Colorado-led U.S. ski squad wins five medals at World University Games

Also, the Wyoming nordic team finished ninth in the men's sprint relay and 11th in the women's last week.

A Colorado-heavy United States ski squad took home four golds and a silver at the World University Games, which wrapped Sunday in Erzurum, Turkey.

"This is the most decorated American group of skiers we've ever had representing the United States at these games," University of Colorado coach Richard Rokos, who was coaching the U.S. squad, said in a statement.

University of Denver skiers won three of the Americans' four gold medals, including senior Seppi Stiegler (men's slalom), freshman Sterling Grant (women's slalom) and sophomore Jennie VanWagner (women's giant slalom). CU's Katie Hartman won the women's super-G.

Stiegler also won silver in the men's alpine overall.
