

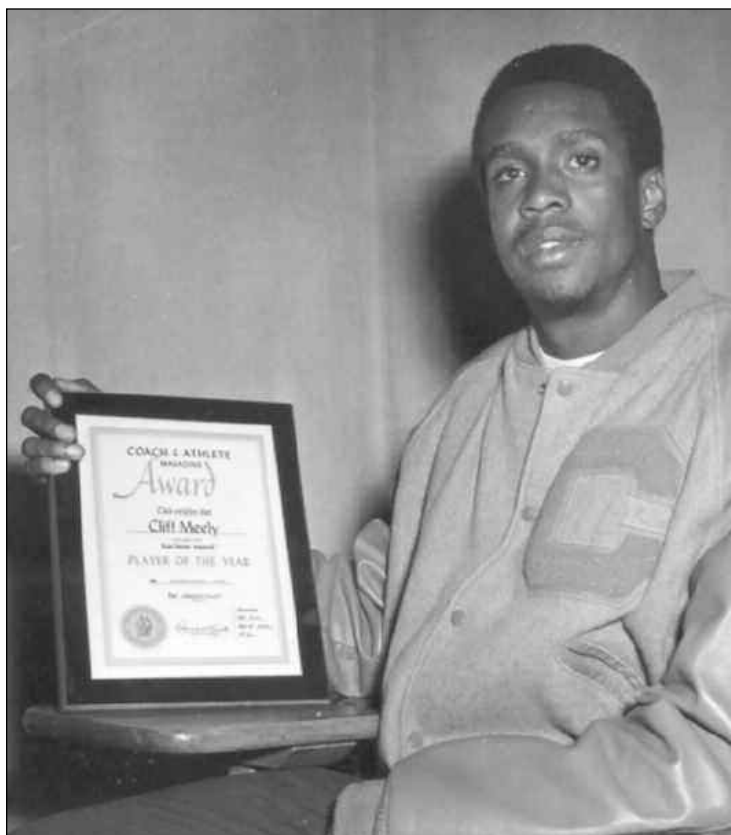
SCORING

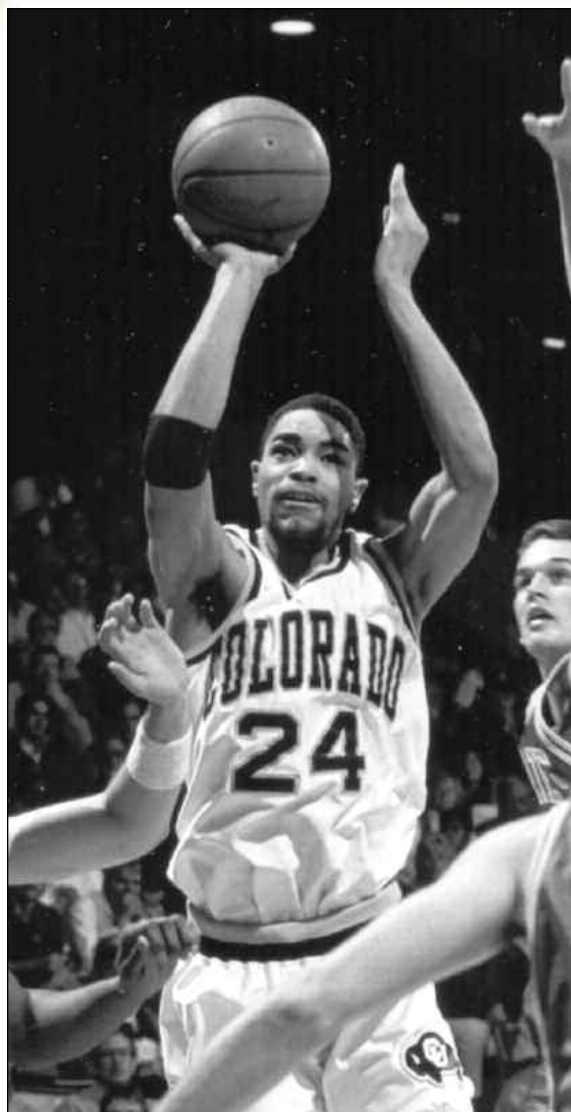
Cliff Meely holds Colorado's all-time single-game and single-season scoring records. In only three seasons, Meely tallied the second most double-doubles with 54.

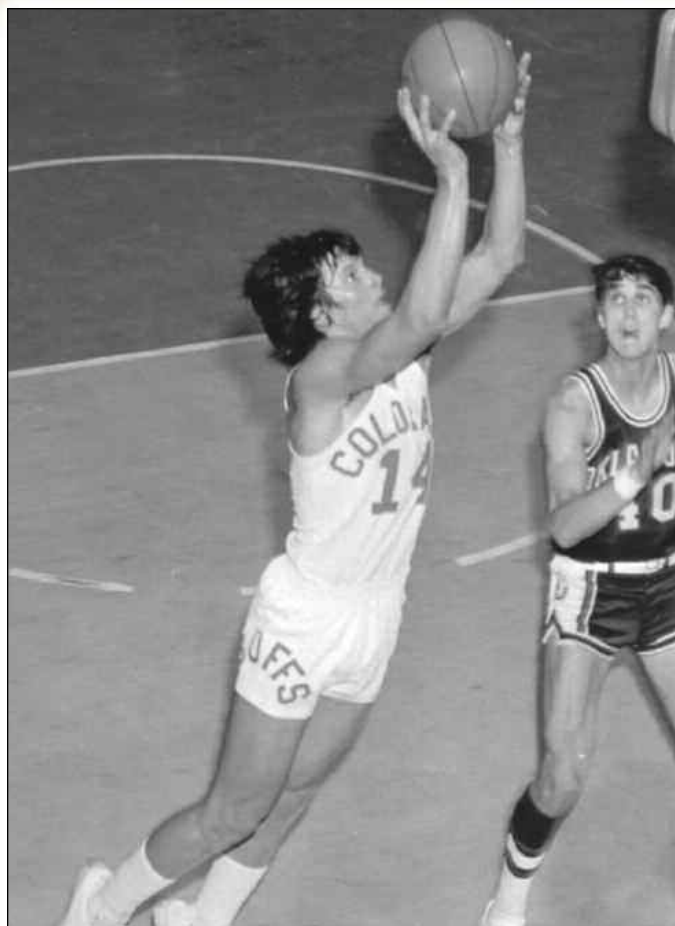
