CU's Boyle on bubble talk: "We have to win."

Speaking Monday on the Big 12 coaches teleconference, Colorado men's basketball coach Tad Boyle said his team needs to win in regard to its bubble status for an NCAA Tournament bid.

Colorado (19-12, 8-8 Big 12) secured the No. 5 seed for the Big 12 Tournament and will open Wednesday with a 1 p.m. game against No. 12 seeded Iowa State (16-15, 3-13). The winner will face fourth-seeded Kansas State on Thursday.

As it stands today, ESPN's Joe Lunardi has the Buffaloes as one of the "last teams in" for the 68-team field of the NCAA Tournament.

"I think we have to win," Boyle said, "(but) I'm not saying we have to win the whole thing (Big 12 Tournament)."

Boyle said he prefers not to try to politic for his team. He said Colorado's season and its accomplishments speak for themselves.

"I like to coach; I don't like to be a politician," Boyle said. "We have shown we're capable of beating good teams. That's what you want in an NCAA Tournament — teams that can play good teams tough."
