Coach Joe Harrington on:

RECRUIT GREG JENSEN: "I was really happy we were able to sign such a quality player late in the recruiting season. Potentially, he has the chance to become a great college player. He rounds out a good freshmen class - we're excited he chose Colorado. He'll give us much added depth inside."

THE LEAGUE AS A WHOLE: "There's more balance in the Big Eight this year than any year I've been at Colorado. The league has a lot of good, young players - it's a strong conference."

THE BUFFS SCHEDULE: "We have an excellent schedule for our very young team. We'll be tested early with games at Colorado State, against Wyoming at home and versus LaSalle in the Mile High Classic.
