## Big 12 honors CU keeper Linder

Kara Linder gave the Colorado soccer team an early lead in the Big 12 standings and members of the conference noticed.

The Buffs` senior goalkeeper was named the Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week for games played over opening weekend on Tuesday.

Linder led CU to a 1-0 victory against then-No. 11 Oklahoma State in the Buffs` season opener Saturday. Linder made three saves for the seventh shutout of her career.

The Big 12 honor is Linder`s second. She was tabbed Newcomer of the Week on Aug. 28, 2006, during her freshman season.

Also Tuesday, Colorado checked in at No. 18 in the National Soccer Coaches Association of America Top-25 Poll. The Buffs are ranked second in the Central Region, behind Texas A&M.

After opening with a Big 12 game, CU will take a break from conference play. The Buffs are slated to play No. 13 Illinois on Friday at 4 p.m. on the University of Denver campus. CU will face St. Mary's on Sunday at 11 a.m. in the DU Invitational.

Broomfield's Steve Ziegler, a junior on the Stanford men's golf team, was among 60 players to qualify for today's start of match play at the U. S. Amateur in Oklahoma. His 2-over-par 72 on the Southern Hills Country Club course in Tulsa, Okla., moved him up into a tie for 20th place at 5-over 145, five strokes behind the leader.

Colorado senior Justin Bardgett, who tied for 61st at 8-over 148, will be part of a 27-player playoff today for four remaining match-play spots. Tom Whitney of the Air Force Academy and Aurora's Gunner Wiebe fell out of contention on the second day and missed the cut.

Tim Jackson shot a second-round 72 to leave him at even par and earn medalist honors. The 50-year-old became the oldest player in the history of the tournament to lead after stroke play. Jackson, a two-time USGA Mid-Amateur champion and the 36-hole leader at this year's U. S. Senior Open, played the second day at Cedar Ridge Country Club in Broken Arrow, Okla., while being regularly outdriven by more than 30 yards by his younger opponents.
