BOULDER, Colo., Mar. - Here are the post-season statistical wrapups on the 1959 Colorado basketball squad as Coach Sox Walseth turned in another classy job.

Walseth's Buffs, tabbed for last-place in pre-season polls covering the Big 8, built a nifty 14-10 record, finished in a third-place tie with Kansas - both with 8-6 marks, and reached the 14-victory mark, a feat accomplished three other times since World War II.

Top men in the statistical columns were senior stalwarts Gerry Schroeder and Don Walker.

Schroeder topped the team in scoring, catching Walker with a 23-point barrage in the finale against Oklahoma - many of those points set up by Walker's passing and screening, incidentally. The Westminster guard popped in 321 points, six more than Walker got. His career total is 813, third best in Colorado history.

That total, by the way, ups Schroeder's record for points by a CU guard in a season. He had set it with his 304 a year ago. Schroeder was a first-team All-Big Eight selection on both AP and UPI votings and will play in the University of Maryland All-Star game at College Park, Md. Mar. 25 and at the Shrine East-West game in Kansas City, Mo., Mar. 28.

Walker topped the Buffs in rebounding with 204. The 6-6 Beverly Hills, Calif. senior was named to the All-Big 8 second five by both the AP and UPI.

BOULDER, Colo., Mar. - No collegiate competition is due for Colorado's ski team this weekend as the Buffs prepare for the NCAA championships following last weekend's upset win over Denver in the Rocky Mountain Intercollegiate Ski Association meet at Gunnisog.

In toppling the favored Pioneers, the Buffs led all the way and added frosting to the cake with their first cross country win over the DU squad.
