# Here's your chance to see Tyler Hansen up close

Good news for Buffs football fans: all spring practices are open to the public.

Drills begin Saturday with a two-hour practice beginning at 10 a.m.

Cell phones, pets and video cameras are prohibited. Anyone taking notes or photos must be credentialed media.

Seven practices are scheduled before the March 20-28 spring break and eight practices will be after the break.

The spring game is Saturday, April 10, with a 1:30 kickoff in Folsom Field.

The primary location for spring drills will be the football practice fields north of Boulder Creek. The team could move inside the bubble during inclement weather, in which case further restrictions could affect spectator access.

# Buff spring practices to be open to public

## First workout set for Saturday

Colorado football officials announced Monday that all of the Buffs' spring practices will be open to the public, with some restrictions involved.

The Buffs open spring drills on Saturday and will conclude with the spring game on April 10 at 1:30 p.m. CU will hold eight practices before the school's spring break (March 20-28), with the final seven scheduled for April.

All practices will be open to the public and media, and all members of the media will be required to wear their CU media credentials. Only credentialed media members will be allowed to take notes, photos and video. Cell phones, pets and video cameras (except those used by media members) will not be allowed.

CU officials also noted that other restrictions may take effect if the team is forced inside the practice bubble because of inclement weather.

The Buffs are allowed 15 practices over 34 days (not including spring break). CU may hold three practices in shorts (no contact), four in pads (no tackling), four in pads (tackling allowed 50 percent or less of the time) and four in pads (tackling allowed throughout).

Also, CU's pro timing day is scheduled for March 10. That event is open to the media but not the public.

Below is CU's spring schedule. Times and dates are subject to change.
