Wrapping up the Colorado basketball season...

'T WAS A LONG YEAR: Colorado's Buffaloes set a school record in longevity, playing nearly a game and a half more than their regular 24-game schedule as they struggled through 11 overtime periods in five extra-session games. The Buff overtime record was 2-3, in this order: defeated Iowa 76-68 in 2 ot's; lost to Oklahoma 62-64 in 2 ot's; whipped Nebraska 62-57 in 1 ot; lost to Iowa State 80-83 in 5 ot's; and lost to Oklahoma again 61-63 in 1 ot. Causing Coach Sox Walseth to comment, after being given a 6-year contract extending through 1966, "If these things keep up I'll never live that long."

JAVERNICK SETS NEW MARATHON RECORD: Forward Frank Javernick played the entire 65 minutes in the Iowa State marathon, a new Colorado record and possibly a Big 8 mark for playing time in one game. Javernick hit a personal career high of 27 points in the game.

GILMORE SOARS HIGH ON CU SCORING LIST: Colorado sophomore Forward Wilky Gilmore's 334 points moves him to fourth place on the Buffalo seasonal scoring list. His total has been topped only by Burdette Halderson's 524 and 367 and Art Bunte's 402. Bunte's total came as a sophomore, too, although he had played varsity ball as a frosh the previous year.
