Wrapping It Up:

This was only the second team in CU history to win 19 games. The other was the 1955 team which did 19-6.....Four records fell during the season, one team and three individual. The Buffs hit .4111 from the field to barely beat the old field goal percentage mark of .4109 set in 1955. Center Jim Davis' .502 field goal percentage is the best ever by a Buff, topping the old mark of .487 by Wilky Gilmore last year. Forward Ken Charlton got two marks - his 19 free throws against Missouri and his total of 172 free throws for the season.

Wilky Gilmore became the second highest career scorer in CU history, winding up with 1026 points in three years. Charlton's 498 points is the second highest seasonal total. Charlton's 238 free throws is the fourth highest total in CU history.

When Gilmore and Charlton were named to the All-Big 8 team it was only the second time CU placed two men on the first five. Burdette Halderson and Bob Jeangerard were the first double in 1955.

Colorado is the only school which has been able to crack the Kansas State-Kansas stranglehold on the Big 8 basketball title during the last 12 seasons. During that period, Kansas State has won five crowns outright and tied for another, Kansas has won three and shared two, and Colorado has won two and shared one.
