIG 12 FOOTBALL QUICK HITS

- Ten Big 12 teams continue non-league action in Week 3 while an early-season conference matchup is on tap with Texas Tech traveling to Texas to open Big 12 play. Two teams hit the road for non-conference outings as Kansas State travels to UCLA while No. 19/18 Nebraska visits No. 13/14 Virginia Tech.
- The Big 12 game between Texas and Texas Tech is the earliest Conference contest since Nebraska hosted Oklahoma State on Aug. 30, 2003.
- Eight Week 3 games are slated for television coverage, including one pay-per-view and one online broadcast.
- In Week 2 the Big 12 had four quarterbacks throw for 300-plus yards, seven receivers and five rushers over the century mark and five double-digit tacklers. Top performances included:

14th Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

The Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship makes its debut in the newly-opened Cowboys Stadium in Arlington, Texas. The 2009 game takes place on Saturday, December 5, at 7:00 p.m. CT and will be nationally televised by ABC.

In 2009, the North representative will be the home team and utilize the home bench which is opposite the press box. Ticket information will be available at a later date.

Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship Winners

In the 13-year history of the event, there have been six different winners. All-time titlists include Texas (1996, 2005), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), Oklahoma (2000, 2002, 2004, 2006, 2007, 2008), Colorado (2001) and Kansas State (2003).

Big 12 Bowl Partners

Again in 2009, the Big 12 will have eight bowl slots guaranteed. With its selection of a Big 12 team in 2008, the Gator Bowl has fulfilled the agreement the Conference has with it and the Sun Bowl of selecting a Big 12 team twice in a four-year period. The Sun Bowl will select a Big 12 team in 2009 - the fourth and final year of the agreement. Following is the 2009 selection order:

Home Win Streaks

Oklahoma owns the nation's longest home win streak at 25. Texas and Texas Tech are tied for sixth with 10 straight victories at home.

Big 12 Heisman Winners

The Big 12 has four Heisman winners in the league's 13-year history, the most of any conference during this time span. A Big 12 player has captured the trophy four of the last 11 seasons: 2008-Sam Bradford (OU); 2003-Jason White (OU); 2001-Eric Crouch (NU); 1998-Ricky Williams (UT).

In 2008, Texas QB Colt McCoy finished second, 122 points behind Bradford, while Texas Tech QB Graham Harrell and WR Michael Crabtree finished fourth and fifth, respectively. This marked the first time in the award's 74-year history four of the top five finishers hailed from the same conference.

Television Partners

ABC begins its 14th season as the conference's national network television partner. The Big 12 also continues its long-standing relationship with FSN for its cable rights. FSN has sublicensed select television games in 2009 to ESPN and Versus.

BCS Sightings

The 2008 season marked the fifth time the Big 12 has advanced two teams to BCS games in the same season (2001, '03, '04, '07, '08). Conference teams have played in 16 BCS games in the 11-year history of the structure, posting a 7-9 mark.

Big 12 Weekly Television Shows

FSN's *Big 12 Showcase* and ESPNU's *Big 12 This Week* are telecast weekly with features on student-athletes, coaches and teams as well as highlights of Conference championships and other events in the league. Check local listings for dates and times.

Big 12 Report will debut on Big12Sports.com Thursday, Sept. 17. The online show, produced by Sam Neumann and hosted by Wendell Barnhouse, will be available every Thursday afternoon. Big 12 Report will feature original programming with news and features on the Conference and its member institutions.

Big 12 Media Preseason Poll

Media covering the conference have correctly predicted the division champions in four of the last six seasons (OU/NU-06, UT/CU-05; OU/KSU-03, CU/OU-02). Overall, the top spot in each division has been accurately picked by the league's media corps 19-of-26 times.

BAYLOR (1-0, 0-0)

This Week: Connecticut

Next Week: Northwestern State

Linebacker Joe Pawelek has at least one interception in four of the last five games; and has created at least one turnover in five of the last six games.

IR Kendall Wright has recorded at least one reception in 13 consecutive games, each game of his career.

Baylor received votes in both the Associated Press and the USA Today Coaches' Poll following its win at Wake Forest. It was BU's first time in the AP since 1998 and the first time since 2005 in the coaches' poll.

Baylor won its 14th season opener on the road and its first since winning at SMU in 2005. It was also the program's first road non-conference victory against a BCS opponent since 1995 at North Carolina State.



COLORADO (0-2, 0-0)

This Week: Wyoming

Next Week: Open

Wide receiver Scotty McKnight extended his streak to 26 games with at least one reception - the school record is 27 games. McKnight tallied 11 receptions, tying the school single-game record.

Cody Hawkins set the CU record for passing attempts in a game with 64, moving him into second place on the all-time attempts list (785). His 30 completions also moved him into second place all-time (486).

Sophomore Darrell Scott set a school record in kickoff returns (8) and kickoff return yardage (204). Scott ranks third in the Conference in kickoff return yardage and first in all-purpose yardage (443).

Linebacker Jeff Smart is tied for fourth in the Big 12 in tackles after his 12-tackle performance at Toledo. Smart has 20 tackles on the season.



IOWA STATE (1-1, 0-0)

This Week: at Kent State

Next Week: Army

Iowa State has reached the 100,000 spectator mark in its first two home games five times in program history, including this season. Iowa State's attendance through two games is 100,920.

Iowa State has a 5-1 record against Kent State, claiming its five victories by an average of 22 points. The Cyclones won their only game at Dix Stadium, 17-14, in 1971.

Alexander Robinson's 100-yard effort against Iowa was the fourth 100-yard game of his ISU career. Robinson ranks fifth in the Big 12 in rushing with 183 yards on 35 carries this season.

Safety David Sims had two interceptions against Iowa and has three for the season. He had a career-high 11 tackles (seven solo).



KANSAS (2-0, 0-0)

This Week: Duke

Next Week: Southern Mississippi

Dating back to last season, Kansas has scored on its opening possession and totaled at least three sacks in four consecutive games. The Jayhawks had five sacks against UTEP.

DE Max Onyegbule was named Big 12 Co-Defensive Player of the Week after registering a career-high and team-high tying six tackles with two sacks and three total tackles for loss vs. UTEP.

Wide receiver Dezmon Briscoe has five consecutive games with 100 or more yards receiving. He has at least two receptions in 20 consecutive games. Senior Kerry Meier has at least two receptions in 23 consecutive contests.

Mark Mangino tied Glen Mason for second on the KU coaches victories list with 47. Mangino's 47th win came in his 88th game, while Mason's was in his 99th game at KU.



KANSAS STATE (1-1, 0-0)

This Week: at UCLA

Next Week: Tennessee Tech

K-State is 3-1 against teams from the state of California under head coach Bill Snyder, although it has not previously faced UCLA. The Wildcats are also on a five-game winning streak against the Pac-10 Conference.

Kansas State successfully converted all three of its tries on fourth down at ULL. Last season the Wildcats converted 18-of-35 fourth down tries.

Running back Daniel Thomas has rushed for a Big 12-leading 240 yards and became the first Wildcat since Cornelius Davis in 1966 to have consecutive 100-yard rushing performances to start his career.

The Wildcats lead the Big 12 in interceptions (3) and pass efficiency defense (78.2) as well as rank second in pass defense (143.5) and fifth in total defense (227.0).



MISSOURI (2-0, 0-0)

This Week: Furman

Next Week: at Nevada (Friday)

Senior linebacker Sean Weatherspoon leads the Big 12 Conference in tackles (12th nationally) with 23, including a 14-tackle outing last Saturday against Bowling Green.

Mizzou is 8-0 all-time against teams from the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS), and head coach Gary Pinkel is 5-0.

Missouri trailed 13-6 at halftime against Bowling Green. It was Missouri's first victory in a regular-season game when trailing at halftime since a 41-38 triple overtime victory at Oklahoma State in 2001 (trailed 14-6).

The attendance of 65,401 was the largest for a home opener since 1978 when 73,655 witnessed the Alabama game.



NEBRASKA (2-0, 0-0)

This Week: at Virginia Tech

Next Week: UL-Lafayette

Nebraska has won six consecutive games, the longest winning streak for the Cornhuskers since winning 13 straight games over the 2000 and 2001 seasons.

The Huskers have passed for at least 200 yards in 20 straight games since 2007. The 358 passing yards against Arkansas State ranked 10th in school history.

Nebraska and Virginia Tech will meet for the third time with the series locked 1-1. Last season, the Hokies won 35-30. The two met in 1996 at the Orange Bowl, when Nebraska won 41-21.

In last season's VT game, NU passed for 278 yards compared to the Hokies' 171 yards. Senior TE Mike McNeil caught three passes for 66 yards and a touchdown.



OKLAHOMA (1-1, 0-0)

This Week: Tulsa

Next Week: Open

Oklahoma will host Tulsa in their 24th meeting. OU leads the series 15-7-1 and has won the last four contests, including a 62-21 victory at Tulsa in 2007. OU has won eight straight over in-state competition.

In 2007 against Tulsa, the offense produced 553 total offensive yards (285 rush/268 pass). DeMarco Murray rushed for 46 yards and 2 TDs. The Sooner defense held Tulsa to just 44 yards rushing.

The Sooners have won 25 consecutive games at home, tying a school record while currently leading the nation.

Landry Jones passed for three touchdowns and 286 yards against Idaho State (18-for-32), tying for the fourth-most passing yards by a freshman QB in program history.



OKLAHOMA STATE (1-1, 0-0)

This Week: Rice

Next Week: Grambling State

Oklahoma State hosts its third straight home game and second straight Conference USA opponent. OSU leads the series with Rice 2-0-1. It's last meeting was in 1923 when the Cowboys won 13-0 in Houston.

The Cowboys are 15-5 against non-conference competition under Mike Gundy.

OSU's Dez Bryant and Perrish Cox have combined for 315 yards on 11 returns this season. Bryant returned a 82-yard punt for a touchdown against Houston, earning Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Week.

Bryant has scored a touchdown in five straight games with 11 touchdowns in his last seven games. He has 30 career touchdowns and his 27 TD receptions rank No. 2 among active NCAA players.



TEXAS (2-0, 0-0)

This Week: Texas Tech

Next Week: UTEP

Texas will host Texas Tech for their 59th meeting in an early conference game covered by ESPN College GameDay. The Horns lead the series 43-15. UT is 27-5 at home against TTU and has won all five home matchups in the Mack Brown era.

UT is 60-6 at home under Mack Brown, including 29-1 against in-state opponents. The Horns are 7-4 overall with the GameDay crew in attendance.

Colt McCoy has thrown for a touchdown in 19 consecutive games, tying the school record held by Major Applewhite.

DT Lamarr Houston was named Big 12 Co-Defensive Player of the Week after posting four tackles, two tackles for loss, a sack, and five QB pressures against Wyoming.



TEXAS A&M (1-0, 0-0)

This Week: Utah State

Next Week: UAB

Texas A&M recorded 606 yards of total offense against New Mexico, 245 rushing and 361 passing, to lead the Big 12 and rank No. 6 nationally. It tied for the 11th-most in school history.

Jerrold Johnson's 406 total yards, 57 rushing and 349 passing, against New Mexico rank No. 1 in the Big 12 and No. 3 in the NCAA in total offense.

Junior Von Miller leads the Big 12 and the nation in sacks with three.

Sophomore receiver Jeff Fuller caught a career-high 10 passes for a career-best 111 yards and one touchdown vs. New Mexico. His previous bests were eight receptions against Iowa State and 95 yards against Iowa State and Colorado.



TEXAS TECH (2-0, 0-0)

This Week: at Texas

Next Week: at Houston

Texas Tech won last year's matchup over Texas 39-33 in Lubbock. It was the program's first win over a No. 1 ranked team and led to Tech's highest program ranking at No. 2/3.

The Red Raiders own a 9-4 record in Big 12 openers on the road.

Taylor Potts became the first Tech Tech quarterback to throw for at least seven touchdowns in a game since B.J. Symons threw eight against Texas A&M in 2003. He was named Big 12 Offensive Player of the Week.

With the win against Rice, Mike Leach (78-39) is now five wins away from becoming the school's all time wins leader which is currently held by Spike Dykes with 82.
